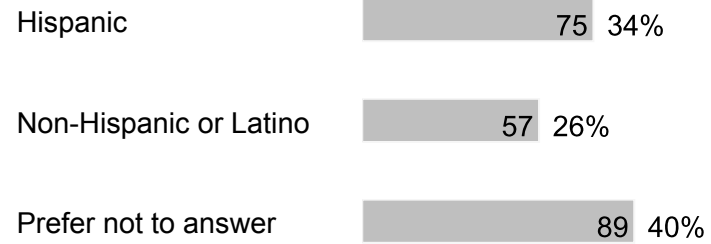

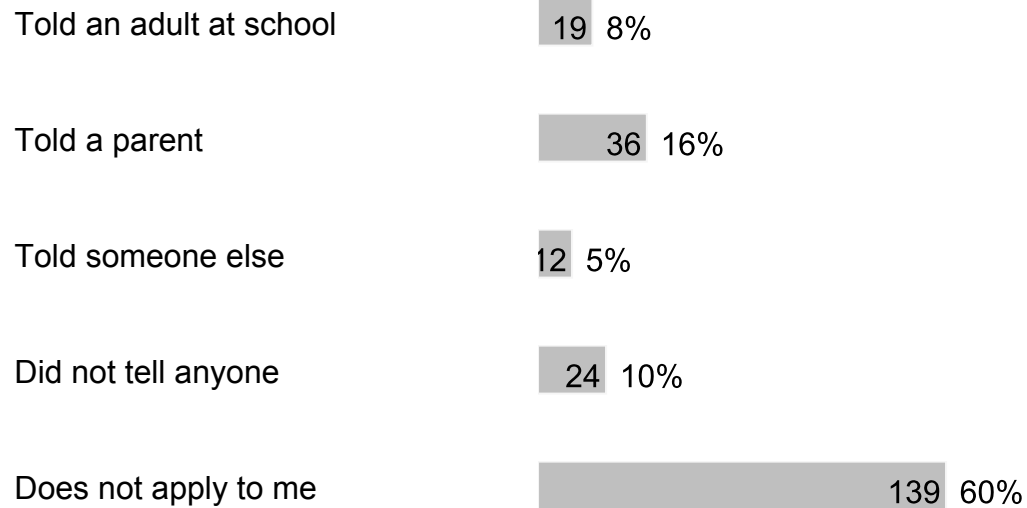

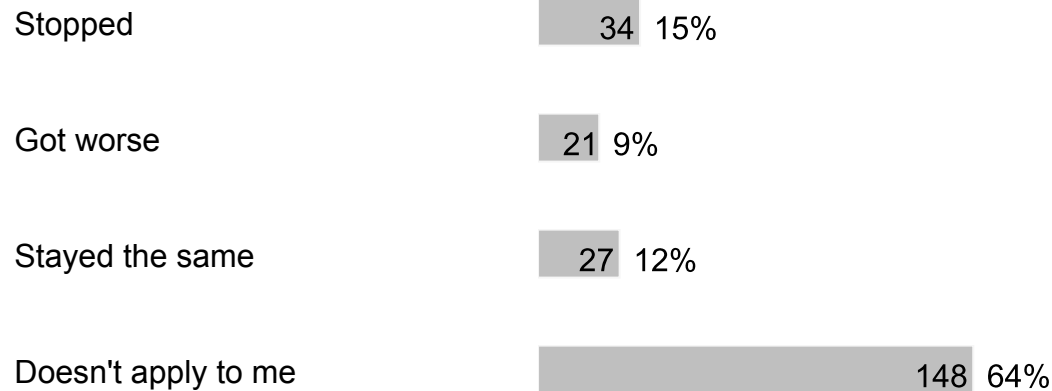

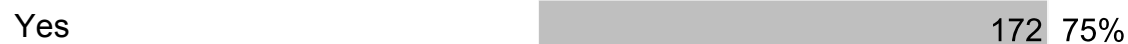

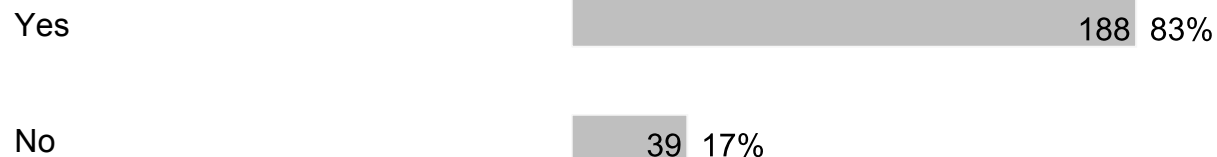

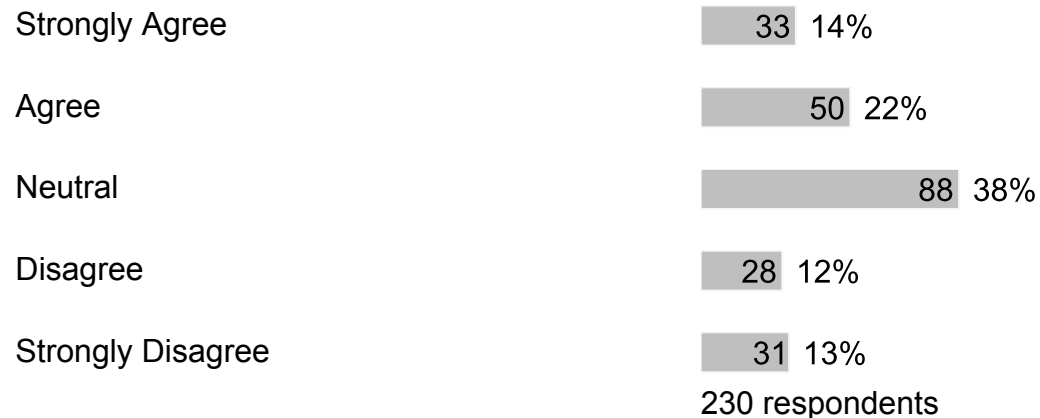

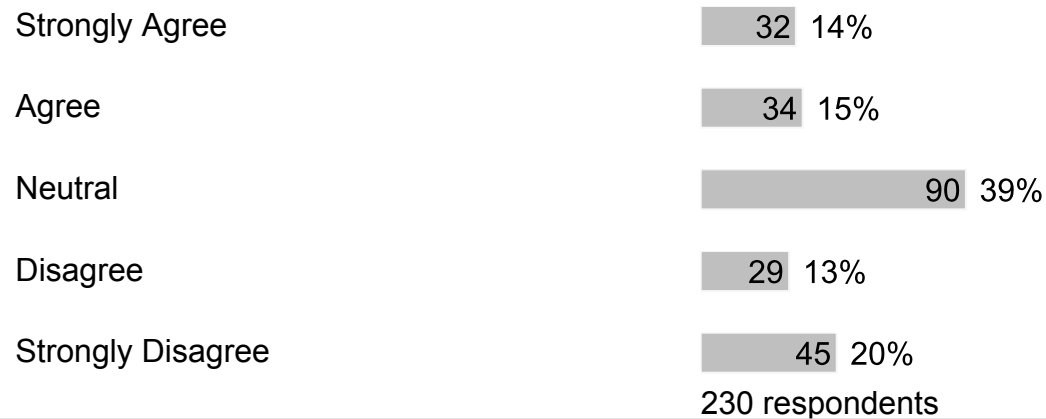

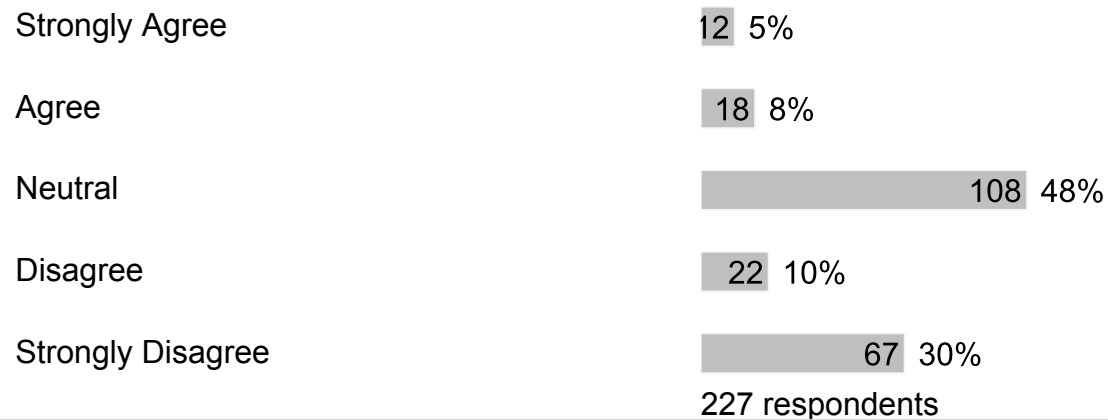

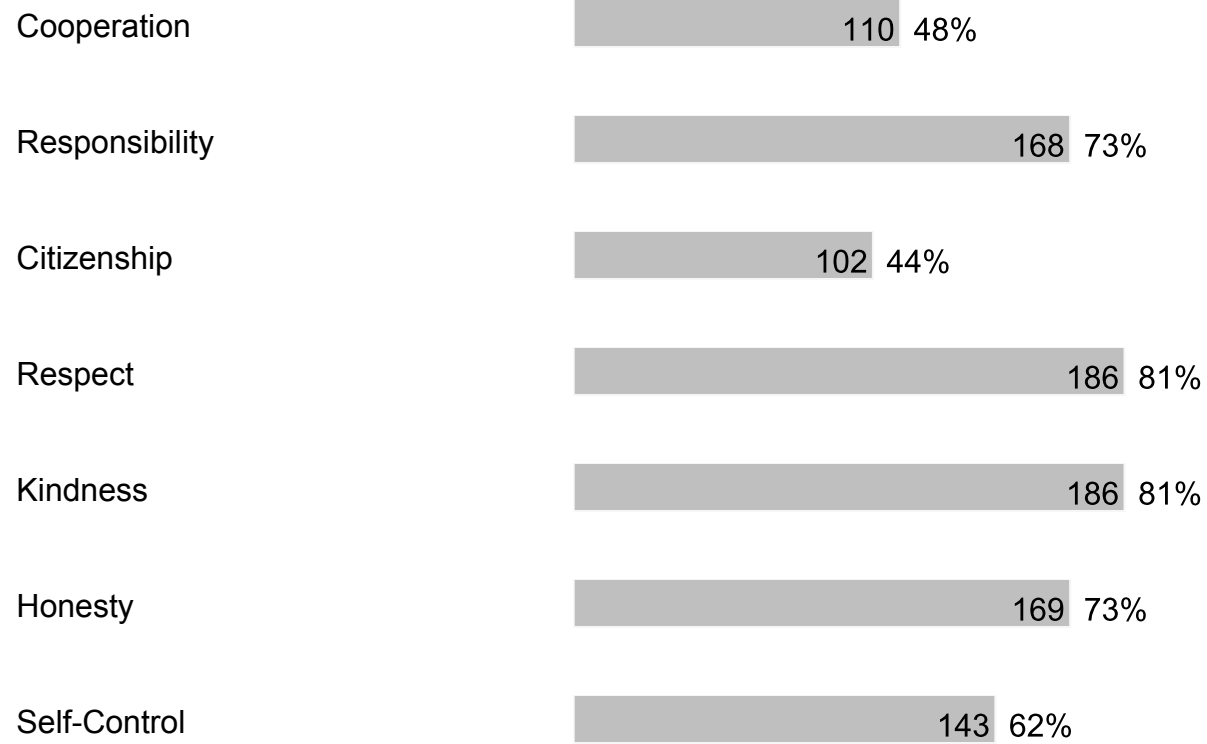

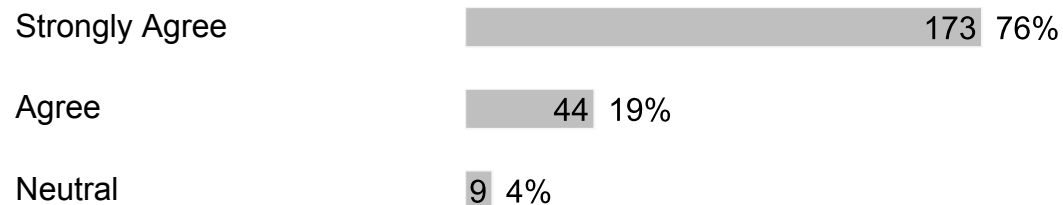

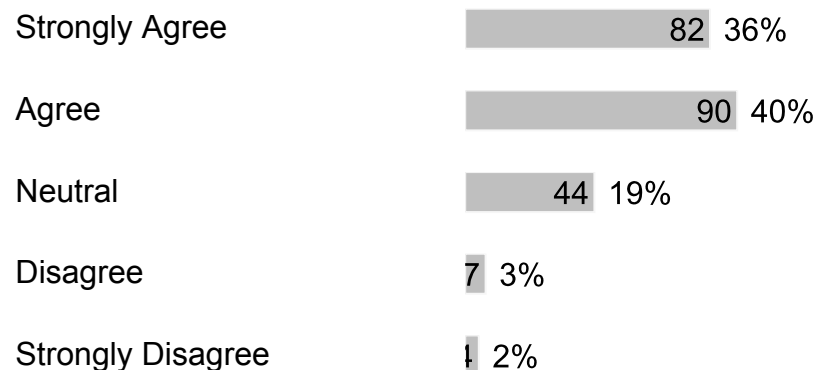

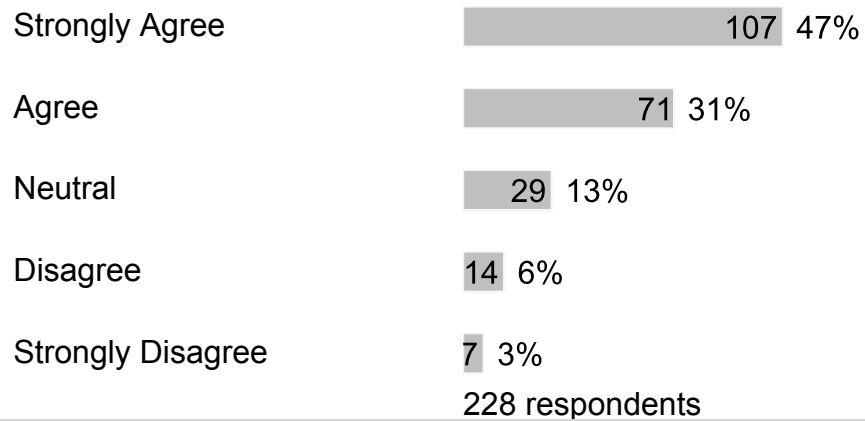

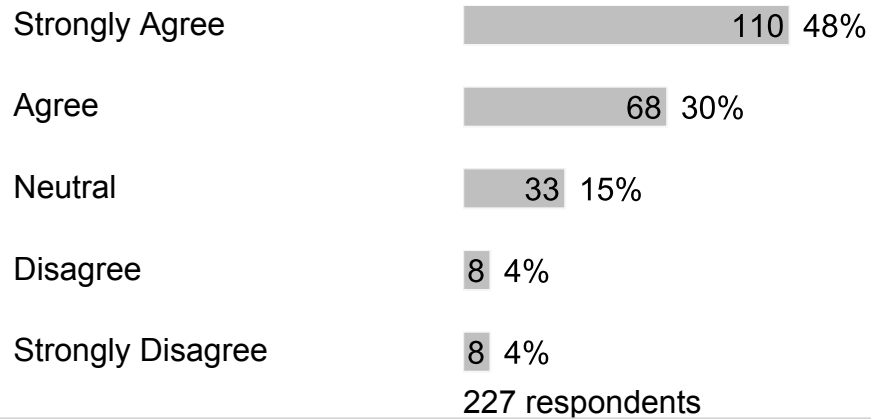

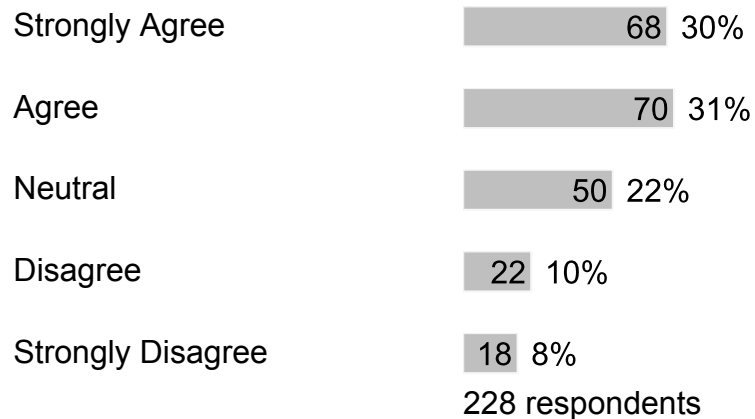
**15. My teachers tell me how I should behave.**



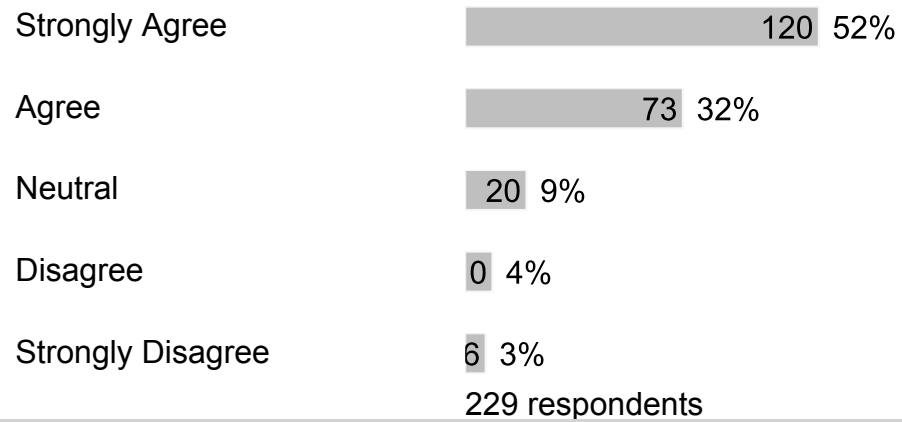
**16. My teachers tell my family how I am doing in school.**



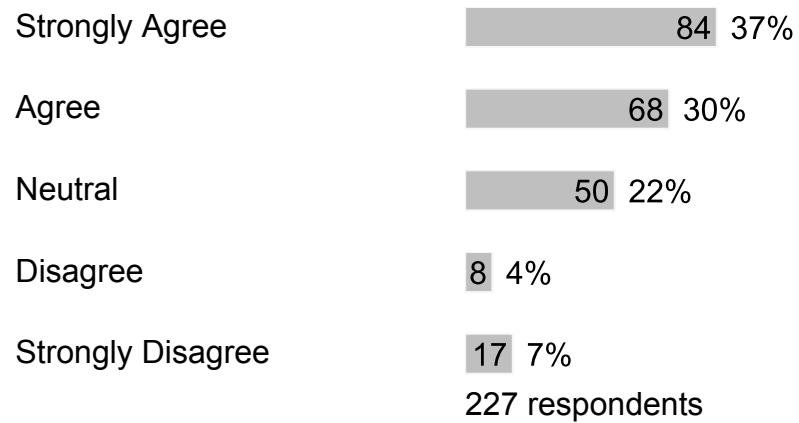
**17. My teachers ask my family to come to school activities.**
