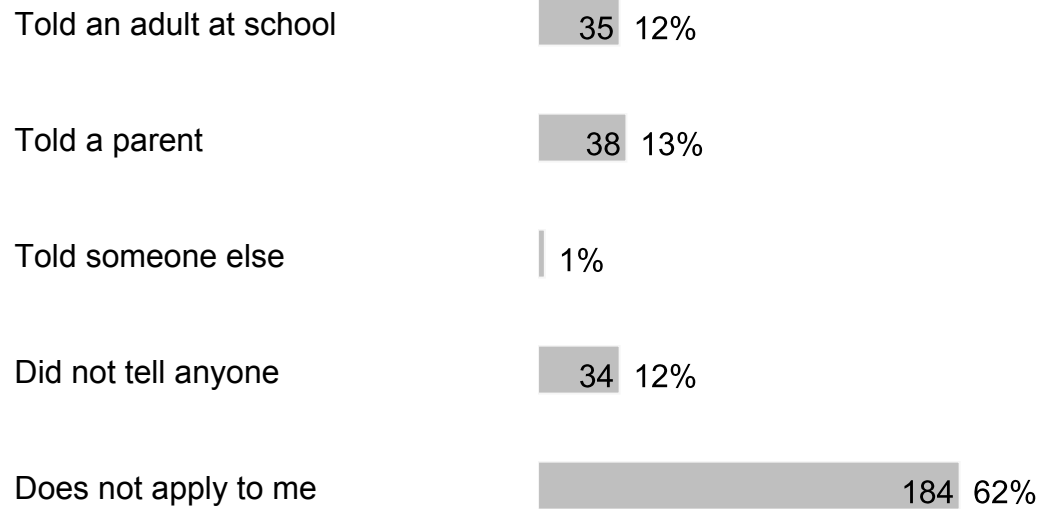

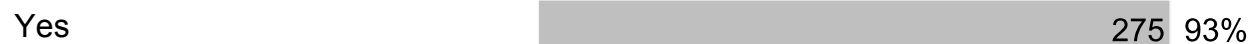

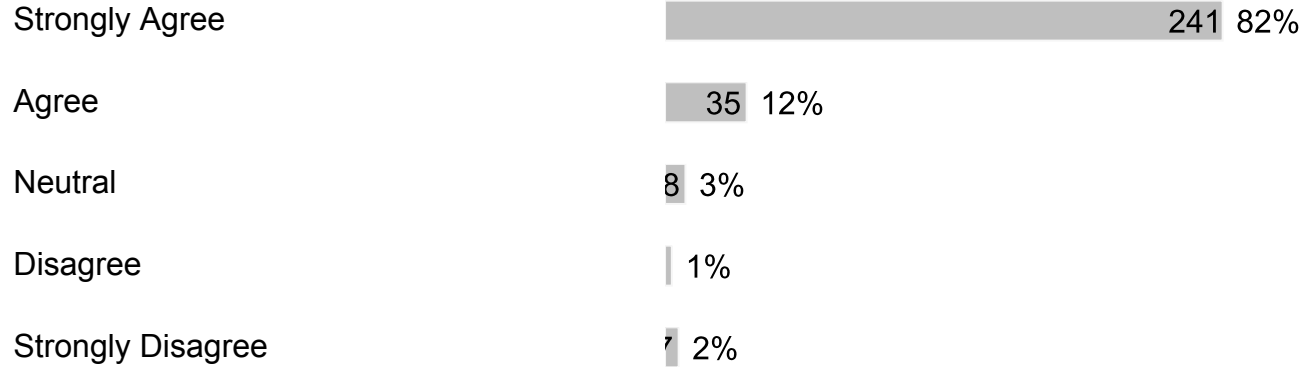

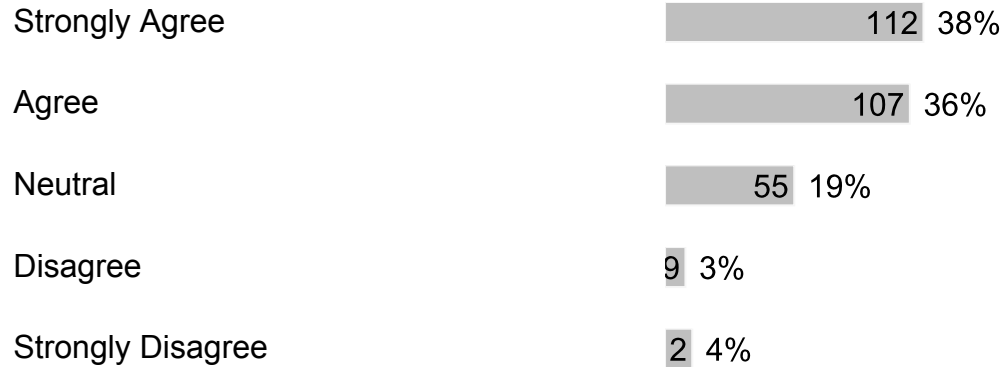

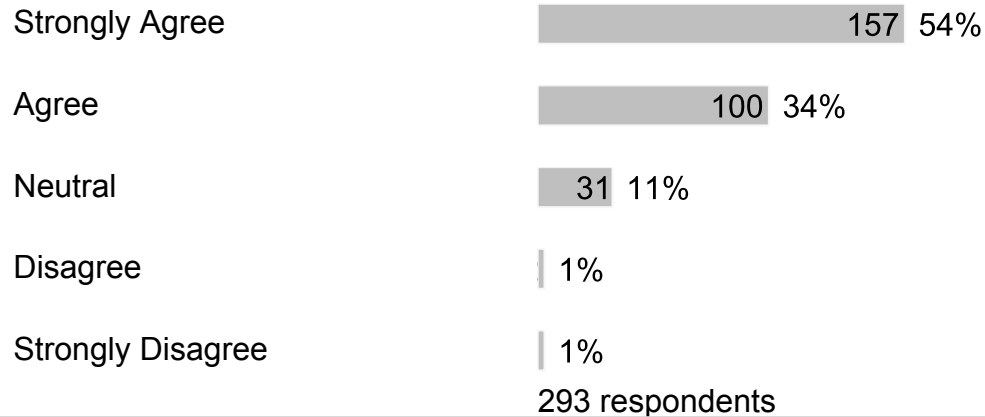

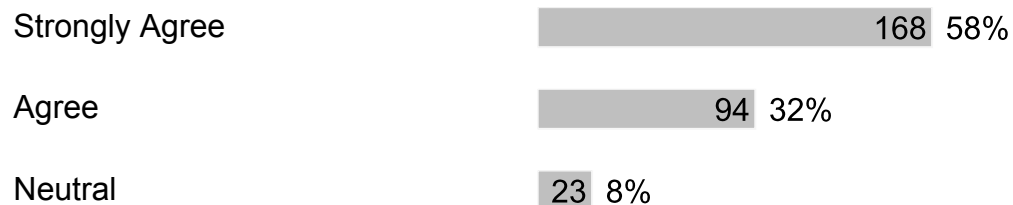

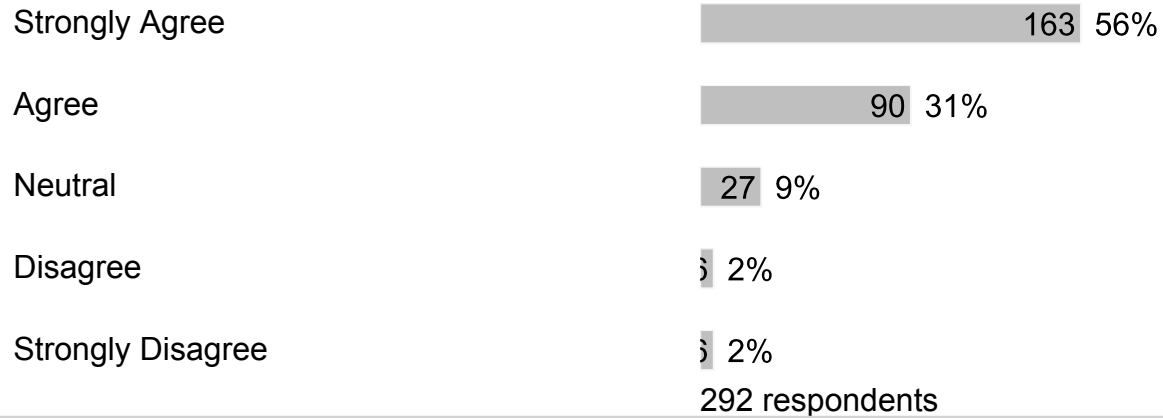

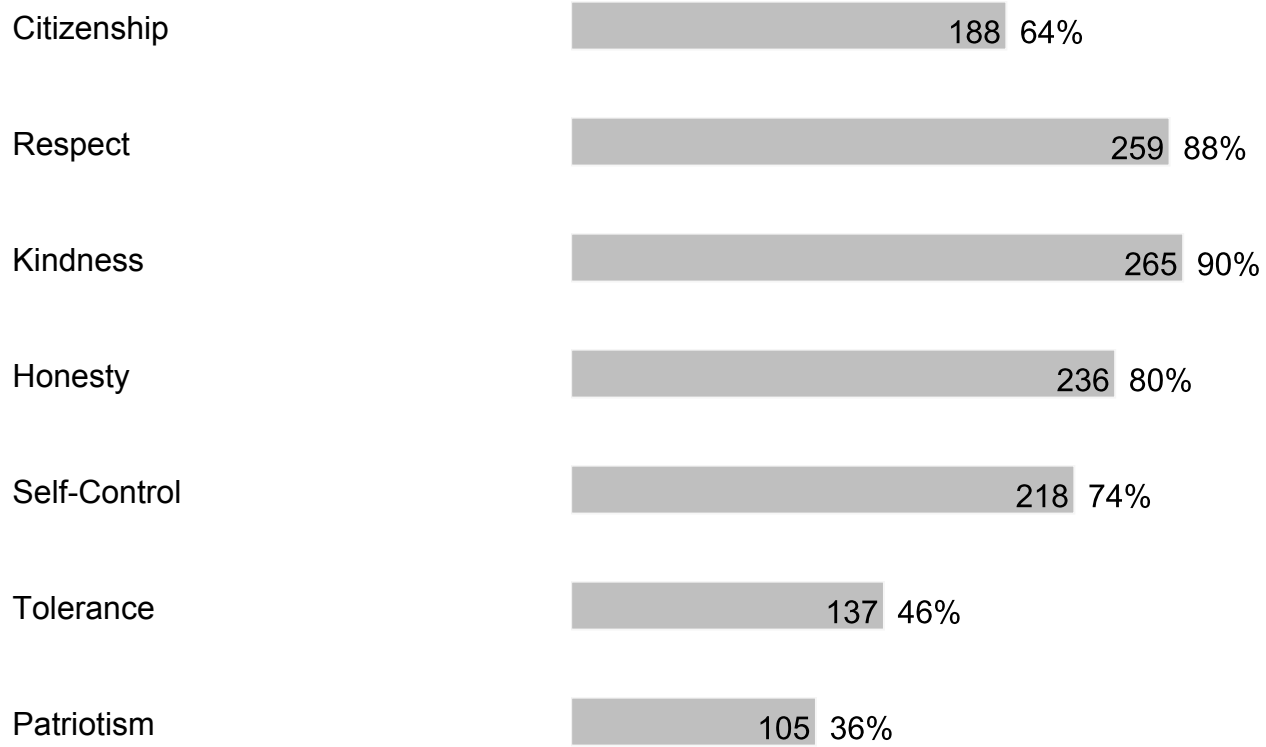

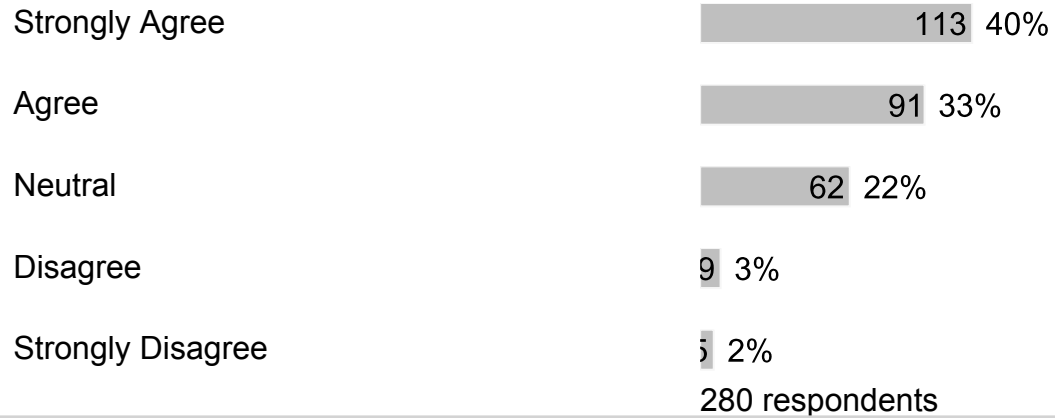

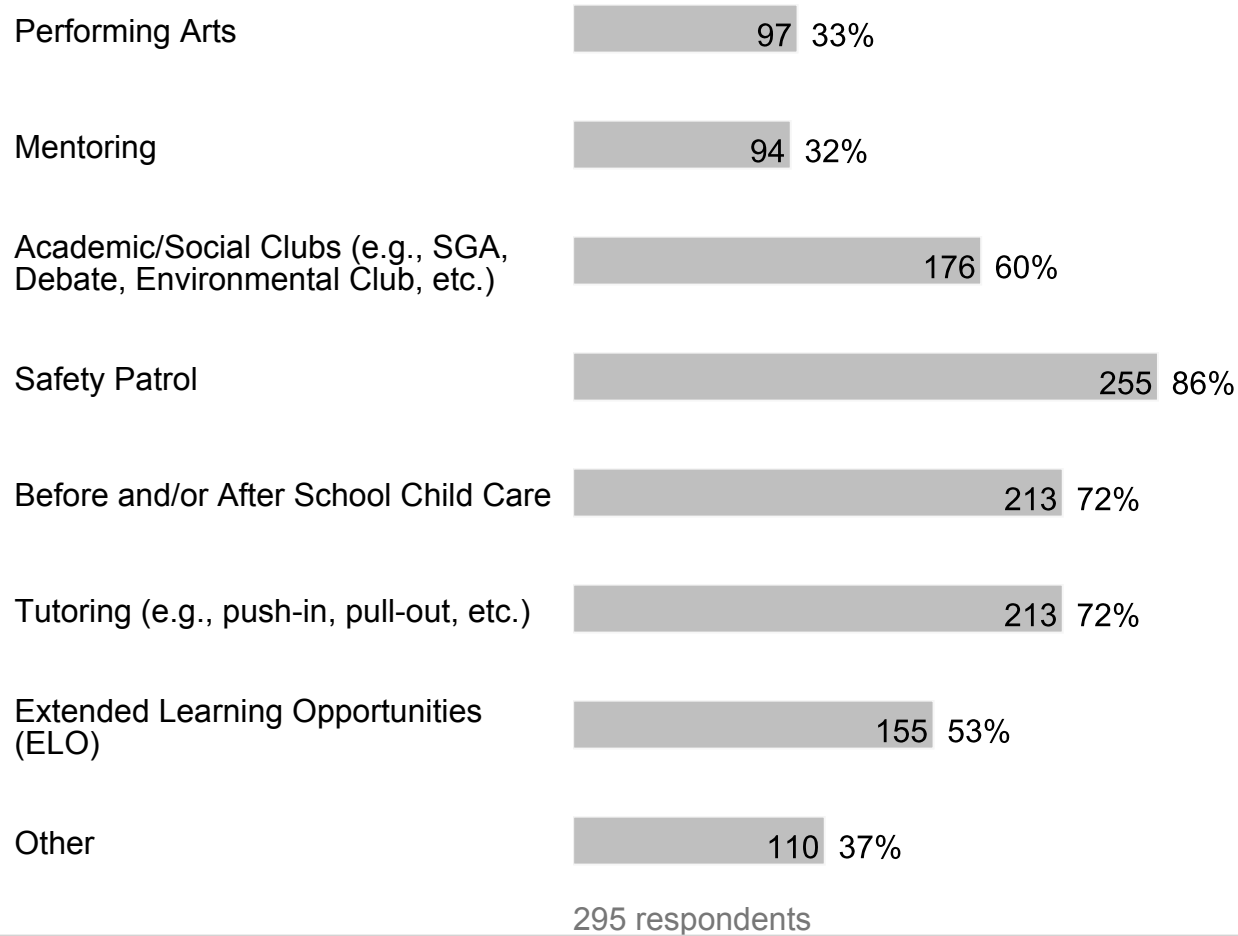


12. I receive acknowledgement and/or praise for my strengths or accomplishments by adults at my school.

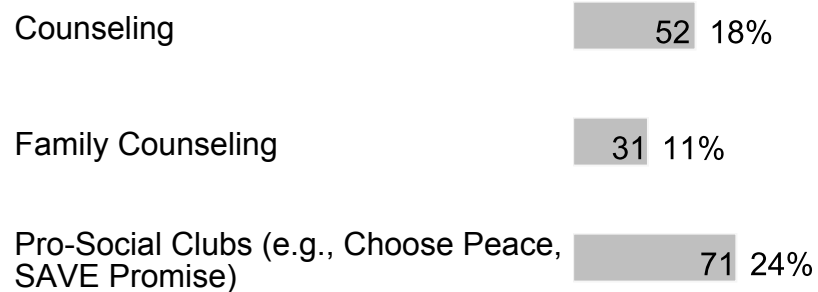


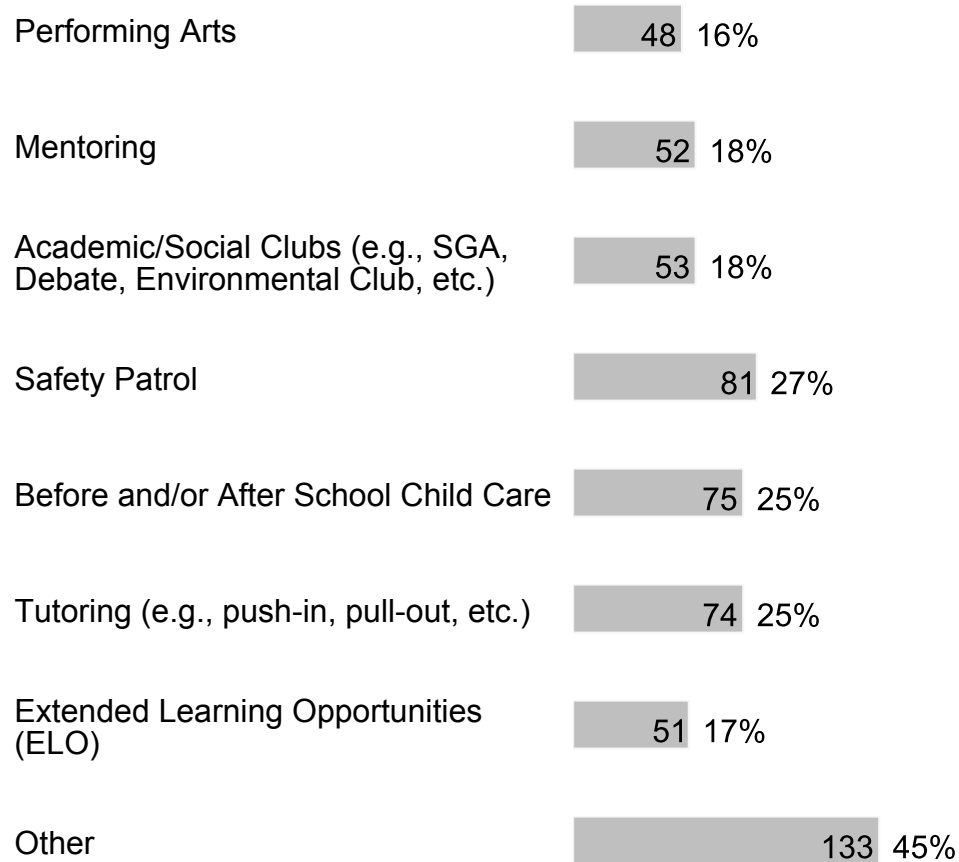

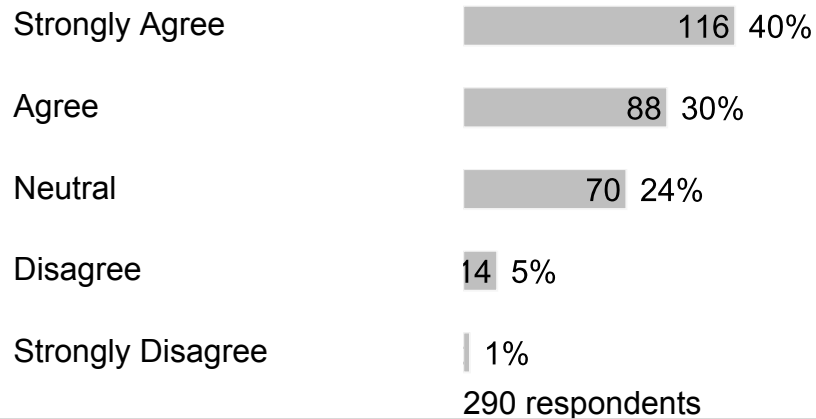

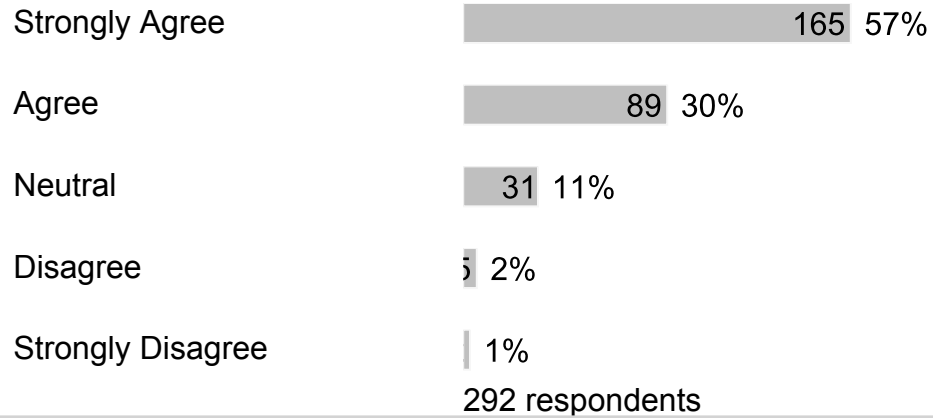
14. I actively participate in class discussions and activities.



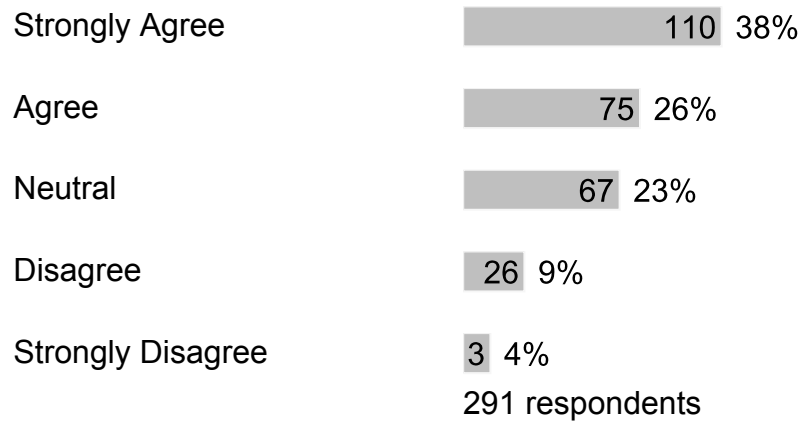
15. My teachers tell me how I should behave.



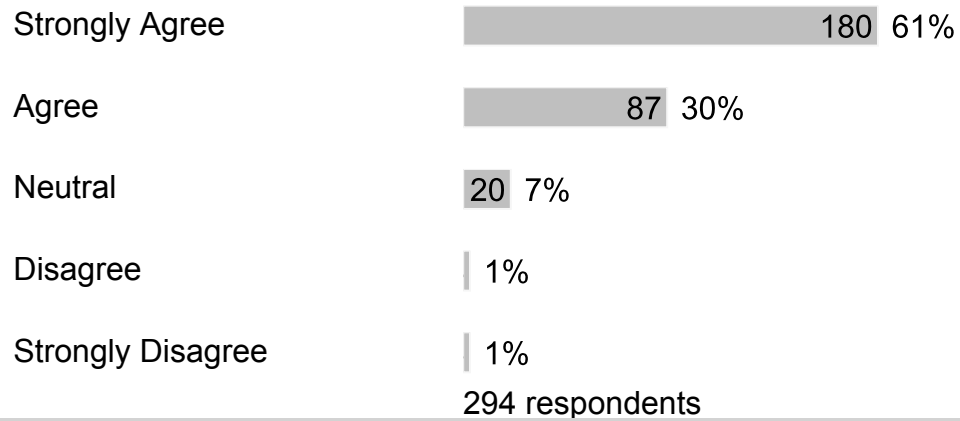

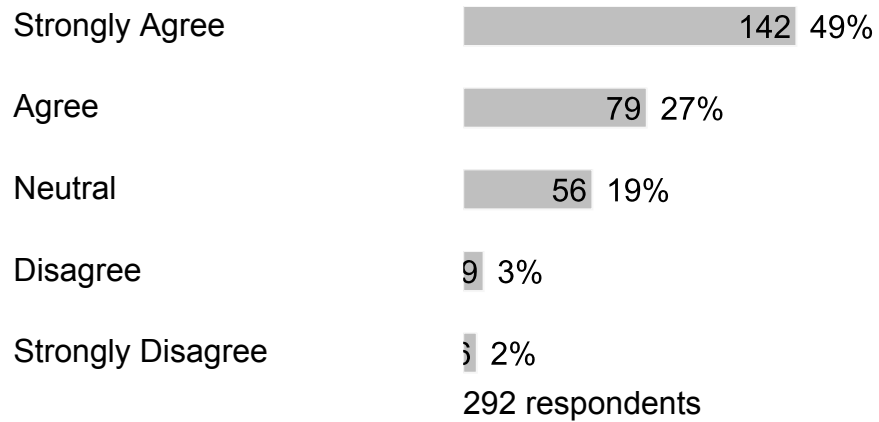
