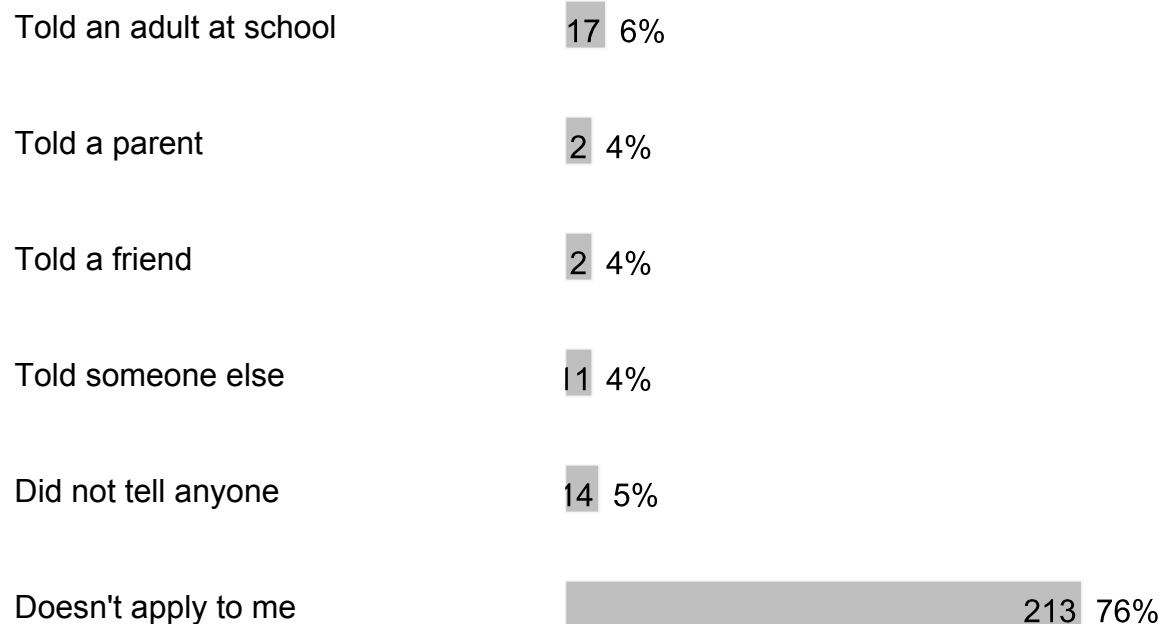

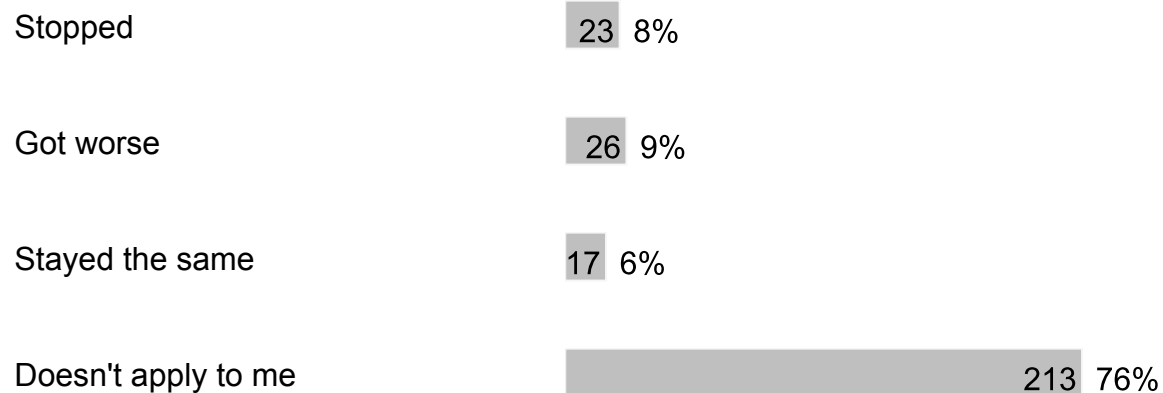

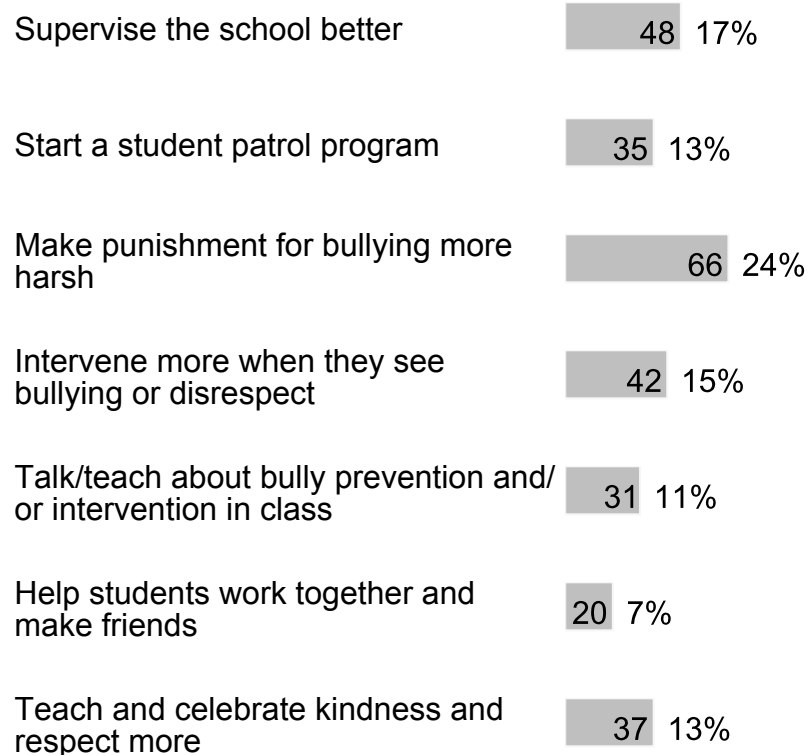

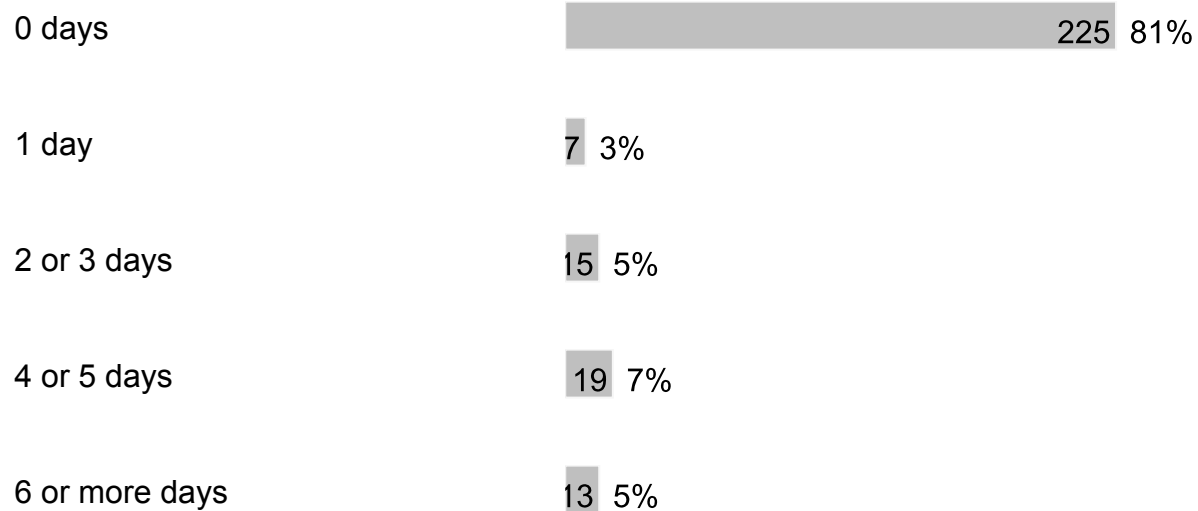


12. What can adults do to help stop bullying at school?



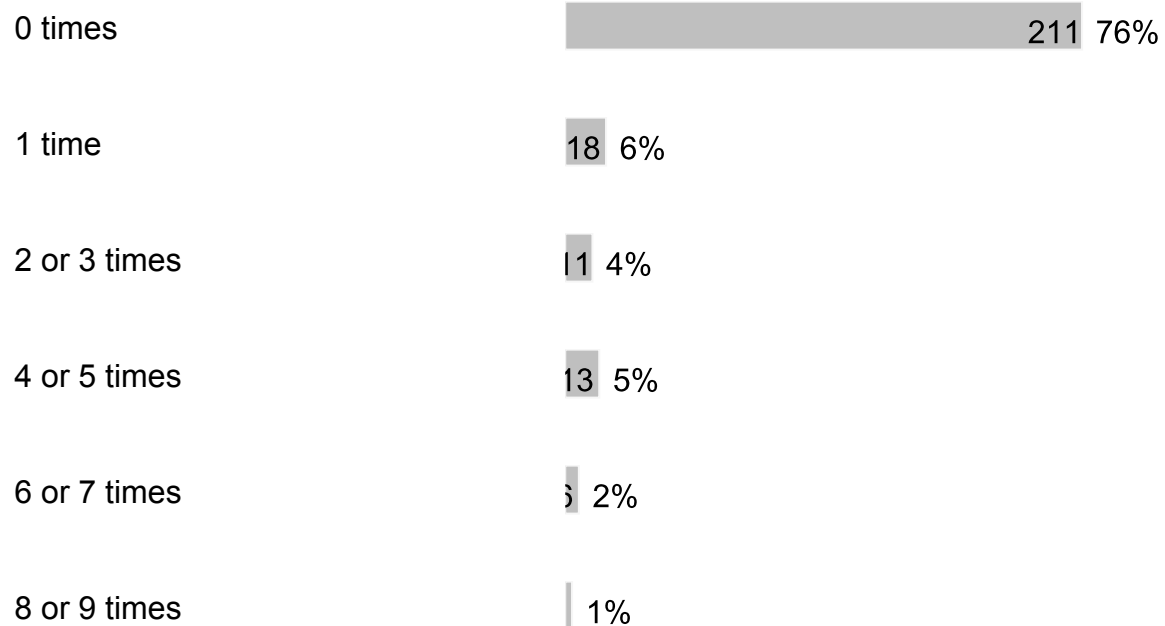

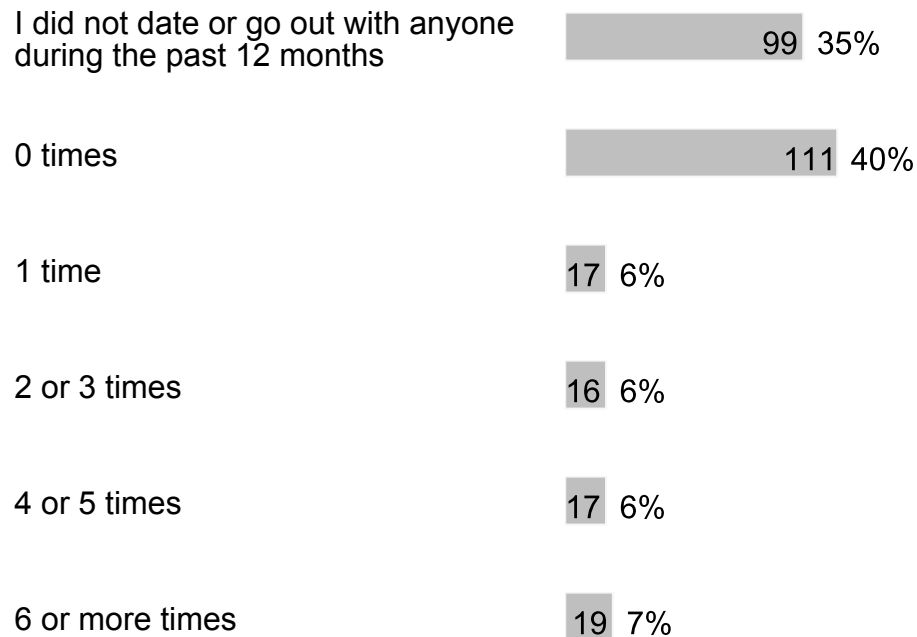

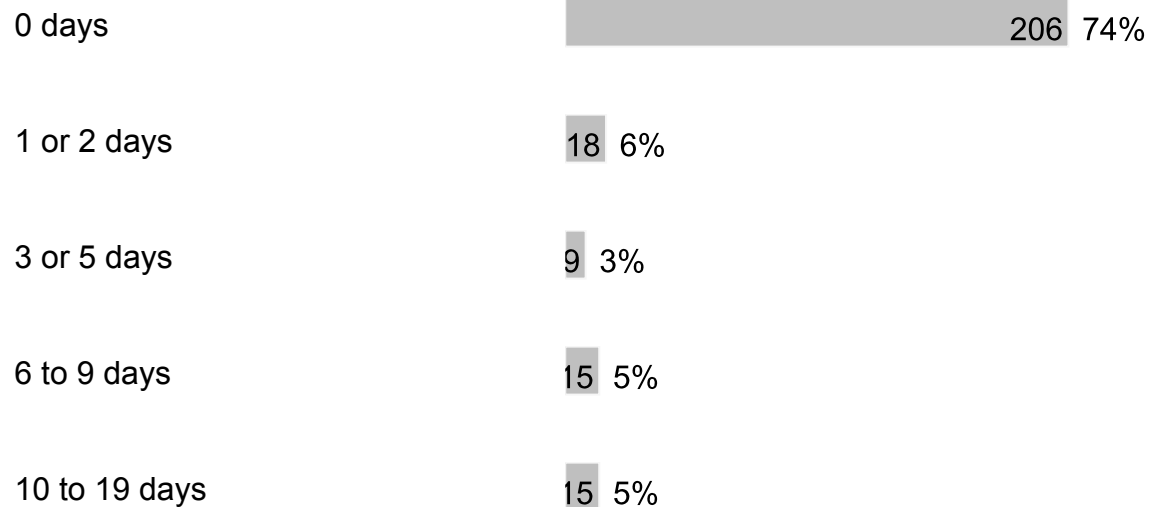

2. During a typical school day, I have access to the internet at school in the following ways (check all that apply):

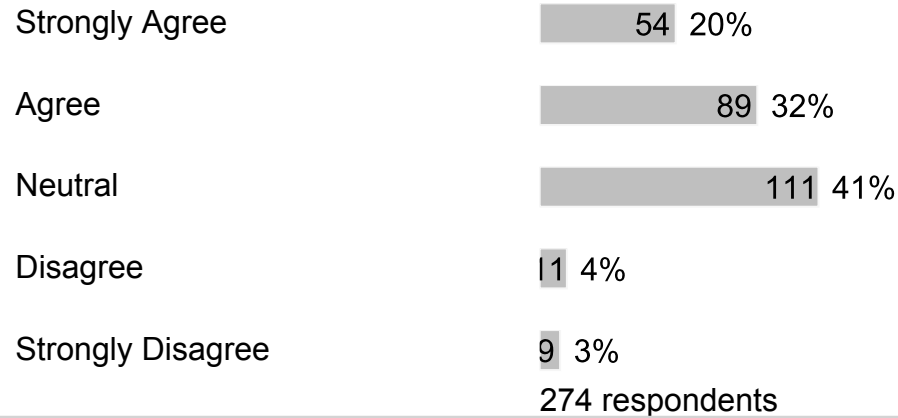




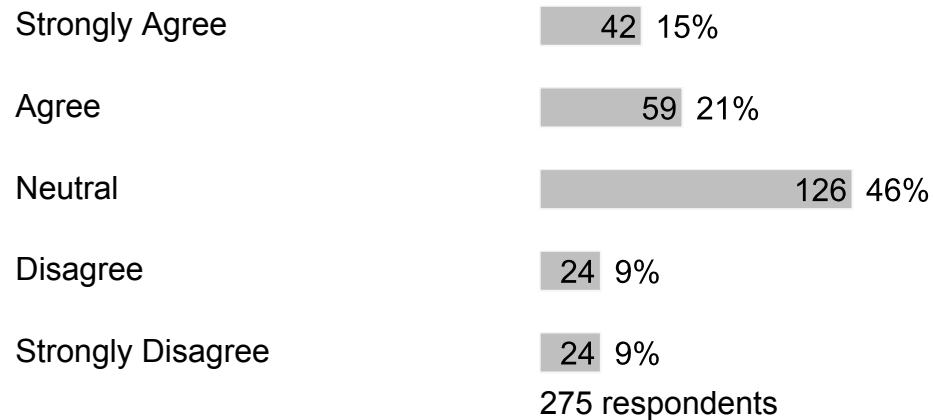

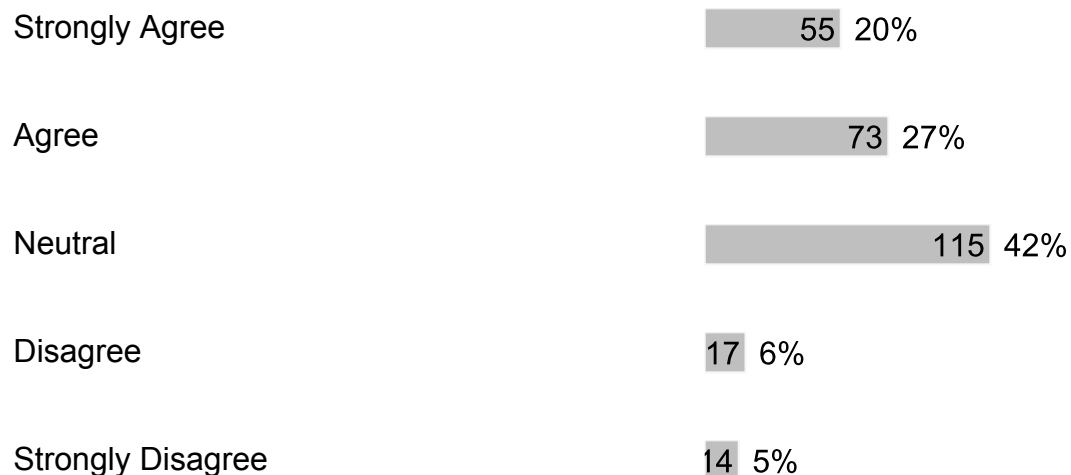

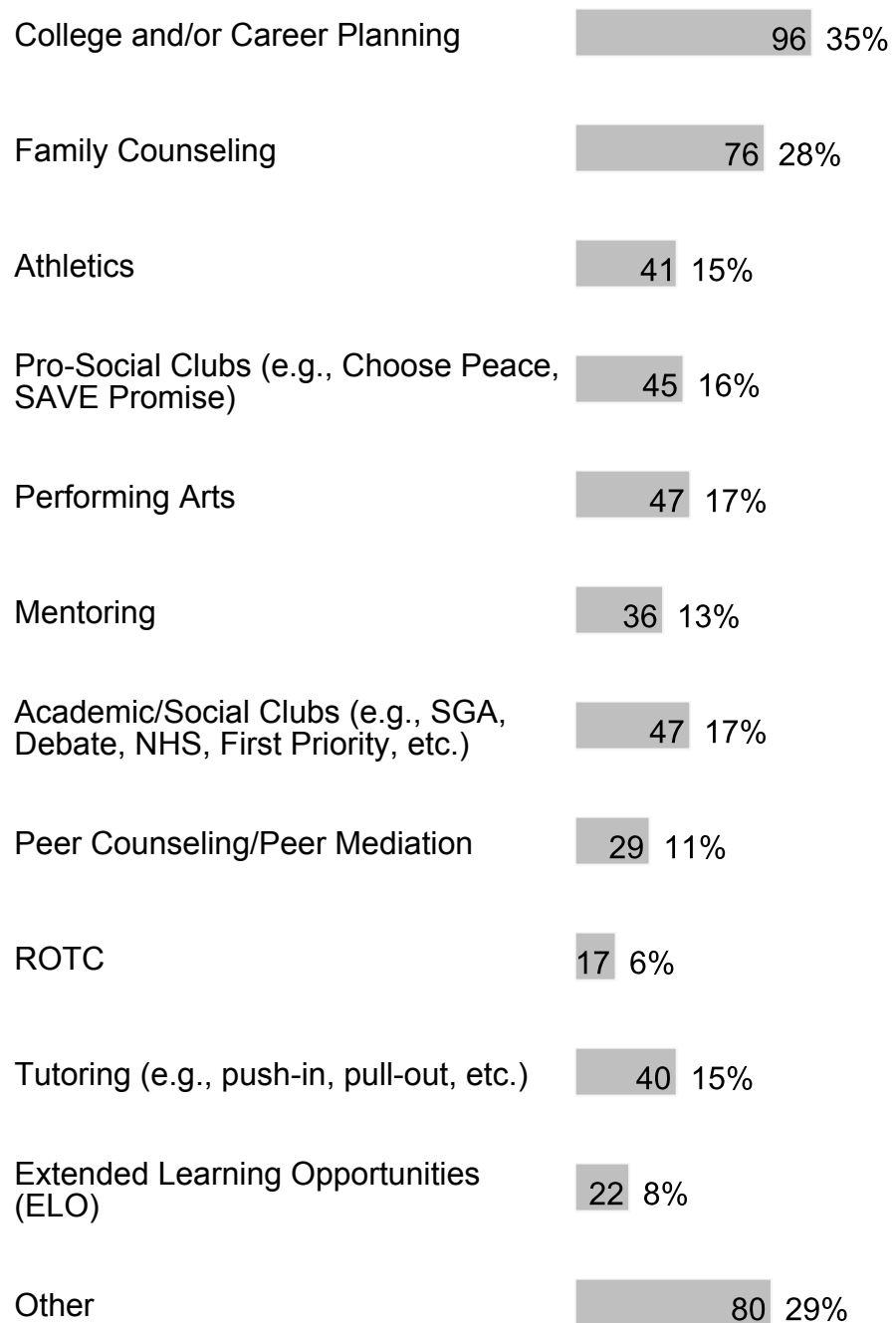

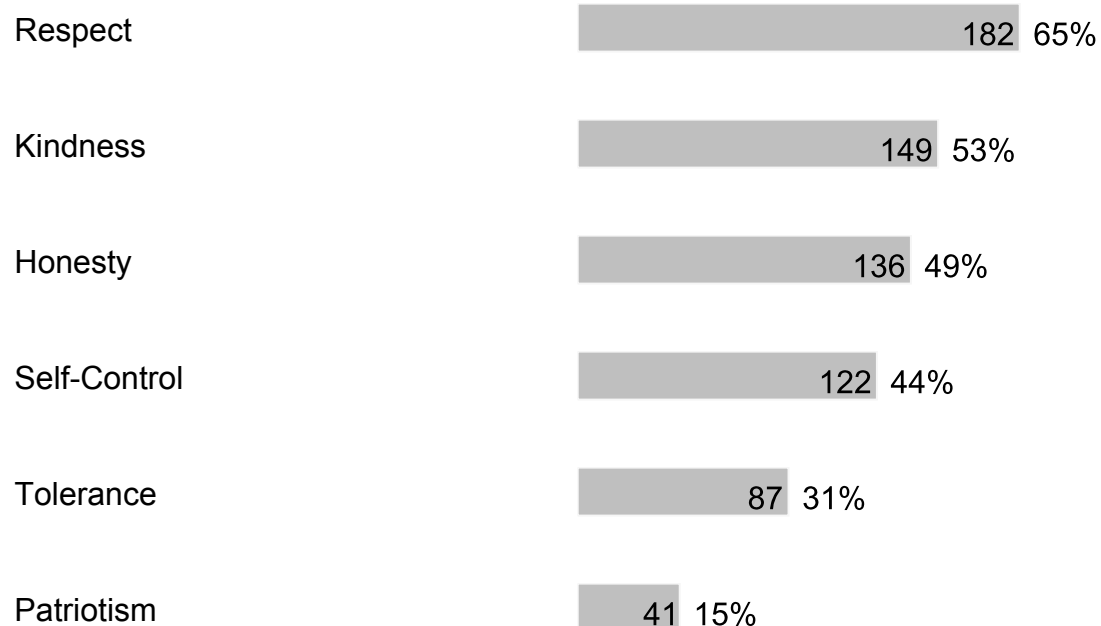

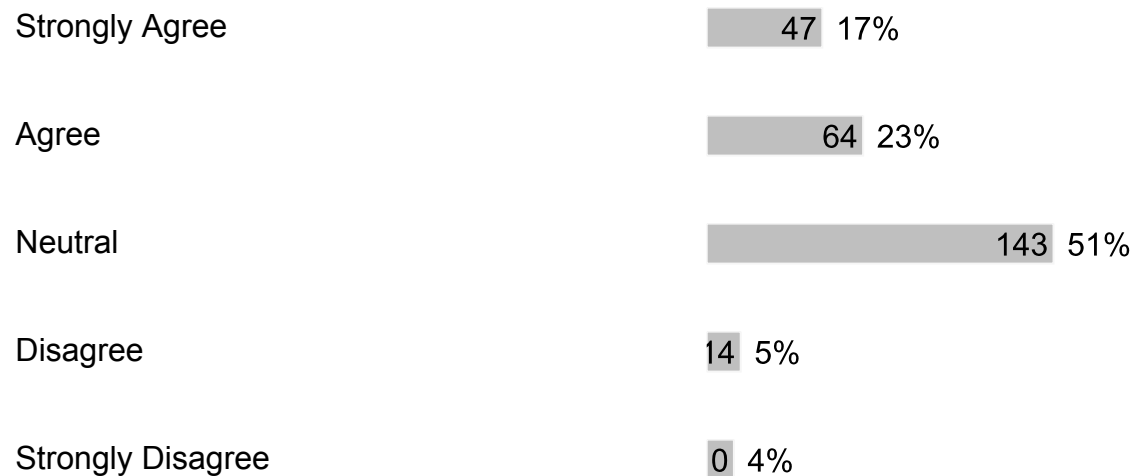
12. Which character traits do you value the most in yourself and others? (check all that apply)

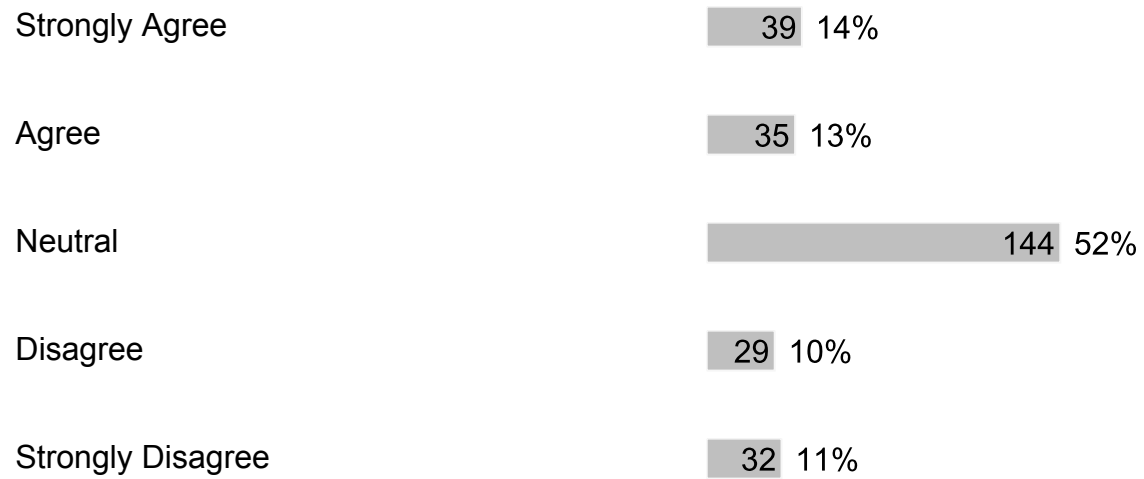

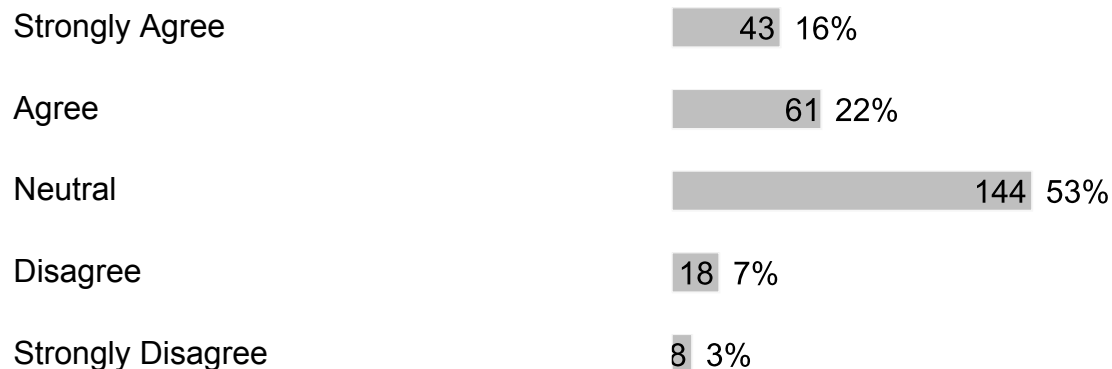
14. I enjoy eating food prepared by the cafeteria.

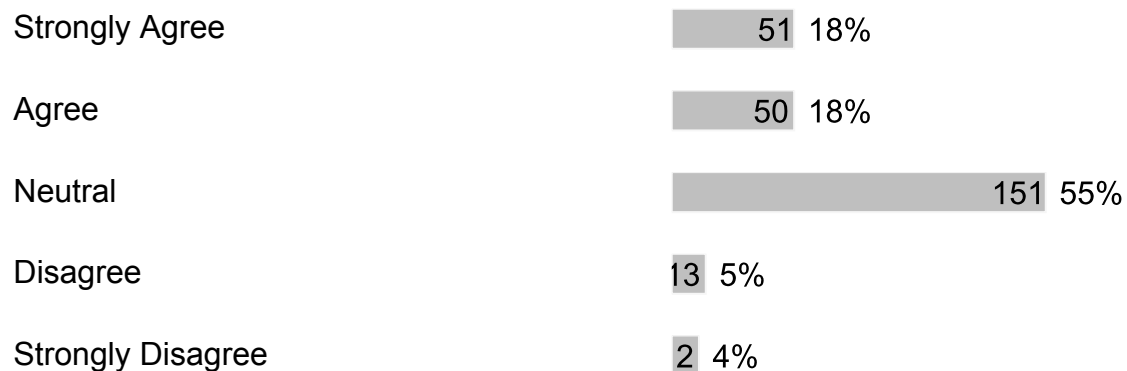

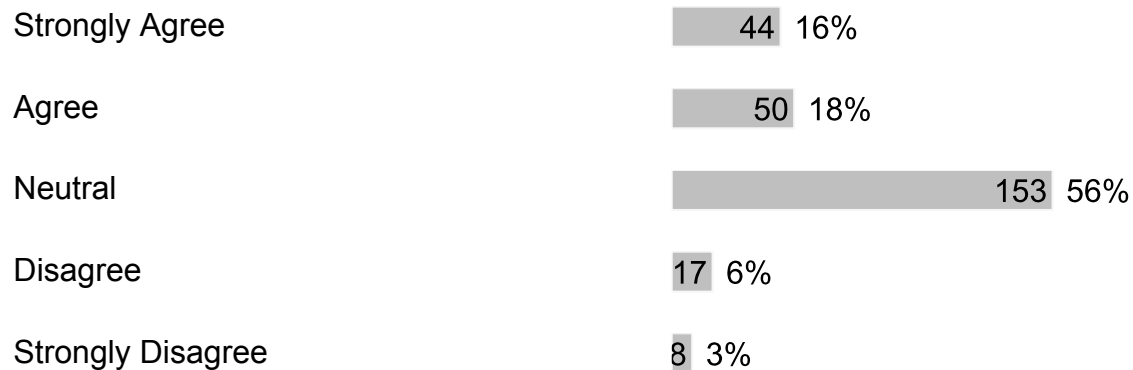

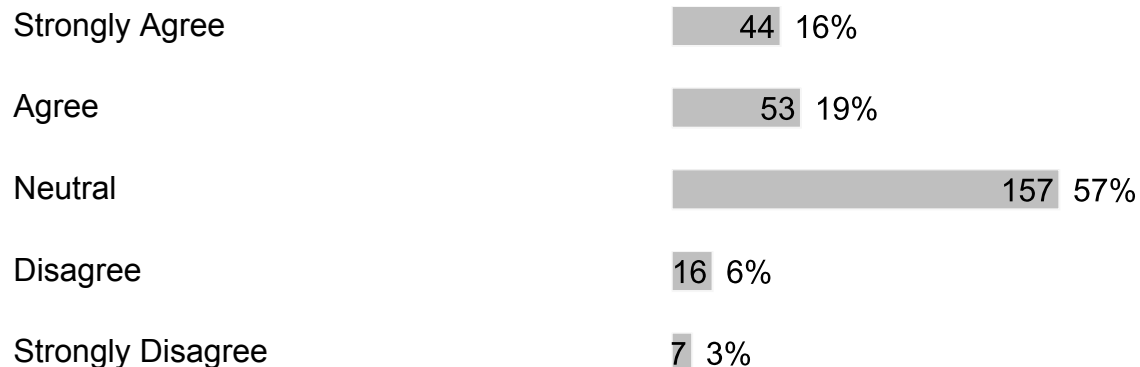

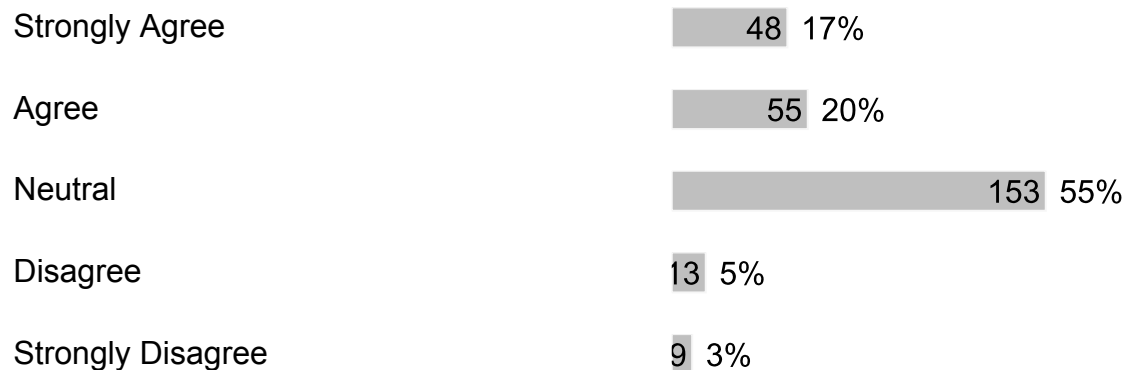

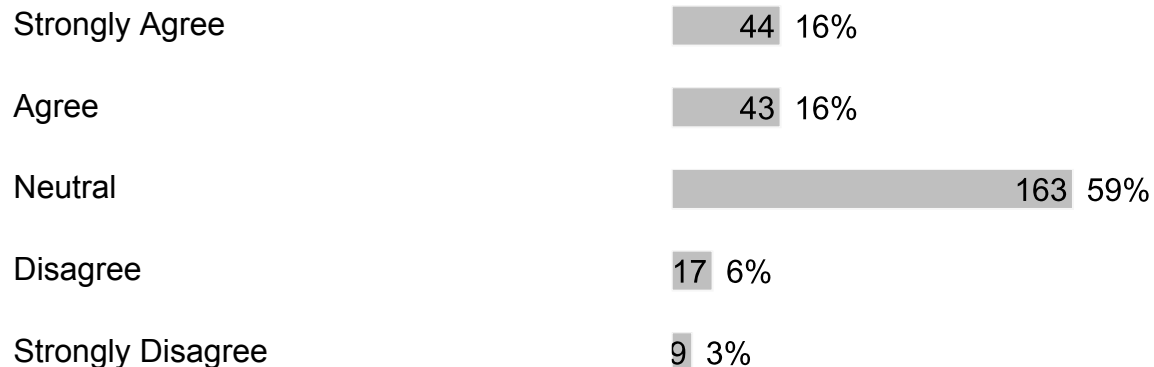

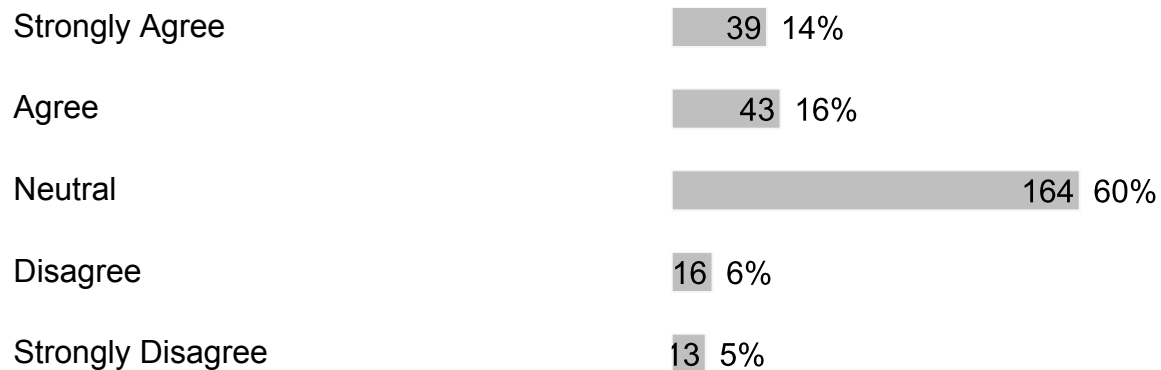

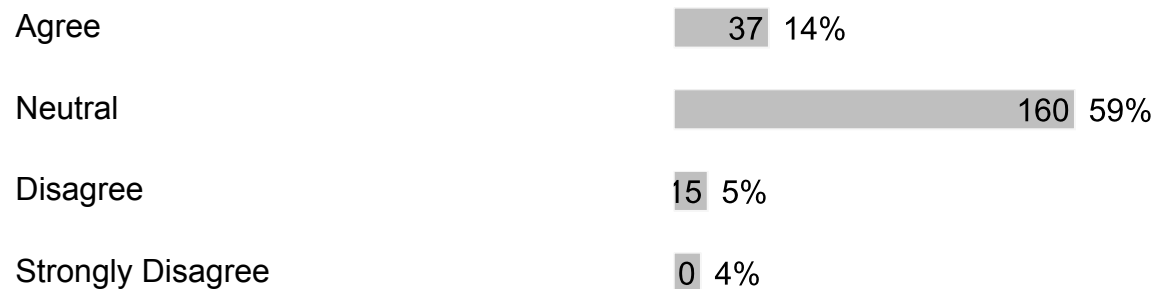


19. My teachers provide me with information about how well I am doing in school.



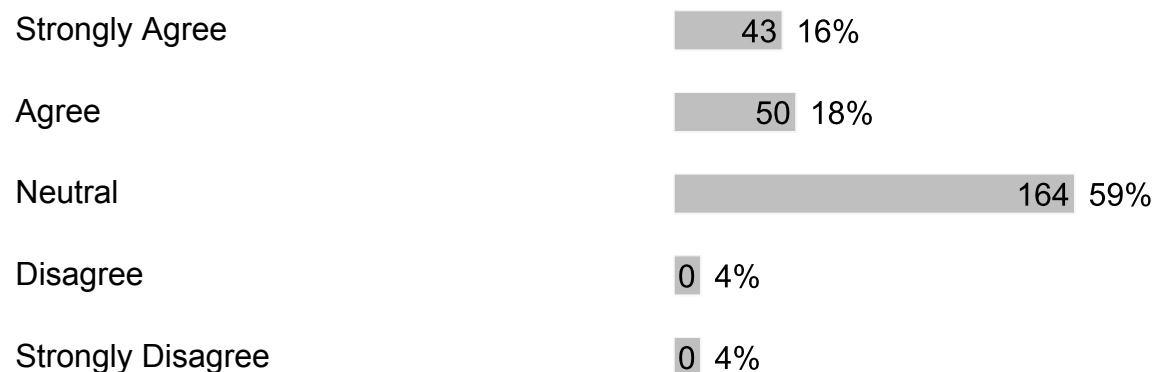

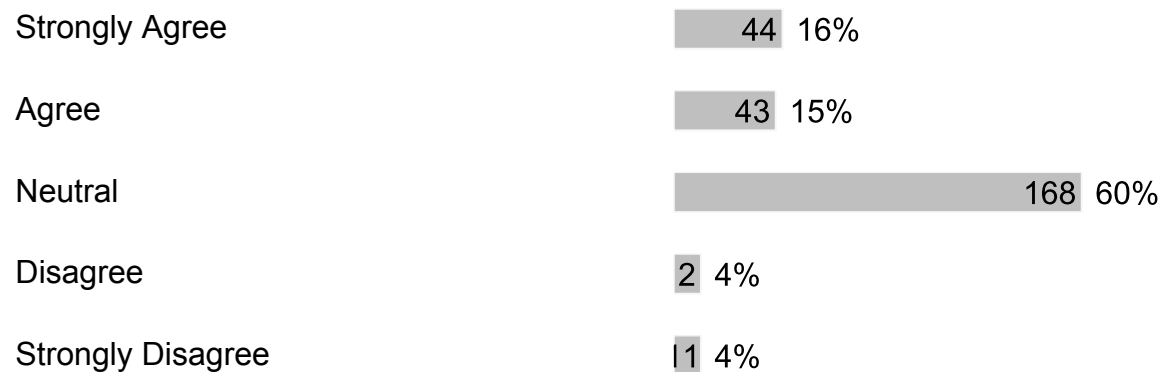
