



Executive Summary for Meadowbrook Elementary School

Description: Meadowbrook Elementary is an urban school located in an unincorporated section of Broward County, Florida. 90% of the families qualify for free or reduced lunch. Additionally, 55% of students are English Language Learners. 32% of our student population has individualized education plans are students with disabilities. Meadowbrook has a growing number of special needs programs including 7 autism classes, 1 Pre-K specialized and 1 Pre-K intensive class. Our demographics are as follows: White 7%, Black 14%, Hispanic 77%, Asian 1 %, and Multi 1%. Meadowbrook has 96 staff combined instructional and non-instructional staff members. Many of our Kindergarten students do not previously attend VPK programs. We offer the dual language program in all grade levels K-5. We are striving for increased parent involvement.

Purpose: The vision for the 2025-2026 school year will provide rigorous standards-based instruction to meet the needs of the 21st century learner in a safe and secure learning environment. This consists of 7 main areas including strengthen leadership team communication, High Quality Instruction, Assessment & Progress Monitoring, High Quality Professional Development, Enhance Parent & Community Involvement, Facilities Improvements, School Safety, Life Skills and Wellness, and most importantly Achievement for ALL; Focus on ESE and ASD growth. Our school-wide theme this year is "Together We Soar". A school wide problem of practice is to strengthen Tier 1 Instruction. This is being addressed through Professional Development and Professional Learning Communities which target High Quality Instruction. Through the District initiatives of CARE and BEST, Meadowbrook has crafted sections of the school day where students can get remediation in areas of weakness as well as Response to Intervention (RTI) and Language Acquisition. The school provides additional certified teacher assistants for the ELL students needing English Language acquisition. Meadowbrook supports the social/emotional growth of the students through Kids of Character, guidance groups, mentoring opportunities, and extra-curricular programs. Parent and community involvement is being enhanced through recruitment events and family nights in the community and at school.
