What data is being collected?

- FAST Star/Cambium Assessment- The FAST is administered to all students in K-5. It will be assessed 3 times a year.
- Kindergarten Letter names, sounds and concepts of print data. Letter names and sounds, concepts of print are assessed 4 times a year.
- Benchmark Advance Unit Tests used for progress monitoring
- Additional Phonics & Phonemic Awareness assessments – BCPS Reading Department Diagnostic

Curriculum and Progress Monitoring

- Based on data results from FAST assessments, students are provided targeted reading instruction and interventions. Teachers will use the updated Decision Tree chart to determine interventions based on need.
- Tier 3 Students will be given intervention small group instruction provided by a reading endorsed teacher.

Components of Reading

- Phonological Awareness, Phonics, Fluency, Oral Language, Vocabulary and Comprehension

- Screener, Diagnostic, Progress Monitoring and Summative
