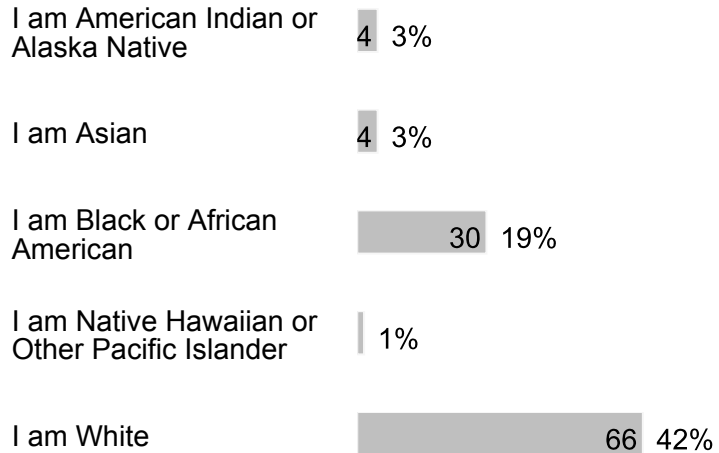

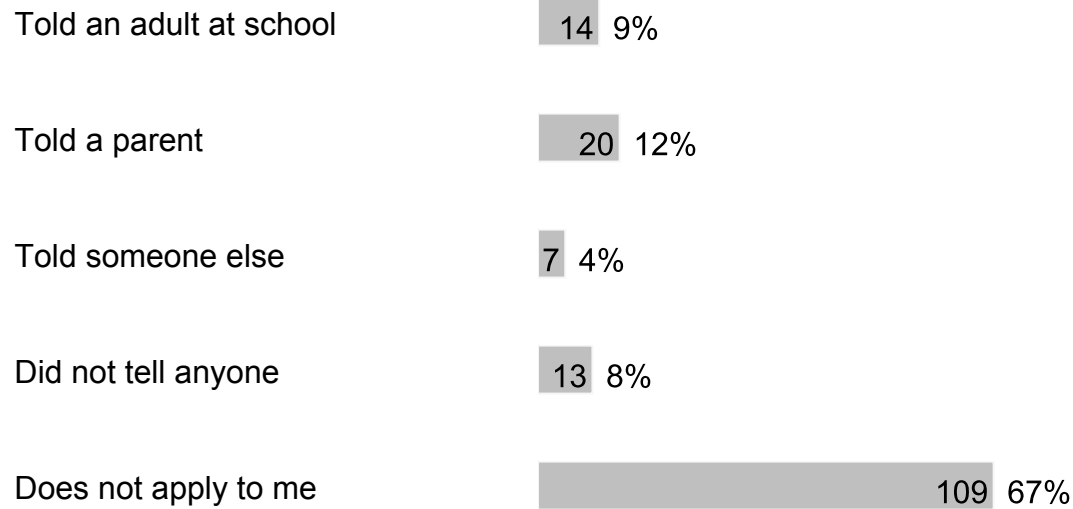

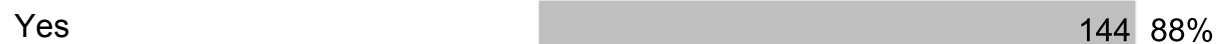

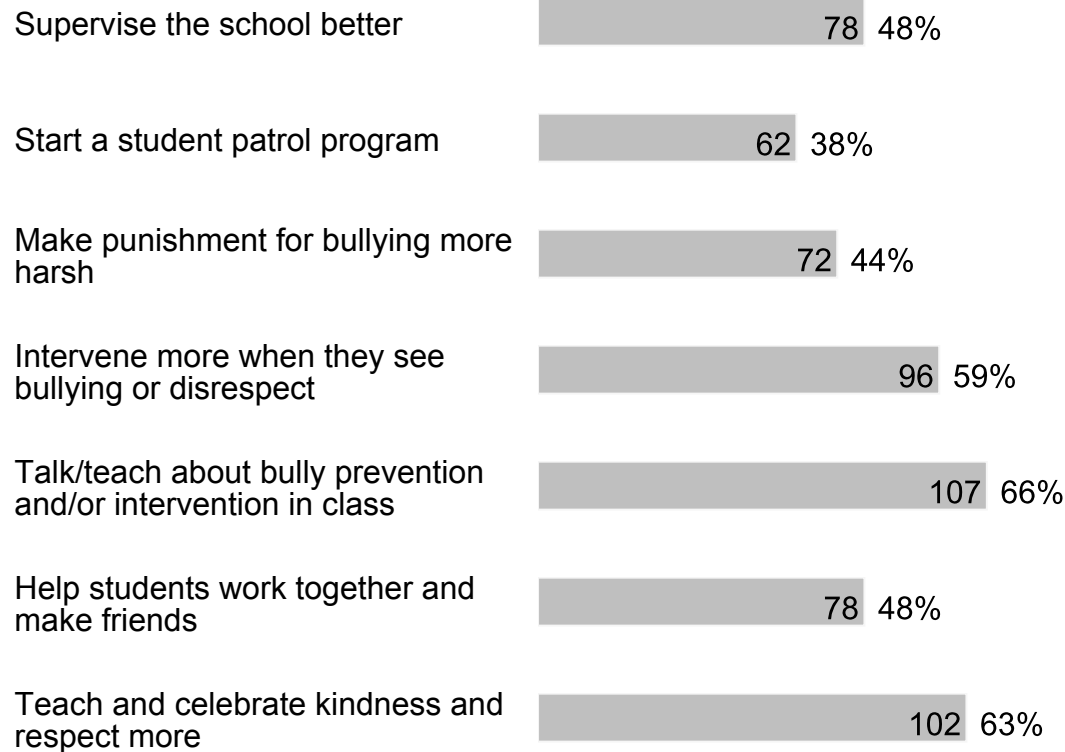

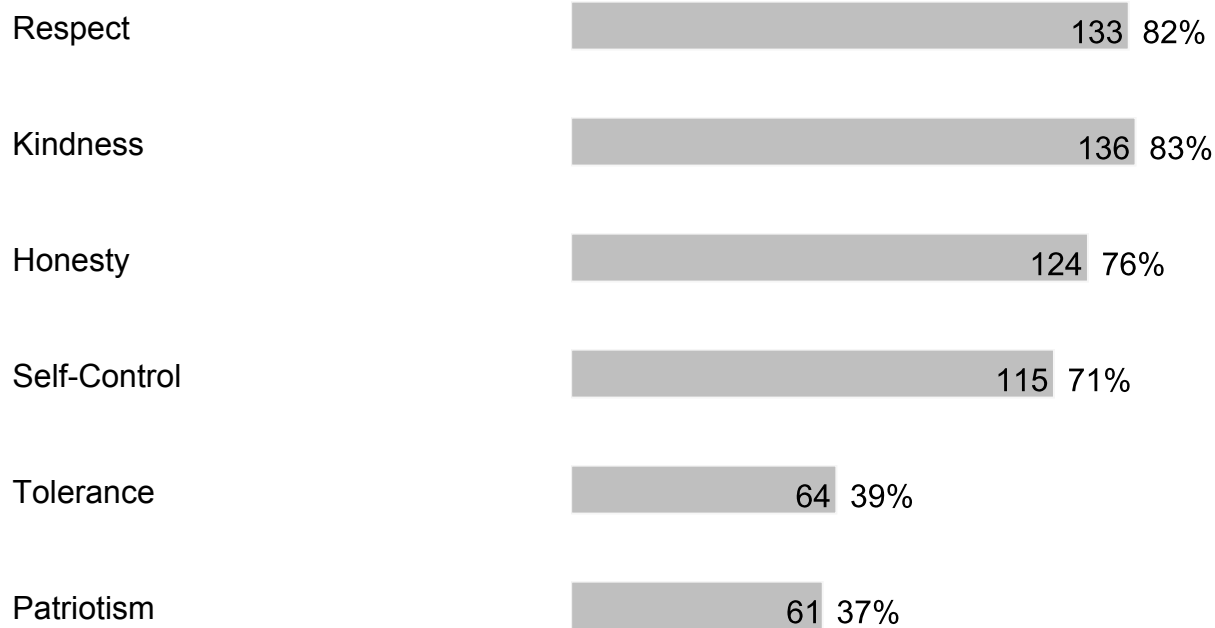

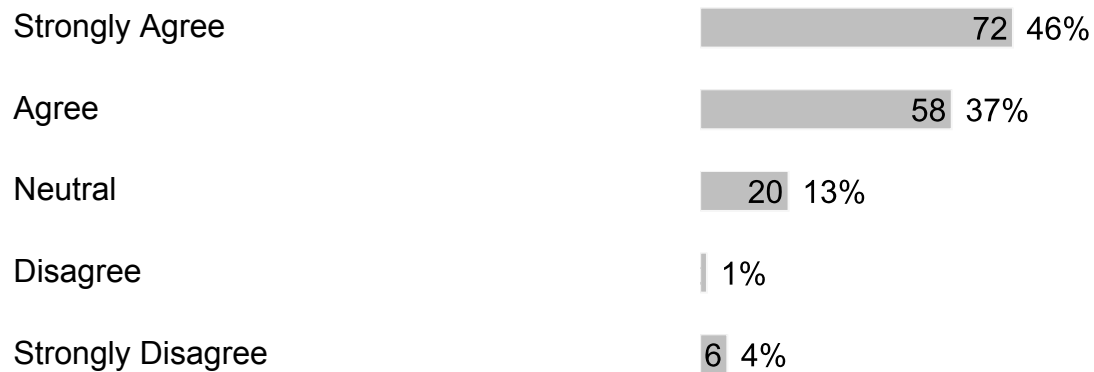

10. My teachers listen to me.



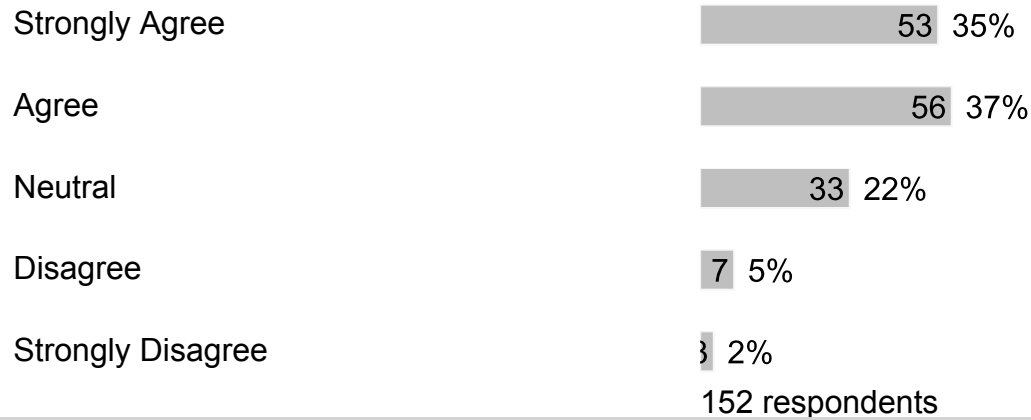

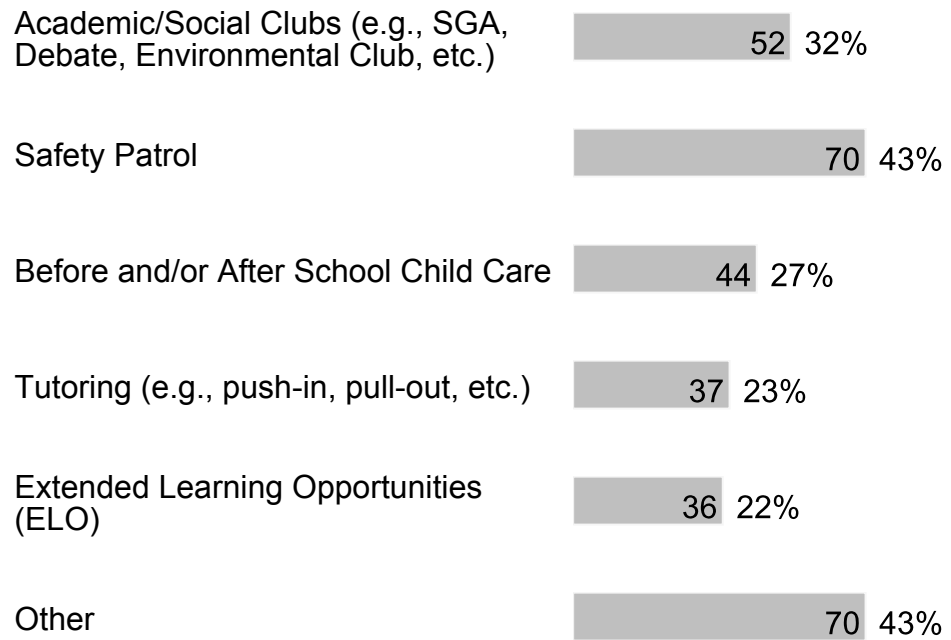

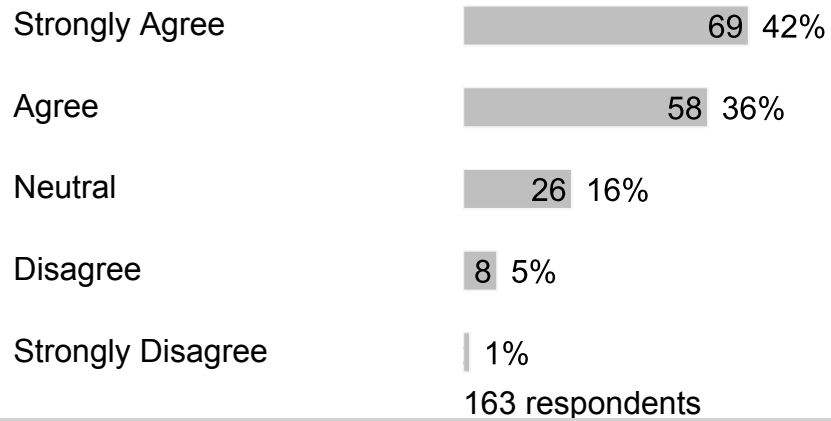
