Fort Lauderdale High School Positive Behavior Plan 2025-2026

The school wide-positive behavior plan (SPBP) was created by a committee of teachers, parents, administrators and community stakeholders to develop a school-wide positive behavior plan for use by FLHS students, faculty and staff. The school-wide positive behavior plan has defined benchmarks and resources based on objective data collection and analysis. The goal of the School-wide Positive Behavior Plan is to reduce the most common misbehaviors that have resulted in suspensions, expulsions, and/or police involvement at the school. The intent is that students & faculty will be rewarded for positive behavior and taught school wide expectations & rules. The school will employ effective consequences in adherence with the School Board of Broward County Secondary Discipline Matrix. Data will be used to track progress and identify target areas for intervention.

School-Wide Expectations and Rules:

- Apply to all staff, students and settings across campus
- Are taught like the academic core curriculum
- Are reinforced/rewarded when exhibited as academic accomplishments are rewarded
- A Reward System will be used and taught to students and staff to encourage and model appropriate behavior

Rewards for Positive Behavior

Administration Rewards:

- Kids of Character
 - Students will be nominated & selected by faculty for demonstrating the kids of character trait and be rewarded by administration.
- Academic Rewards
 - Students who have achieved outstanding academic achievement for an entire semester by receiving A's and B's only will qualify to be rewarded by administration.
- Teacher with Flying L PRIDE
 - Students, faculty, and staff can nominate teachers that have demonstrated Flying L PRIDE. Administrator will reward a selected teacher on a monthly basis.

Classroom Rewards:

- Classroom
 - Students will earn points from their teacher for demonstrating Flying L PRIDE and adhering to classroom rules.
 - Points earned will be redeemed in the Flying L PRIDE store.

Campus Rewards:

- Campus Reward
 - Students will earn points from Faculty & Staff for demonstrating Flying L PRIDE and adhering to classroom rules.
 - Points earned will be redeemed in the Flying L PRIDE store.

Student Rewards:

- Student Points.
 - Students are responsible for maintaining their own record of points earned.
 - Students may receive points from any Fort Lauderdale High School Faculty or Staff Member.
 - Point system is subject to availability of rewards.

Teacher Rewards:

- Teacher Points
