Bayview Elementary serves the Coral Ridge, Sunrise Intracoastal, and beach areas of Fort Lauderdale. Present enrollment is approximately 572 students. The ethnic breakdown is as follows: 84% White, 25% Hispanic, 4% African American, 4% Asian, and 7% Multiethnic. Bayview Elementary has a long history of high student achievement with students scoring at high levels in ELA, Mathematics, and Science standardized assessments. Bayview Elementary has consistently earned an A rating by the state of Florida based on exceptional student achievement since 2000. The school ranks in the top 1% of county and state for ELA, Math, and Science. Bayview is fortunate to have strong parental involvement and community partnerships. Teachers dedicate time designing instruction that is creative and challenging to differentiate the needs of all students. Many instructional staff are National Board Certified or have master's degrees and various educational endorsements. Parents spend more than 2,000 volunteer hours working in school strengthening the overall school program.

SAVVAS. Several student driven programs are Spring Fling, “Popsicles in the Park,” volunteer breakfast, book fair, and the talent show. Bayview strives to implement innovative programs addressing the needs of learners. Student activities include Safety Patrol, WBAY (student led broadcast), student council, Bayview Bunch, Debate, and gifted/high-achieving programs in grades 2-5.
