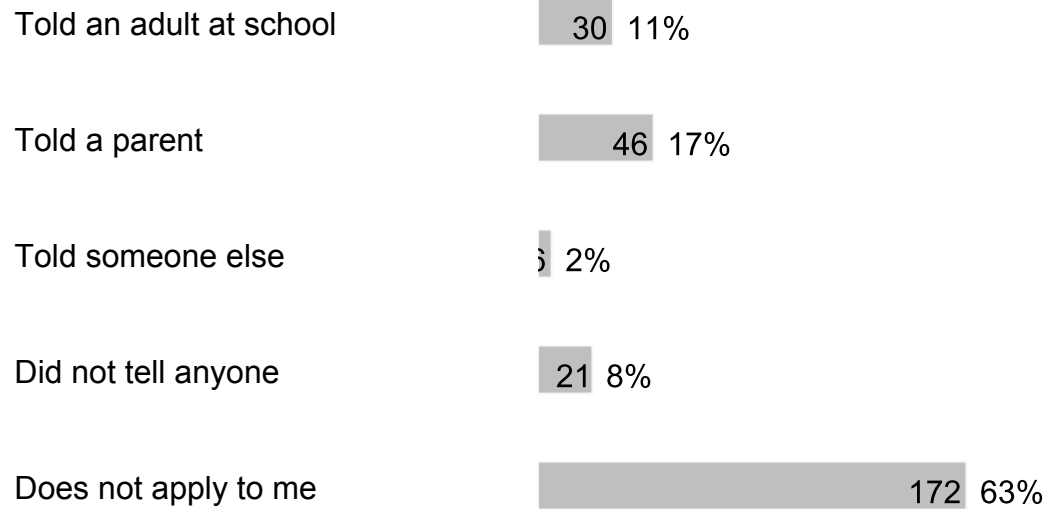

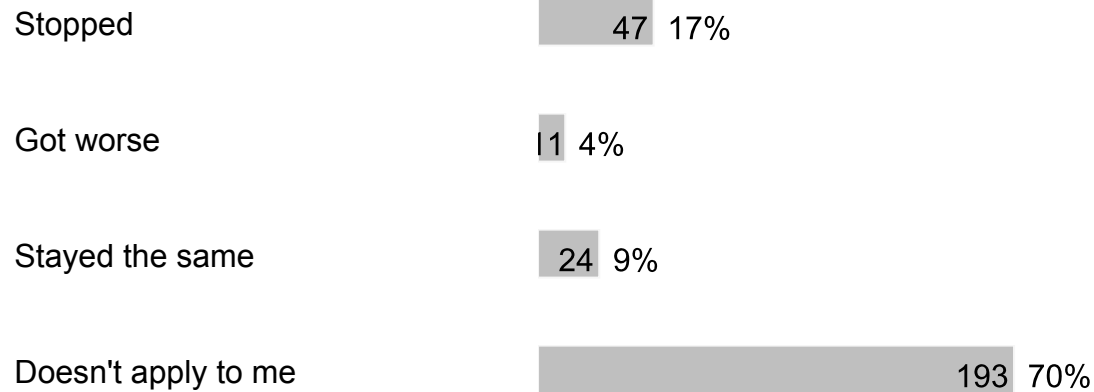

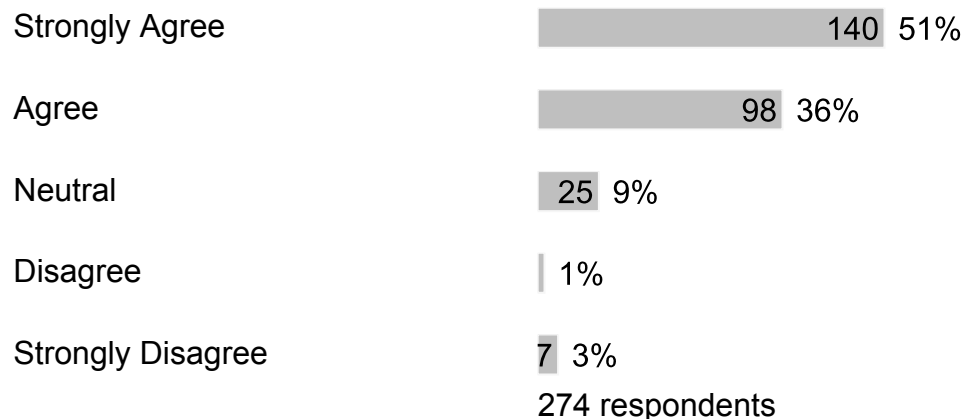

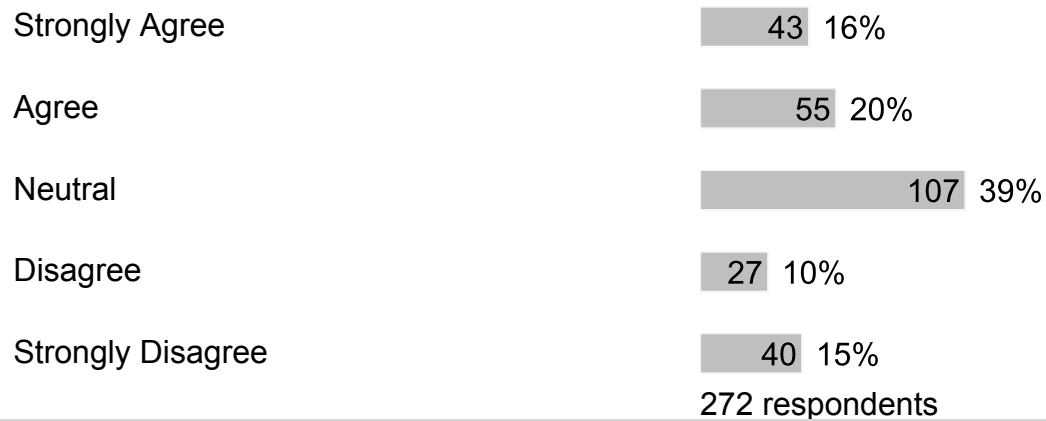

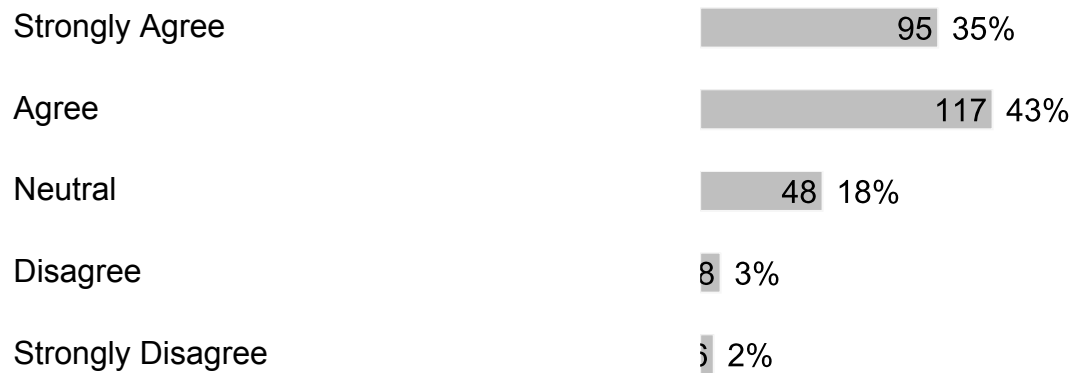

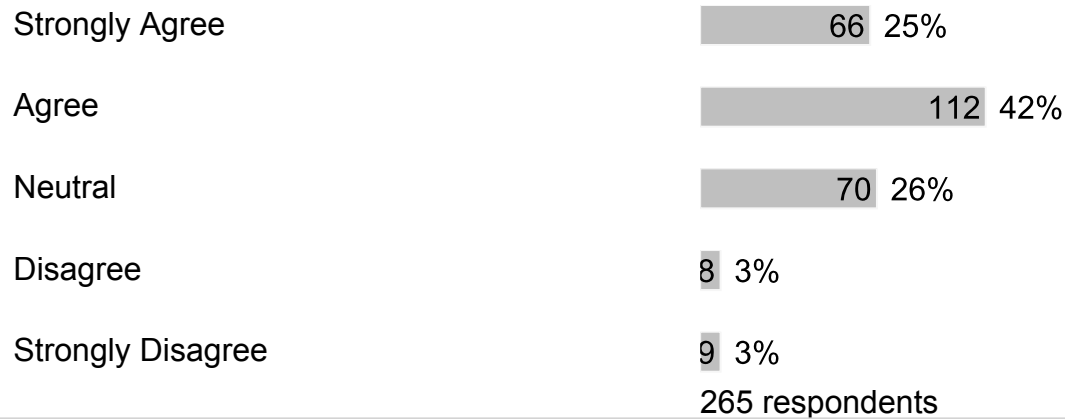

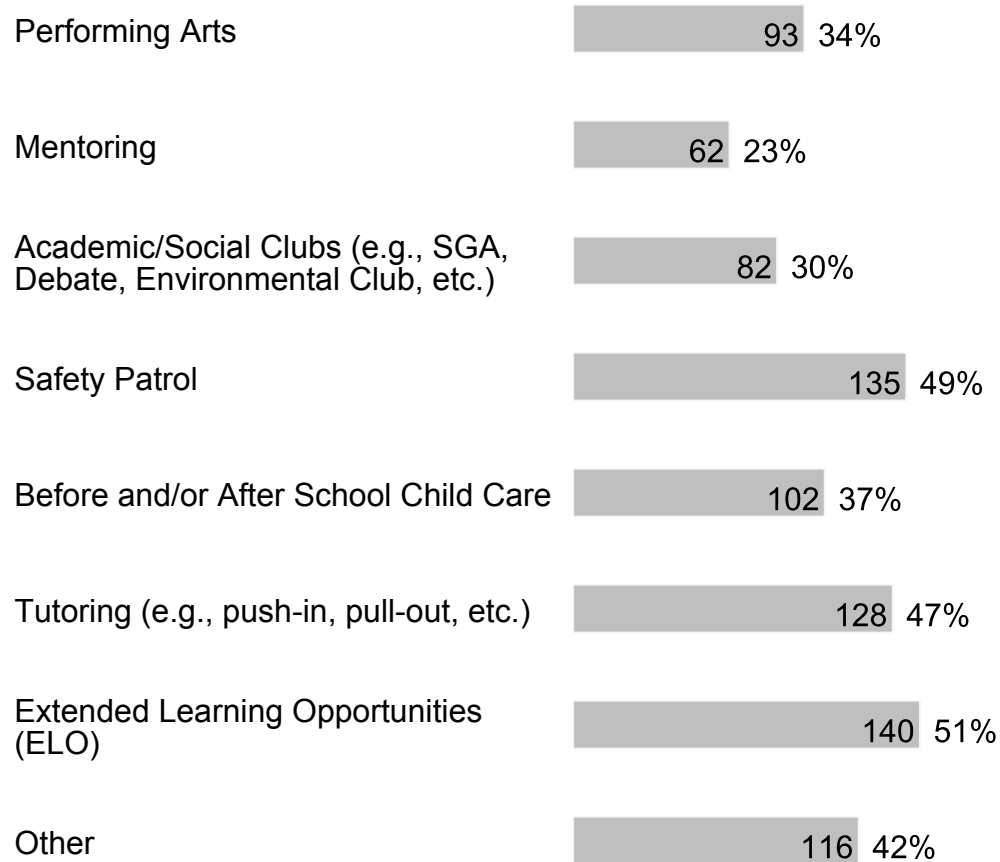


12. I receive acknowledgement and/or praise for my strengths or accomplishments by adults at my school.



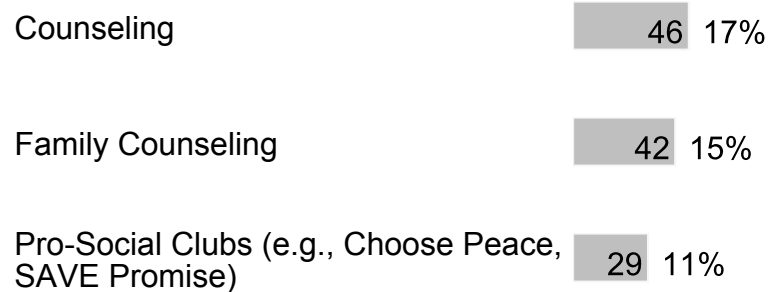

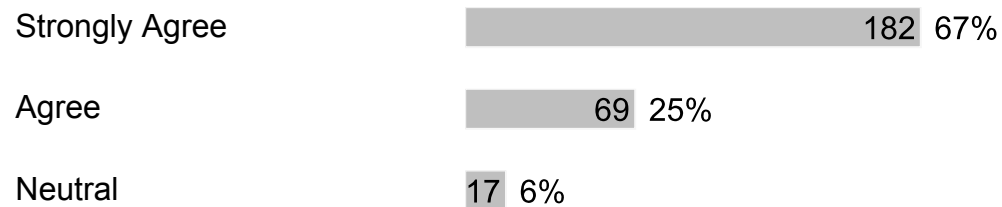

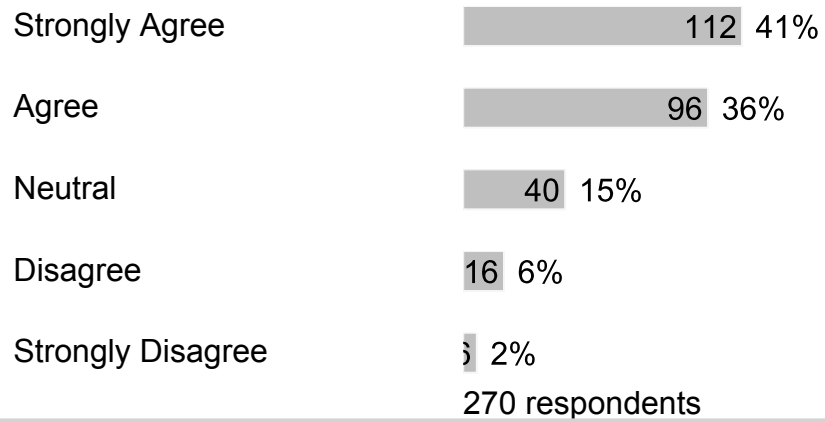

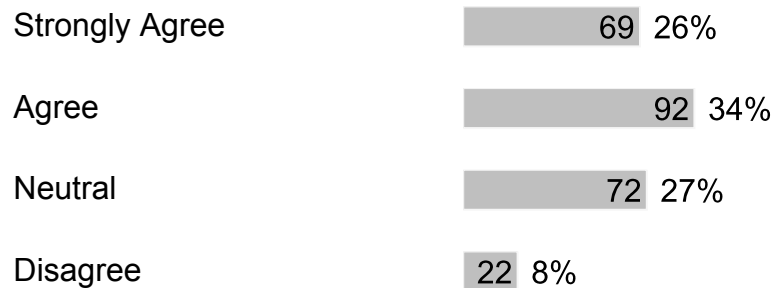
