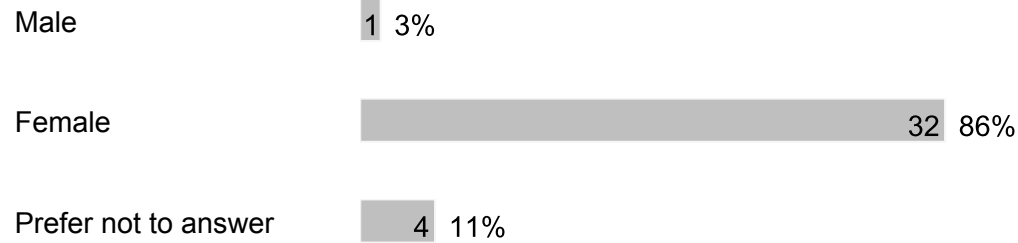

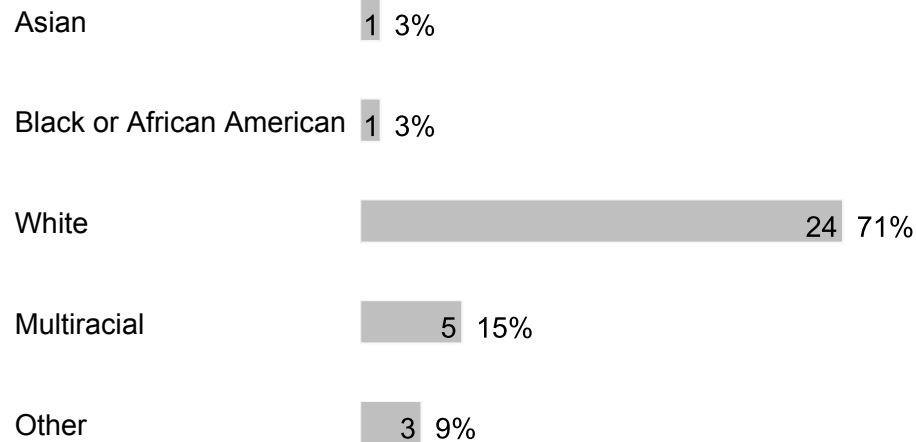

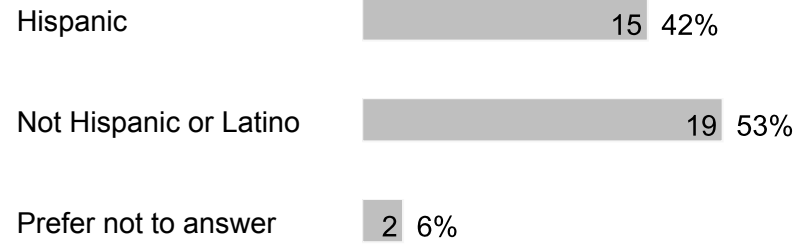

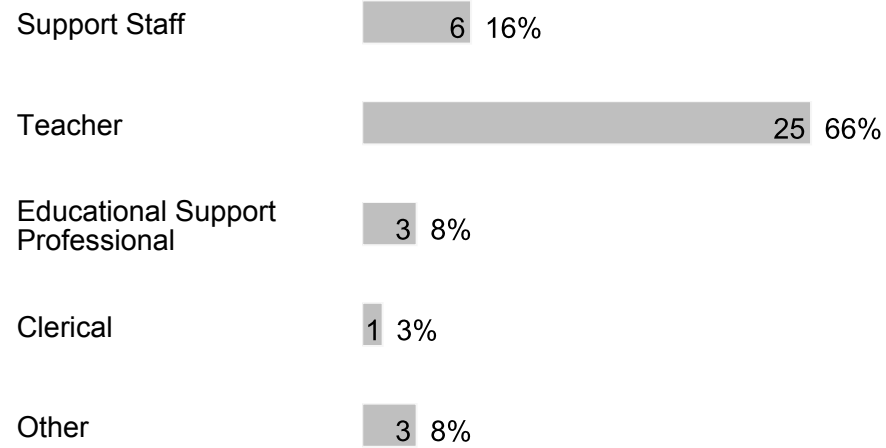

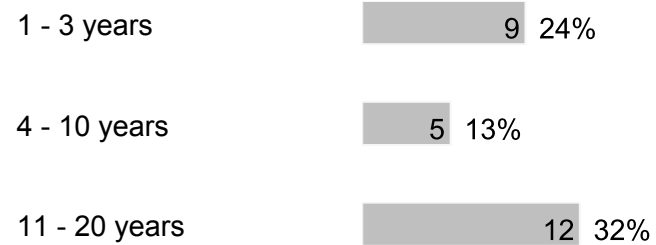

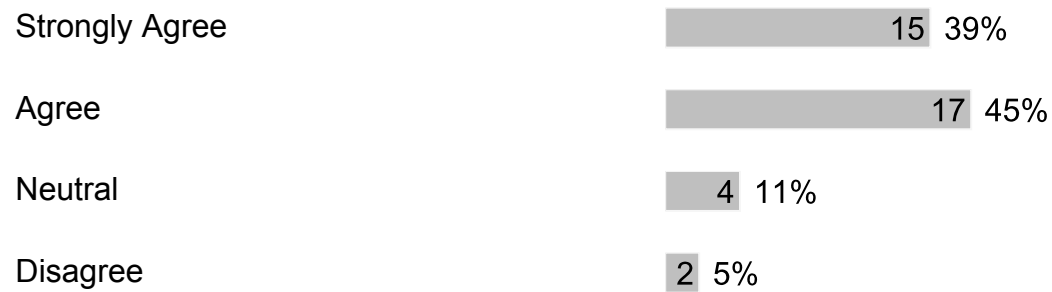

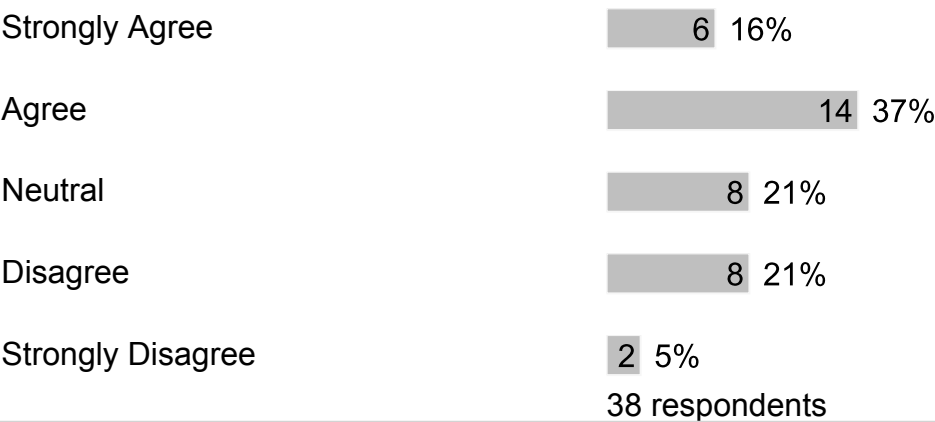

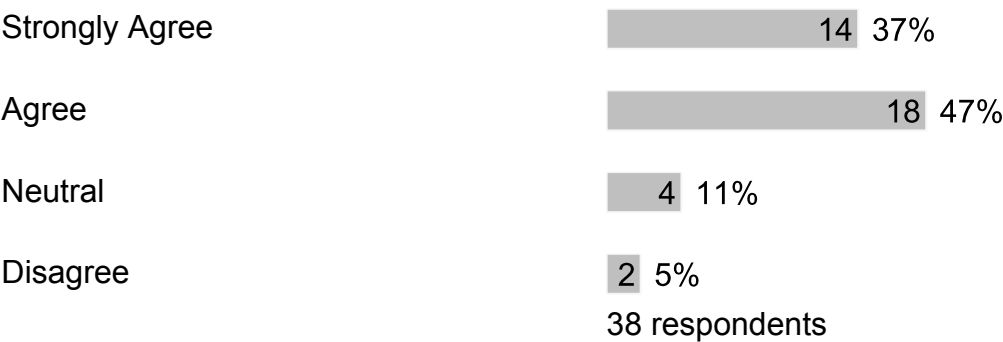

1. Our school provides teachers with sufficient instructional material and informational resources to meet students' needs.

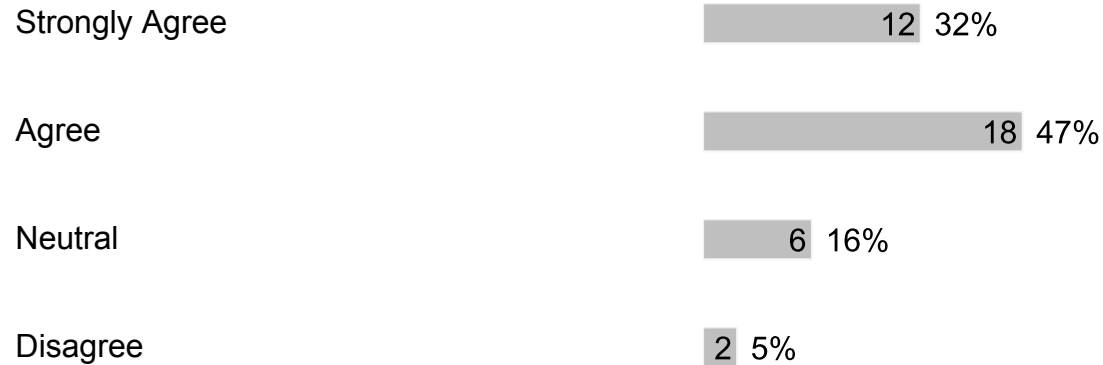

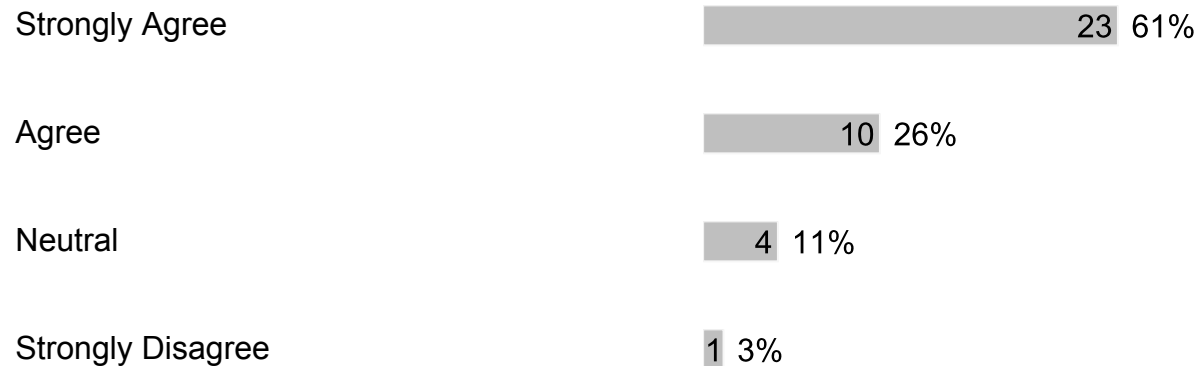

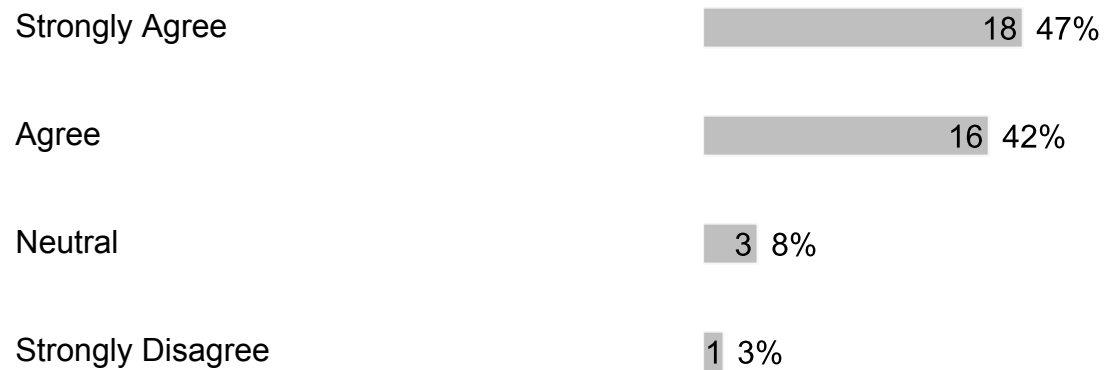

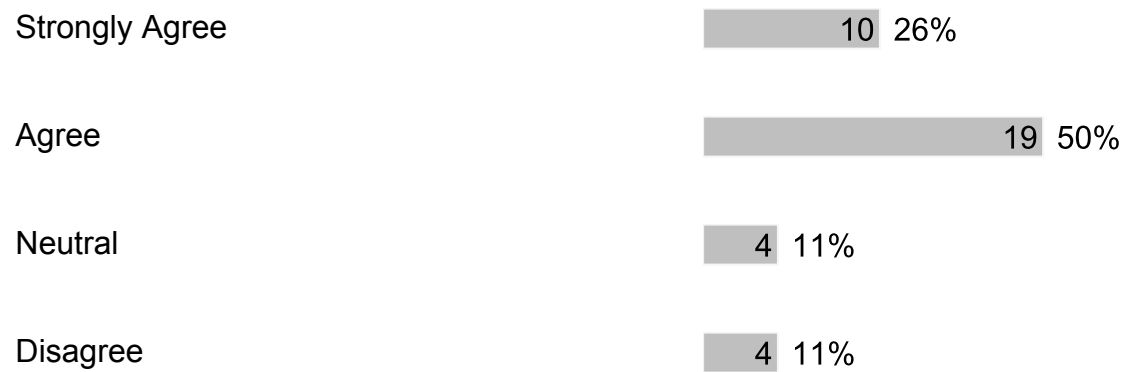

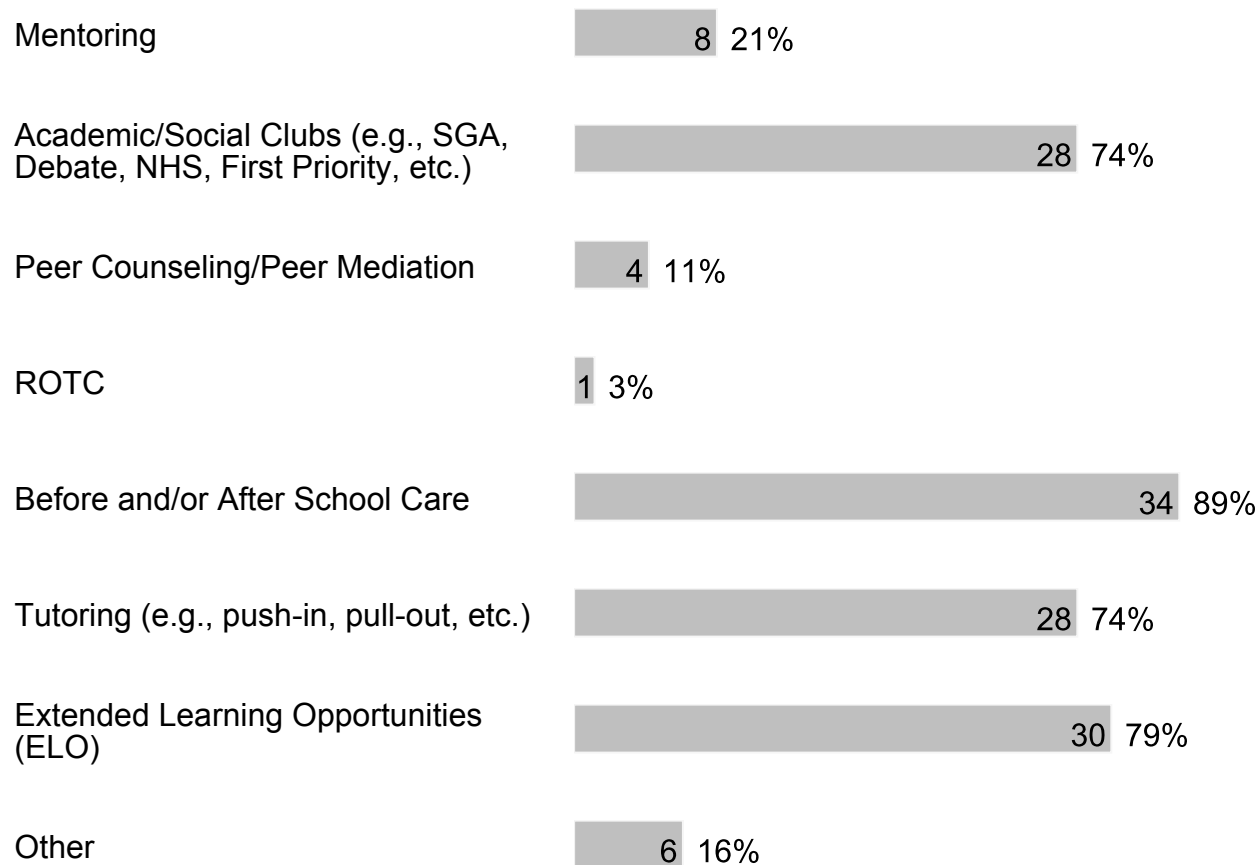

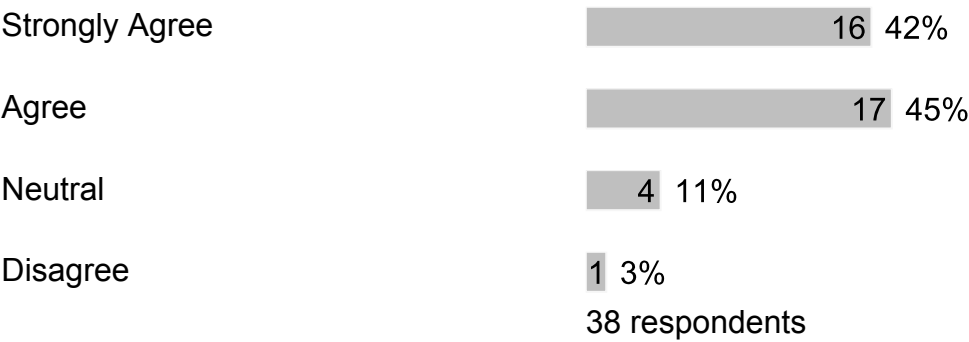

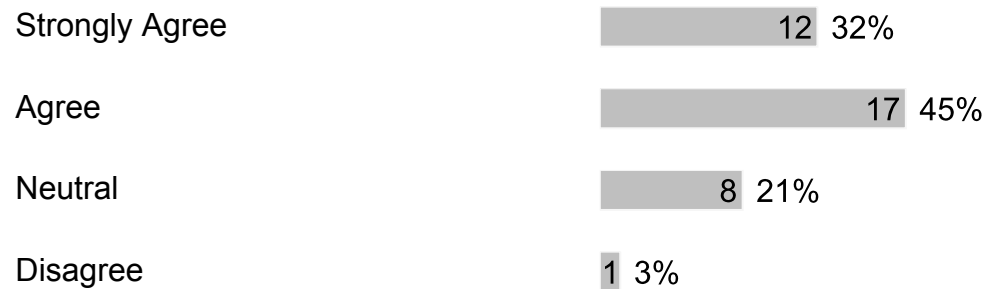

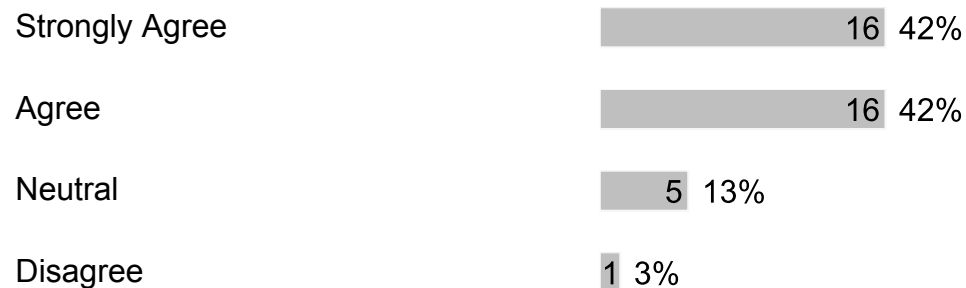

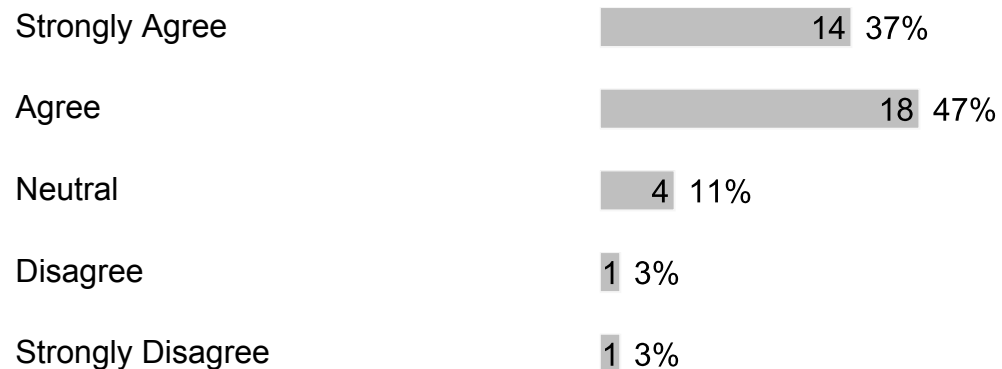

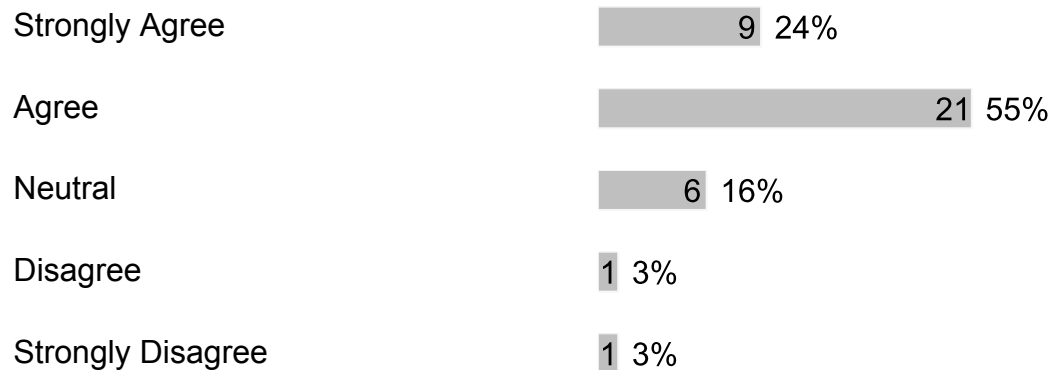

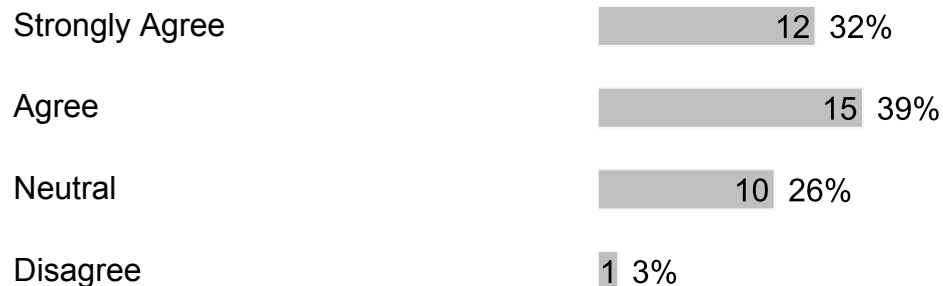

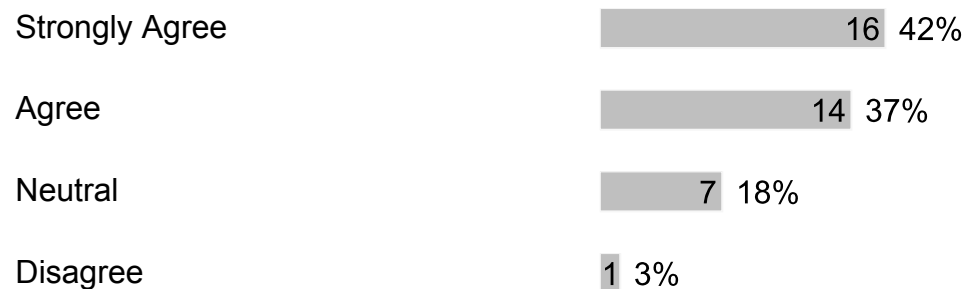

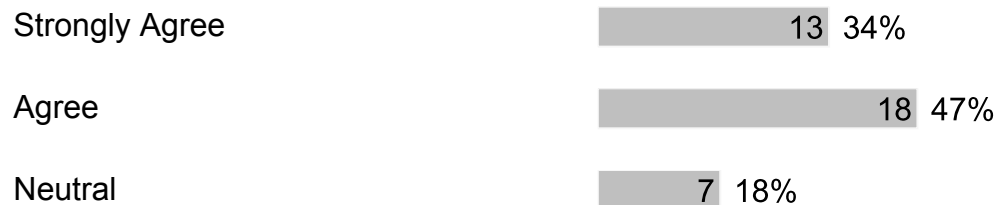

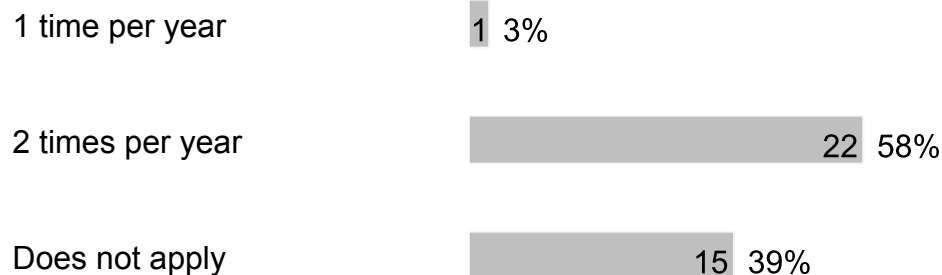
