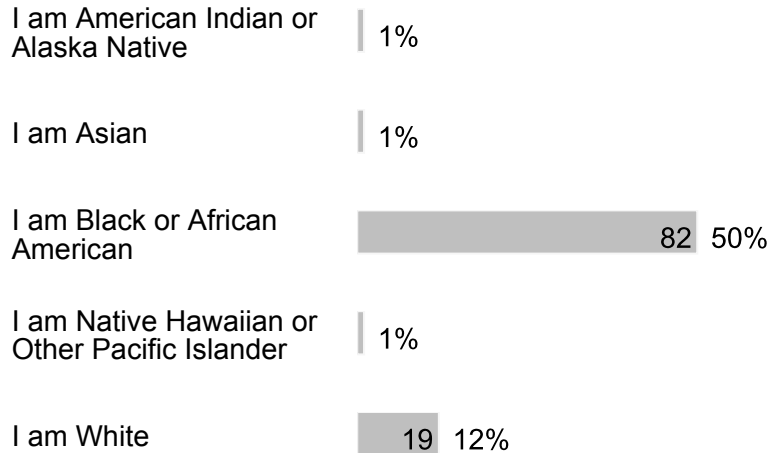

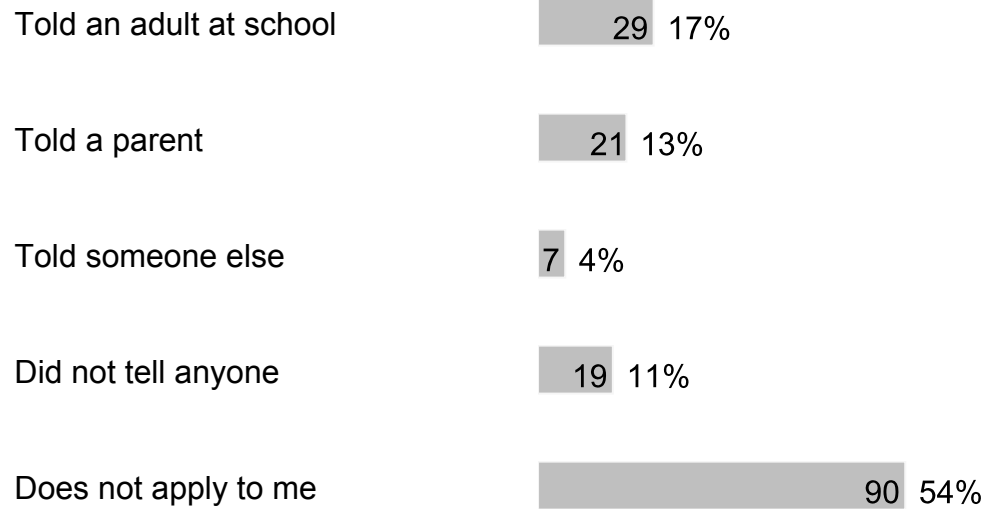

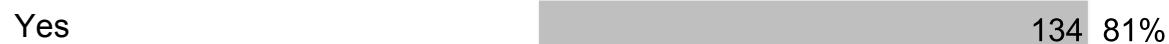

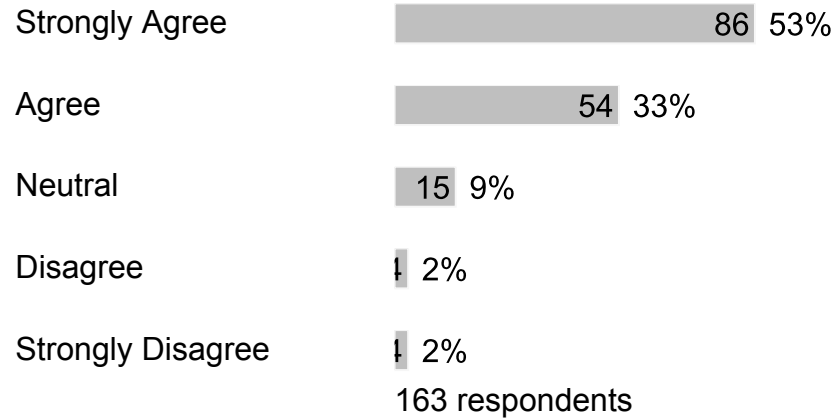

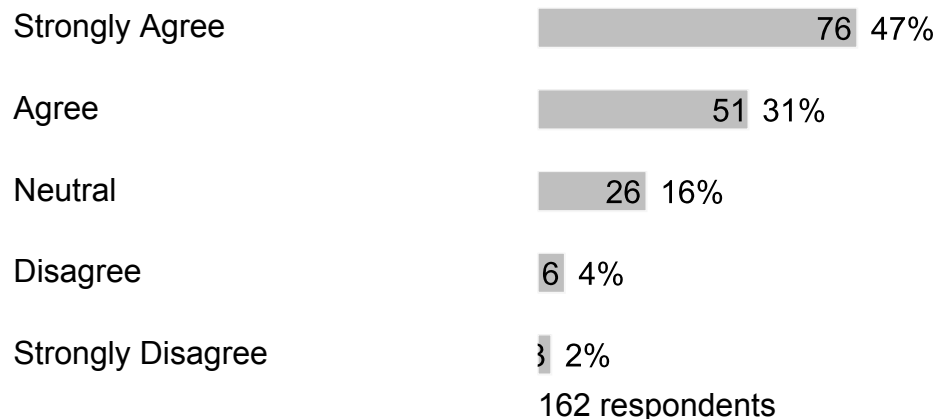

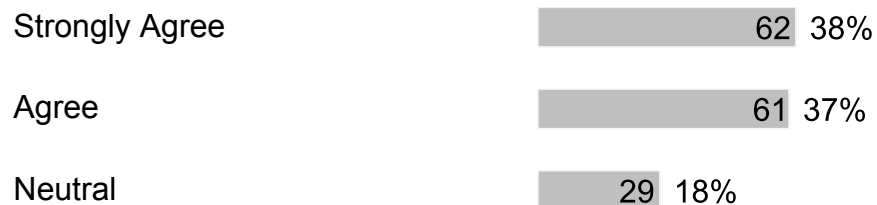

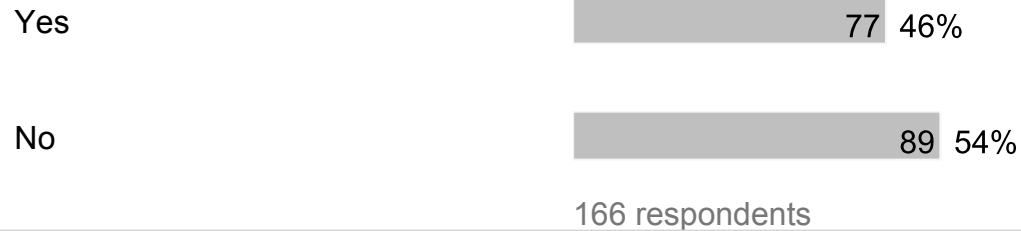

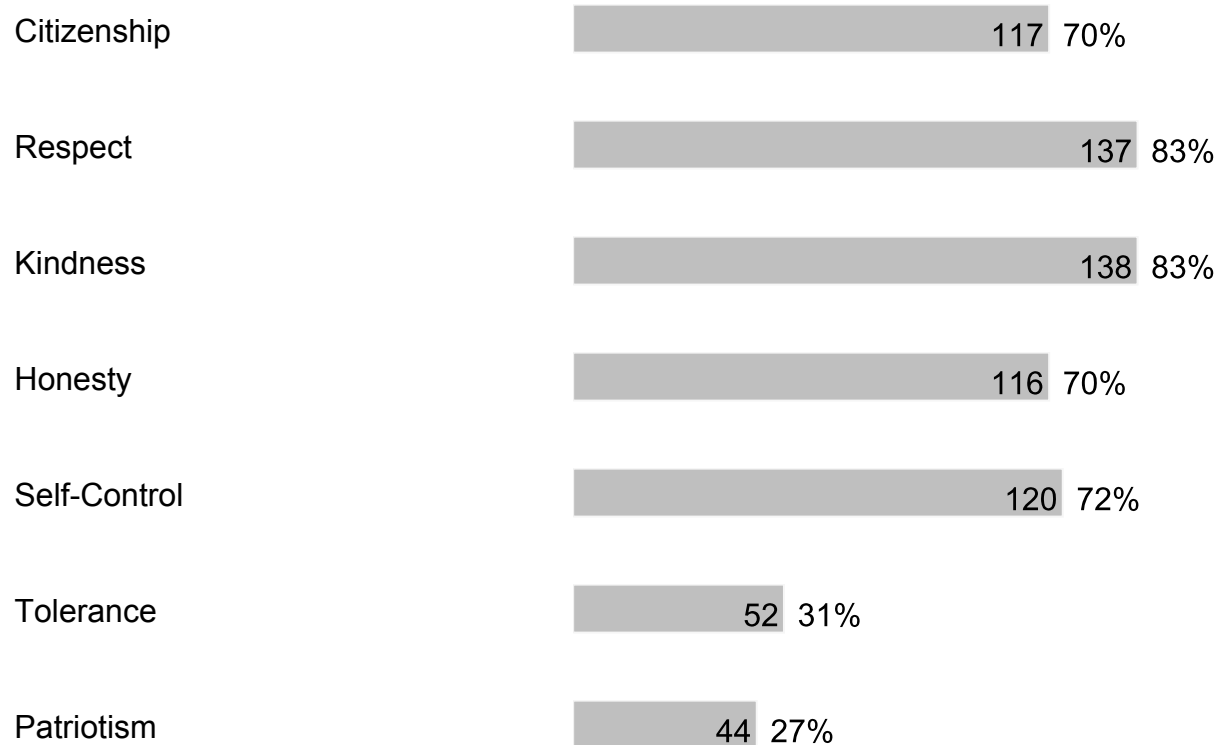

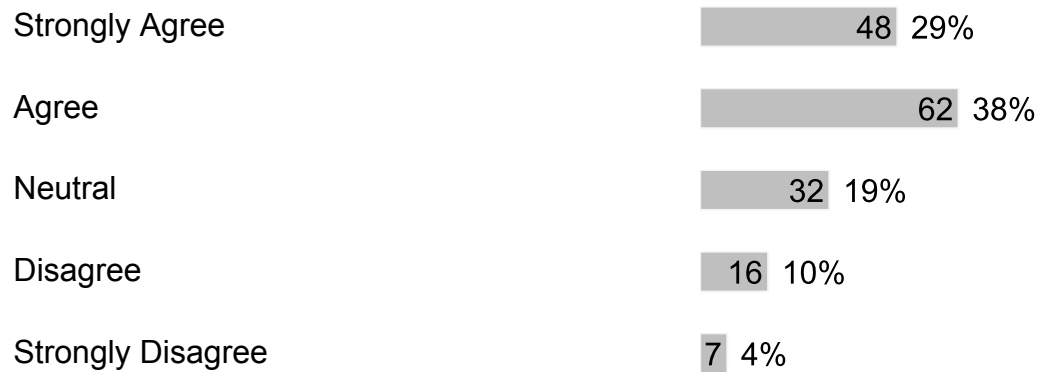
9. Which character traits do you value the most in yourself and others? (check all that apply)

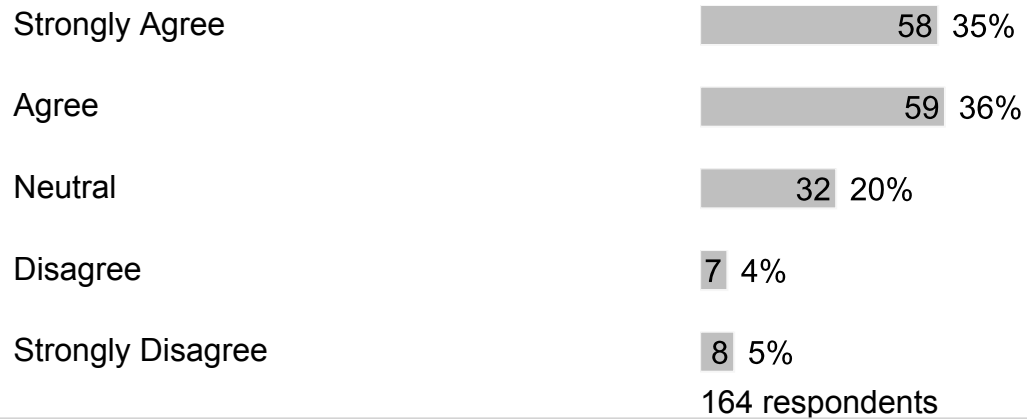

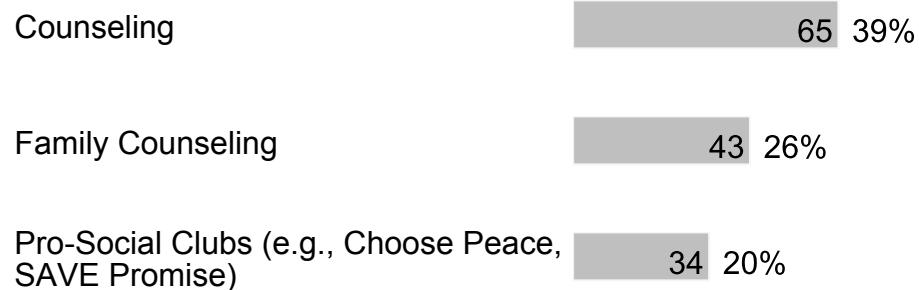

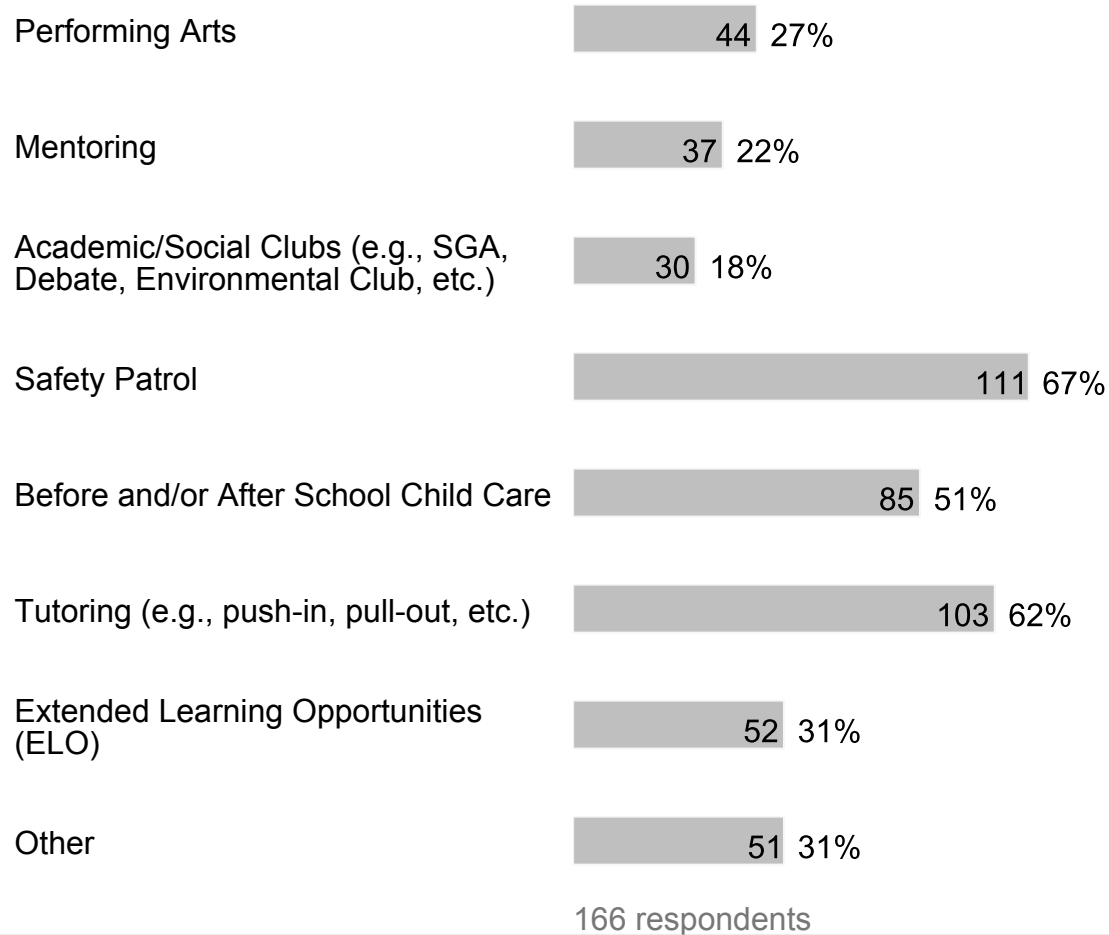


12. I receive acknowledgement and/or praise for my strengths or accomplishments by adults at my school.

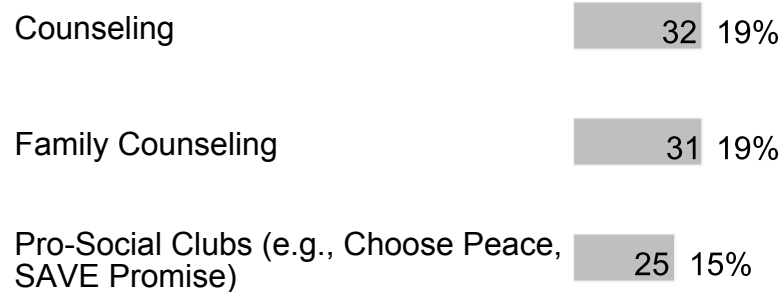


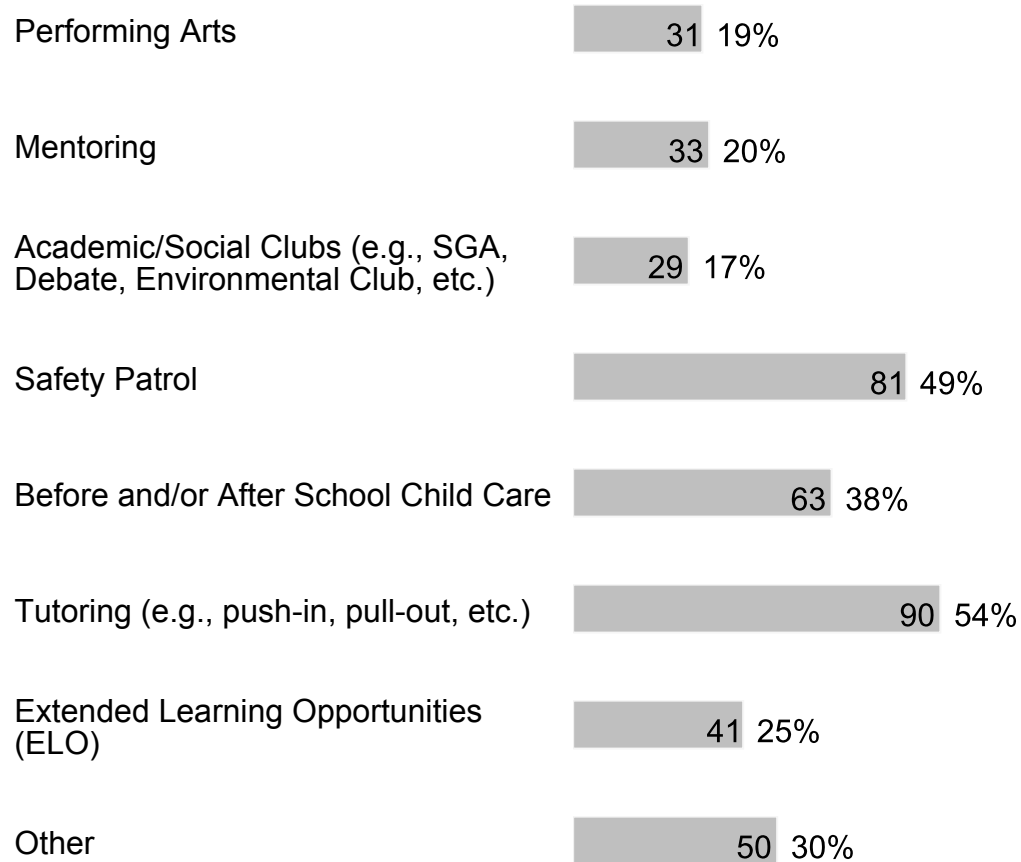

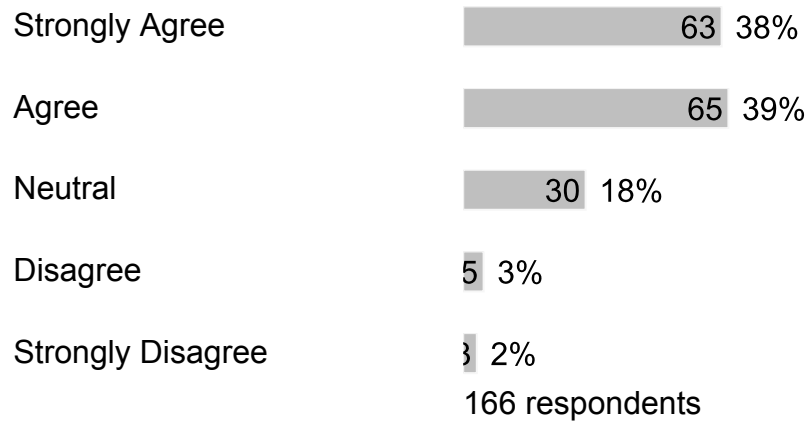

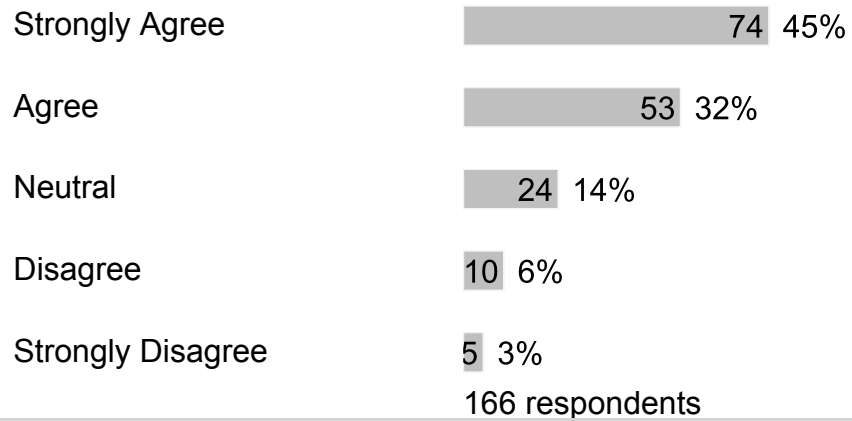

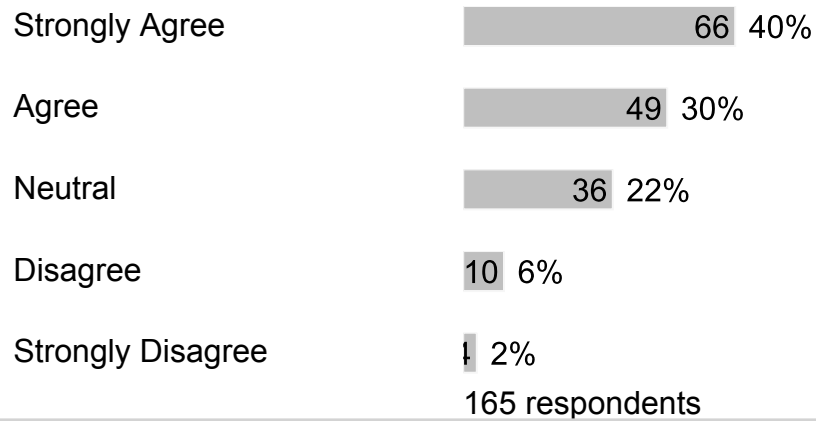

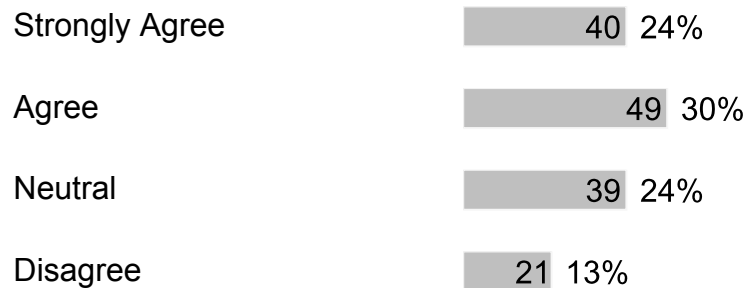
