Millennium 6-12 Collegiate Academy is a public combined middle and high school that has a staff of 125. We serve grades 6-12, with 63 seniors, 53 juniors, 76 sophomores, and 89 freshmen for a total of 281 high school students. Ranked #1 High School in the region and #2 in the State of Florida in 2024. A-rated school. Our first graduation class was in 2021. Our innovative collegiate academy has space for 75 seats in grades 9-11 and for their senior year, they will attend FLVS and Broward College as Early Admission students. This will be the seventh year of our collegiate academy high school pathway.

We are proud to say that Millennium 6-12 Collegiate Academy is Tamarac's only high school. Our demographics are comprised of 60 % African American, 23% Hispanic, 9% white, and 3.7% Asian. Of our student body, 57.2% are from economically disadvantaged homes, 3.8% are English Language Learners, and 13% are students with disabilities and .9% are indicated as homeless.

Our school community has remained stable, with no significant changes in our boundary lines. However, one challenge we face is the competition from neighboring schools offering an accelerated pathway for students from 6th through 8th grade in advanced track programs. This may have attracted some students away from our school. In response, Millennium 6-12 has developed an advanced track with high school credit opportunities, leading into our collegiate program. This year, we plan to actively promote our middle school program at feeder elementary schools and market our high school program to middle schools across the county.
