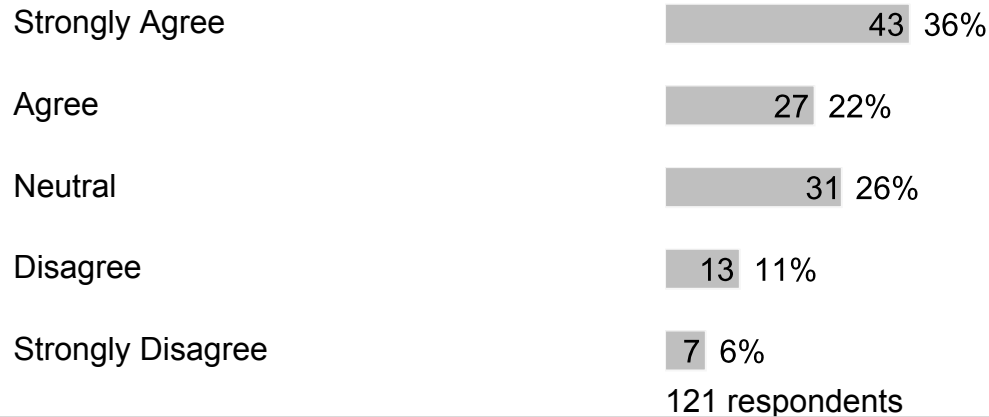

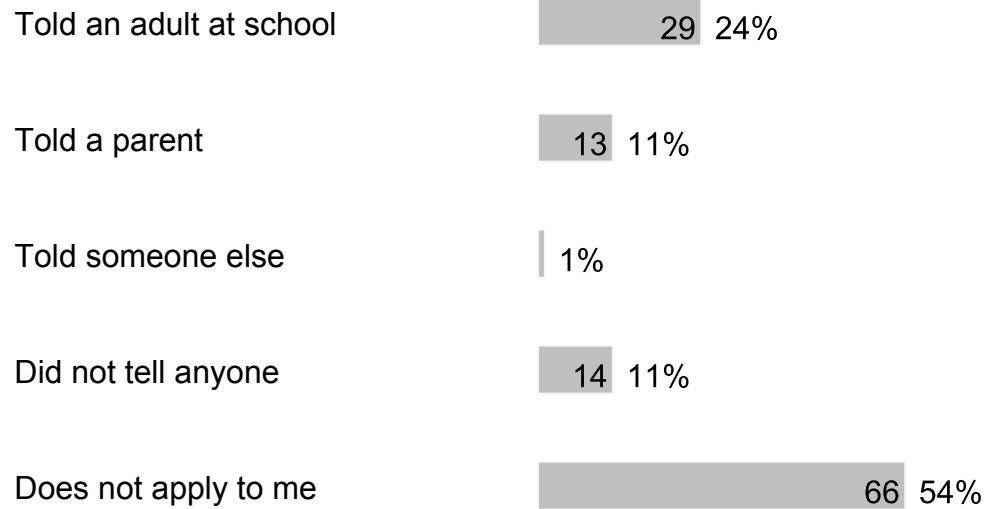

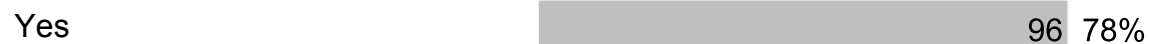

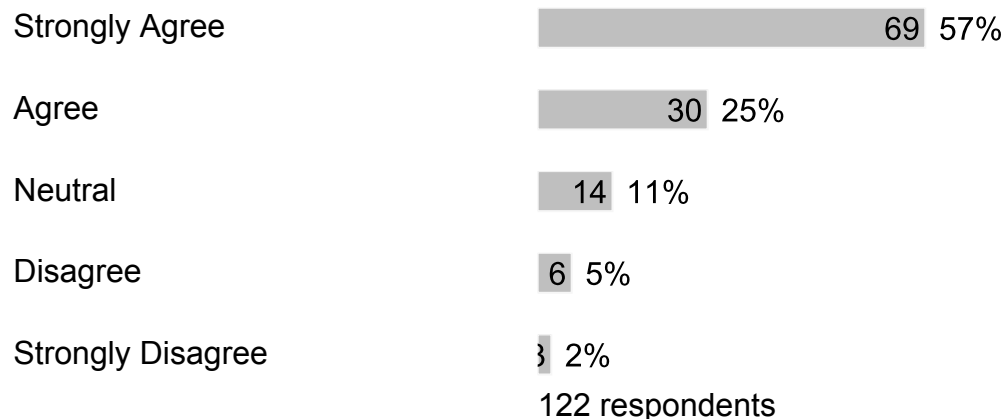

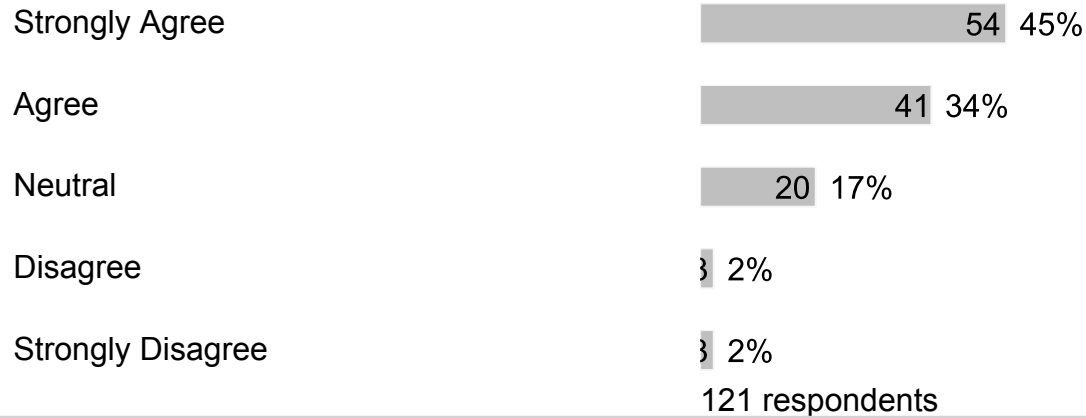

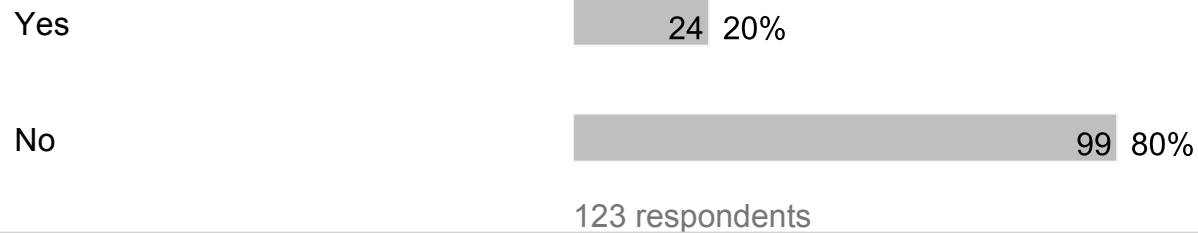

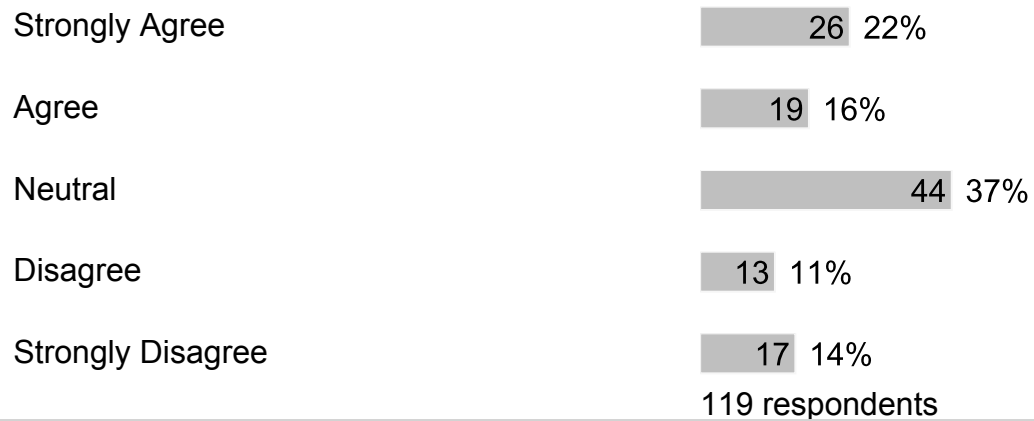

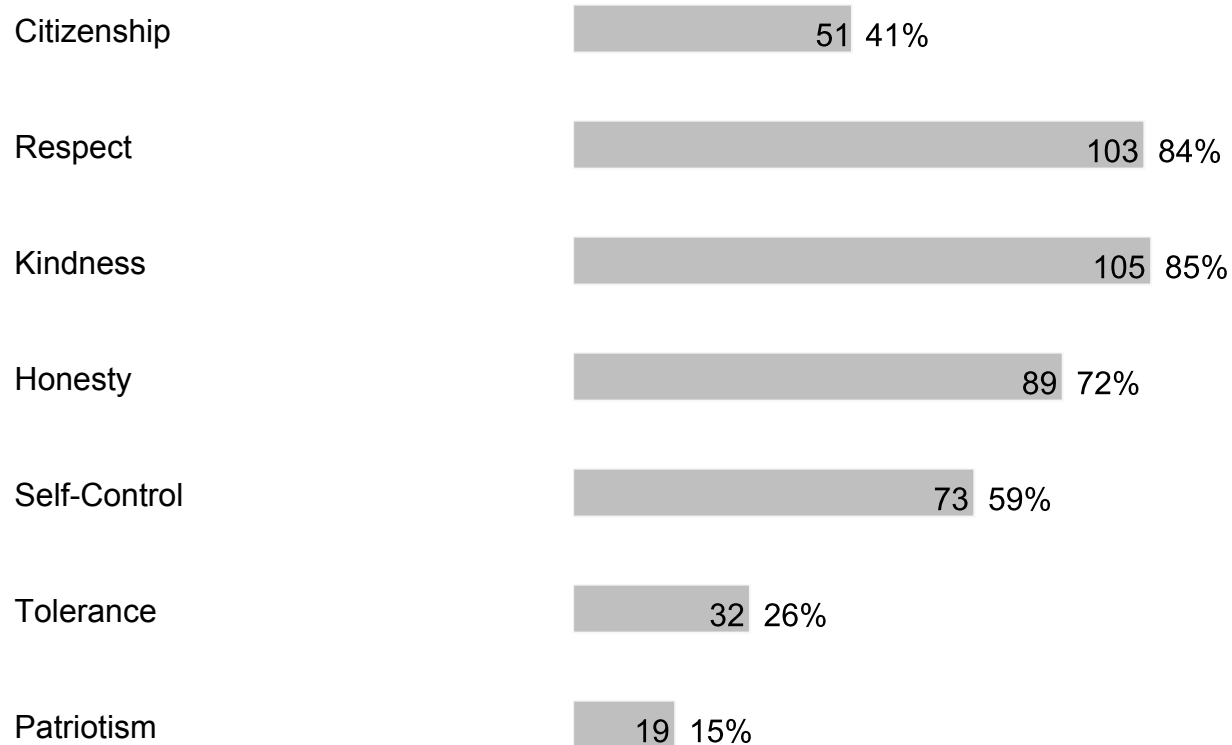

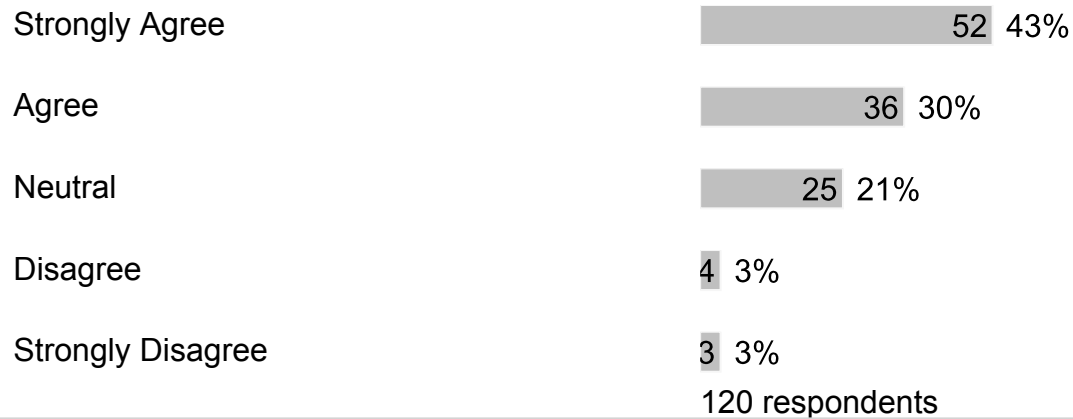

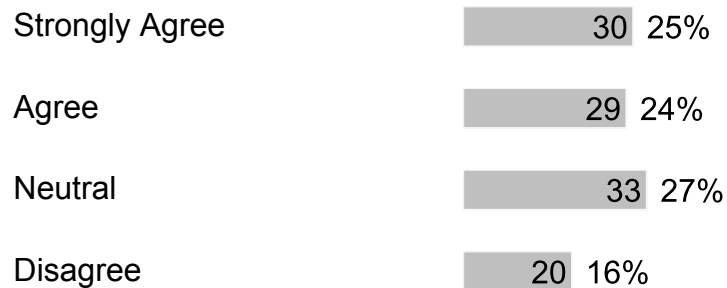

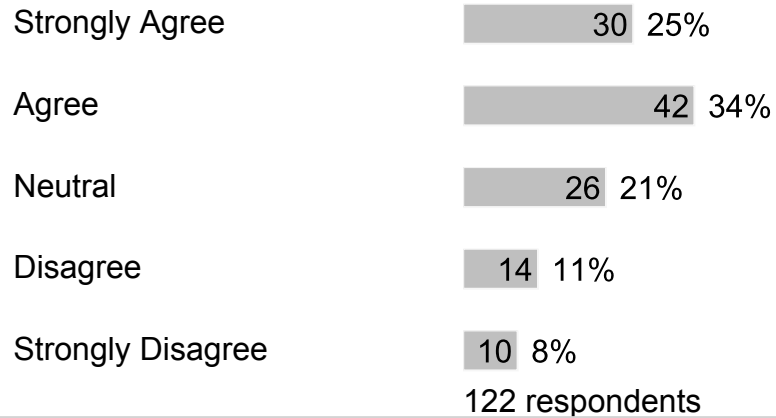

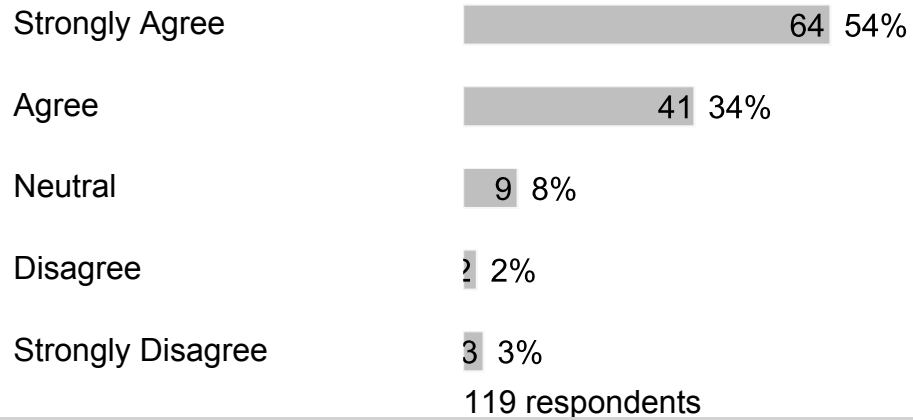

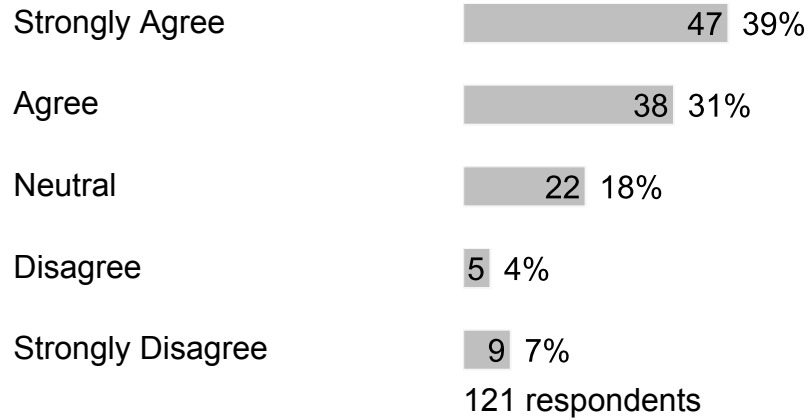
**17. My teachers ask my family to come to school activities.**
