These challenges often affect student performance in school, and counseling can help the student function more effectively at school, at home and in the community.

The Family Counseling Centers are staffed with master's or doctoral level, licensed therapists who have extensive experience in individual and family counseling. Services are available in English, Spanish, Portuguese and Haitian Creole.

Services

The Family Counseling Program provides short-term individual and family counseling to help address challenges across a number of areas including:

- Significant family issues including communication, divorce/separation, abandonment, parenting skills, abuse, and bereavement/loss.
- Social issues including self-esteem, bullying, peer pressure, and conflict resolution.
- Emotional issues such as anxiety/depression, crisis intervention, trauma, anger management, stress management, and mild substance misuse.
- School-related issues including study skills, school anxiety/phobia, attention deficit disorder, attendance, and behavioral issues in class.

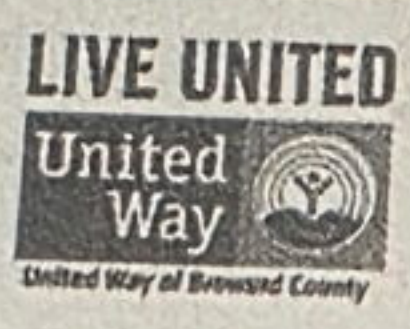

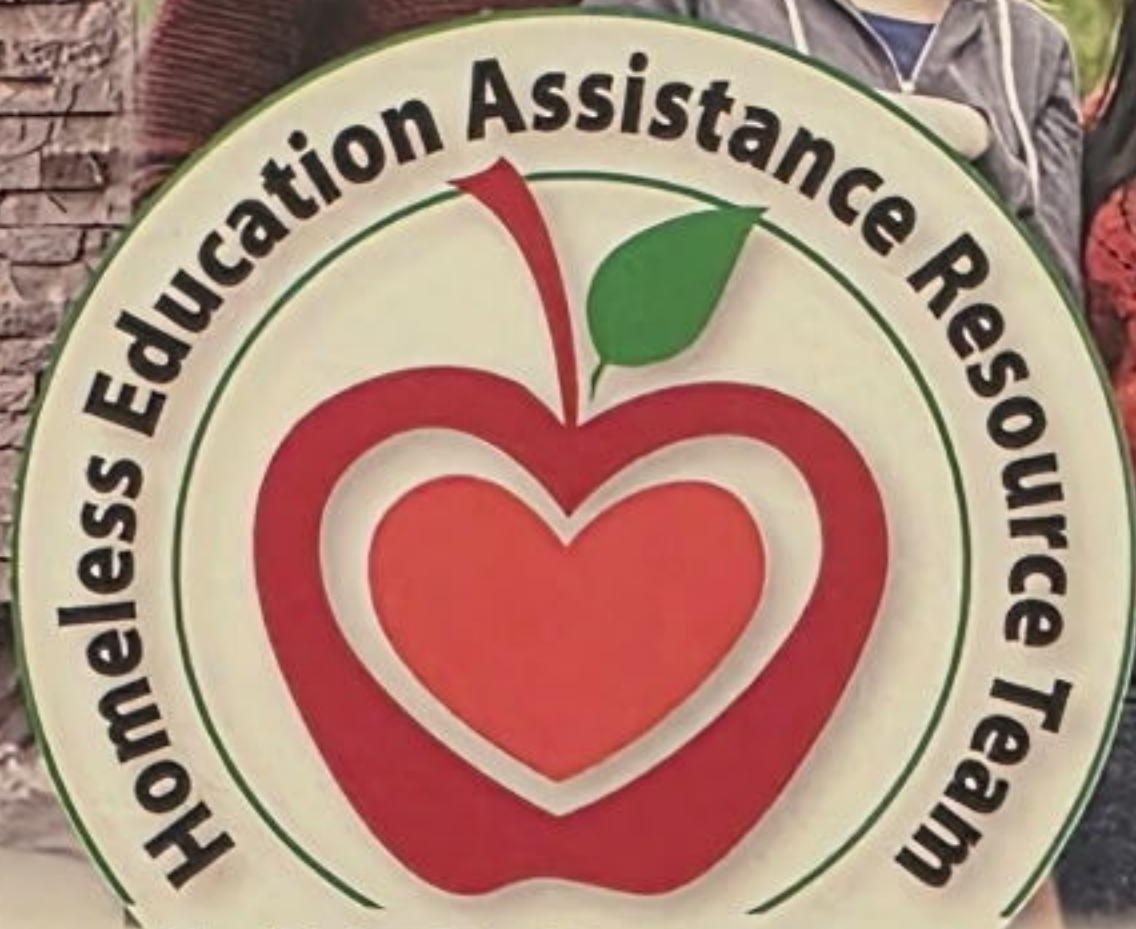

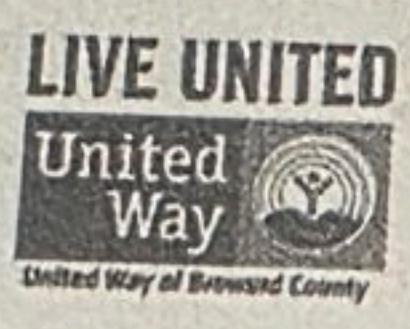

Health & Wellness Support

Q. How is Children's Medicaid eligibility different from other Florida KidCare programs? *Medicaid* eligibility depends on the child's age along with household income and household size. Florida KidCare checks all applications for Medicaid eligibility. If a child qualifies, by federal law he or she enrolls in Florida KidCare *Medicaid*, not in another KidCare program. No interview is needed.

Q. How often does Florida KidCare re-determine eligibility? What is the process? All children in Florida KidCare have at least 12 months of continuous coverage, if monthly premiums are paid. Continuous coverage is different for Medicaid. (*Children's Medicaid* has no premiums.) Children under five years of age in *Medicaid* have twelve months of continuous coverage. For *Medicaid* reviews, families use the simple, mail-in application form. For the other programs, families are sent their file information and notify Florida KidCare if anything has changed. No personal visits are required.

Benefits

The Florida KidCare program offers families peace of mind through its child health insurance program. Eligible uninsured children under age 19 receive a full array of comprehensive health benefits.

All Florida KidCare programs use selected doctors, hospitals, therapists, or health plans to provide services. In some parts of the state, you may choose from more than one health plan or HMO.

Some covered benefits/services are:

- Doctor visits
- Check-ups
- Shots
- Hospital
- Surgery
- Prescriptions
- Vision
- Hearing
- Behavioral health
- Referred services
- Emergencies
- Dental services

Cost

- There is no cost for *Children's Medicaid*.
- For the other Florida KidCare programs, most families pay a premium of \$15 or \$20 per month-no matter how many children are enrolled (if income eligible).
- *Healthy Kids* families also pay small co-payments of \$5 to \$10 for some medical services, such as prescriptions.
- Florida KidCare has a Full Premium option for some of its components. Call the local office at (954) 467-8737 for the full premium cost.

Q. Do I send money with the application? How much? To save time, you may send \$20 with your application. This is the child's first month premium. Getting coverage quickly is good for your child. However, sending money with the application is not a requirement.

Q. If my child is not eligible, or is eligible for Medicaid, will I get the \$20 back? Yes. You will receive a letter from Florida KidCare with a refund. Note: If you are ineligible only because your income is too high, you can enroll in *Healthy Kids* by paying a full premium. Florida KidCare will give you that choice, if you do not choose the full premium option; the \$20.00 will be refunded.

Q. What happens if I miss a payment? The premium is due on the first day of the month. If we don't receive payment, coverage is cancelled. Then, by law, you must wait at least 30 days and pay premium before your child can be re-enrolled.

Q. Are there deductibles for Florida KidCare? No.

Applying and Enrolling

- One Florida KidCare application to apply to all 4 programs
- Application process can take up to 8 weeks
- Florida KidCare application can also be completed online at www.FloridaKidCare.org
- All applications are sent to Tallahassee; county coordinators do not have access to the state system. Applications are valid for 120 days.
- IF parent/guardian receives a letter, contact the number provided on the letter for further information
- IF an application is not completed correctly, sections left blank, or not legible - it may not be processed
- Attach a current W-2 form, or four weeks of pay check stubs to the application, as proof of income
