The School Board of Broward County, Florida, has adopted a strategic plan for the period from 2013 to 2017. The plan is designed to guide the district's operations and ensure that we are providing the highest quality education for all students. The plan is based on the district's vision and mission statements and is aligned with the state's educational goals.

GOALS

Academic Excellence
The percentage of students who demonstrate proficiency in mathematics and science on the state English Language Arts Proficiency Assessment will increase from 70% in June 2013 to 75% by June 2017.

College Readiness
The percentage of students who meet the Florida College Readiness Assessment requirements for the first or second time will increase from 70% in June 2013 to 80% by June 2017.

Equity and Access
The percentage of students who are economically disadvantaged, students with disabilities, and students from diverse backgrounds who are proficient in mathematics and science will increase from 65% in June 2013 to 70% by June 2017.




Early Literacy Foundation
The percentage of grade 1 students who demonstrate foundational performance or above on the state English Language Arts (ELA) assessment will increase from 57% in June 2022 to 60% by June 2027.
