Coral Park Elementary School, located in Coral Springs, Florida, is a proud member of Broward County Public Schools. Situated in the northwestern area of Broward County, our school serves a predominantly middle-class community comprised of working families. Coral Springs itself is a culturally rich and diverse city, and our student population is a direct reflection of this diversity.

Our current enrollment is 435 students in grades PreK through five. The demographic composition of our student body includes 23.2% White, 34.9% Hispanic, 28.5% Black, 7.6% Asian, and 5.7% Multi-Racial students. Additionally, 16.78% of our students are English Language Learners, and 30.34% receive Exceptional Student Education (ESE) services. Coral Park is also home to a specialized Autism program, and we remain deeply committed to ensuring that all students with special needs are fully included in schoolwide activities.

One example of this commitment is our Play Pals Program, a peer partnership initiative where general education students are paired with ESE peers to build physical and social skills through structured play. Beyond this program, Coral Park offers a variety of enrichment opportunities for students, including clubs in Music, Robotics, Environmental Studies, Speech and Debate, Student Council, Safety Patrol, and TV Production.

Our staff plays an essential role in the success of our school. Coral Park benefits from a highly dedicated faculty and staff with a low turnover rate, which fosters stability and continuity for students and families. The professional culture at Coral Park is one of continuous learning, with teachers actively engaged in district professional development as well as bi-monthly, on-site Professional Learning Communities (PLCs). This ongoing commitment to growth extends into classrooms, where our educators nurture a strong love of learning among students.

Like many communities, Coral Springs faces the challenges of rising housing costs, which have impacted our school's enrollment. Over the past three years, Coral Park has experienced a gradual decline in student enrollment, a trend that has continued into the current school year. Despite this challenge, we remain steadfast in our mission to provide high-quality instruction, maintain a supportive learning environment, and ensure every student has the opportunity to achieve success.

The vision of Coral Park Elementary School is to prepare today's students for success in tomorrow's world by fostering a school culture that empowers teachers to address the diverse academic and social-emotional needs of all learners.

Over the past three years, Coral Park Elementary has demonstrated steady growth in student achievement. Our percentage of 3rd grade students scoring proficient in reading has increased from 51% in 2023 to 67% in 2025. This positive trend reflects the effectiveness of our literacy Science of Reading initiatives, targeted interventions, and data-driven instructional

practices in addition, our schoolwide commitment to science instruction has yielded significant results. With the implementation of a daily dedicated science block and the integration of science standards within Coral Park's STEAM special, our fifth-grade proficiency rate in science increased by 12 percentage points, rising from 57% in 2024 to 69% in 2025. These gains highlight the success of intentional scheduling, standards-based instruction, and engaging enrichment opportunities in strengthening student achievement in core content
