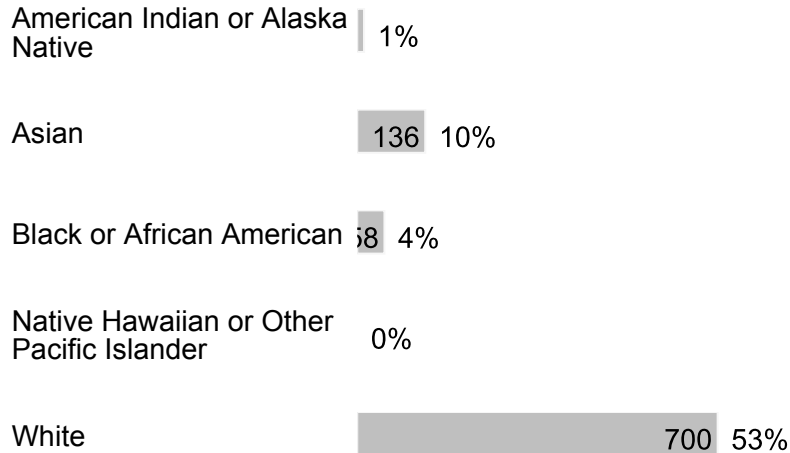

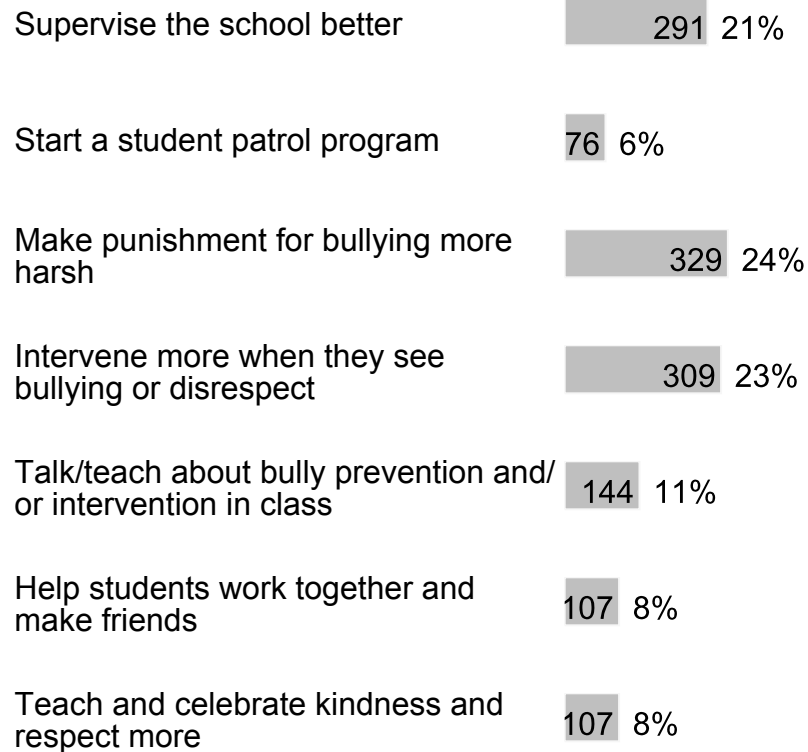

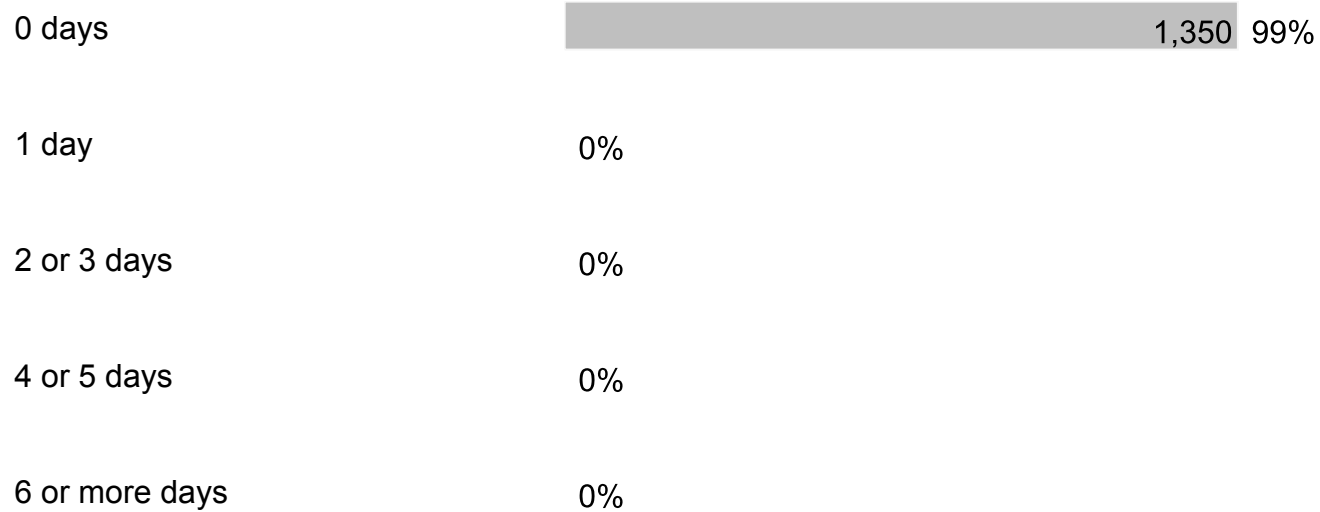

12. What can adults do to help stop bullying at school?

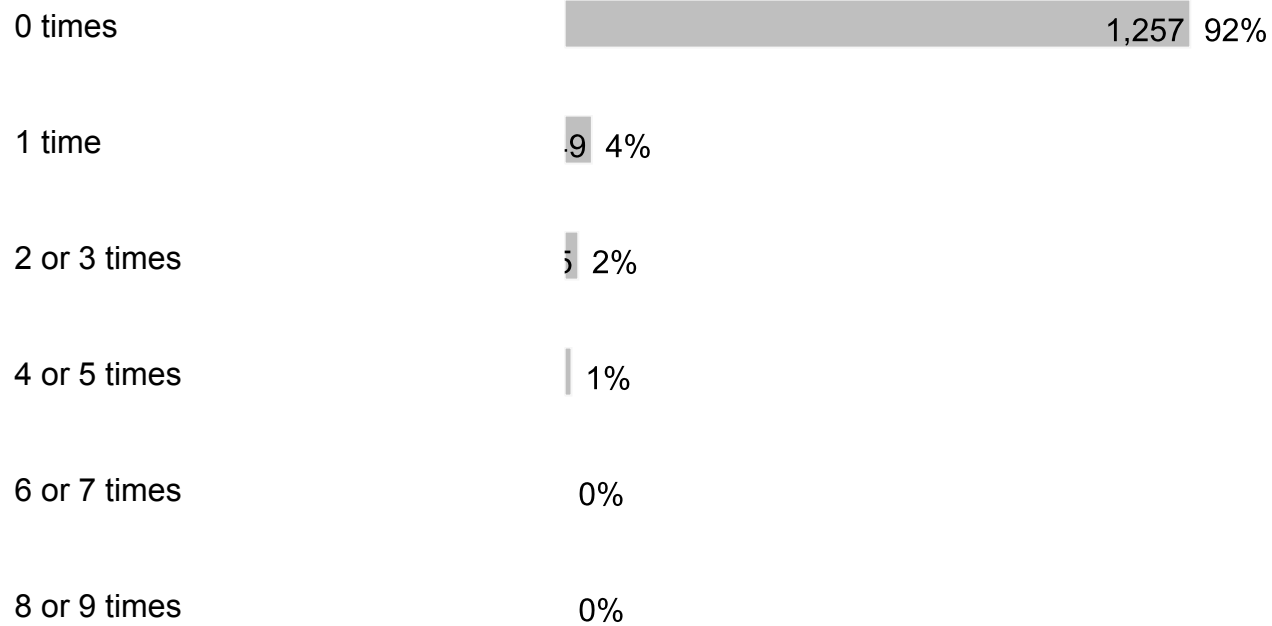


13. During the past 30 days, how many days did you carry a weapon such as a gun, knife or club on school property?

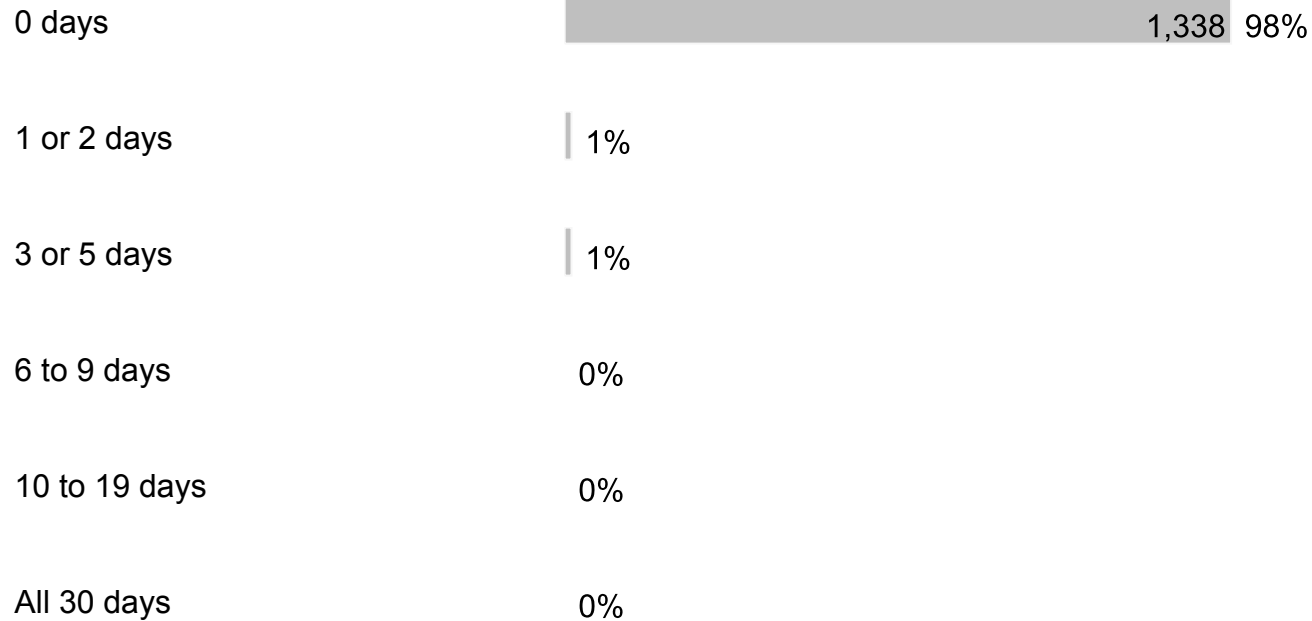

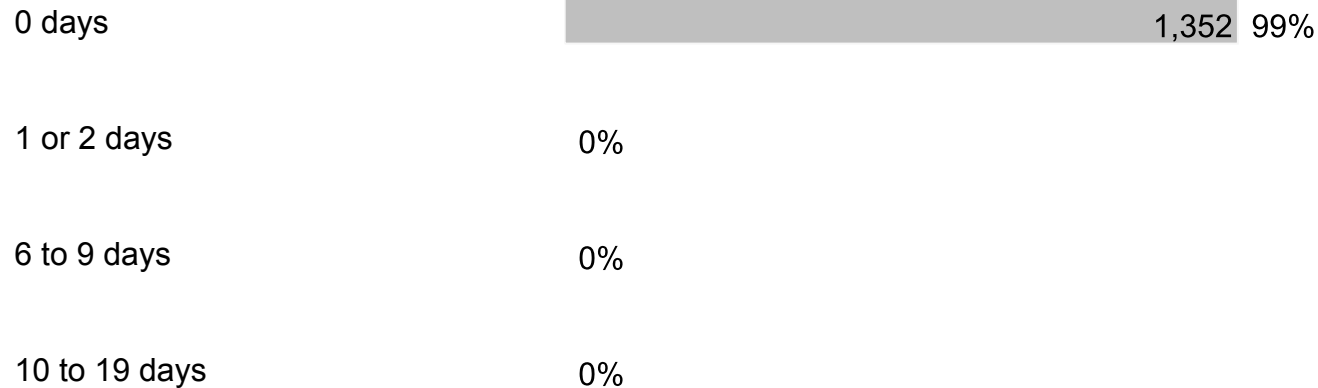

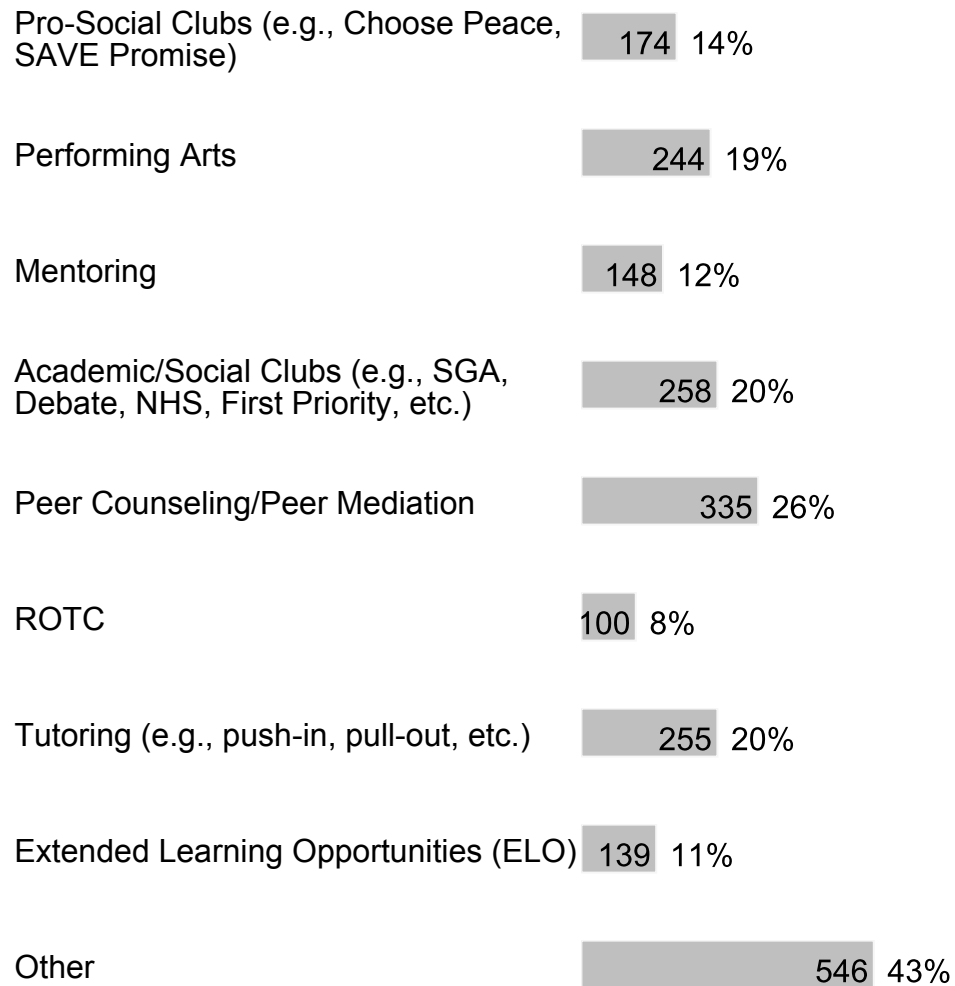

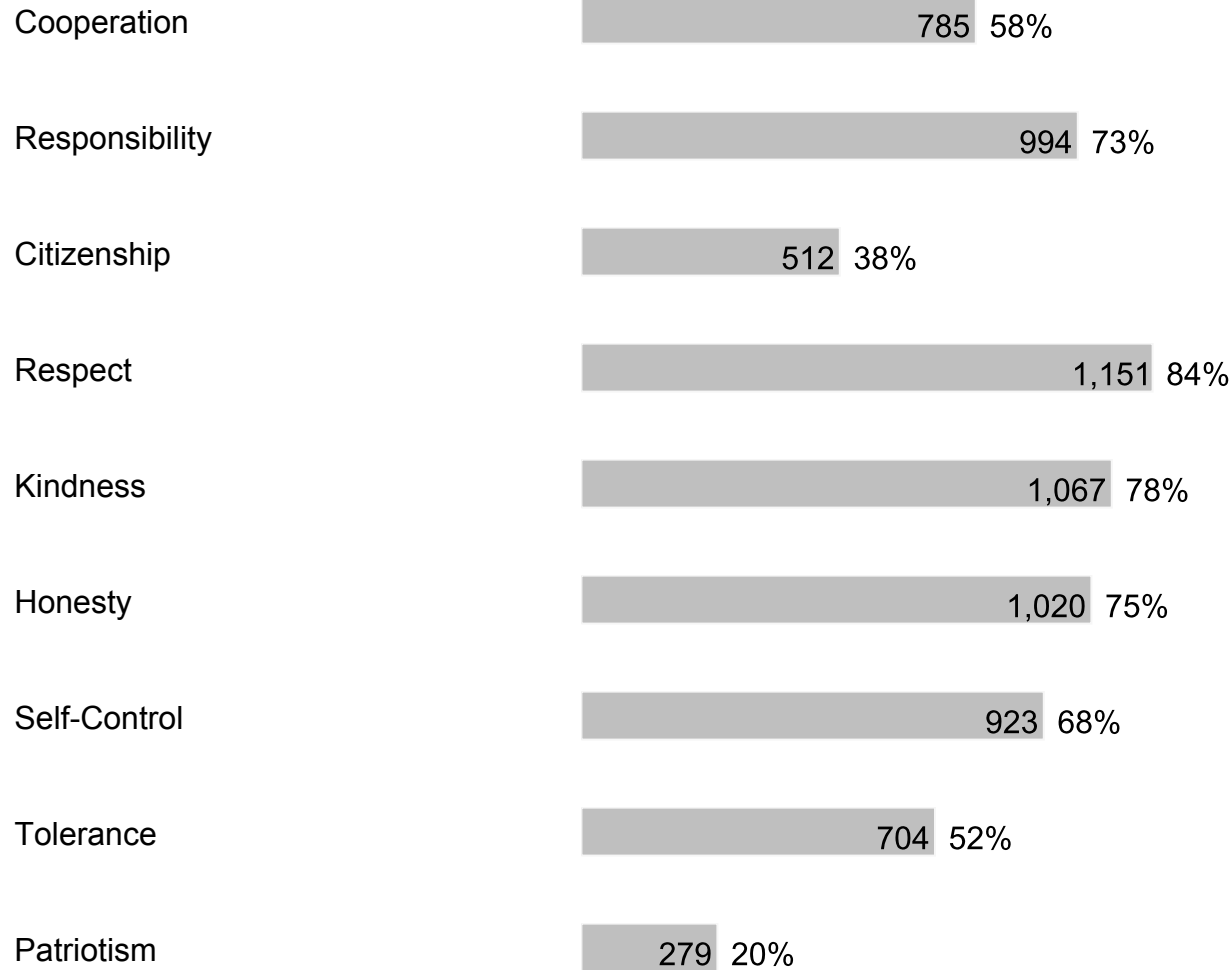

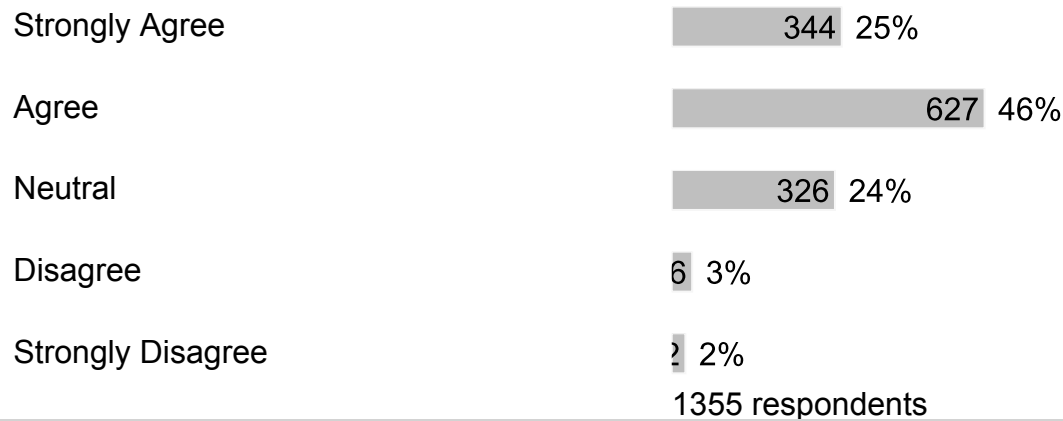

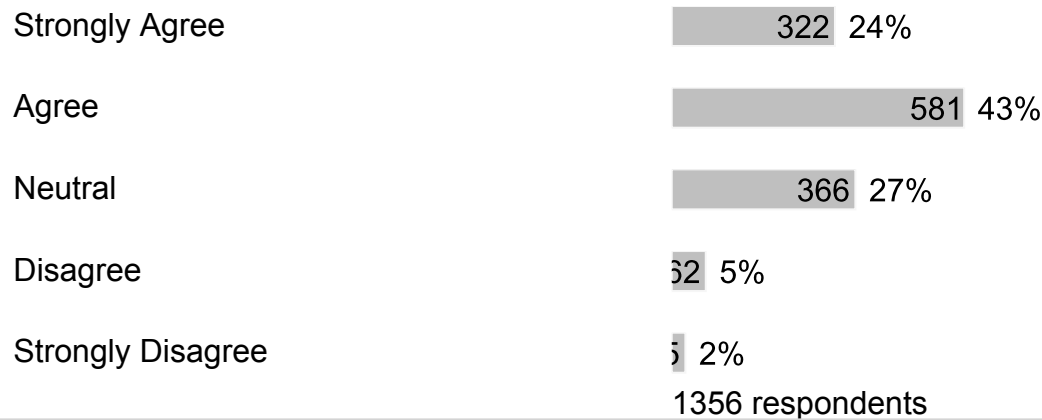

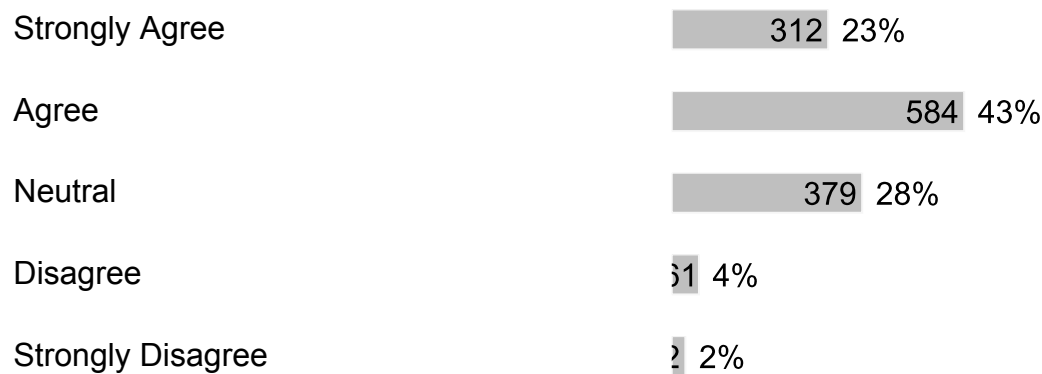
