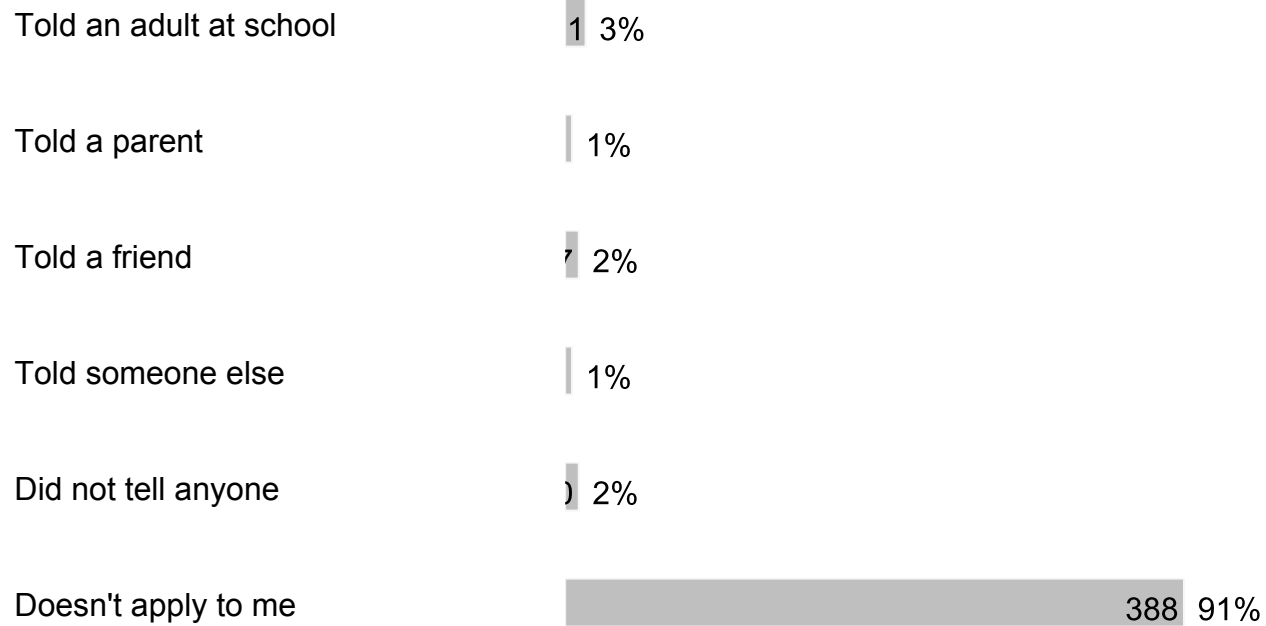

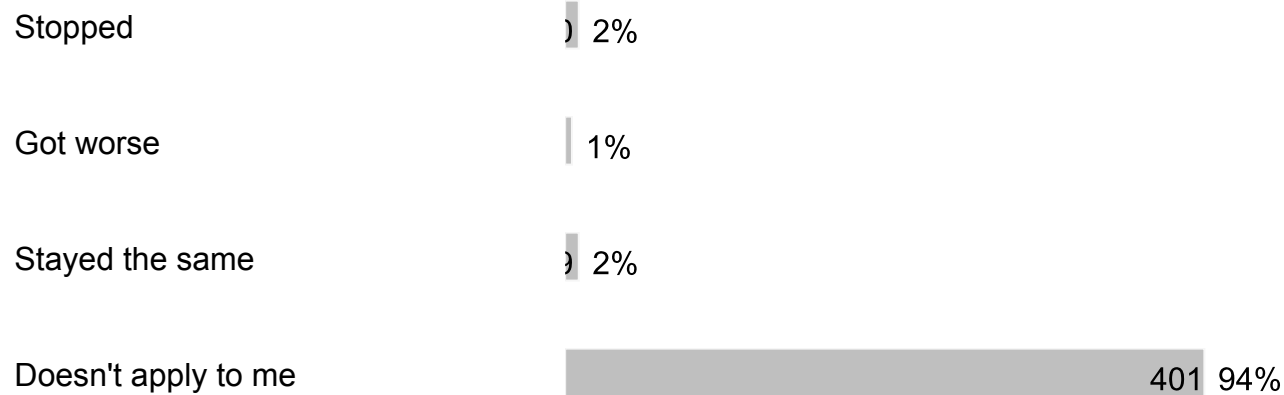

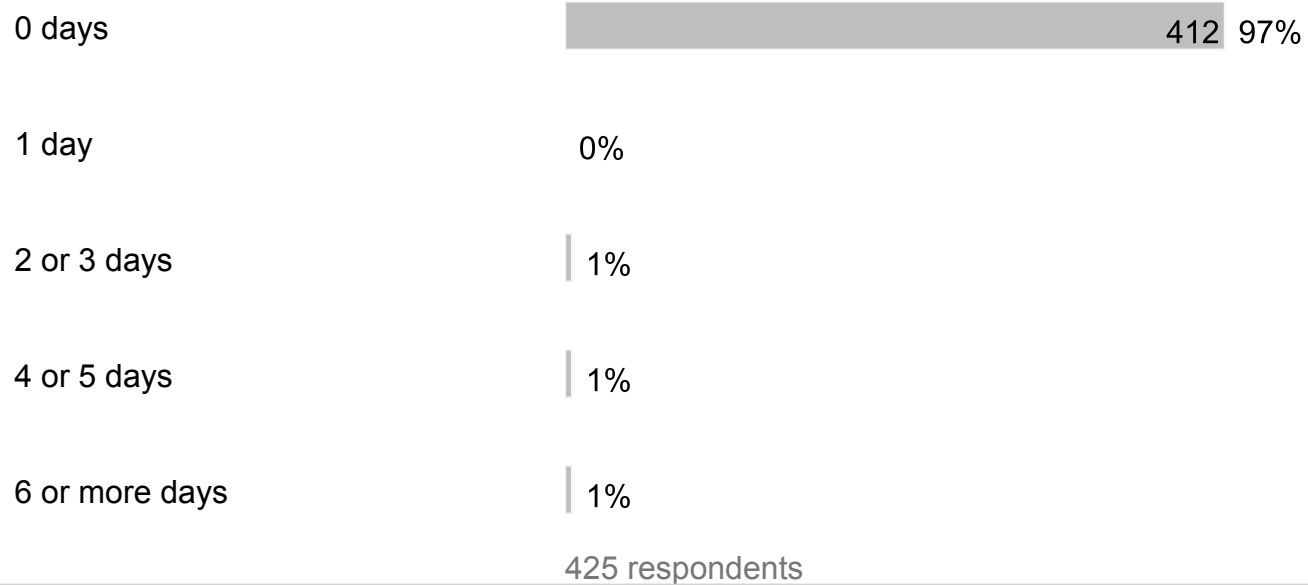


12. What can adults do to help stop bullying at school?

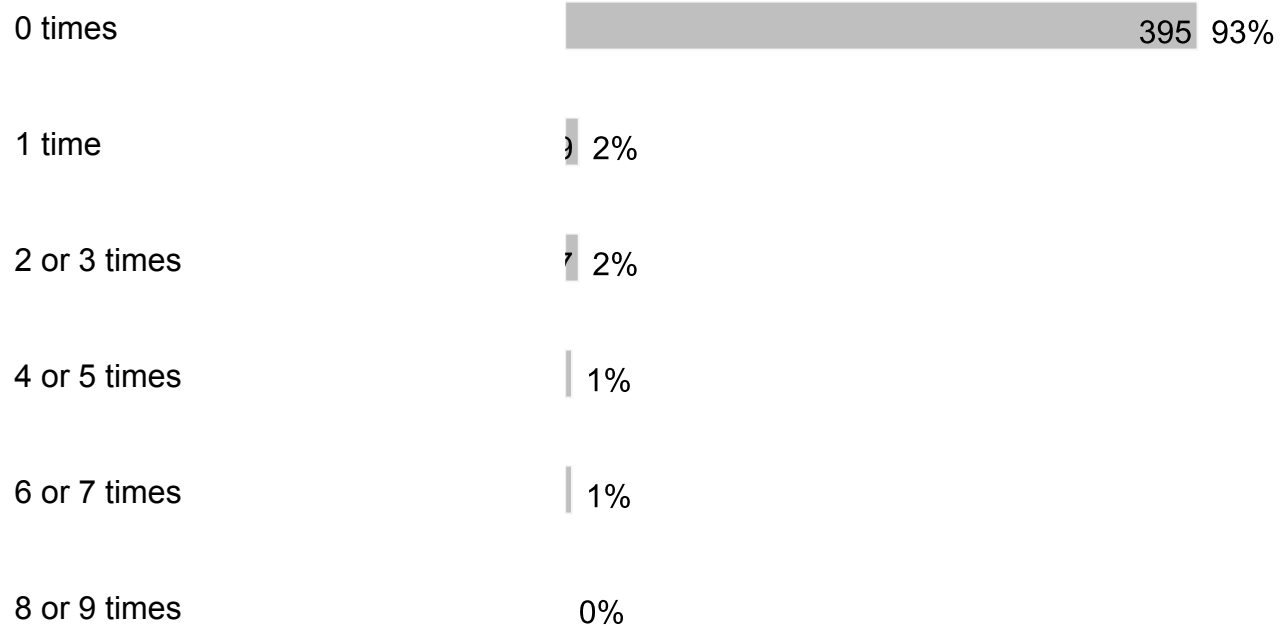

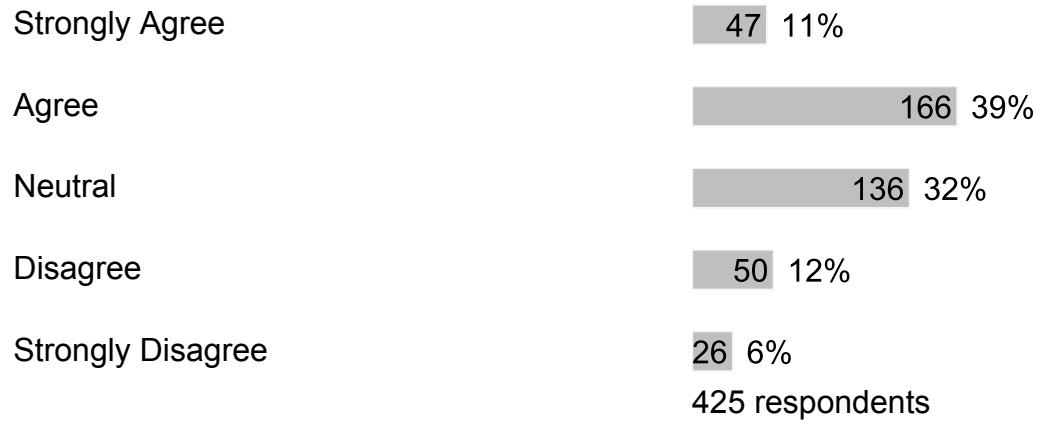

24. At what age is a human brain fully developed?



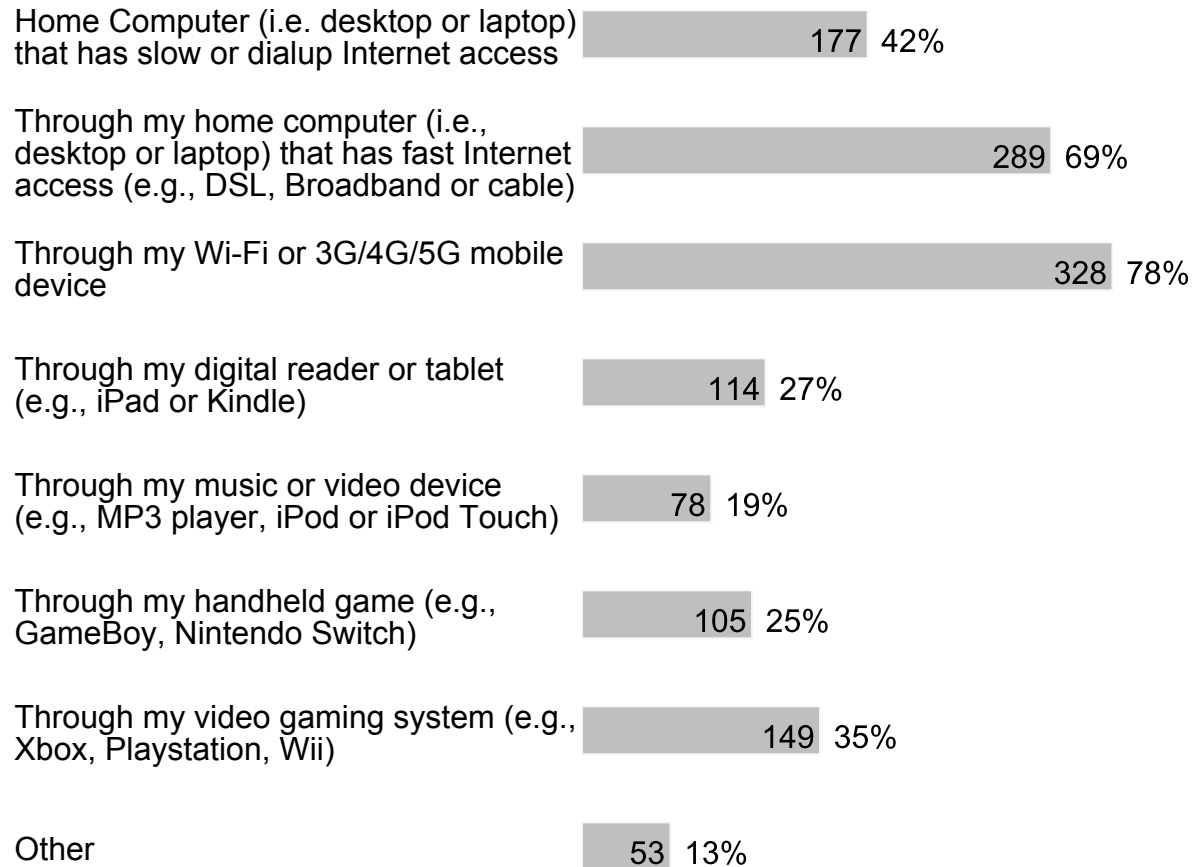

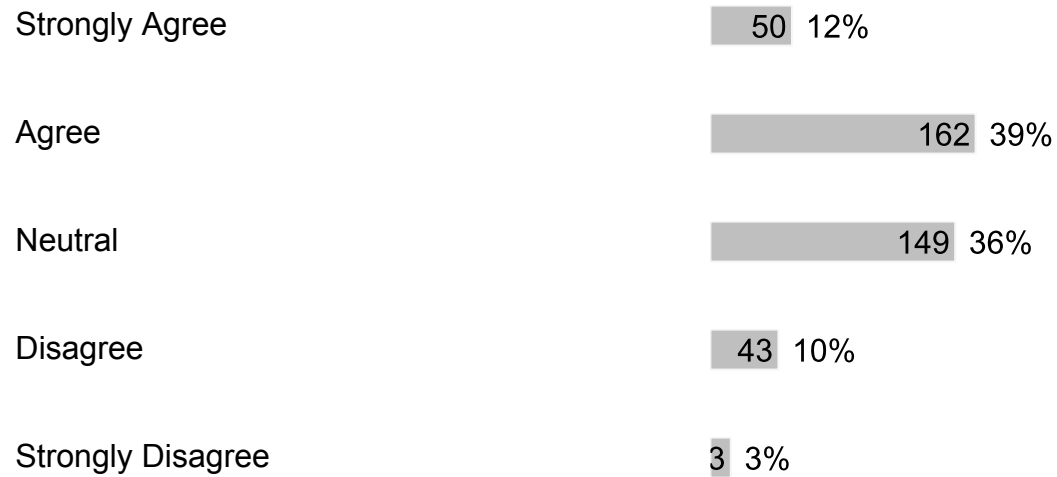

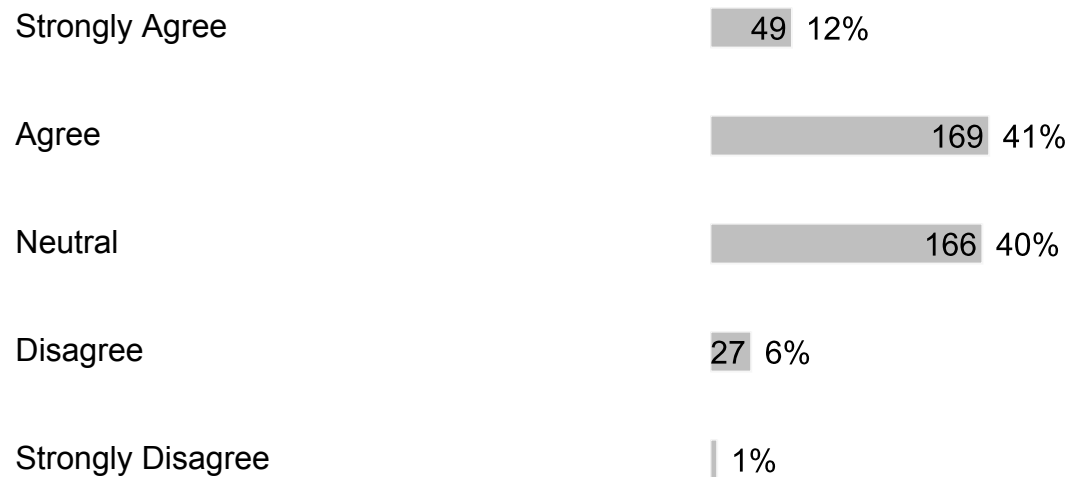

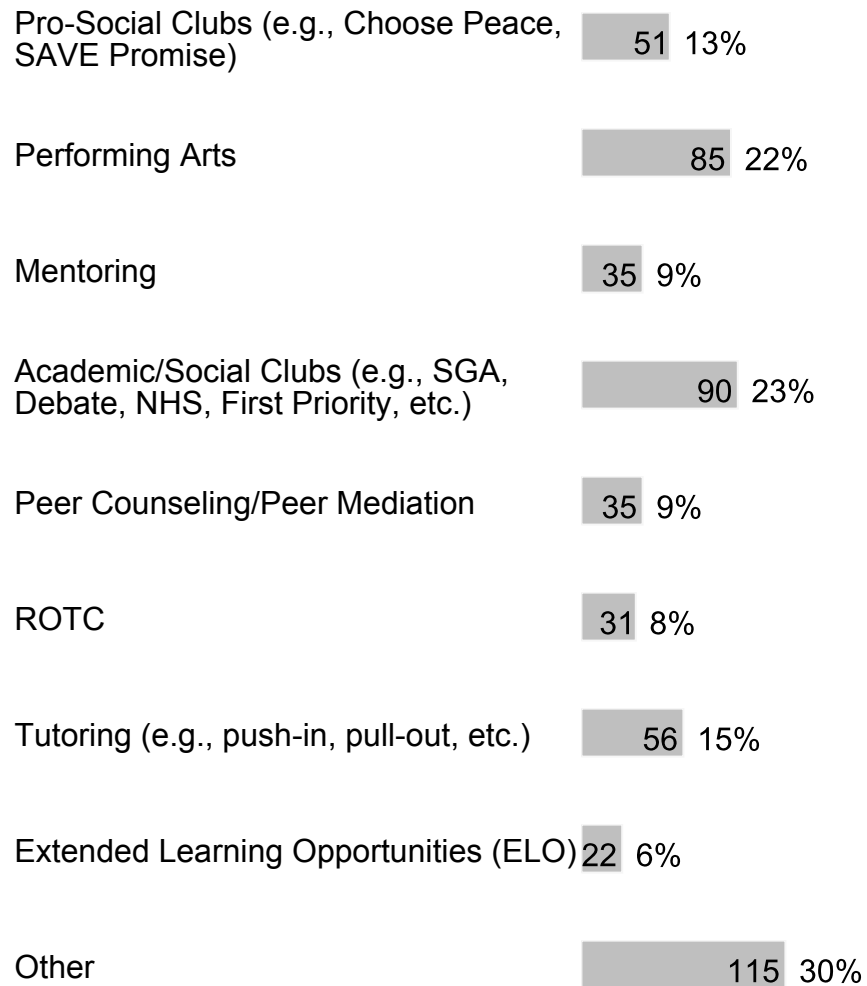

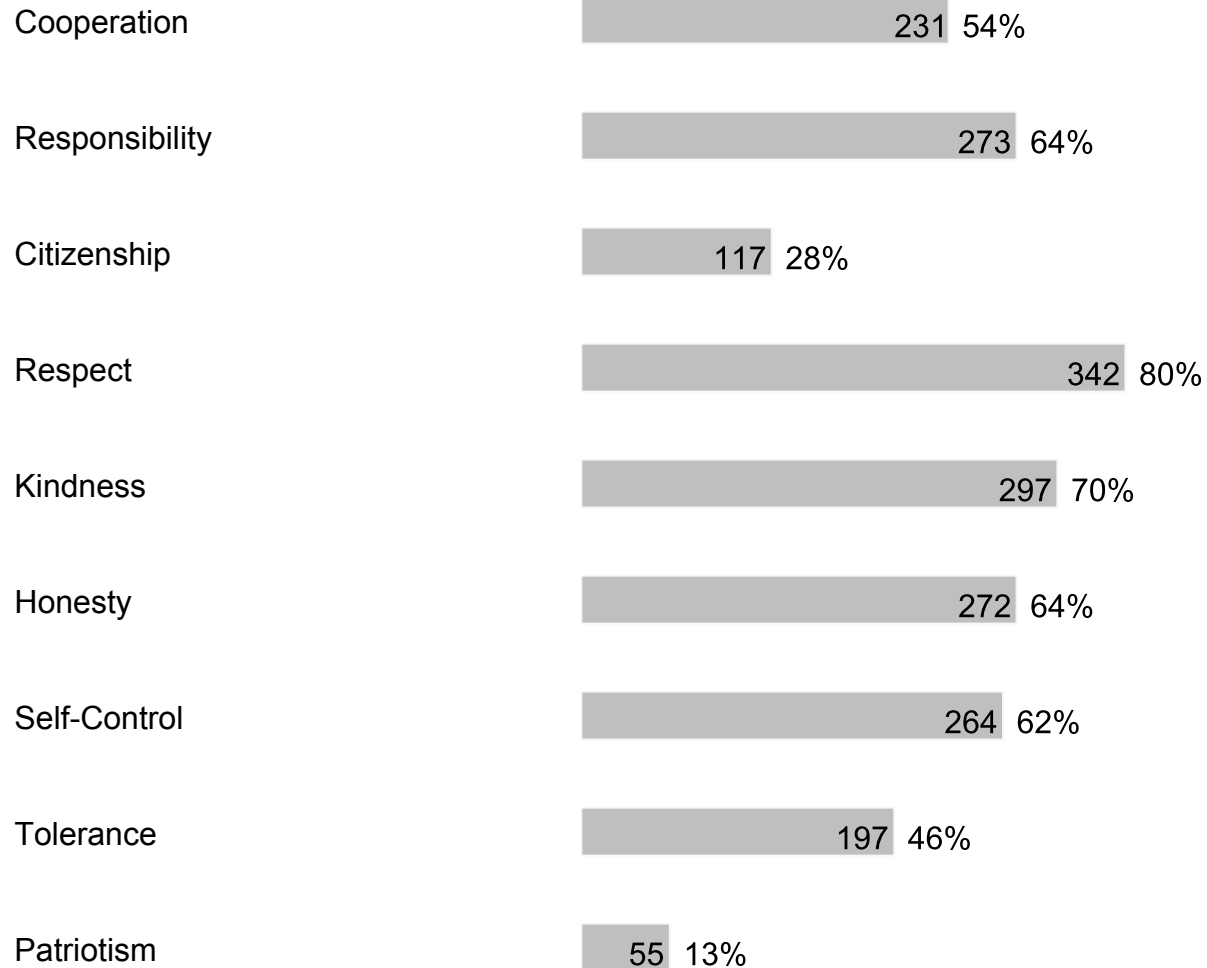

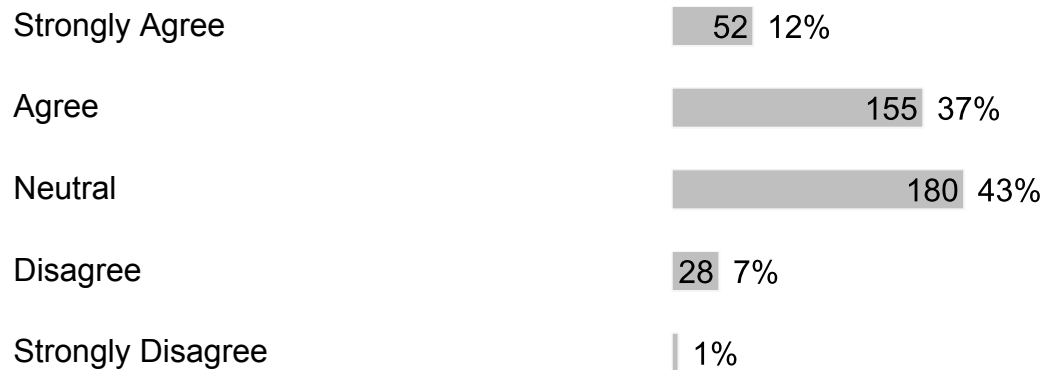
