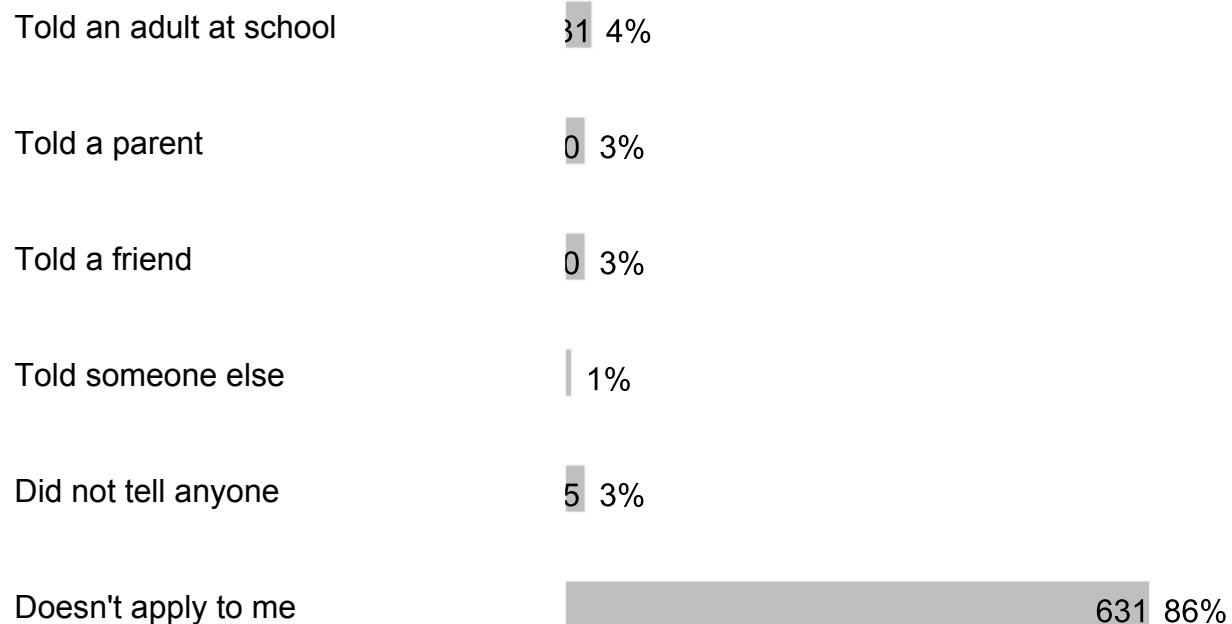

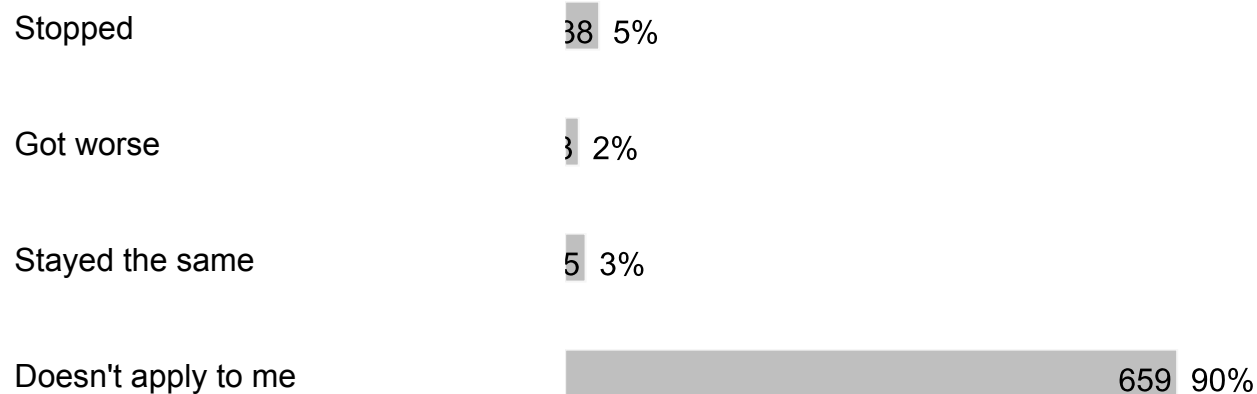

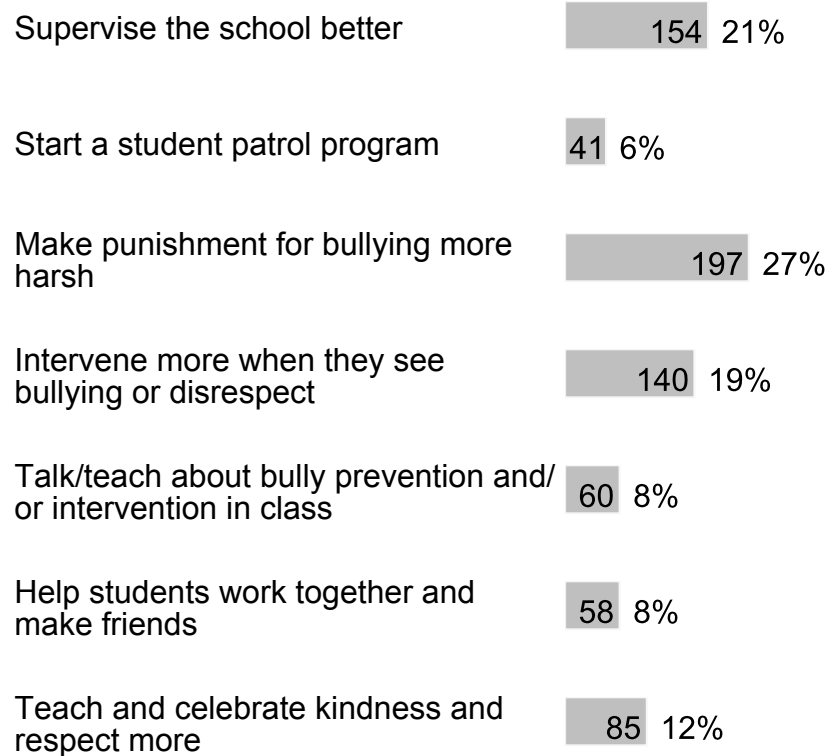

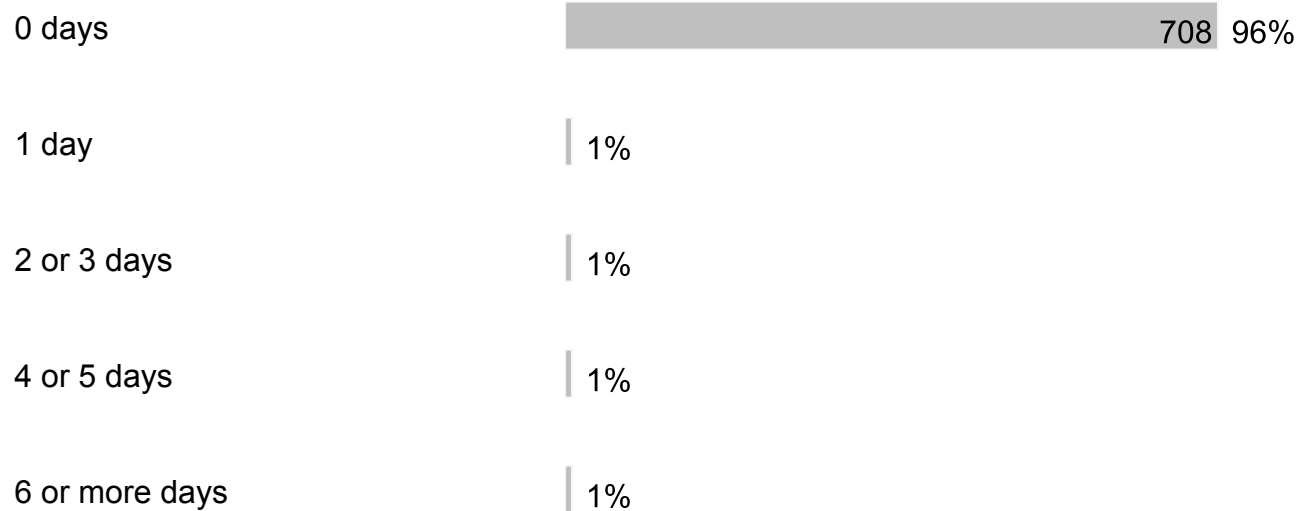

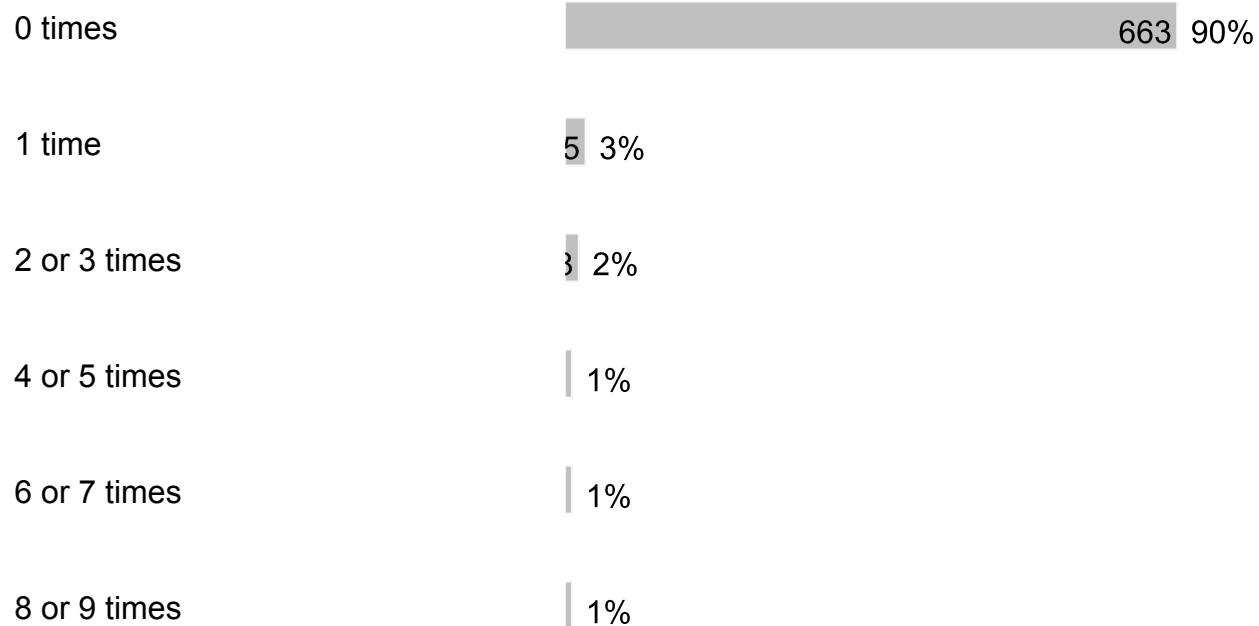

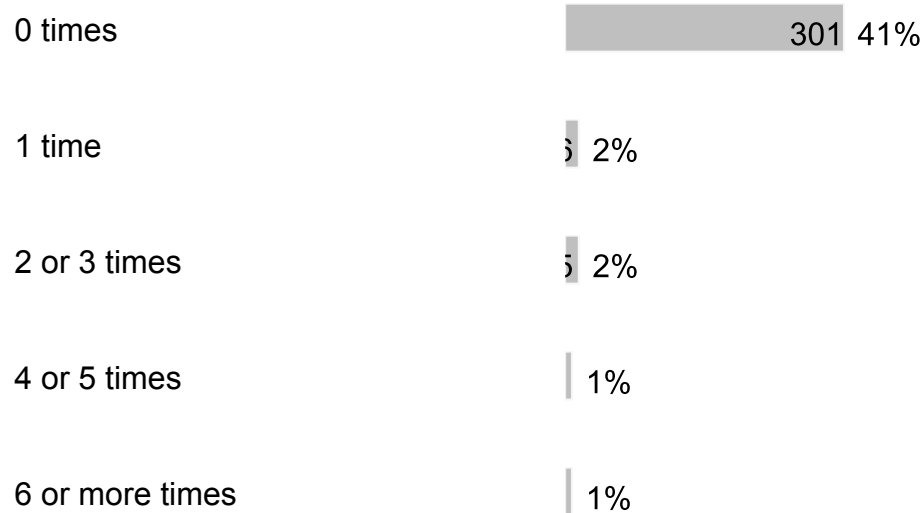

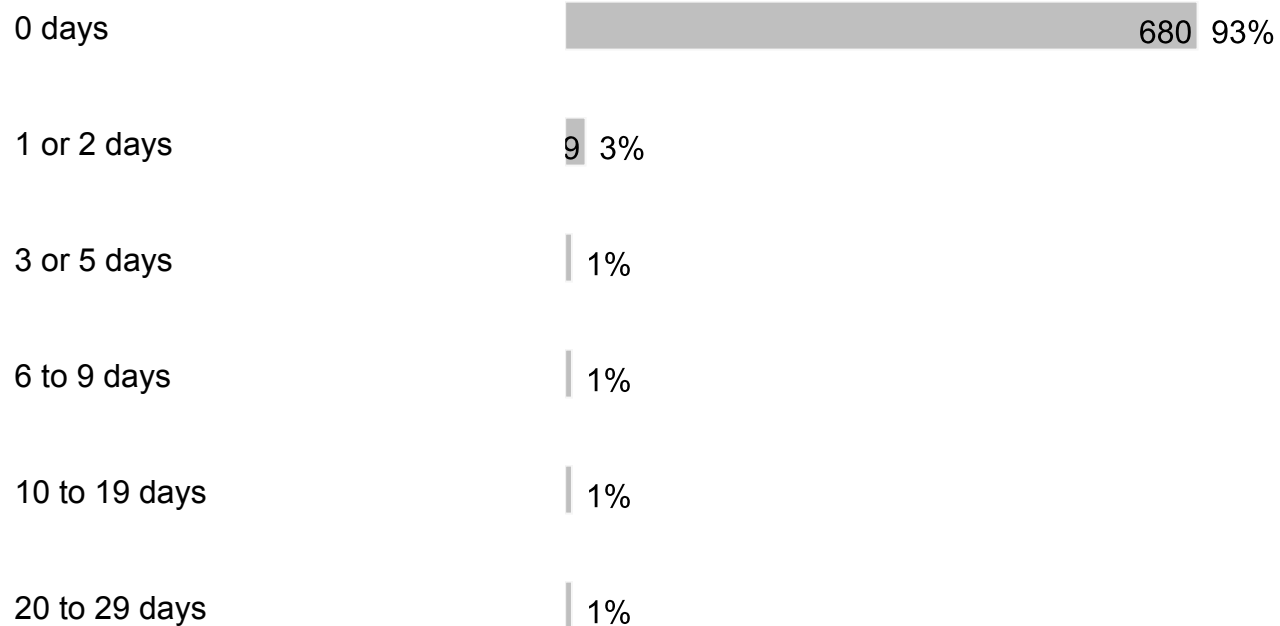

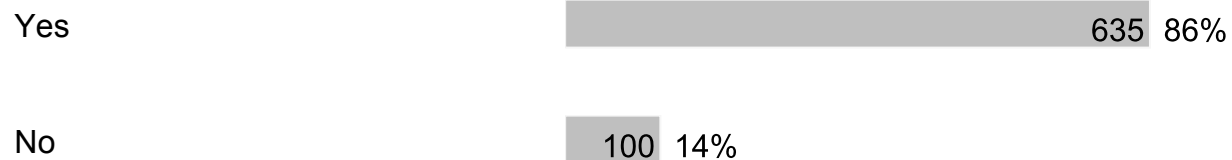

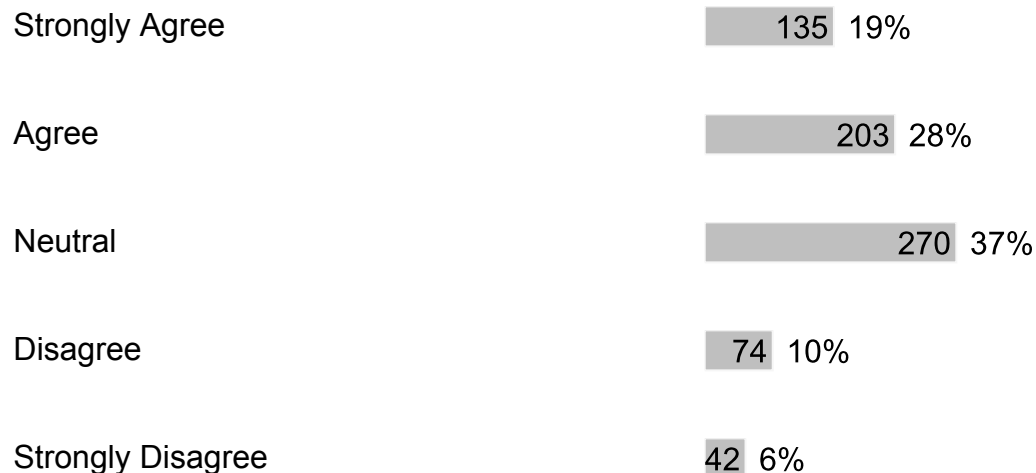

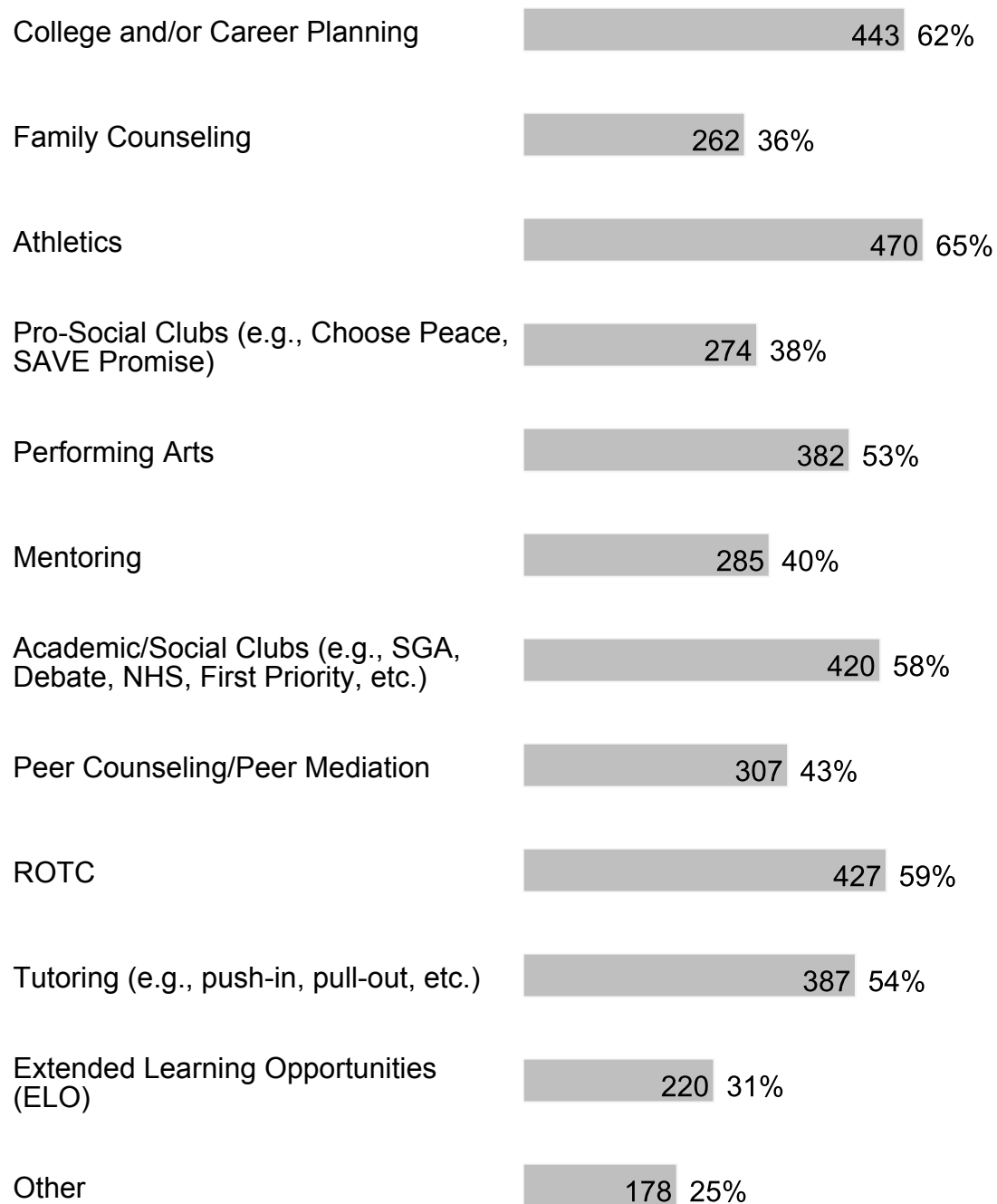

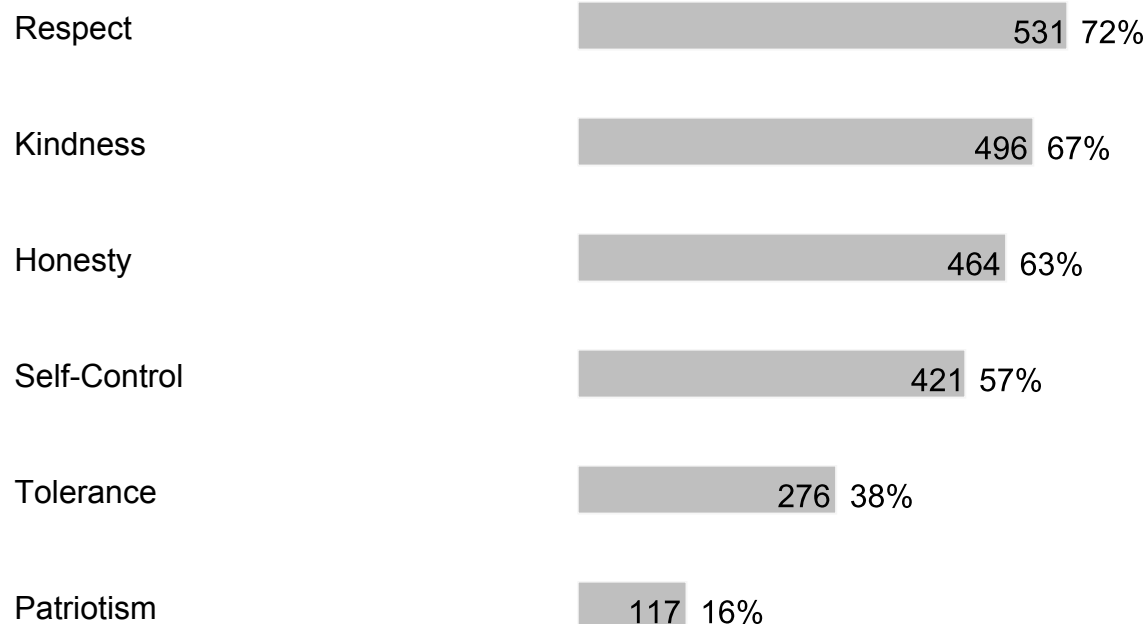
11. I am friends with other students at this school.

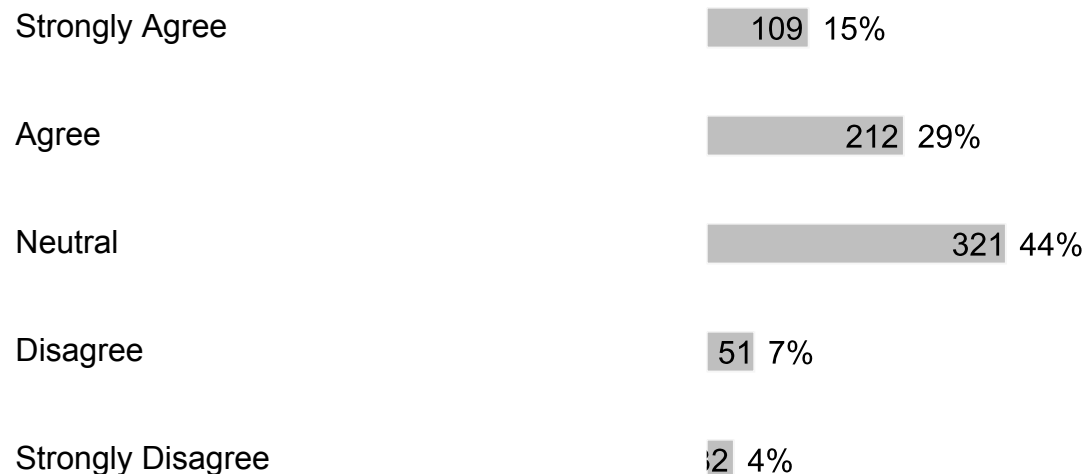
12. Which character traits do you value the most in yourself and others? (check all that apply)





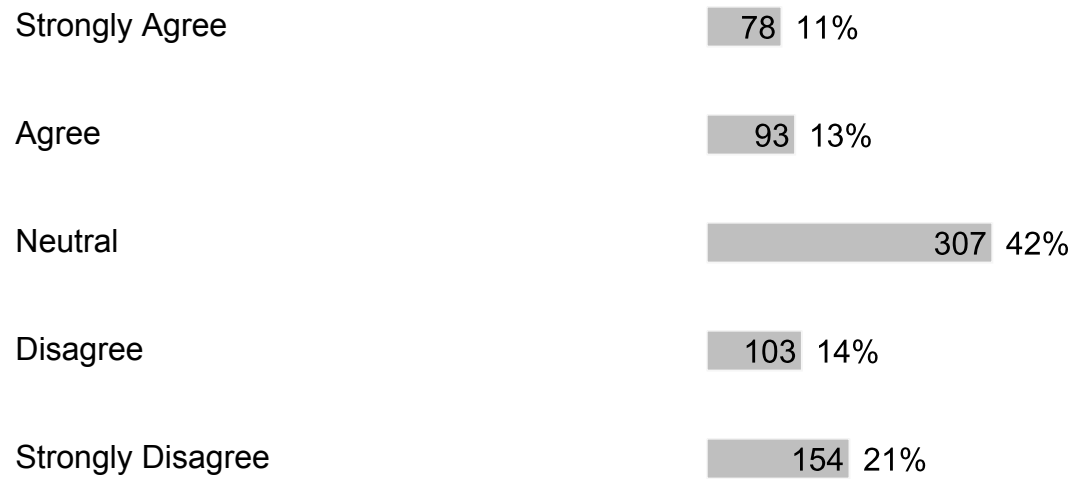

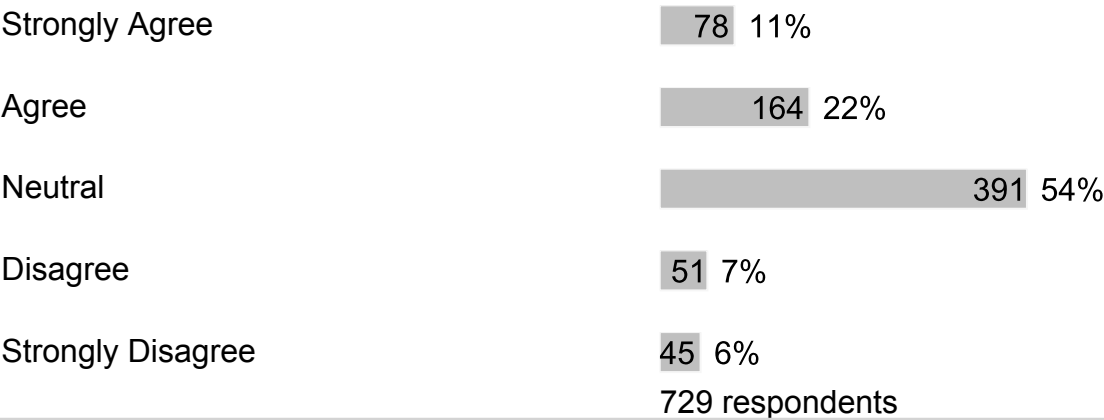
14. I enjoy eating food prepared by the cafeteria.



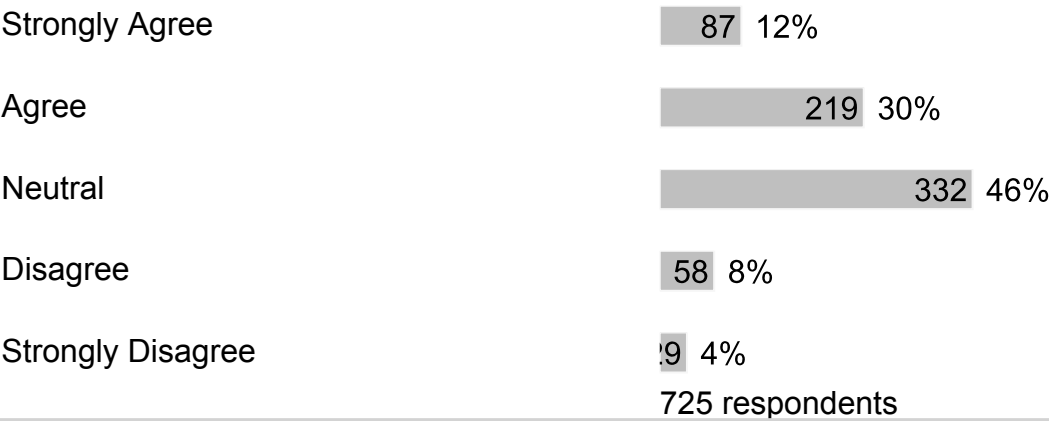

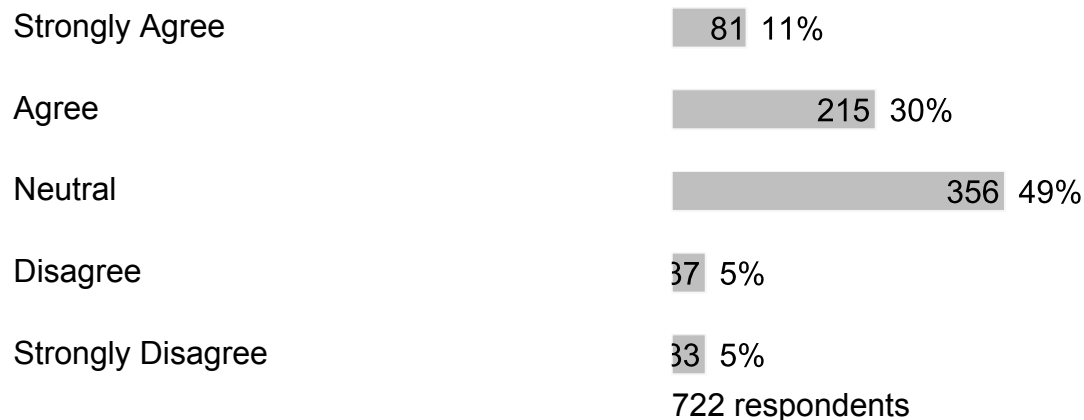

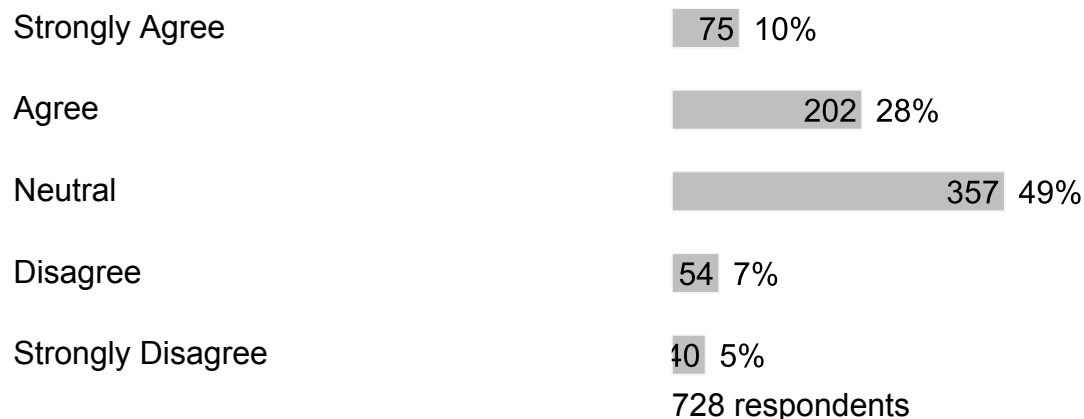

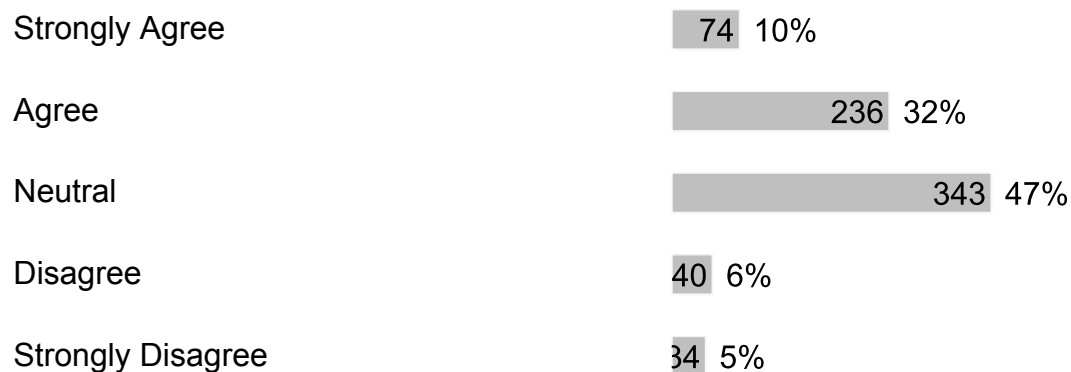

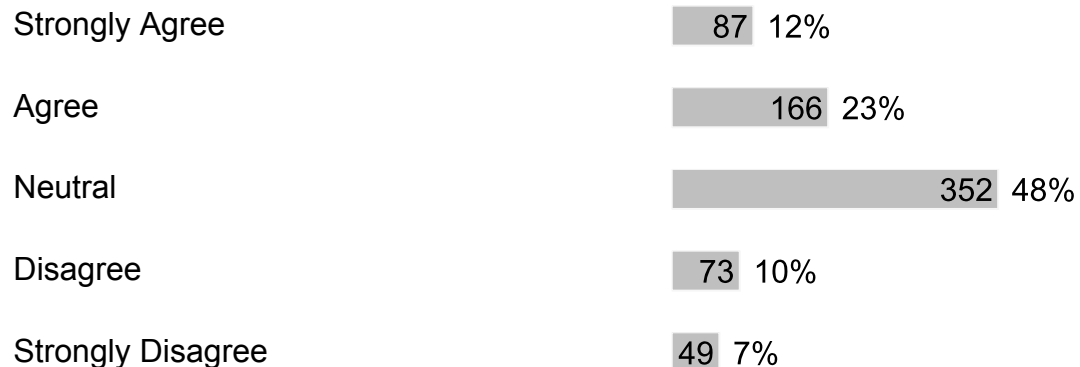

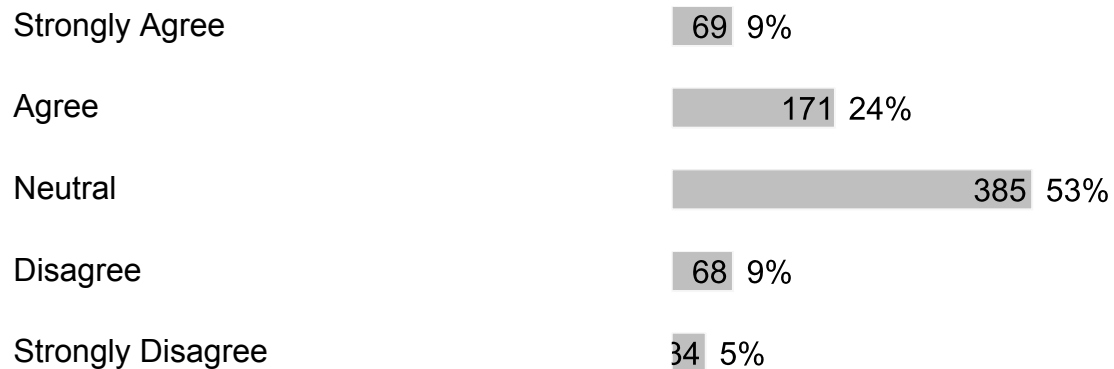
