

Seagull Alternative High School is a center school located in Fort Lauderdale. Originally Seagull School was for parenting and pregnant girls. Because of this distinction, Seagull Alternative High School is one of only a few schools in Broward County to have a licensed day care center on site. Students with children can bring their child to school and have their child cared for while they attend classes. Today, Seagull continues to serve pregnant girls, however, now we serve parenting males as well.

Our current enrollment Pre-K -12 is 185 which includes 40 Pre-K students and 145, 9-12 grade students. In addition to the Pre-K – 12 grade students, we have 78 participants enrolled in our Adults with Disabilities Program.

The students enrolled at Seagull enter one of three programs or a combination of programs; direct teaching; the teacher imparts content of the curriculum with creative pedagogies, blended curriculum; online computer-based programs and teacher direct instruction, and the Adult with Disabilities (AWD) Program, a program for adult students who have already graduated high school and are receiving life skills curriculum.

At Seagull the students are supported by a wide array of support personnel, programs and community partnerships. The students are supported by the school counselors, a social worker, a family counselor, an ESE specialist, an ESE support teacher, an ESOL support staff member, a literacy coach and various other support staff members. The staff at Seagull provides a personalized approach to student education and overall success.
