

### 5 Keys to a Calmer Mind



- Breathe Deeply:** Take a moment to relax. Inhale for 3 seconds. Hold for 3 seconds. Exhale for 3 seconds.
- Check-in with your feelings:** How are you feeling right now? It's okay to feel this way.
- Take a Break:** When things get tough, step away for a short break. Recharge and return stronger.
