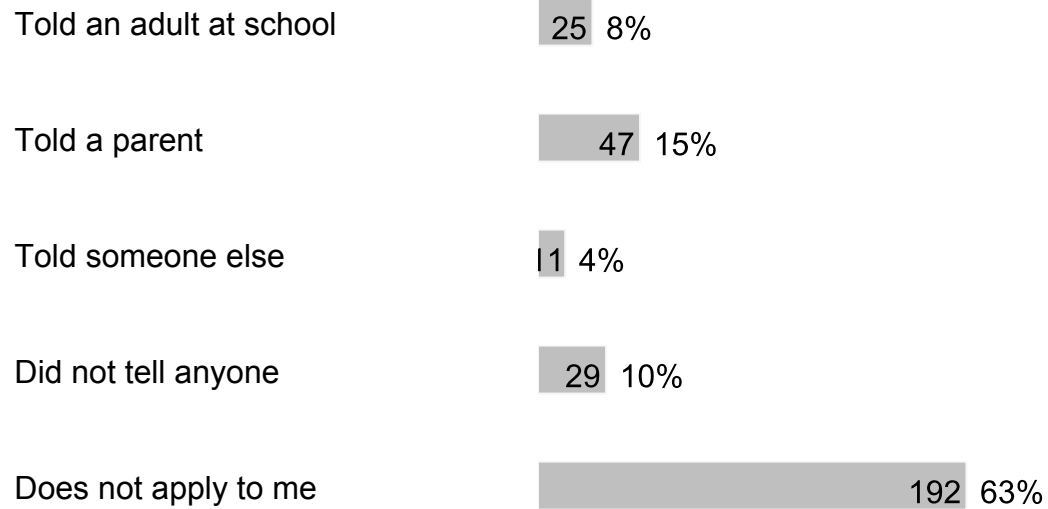

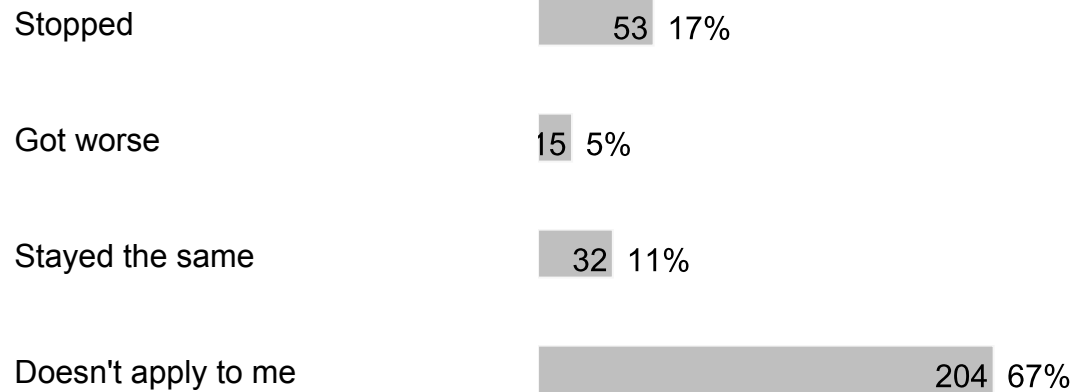

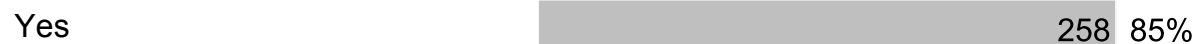

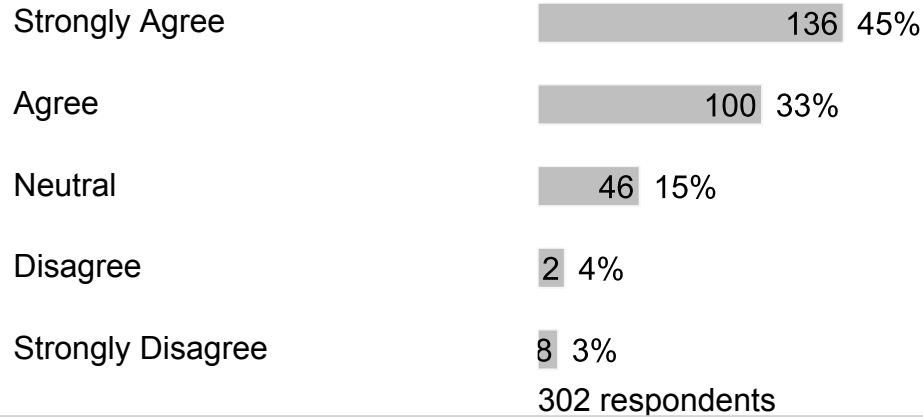

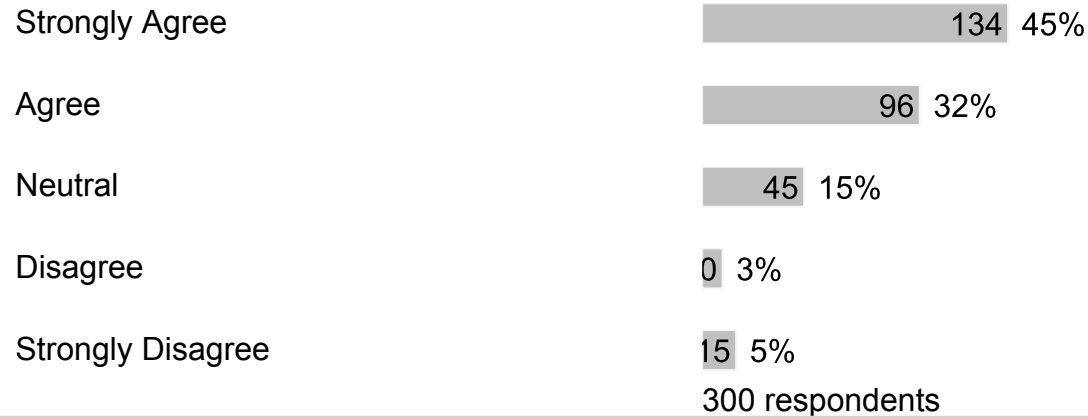

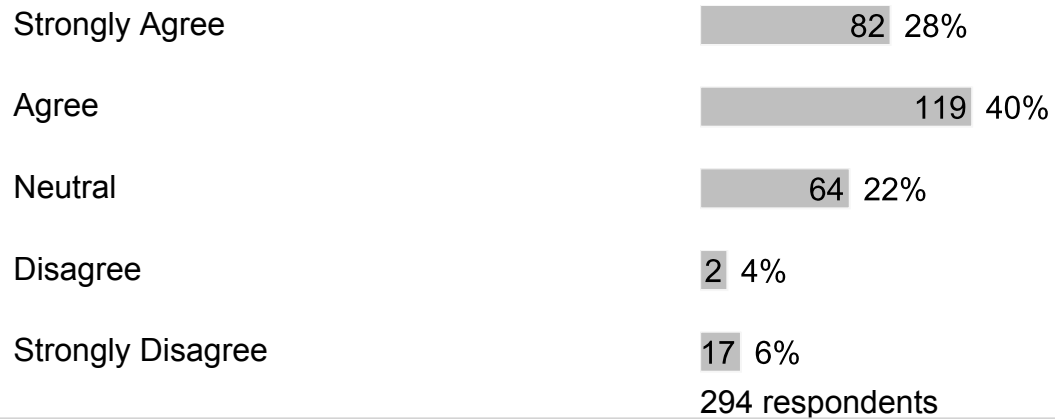

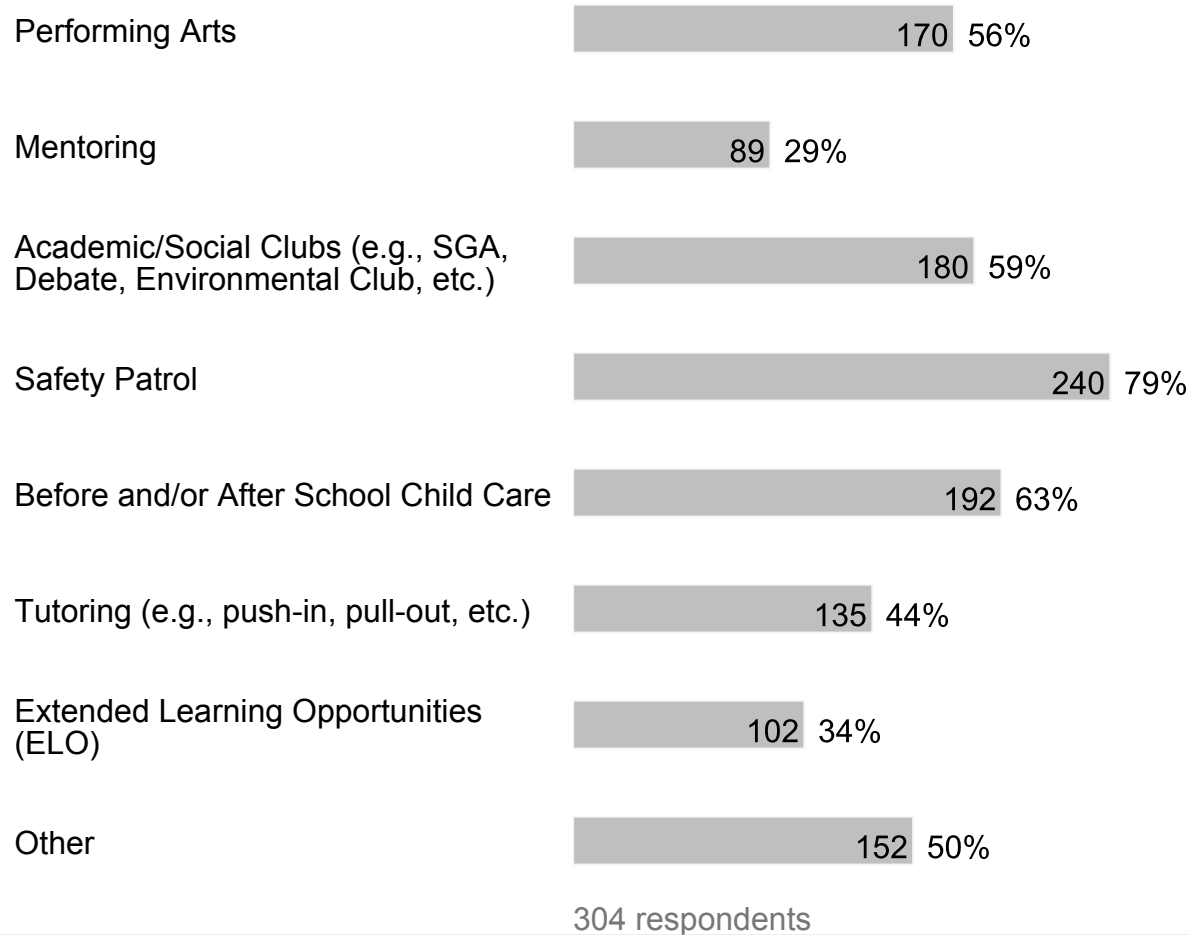


**12. I receive acknowledgement and/or praise for my strengths or accomplishments by adults at my school.**

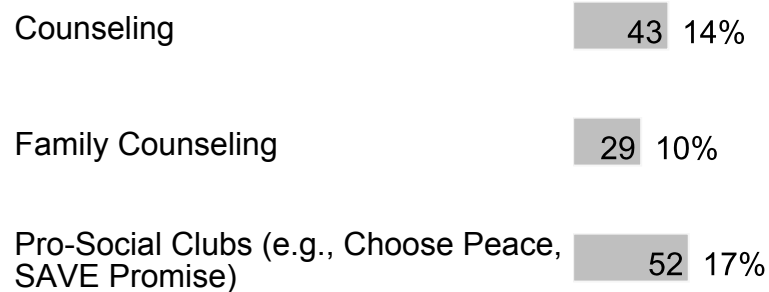


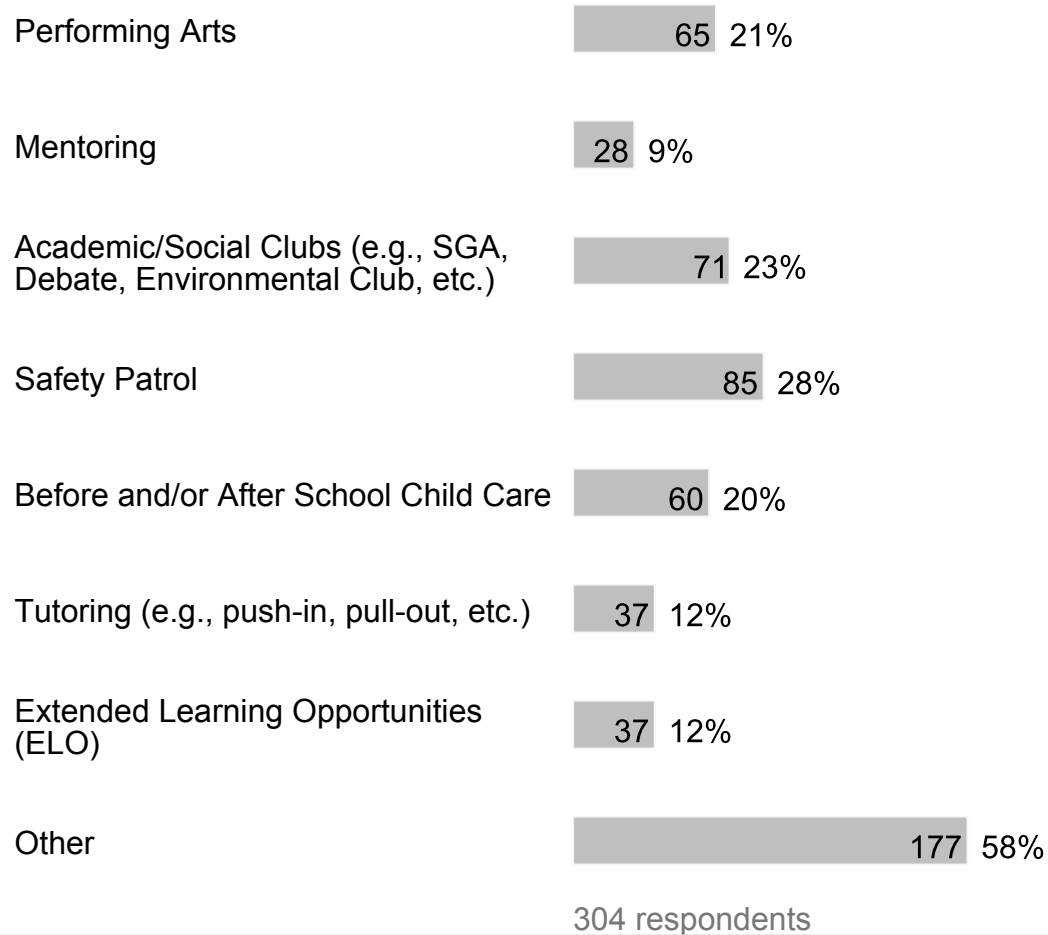

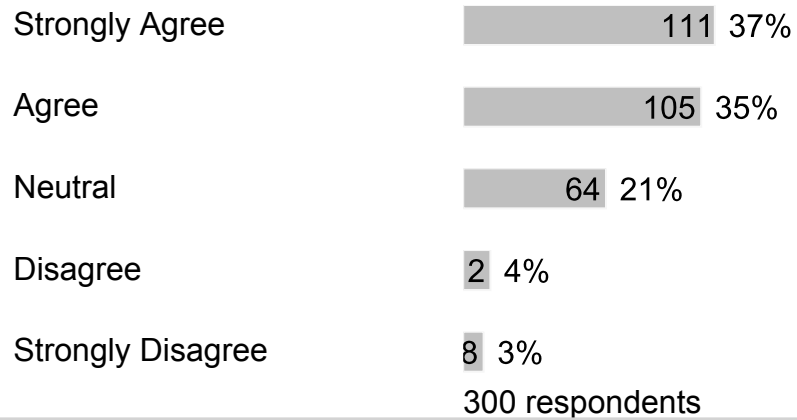

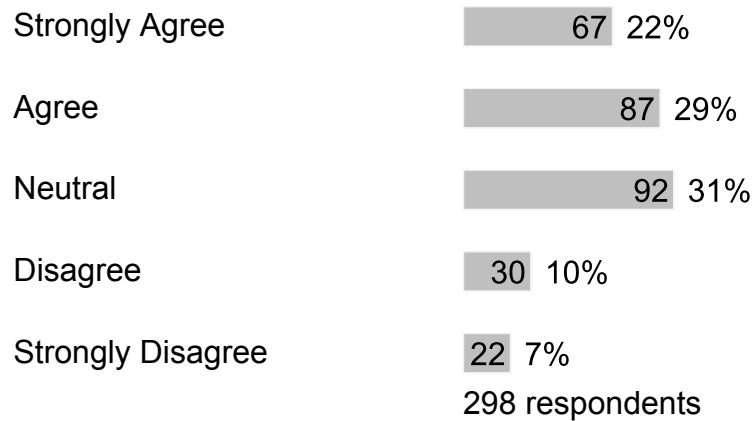
**15. My teachers tell me how I should behave.**



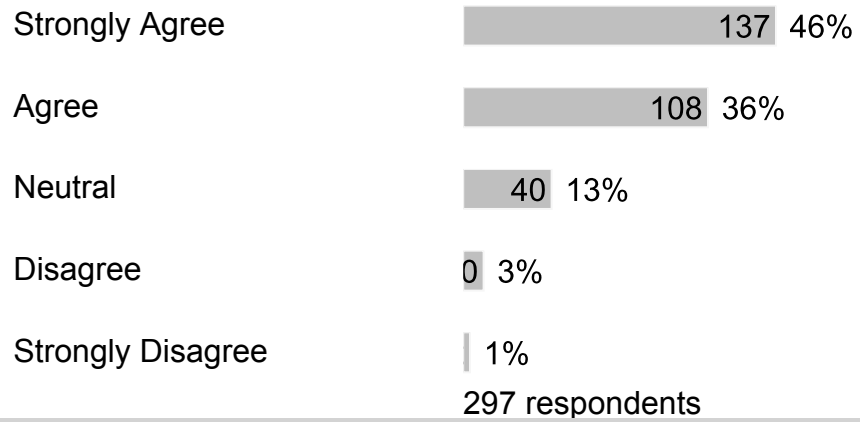
**16. My teachers tell my family how I am doing in school.**



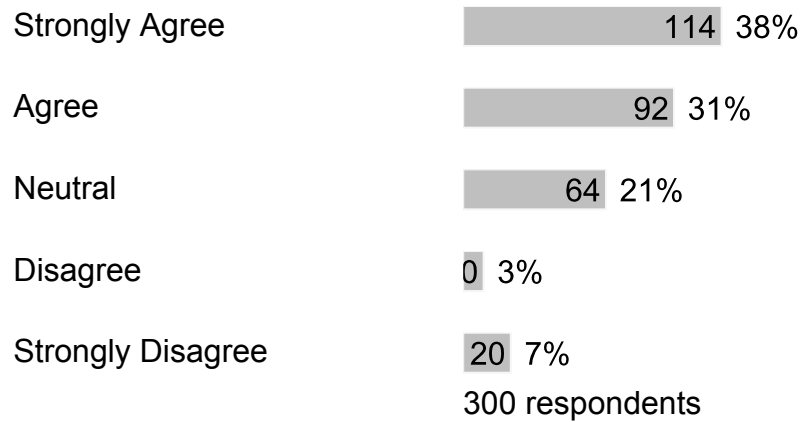
