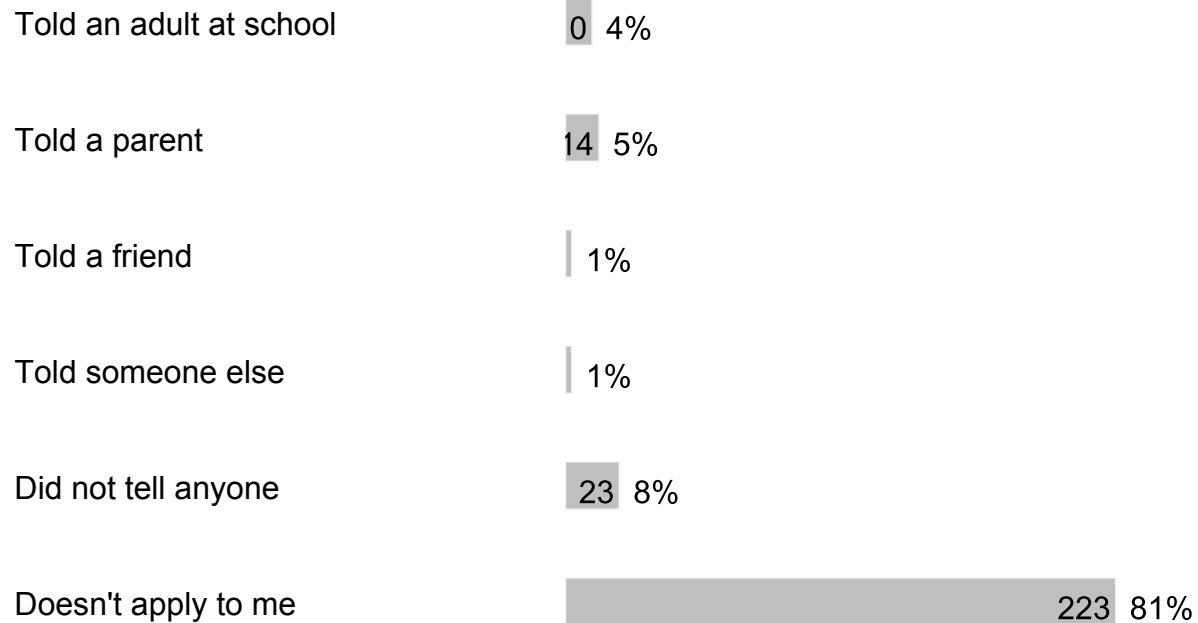

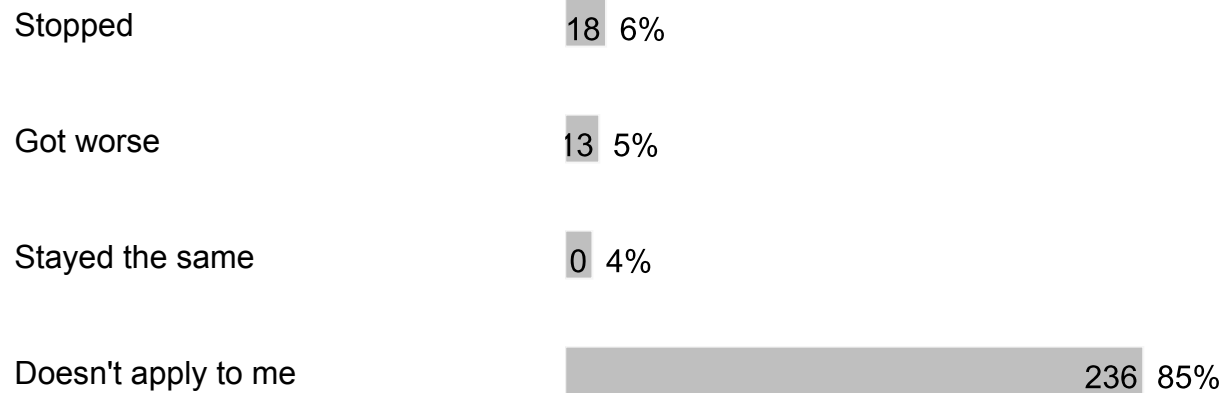

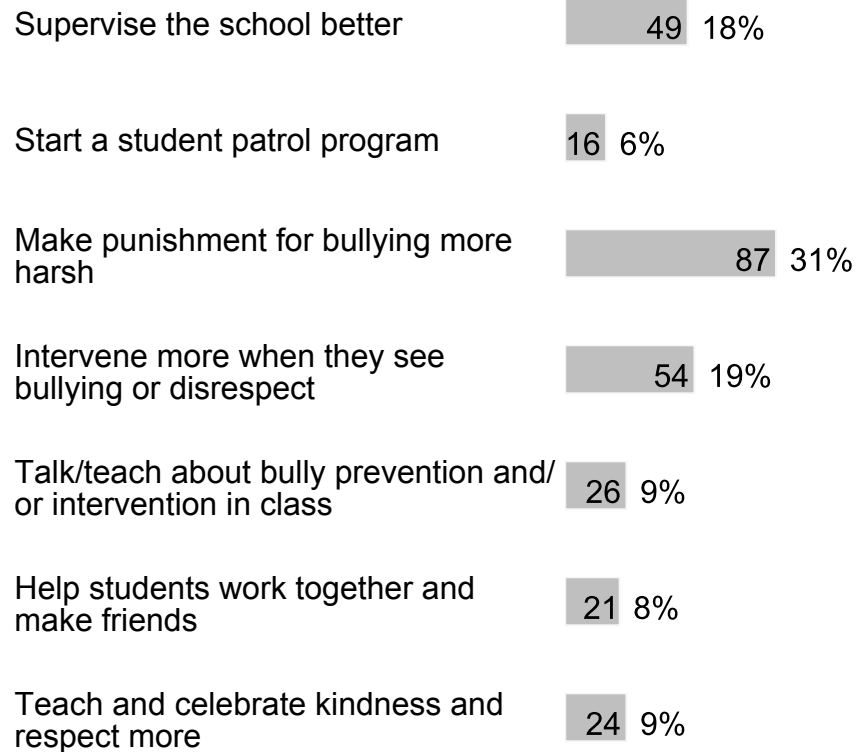

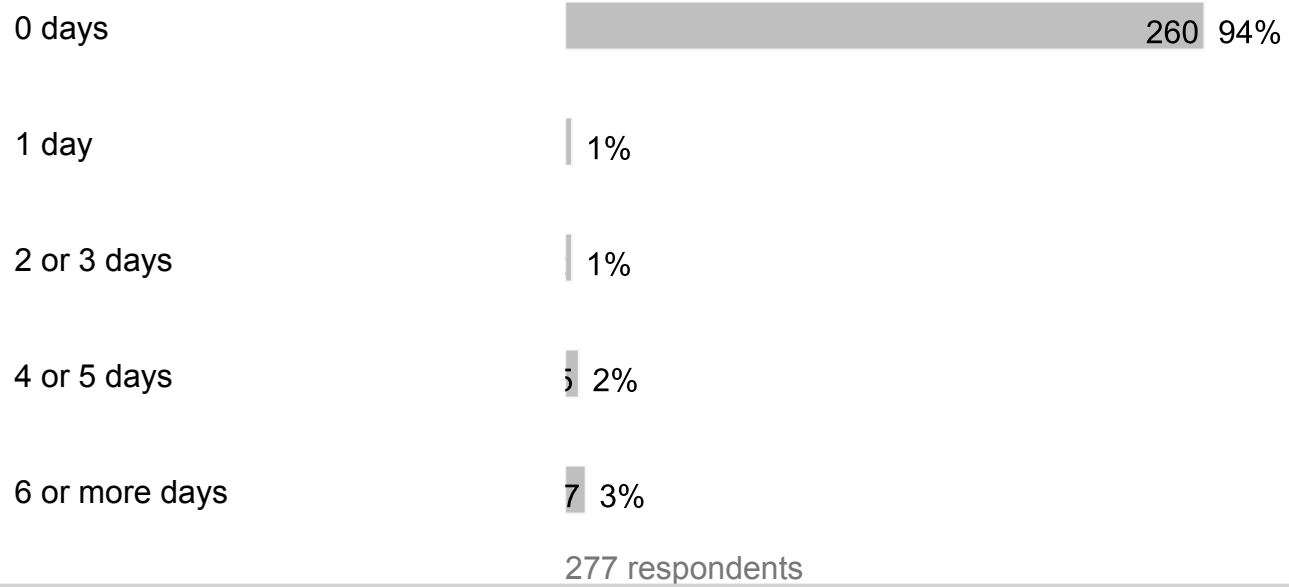


12. What can adults do to help stop bullying at school?

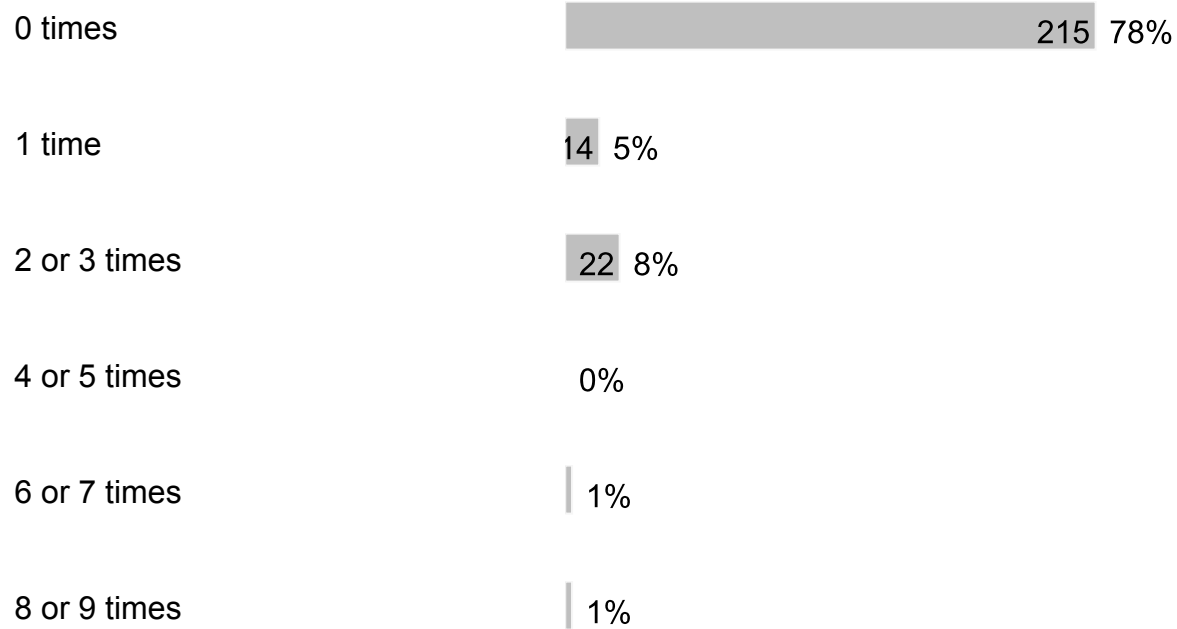

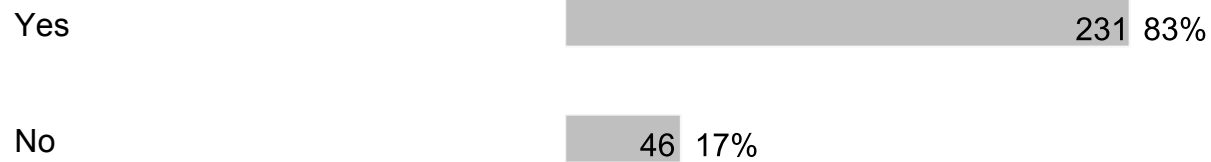

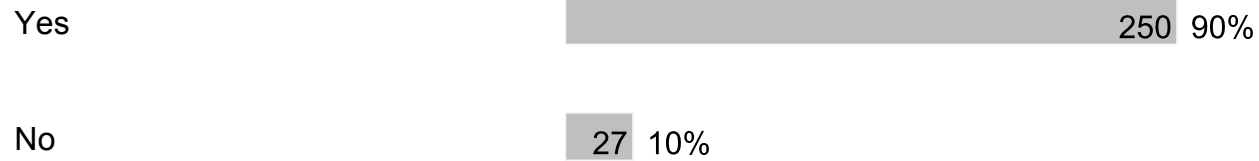

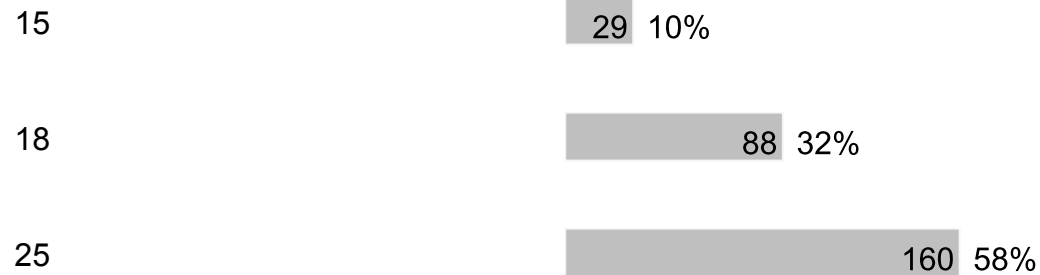

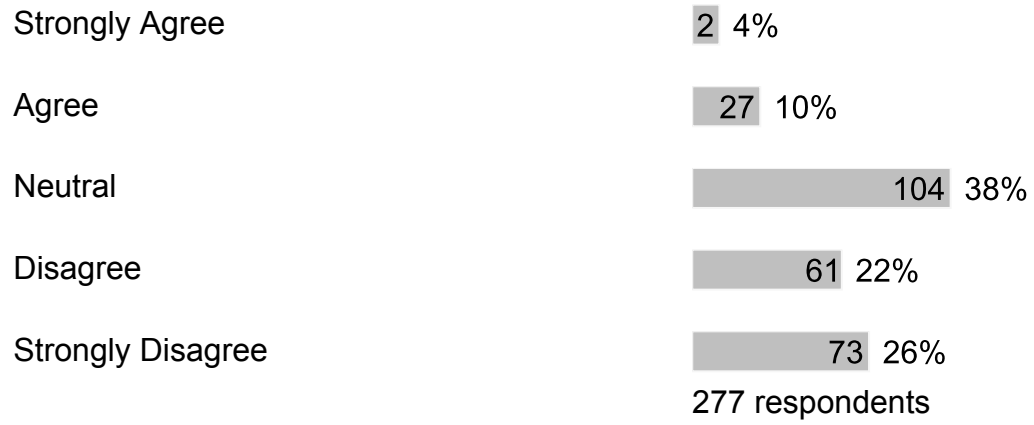

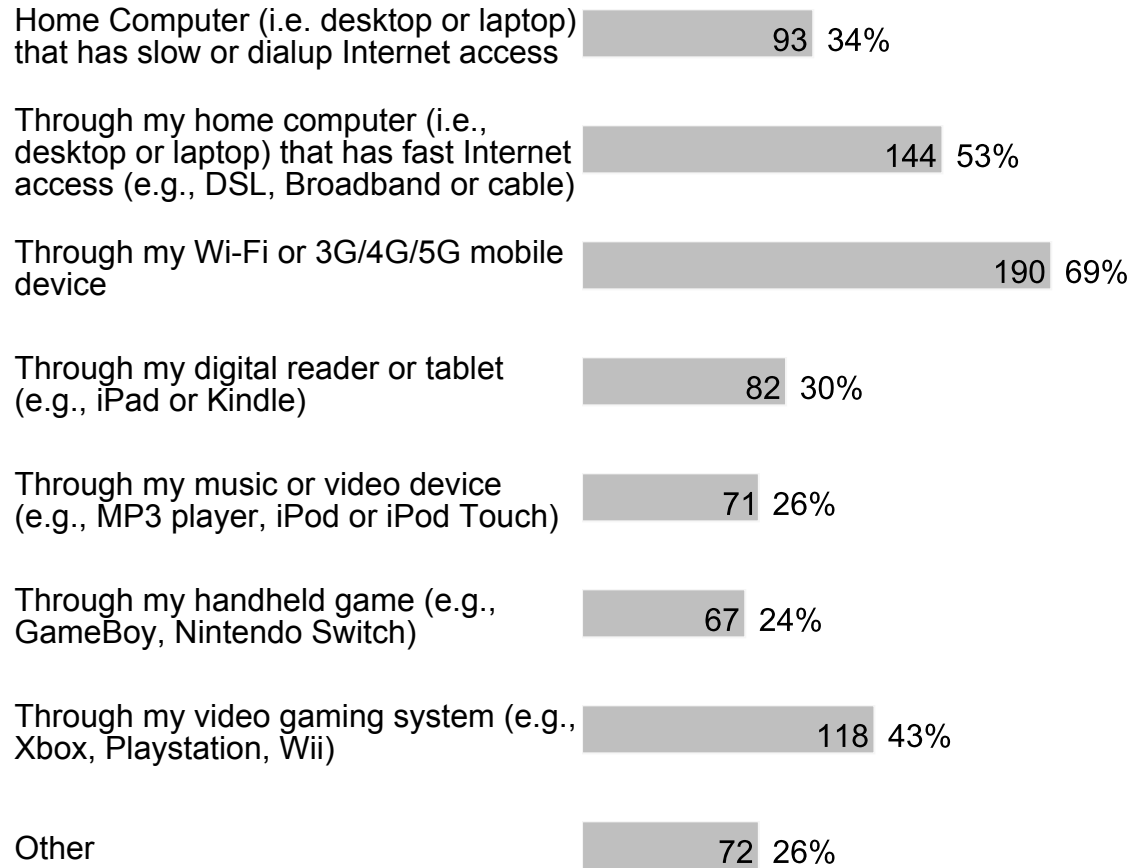

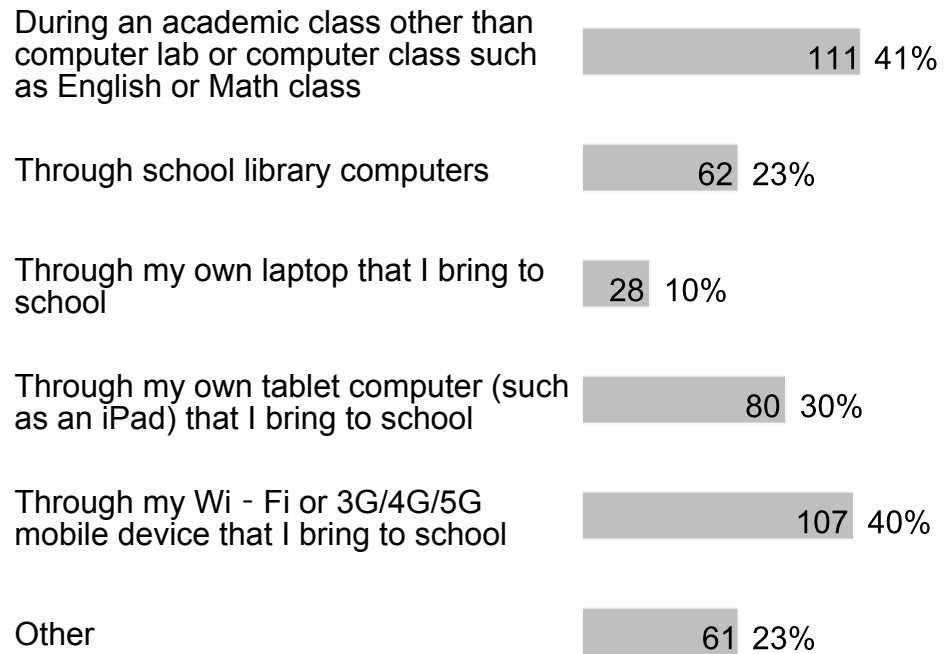

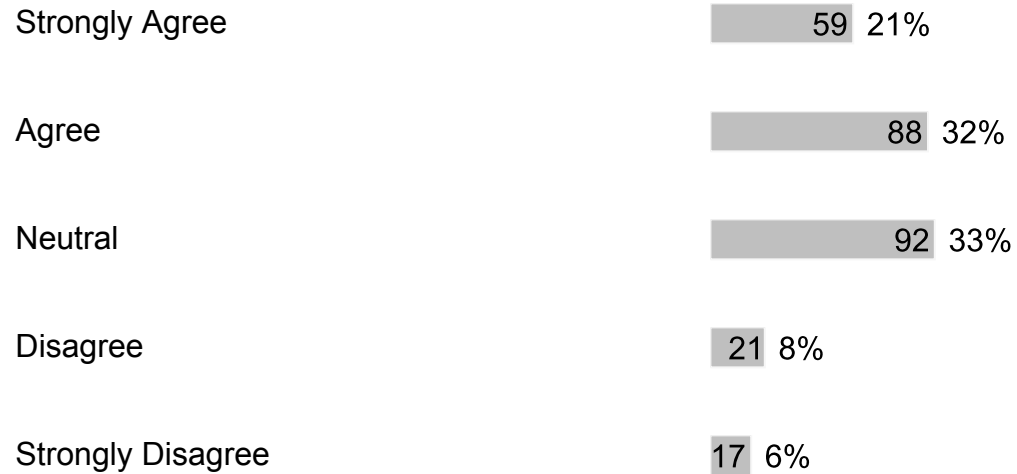

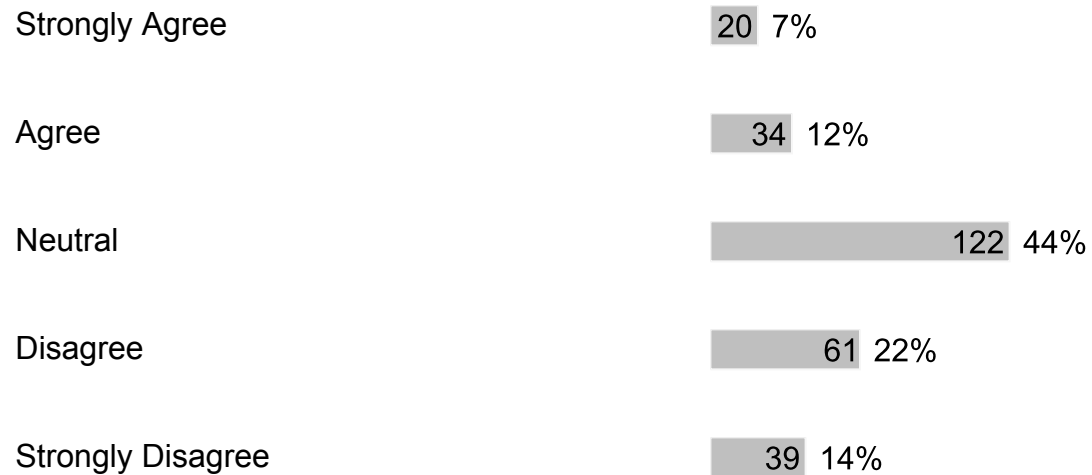

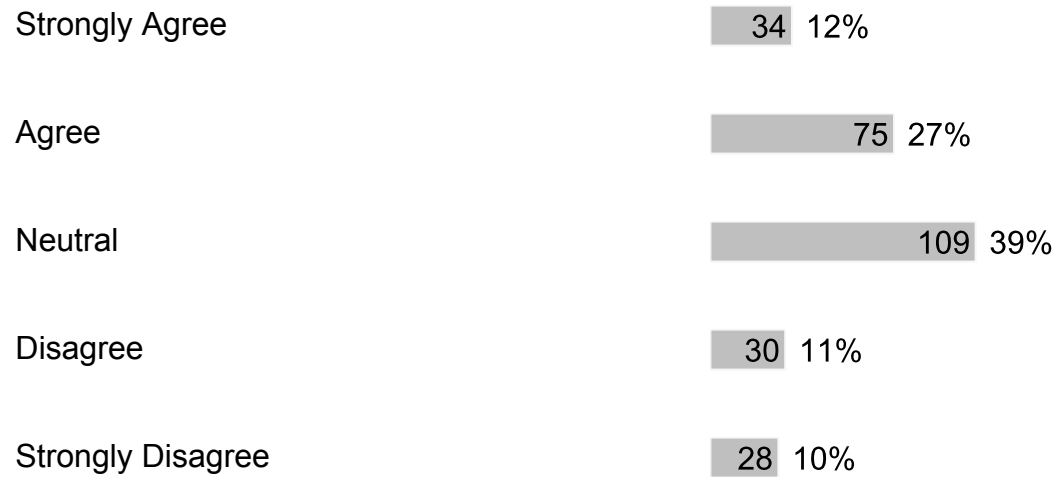

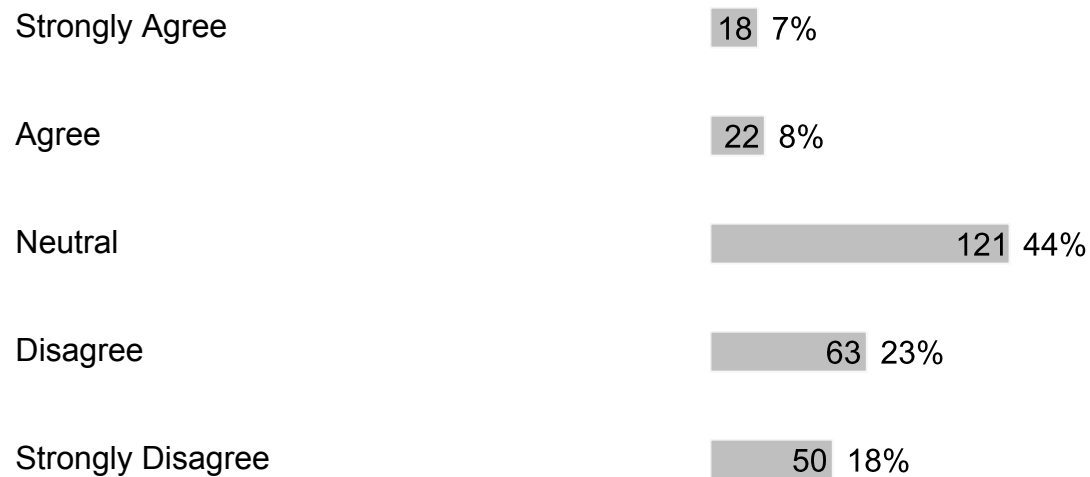

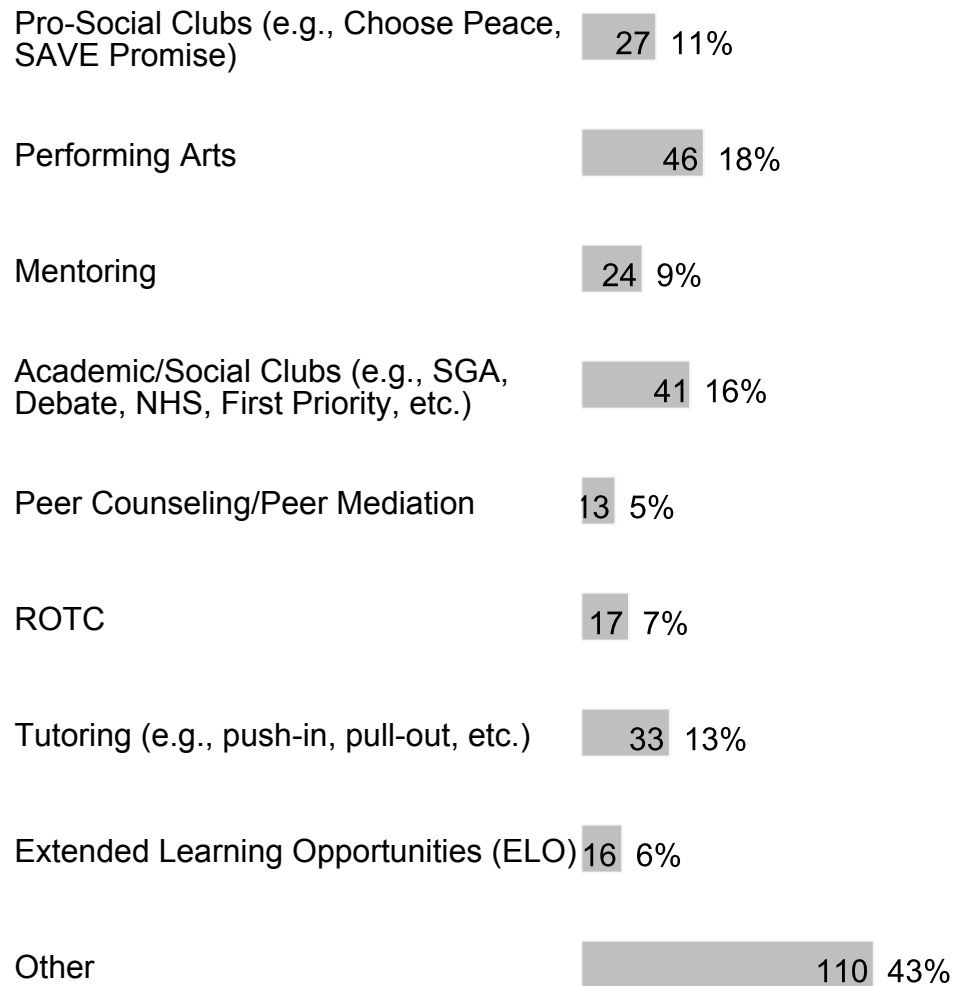

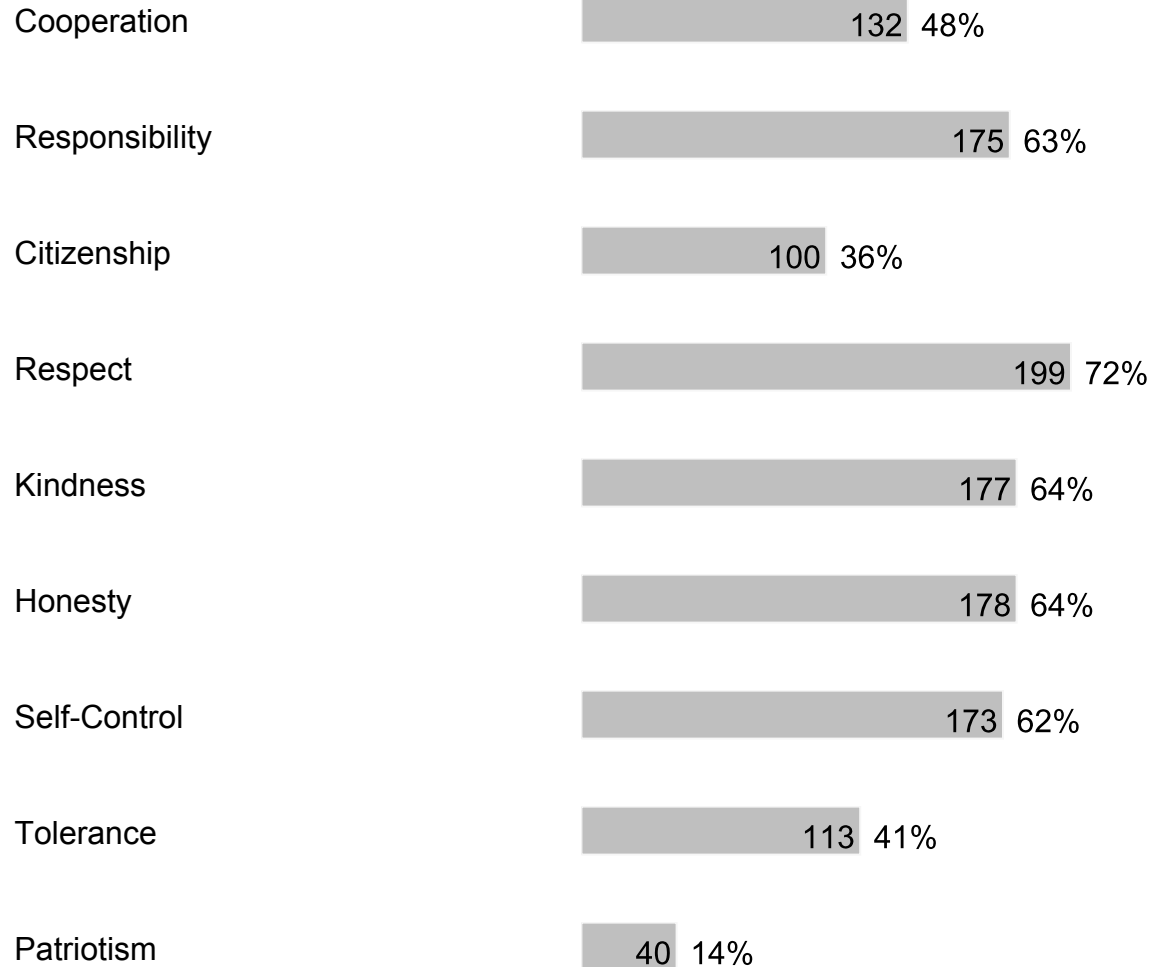

10. Which character traits do you value the most in yourself and others? (check all that apply)



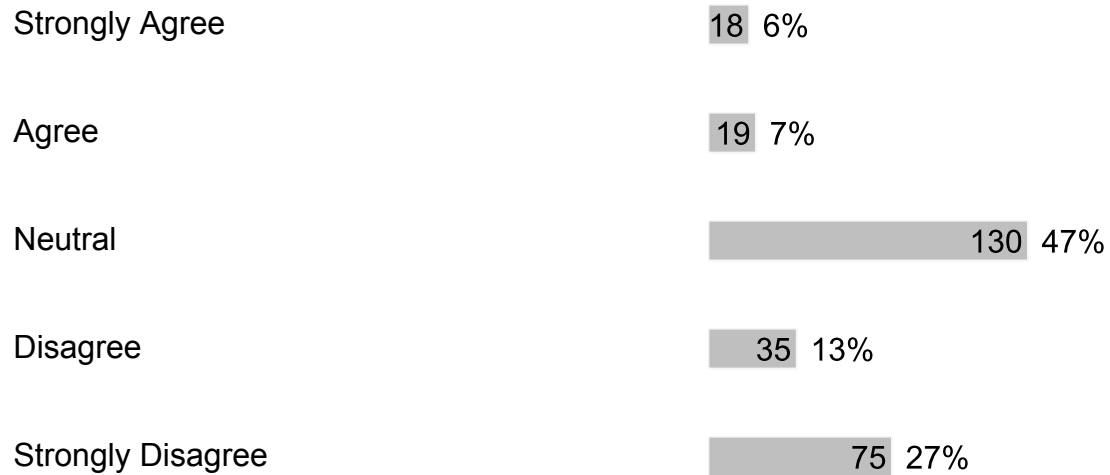
