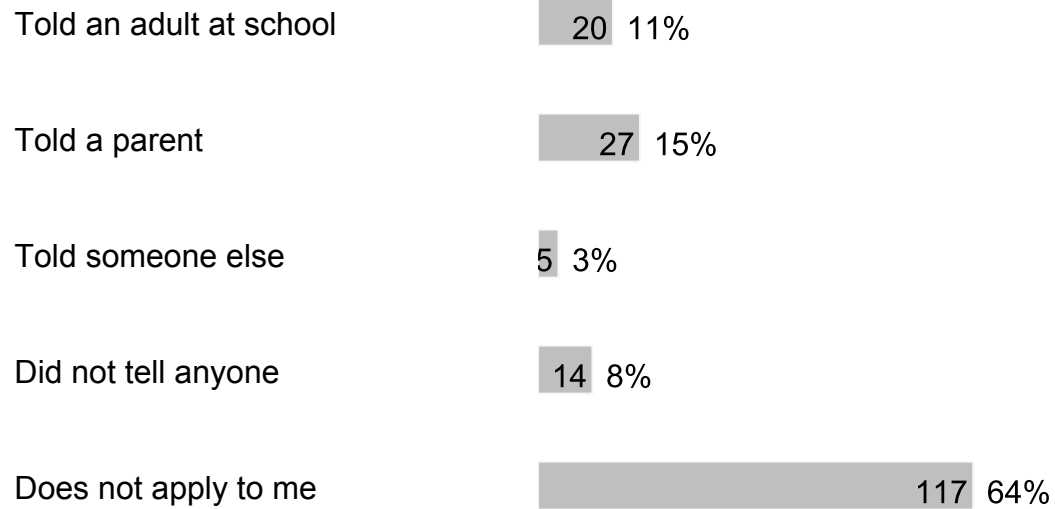

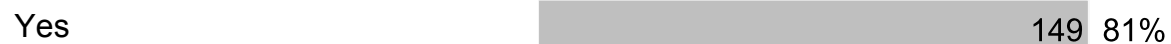

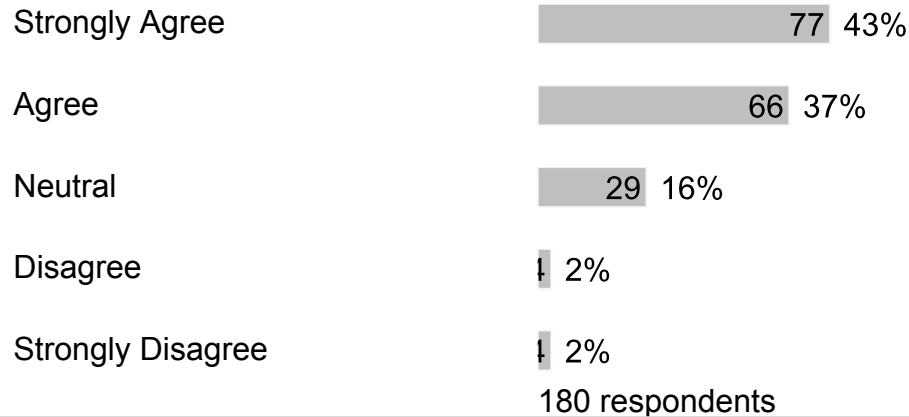

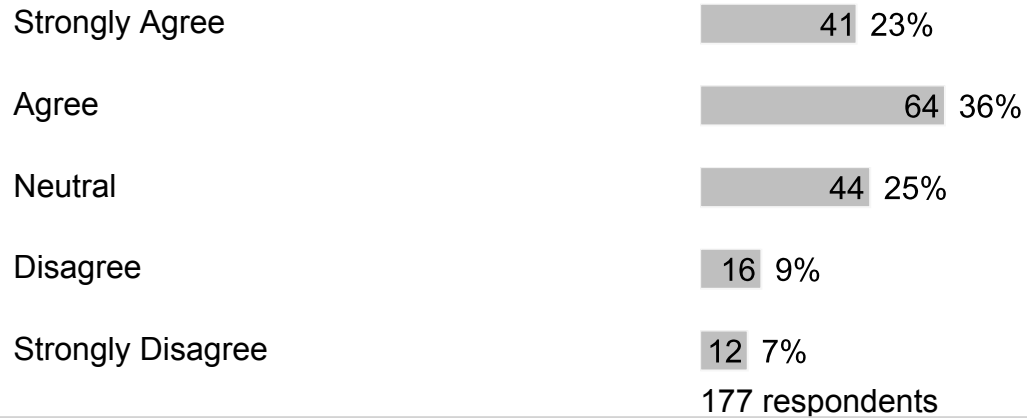

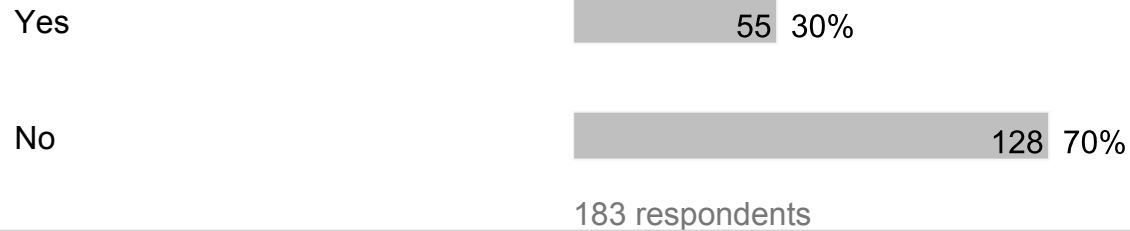

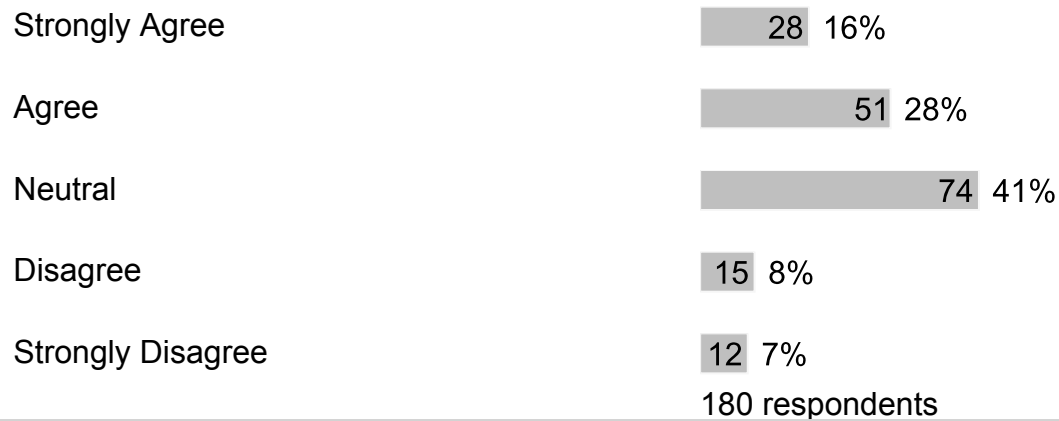

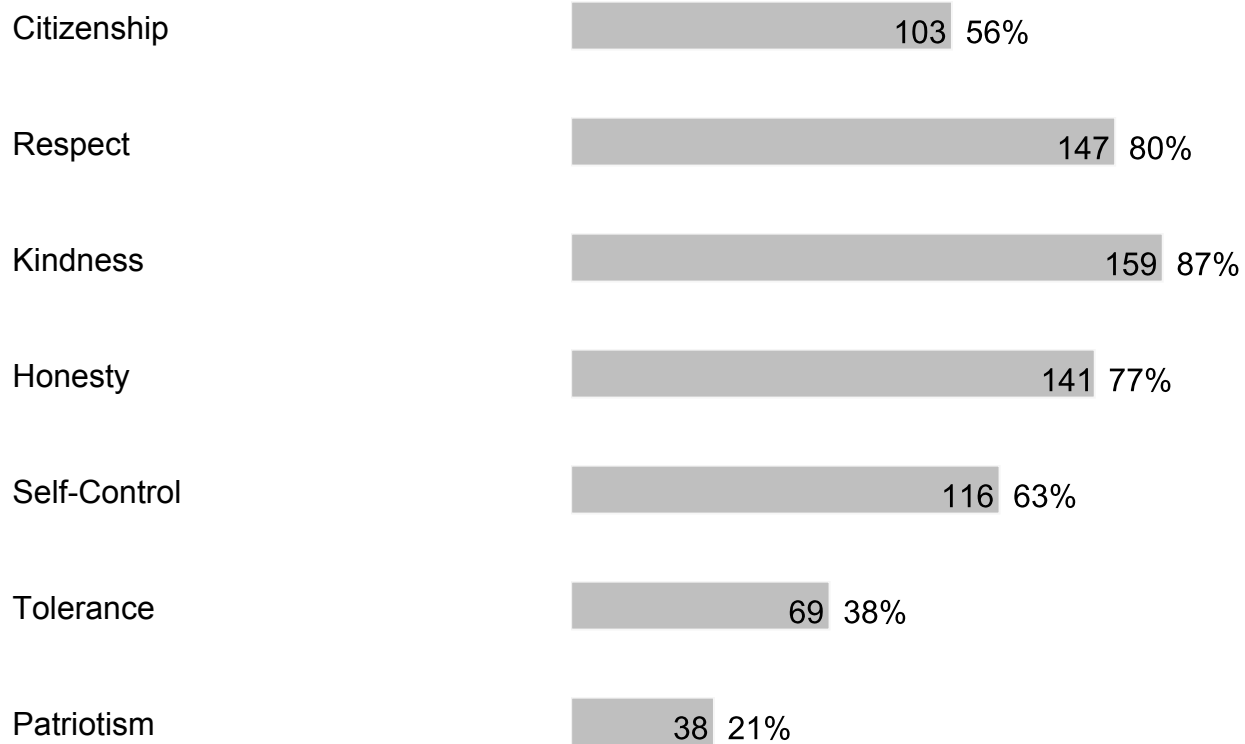

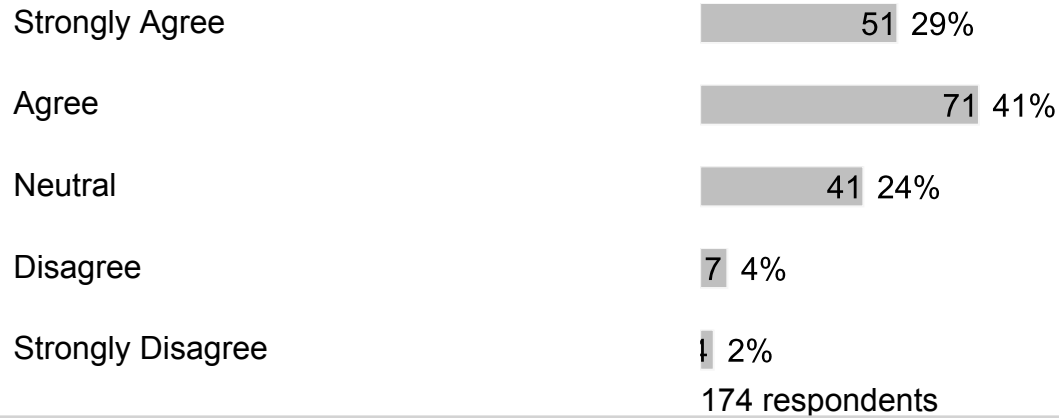

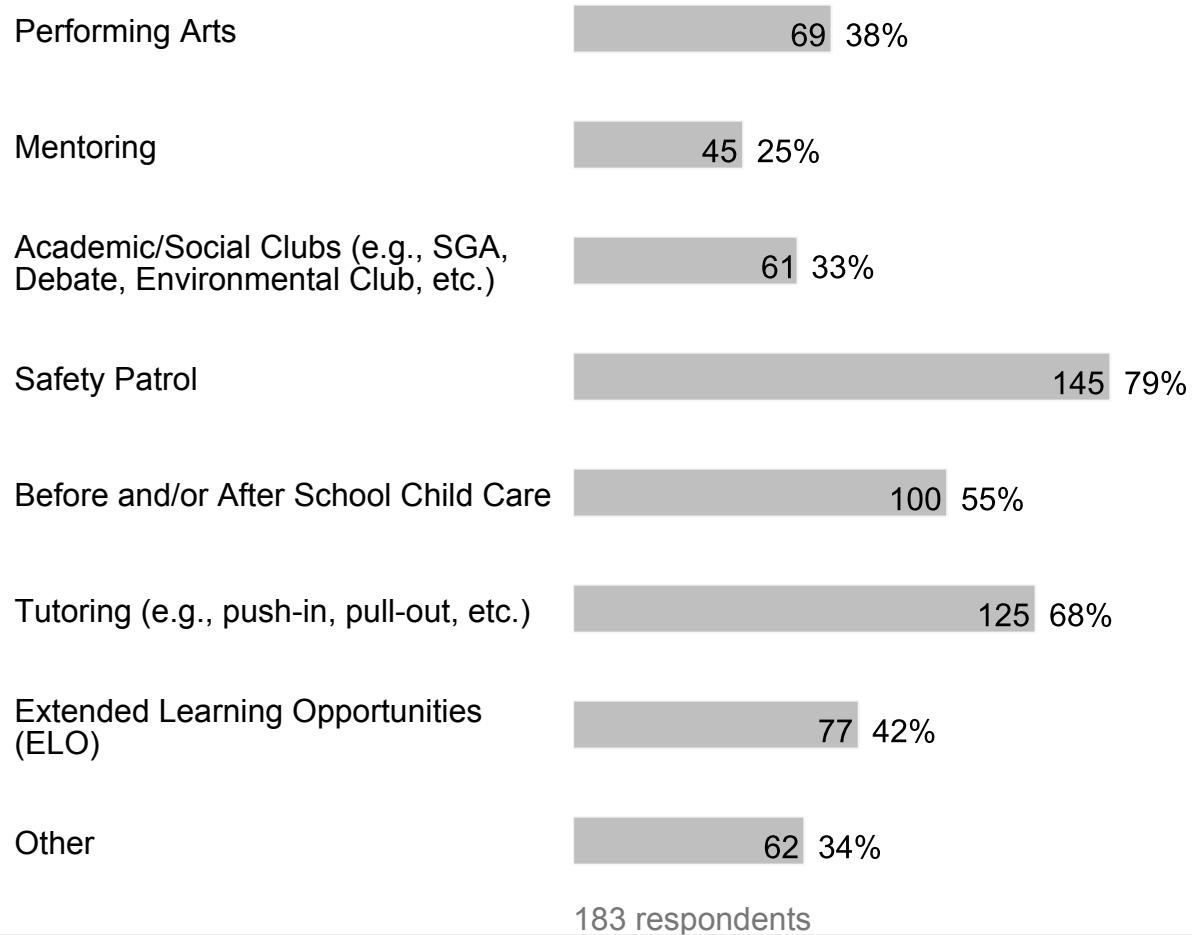

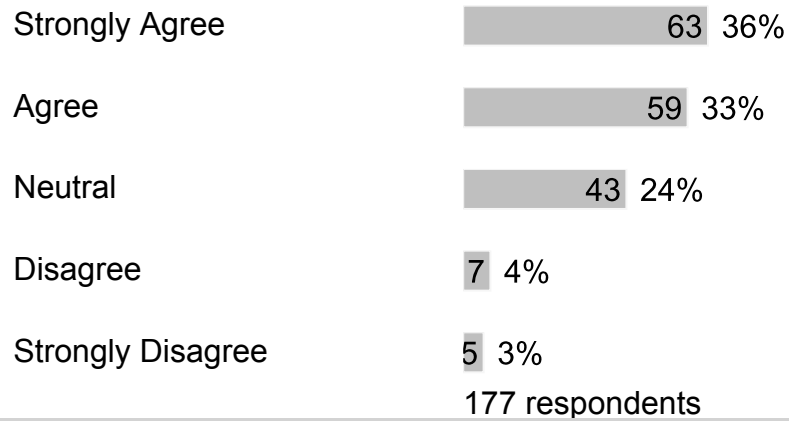

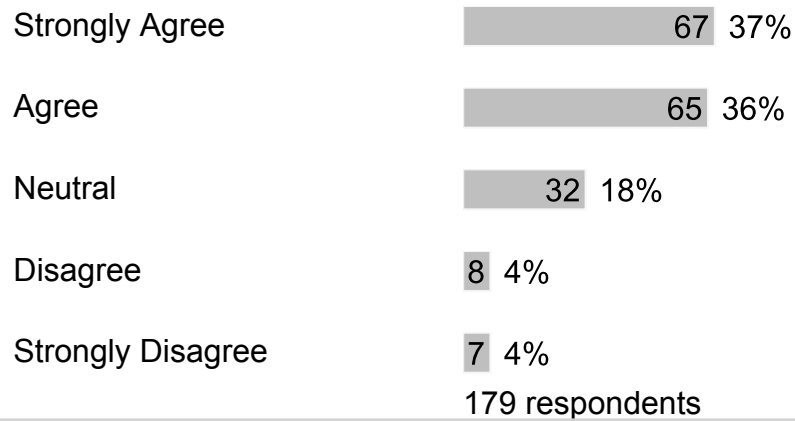

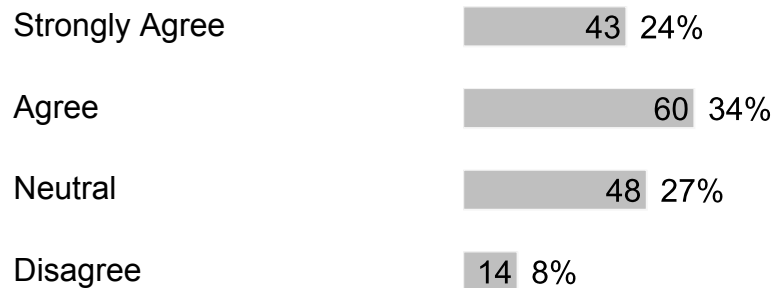

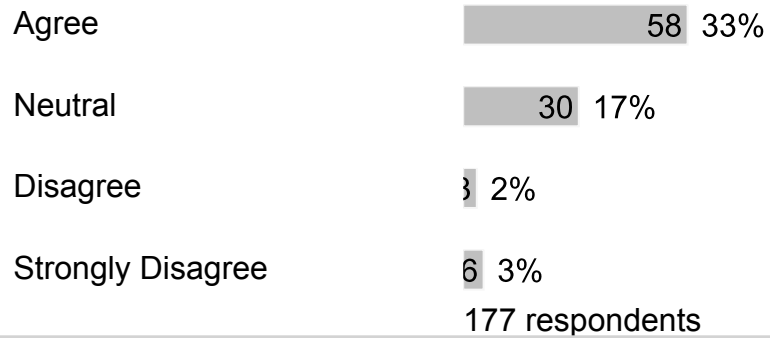

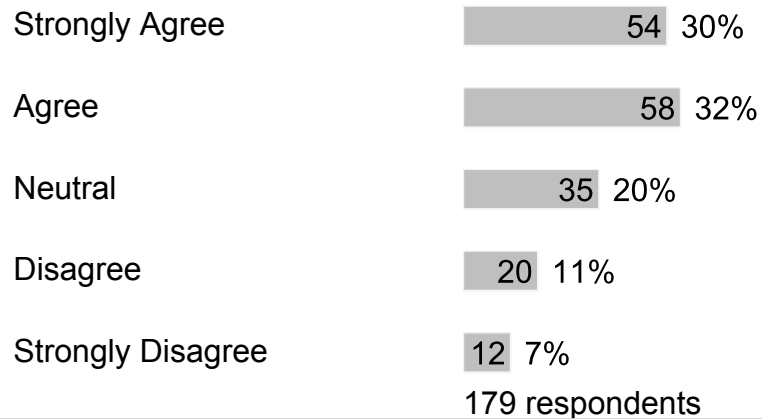

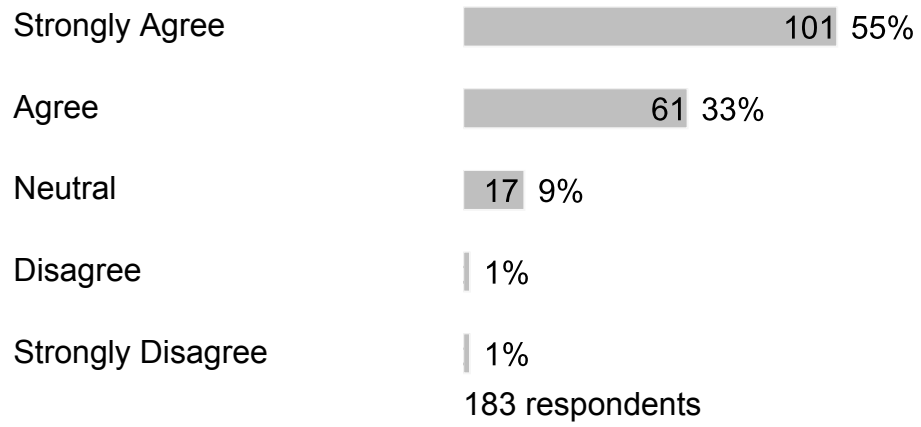
16. My teachers tell my family how I am doing in school.
