NOTICE
Mandatory Reporting Of Child Abuse, Abandonment, Or Neglect

PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 39, FLORIDA STATUTES, ALL EMPLOYEES OR AGENTS OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA HAVE:

- 1) AN AFFIRMATIVE DUTY TO REPORT ALL ACTUAL OR SUSPECTED CASES OF CHILD ABUSE, ABANDONMENT, OR NEGLECT;
- 2) IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY IF THEY REPORT SUCH CASES IN GOOD FAITH AND;
- 3) A DUTY TO COOPER WITH CHILD PROTECTIVE INVESTIGATIONS AND ALL OTHER PROVISIONS OF LAW RELATING TO CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT.
