















**20. During the school year, I participated in alcohol, other drug or tobacco prevention activities or lessons.**





**22.** In your opinion, what percentage of Broward County students in grades 6 - 12 choose not to drink alcohol?





**24.** At what age is a human brain fully developed?


















**12. I enjoy eating food prepared by the cafeteria.**








