Community Partnership Plan (2025–2026)

Purpose

As a designated **Community Partnership School**, Hallandale Magnet High School is committed to leveraging strong partnerships to support students, families, and the greater Hallandale community. Through collaboration with **United Way** and other stakeholders, the school ensures families have access to resources, support services, and engagement opportunities that enhance student success and family well-being.

Key Focus Areas

1. Health & Wellness Support

- Collaborate with United Way and community health partners to provide information on local medical, mental health, and dental clinics.
- Feature wellness workshops and resource flyers on the **FACE SPACE wall**.
- Explore partnerships for on-campus screenings and parent wellness nights.

2. Food Security Resources

- Continue United Way-supported events such as **Family Crock Pot Night**, hosted in conjunction with the School Advisory Council (SAC), to bring families together around food and culture.
- Share flyers and applications for local food pantries, SNAP enrollment assistance, and weekend food programs.

3. Housing & Financial Support

- Provide updated information on housing assistance programs, job readiness resources, and budgeting/tax workshops.
- United Way's network of financial empowerment programs will be shared through FACE SPACE to connect families with direct services.

4. Learning Opportunities

- Highlight ESOL classes, GED programs, and United Way-sponsored **parent workshops** on literacy, leadership, and workforce skills.
- Expand family engagement through shared professional learning opportunities and training aligned with the school's Community Partnership goals.

5. Family Support Services

- Showcase United Way volunteer programs for mentoring, tutoring, and afterschool enrichment.
- Promote school-based supports such as childcare for evening events, sports sign-ups, and parent coaching sessions.

6. School Engagement Opportunities

- Encourage family participation in **SAC, PTA, and volunteer initiatives**.
- Showcase opportunities for involvement in United Way drives, school supply giveaways, and annual events like Freshman Invasion and the Black History Museum & Literary Fair.
