Everglades High School is a moderately sized, multi-ethnic school of over 2000 students. Our school prides itself in its racial and ethnic diversity, and has a student population that is 45% Hispanic, 36% African American, 8% white, 8% Asian, and 2% Multi-Racial. The school is located in the beautiful and burgeoning city of Miramar, FL, and borders both Pembroke Pines and Miami Lakes. The surrounding neighborhood consists of predominantly middle-class households with a median income of over \$50,000. The racial composition of the surrounding community closely mirrors that of our school, with a slightly higher white population than we have enrolled in the school. The community also has a large population of people from a variety of Caribbean nations, such as Jamaica, Trinidad, Dominican Republic, and Cuba. Most of our students come from households where one or both of their caregivers have earned a Bachelor and/or Graduate degree. In addition to our students and surrounding community, the school's staff is highly motivated and extremely qualified. The majority of our teachers have graduate degrees, and many are certified to teach multiple disciplines. In addition, most of our teachers have many years of teaching experience and have built a great relationship with students and the community. Miramar is one of the fastest growing cities in the country, and is home to prominent businesses, such as Huntington Learning Center, Ross University, Carnival Cruise Lines, Comcast, among others. Our biggest challenge we have found is parent involvement.

To accomplish this, Everglades has developed a robust and efficient network of Professional Learning Communities, where teachers are educated on the most up-to-date, innovative, and effective teaching strategies available. Teachers are encouraged to share best practices and model instructional strategies to assist each other in their professional growth, which has had a positive impact on student achievement over the years.

Our school promotes innovation and rigor by offering students an array of courses that challenge their intellect, while still providing them with opportunities to demonstrate their creativity and uniqueness. In addition to the traditional courses offered by most high schools, students at Everglades have the opportunity to enroll in our highly accredited Cambridge Program, Sports Management, Pre-Law, FBI, our one-of-a-kind Fire Academy, our new Hospitality and Tourism program, Communication Technology, Master-Cam Auto Technician, and a variety of Industry Certifications. In addition, students have the opportunity to earn college credit while still in high school. These courses can be taken both on campus as well as in alternative locations. Students have the ability to take Advanced Placement courses, enroll in our College Academy, take Dual Enrollment, or be admitted into our newly established Cambridge Academy Program. Having these options available to students gives them the freedom to custom tailor their academic experience. In addition to maintaining high expectations for all of its students, fostering a school culture and learning environment that enables teachers to deliver effective instruction, the school is active in the surrounding community. We routinely sponsor drama presentations and concerts that provide community stakeholders with the opportunity to appreciate the wealth of talent Everglades. We host Curriculum and College Fairs that equip caregivers with the information they need to make sound decisions regarding their child's academic future. We have formed lasting bonds with community businesses, city officials, school board members, and other prominent members of the community. These relationships have been essential to the success Everglades has experienced since its inception in 2003. Parents and students are constantly updated on classroom and school-wide activities, homework assignments and assessments, and upcoming events through our first-rate website. They are also able to access Pinnacle and Virtual Counselor and correspond with members of the faculty and staff through our website. Everglades also communicates through regular email, text, calls, and mail, SAC, SAF, and the PTSA, which has contributed to the strong relationship we share with our stakeholders.

This has given students that are interested in firefighting, the opportunity to earn level 1 firefighting certification. Our graduation rate has also been a source of pride for our school over the last few years as we have consistently outperformed the state average by as much as thirteen percentage points, and have experienced success in having many of our students accepted into college and other post-secondary institutions of learning. Finally, through principled leadership, dedication to excellence, and sacrifice, Everglades has earned an A-rating, four out of the last five school years.

Despite our many successes, Everglades is still in need of improvement in the areas of student attendance, parental involvement, and continuing to strive for excellence as a school. To improve student attendance, we have worked diligently on creating, implementing, and monitoring a comprehensive attitude and behavior modification plan. Although we have seen some success from our plan, we are still in need of improvement, especially when it comes to reducing patterns of non-attendance, truancy, and tardiness, which research shows impacts student achievement more than any other variable. We have also been aggressive in our efforts to get parents more involved in the efforts of the school. Through the promotion of the SAC, SAF, and PTSA we have provided parents with opportunities to have a voice in the decision making of their school. We have also sponsored many activities geared toward educating parents on graduation and college entrance requirements, financial aid opportunities, course offerings at the school, and student activities. Over the next three years, we intend to build our various innovative and advanced academics course to continue attracting the best and brightest students in Broward County, and hope to continue to grow as a school.
