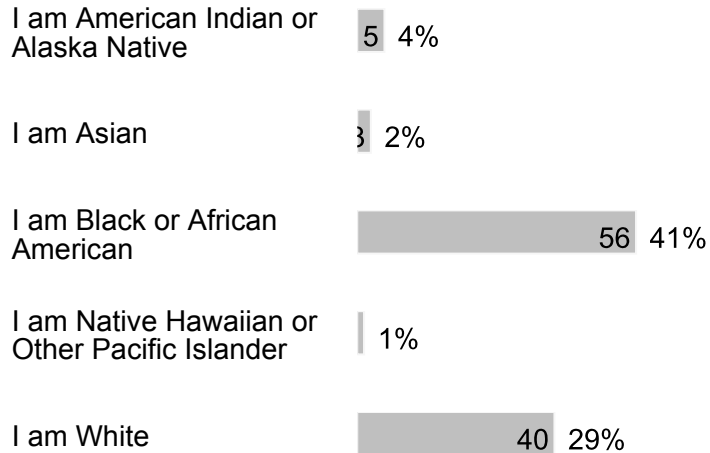

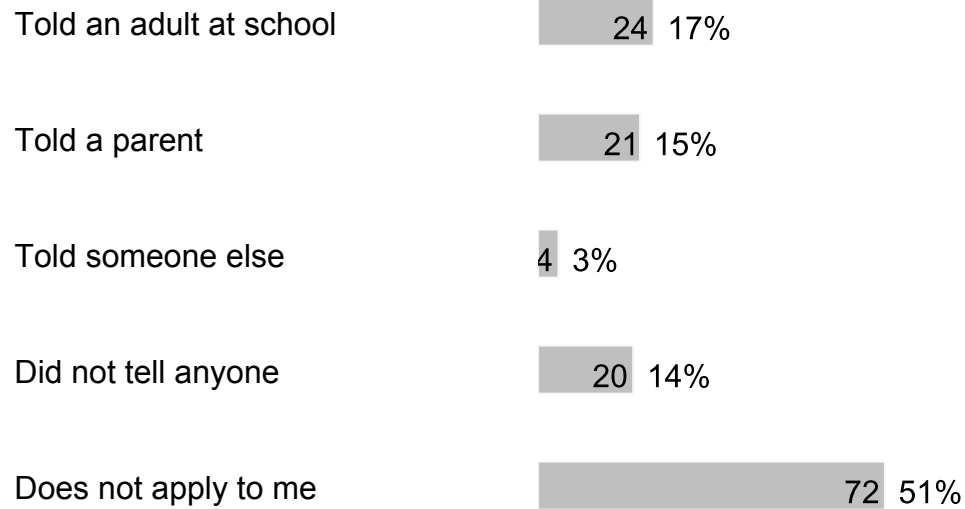

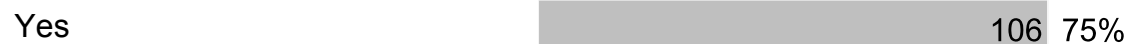

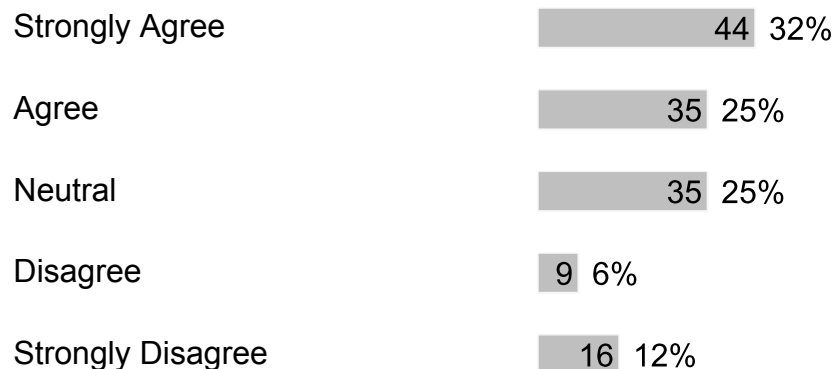

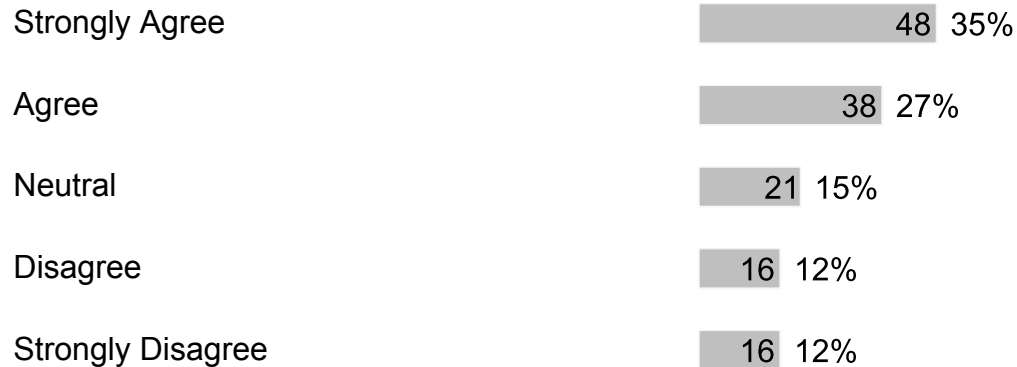

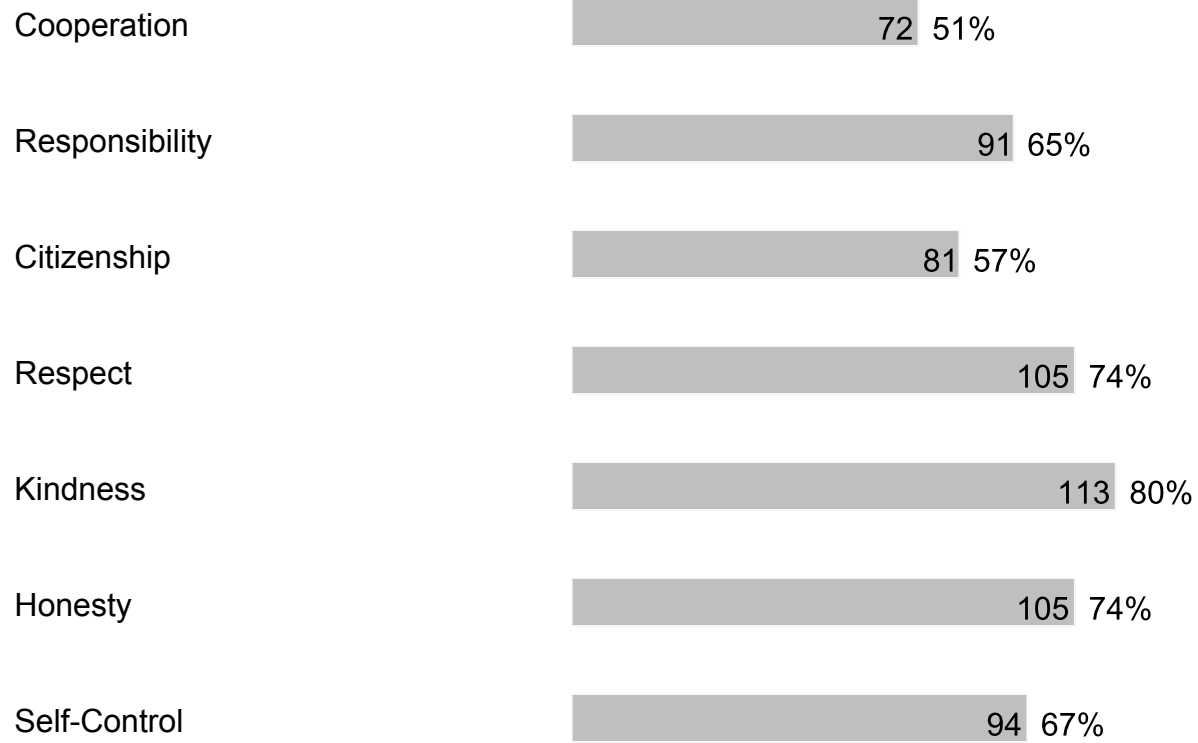

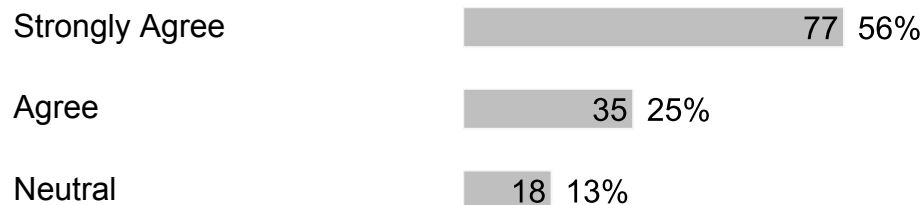

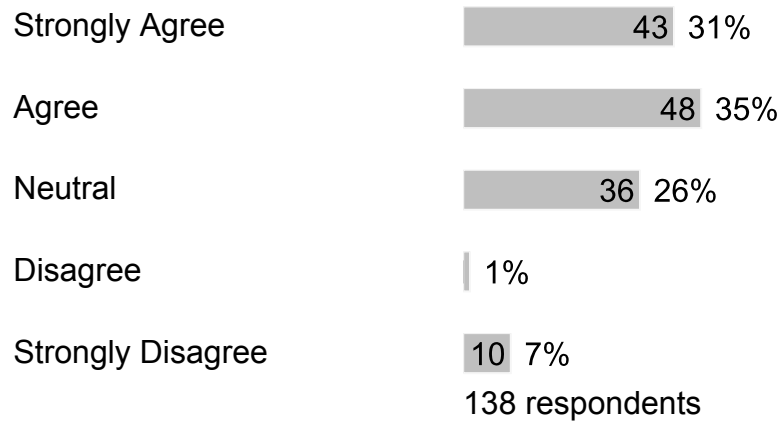
12. I receive feedback about my work that helps me better understand what I'm learning.



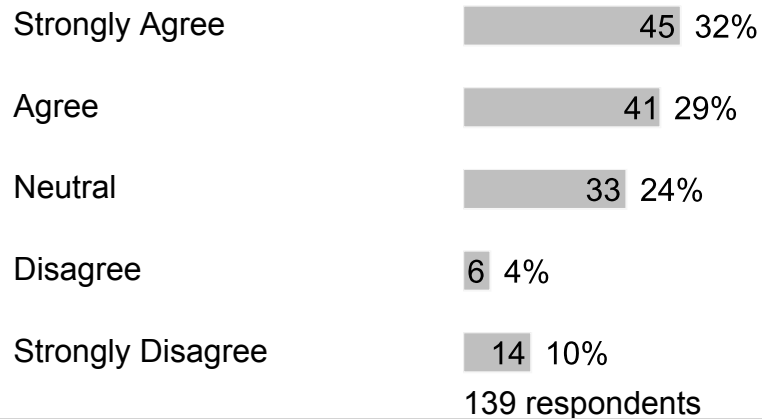

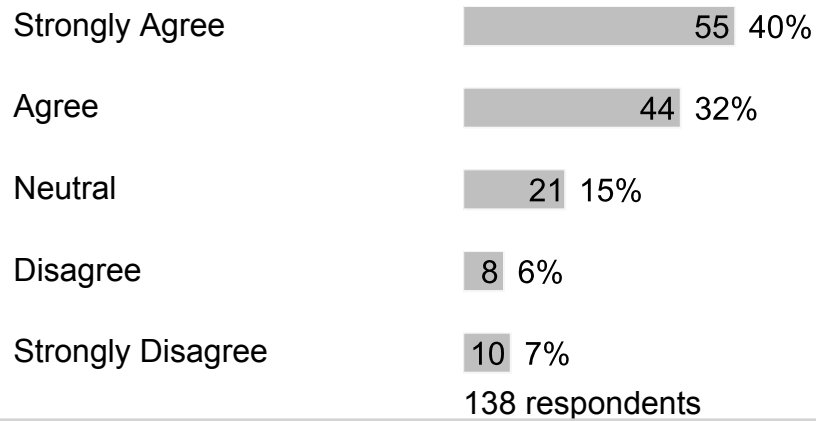

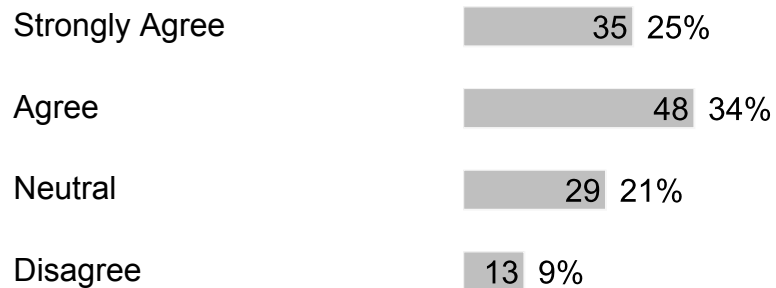
