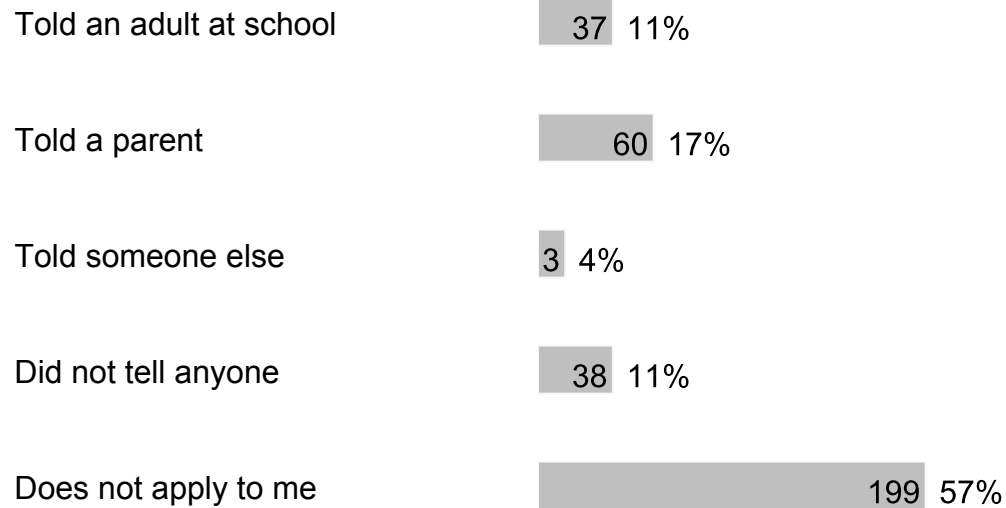

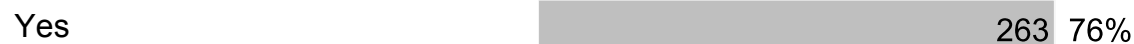

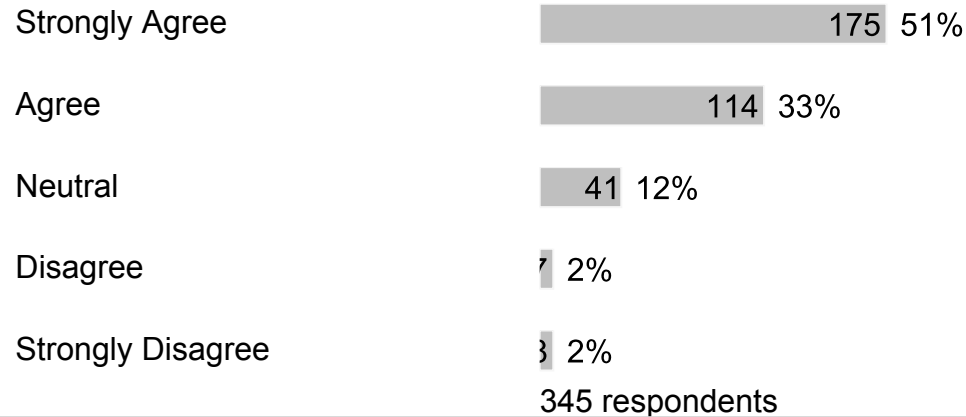

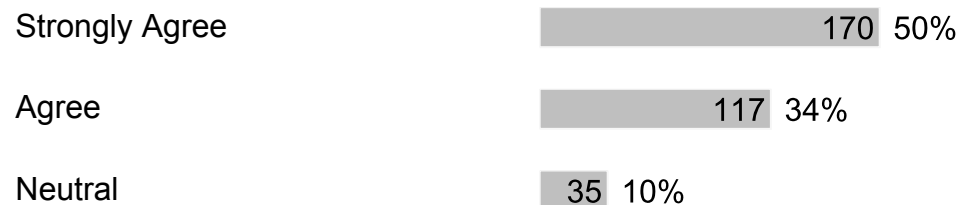

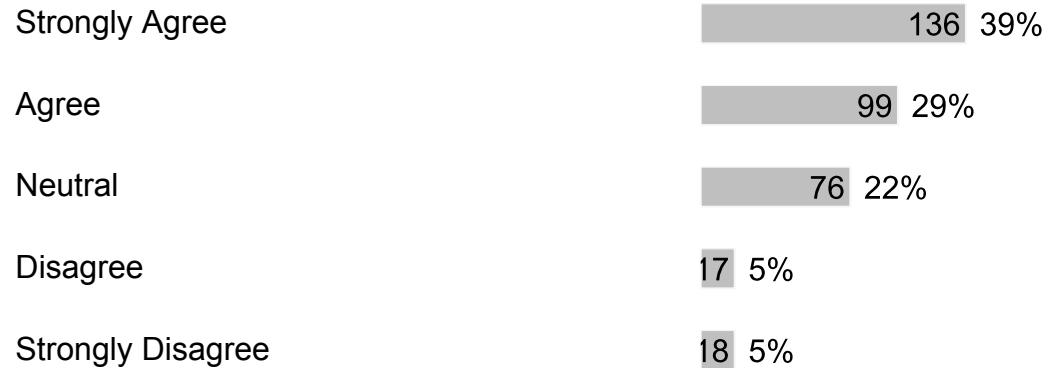

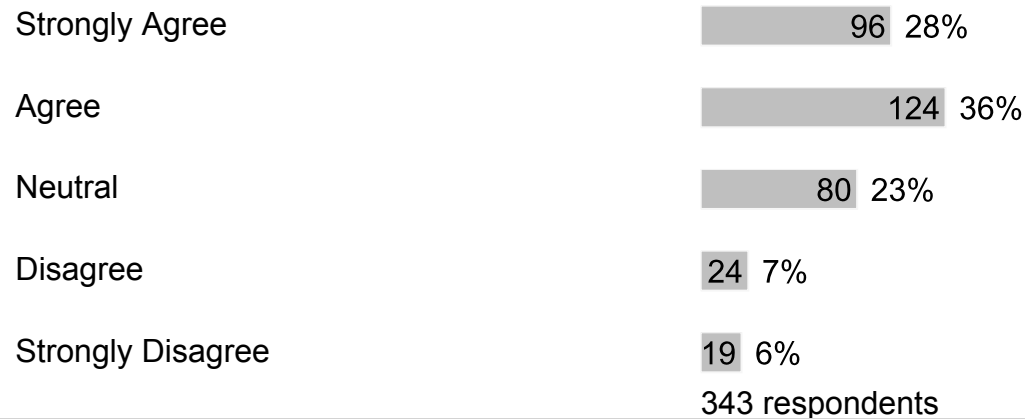

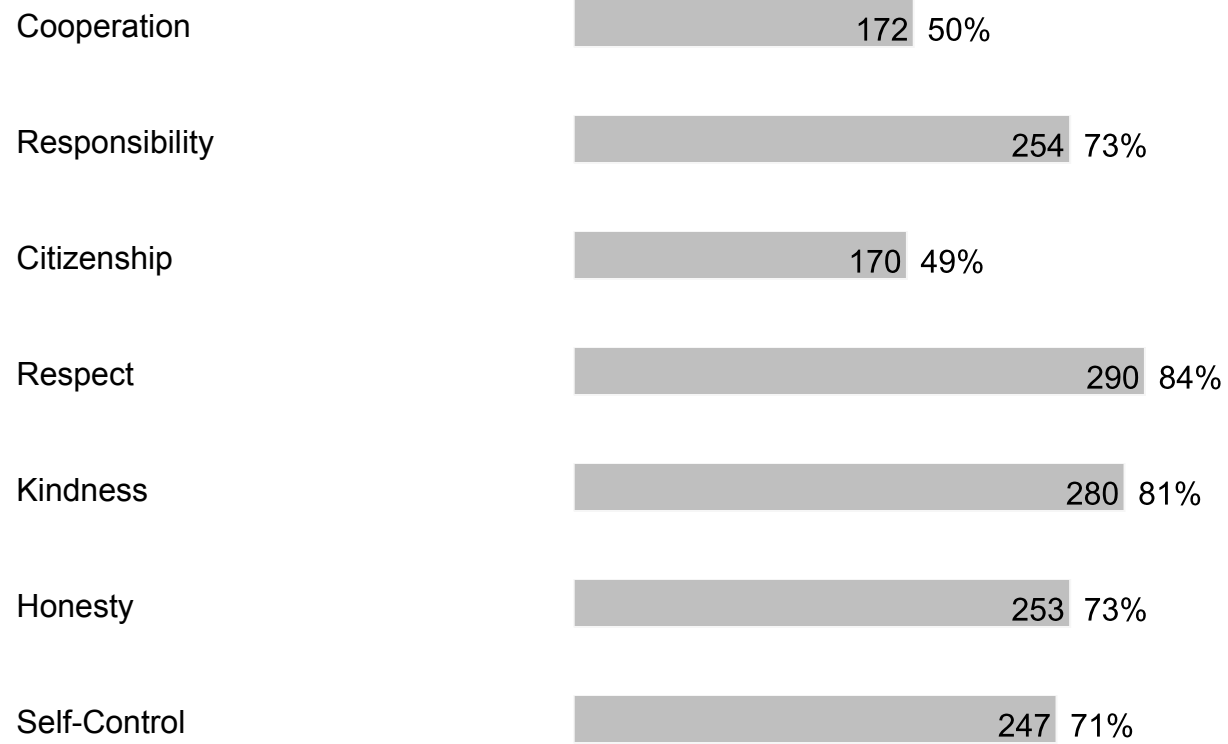

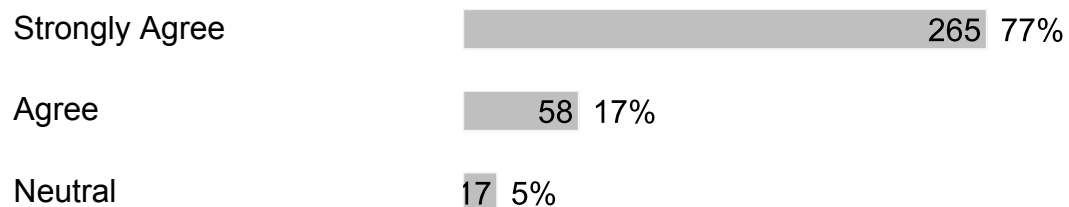

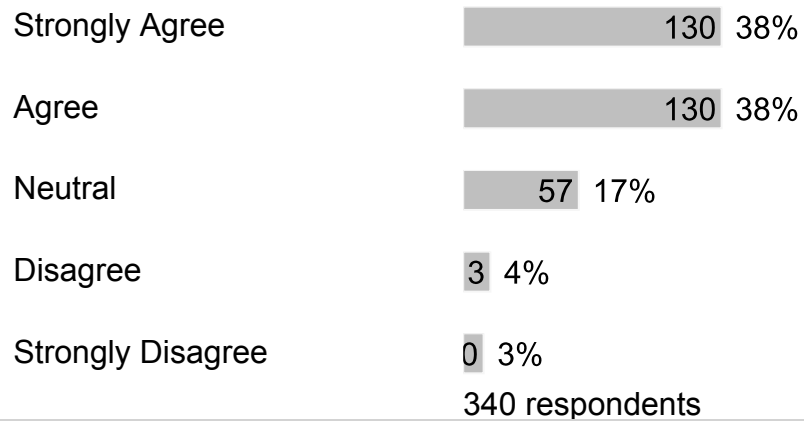

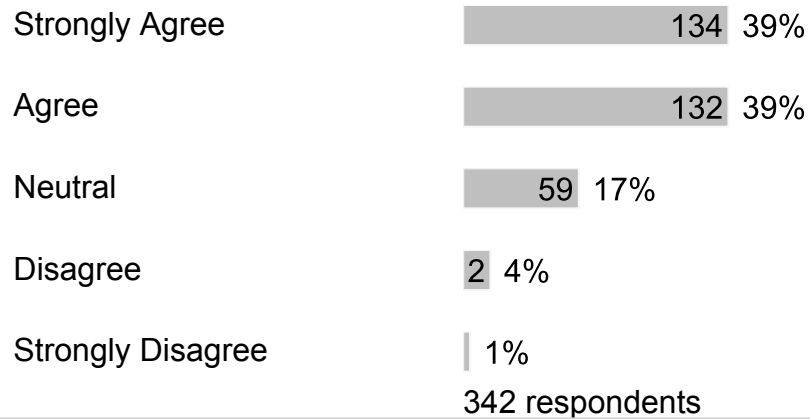

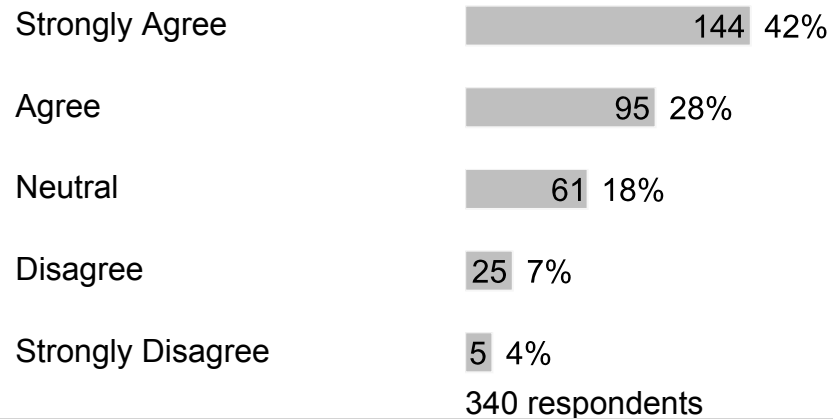
13. I am provided opportunities to correct or improve my work.



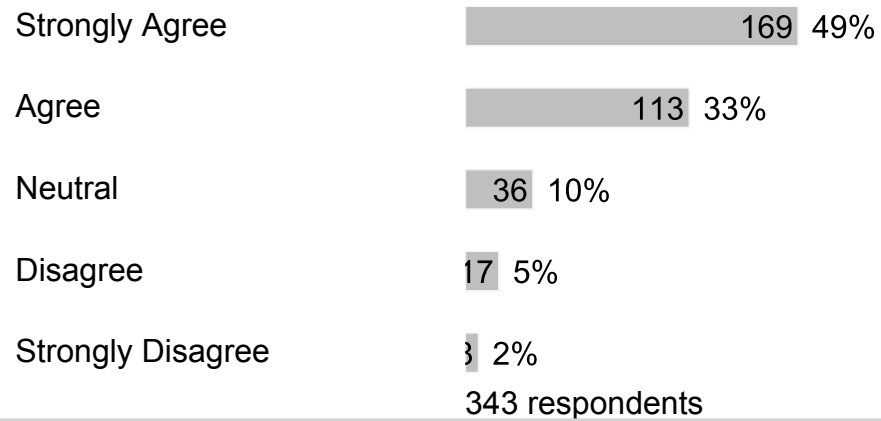
14. I actively participate in class discussions and activities.



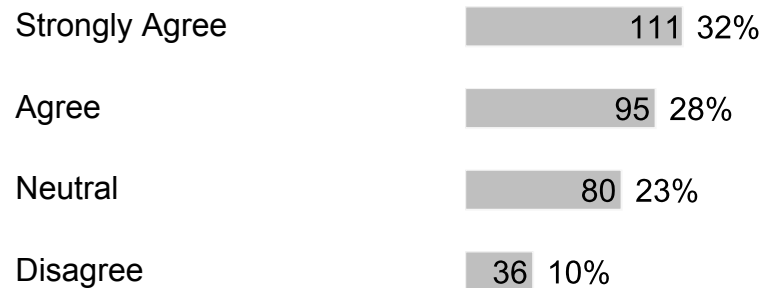
15. My teachers tell me how I should behave.
