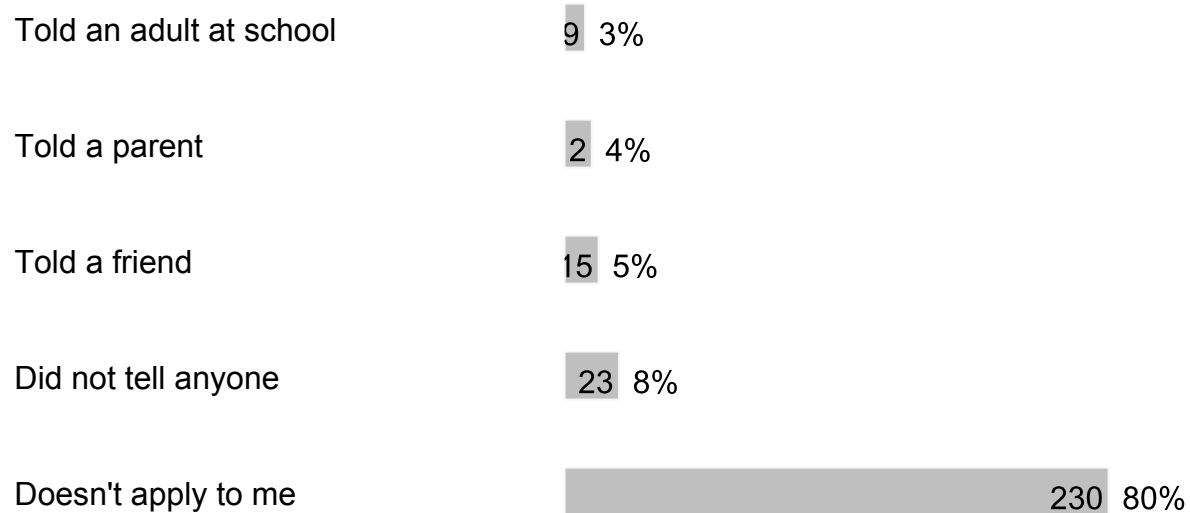

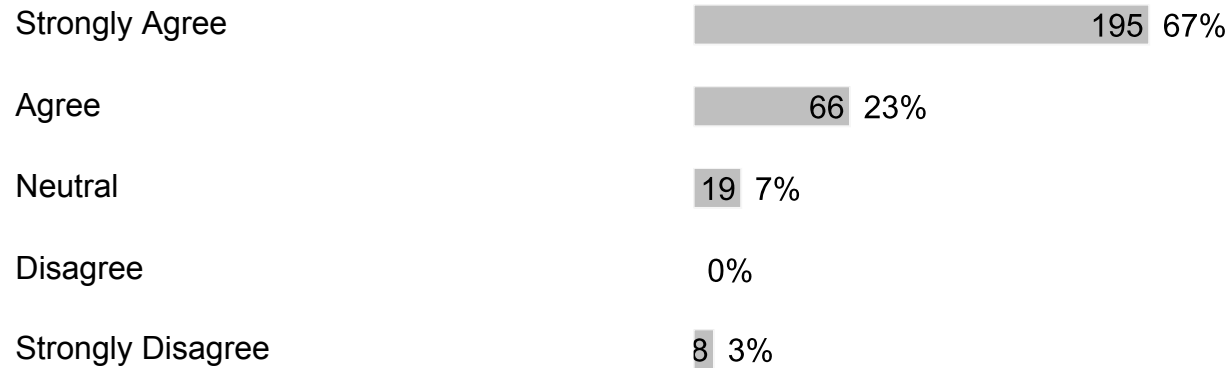

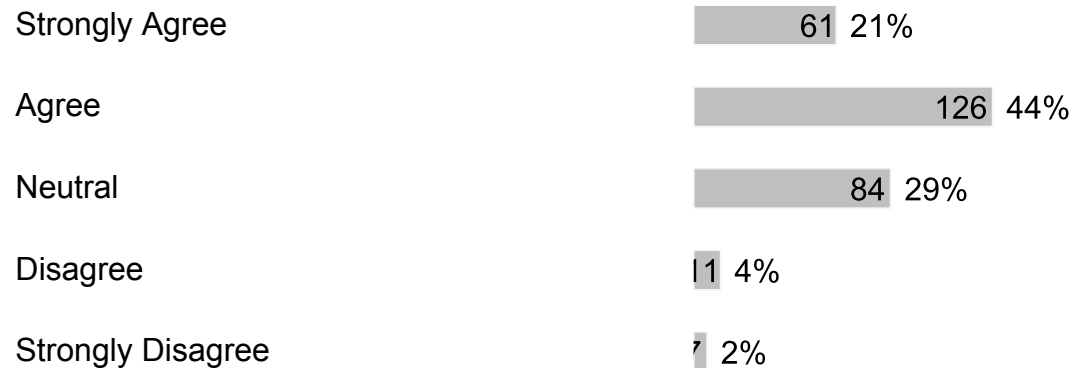

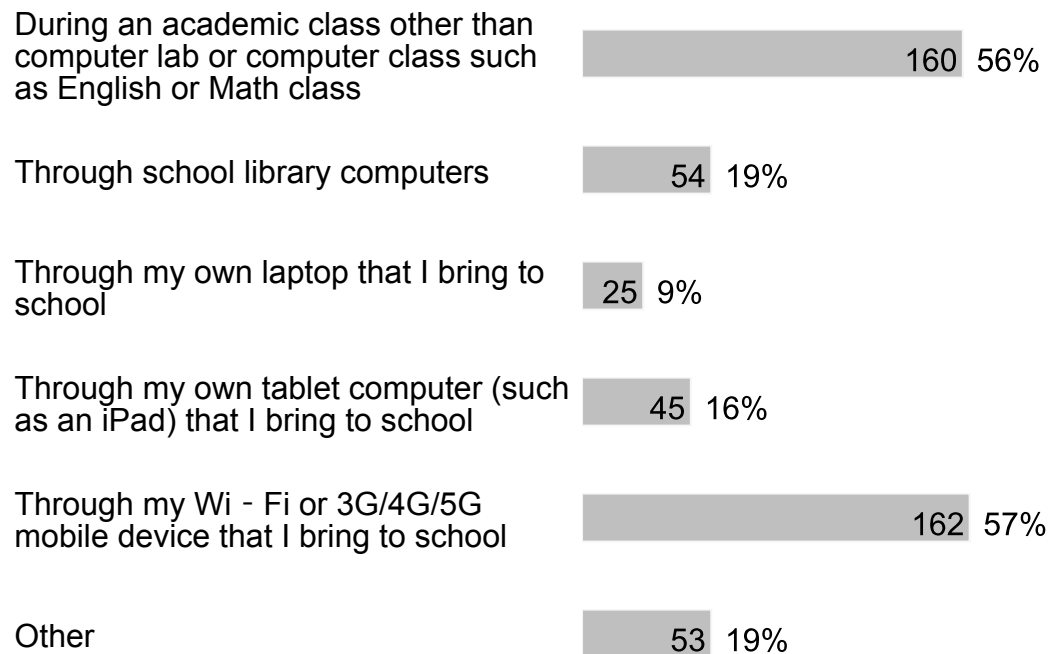

2. During a typical school day, I have access to the internet at school in the following ways (check all that apply):

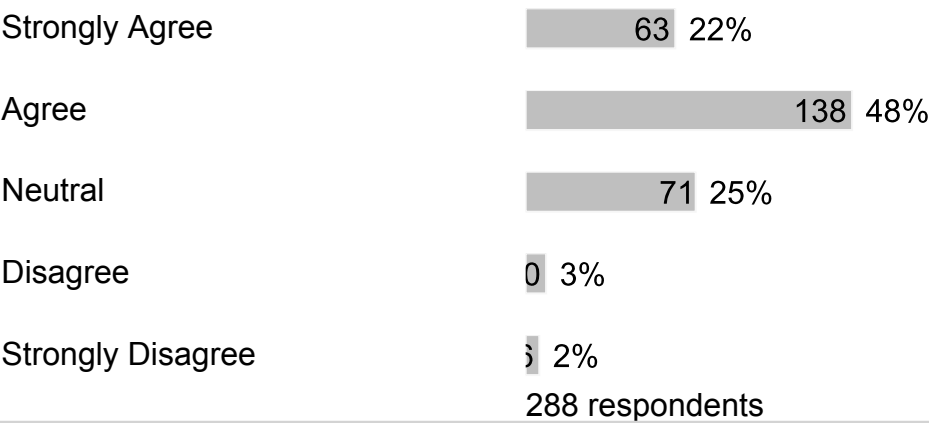




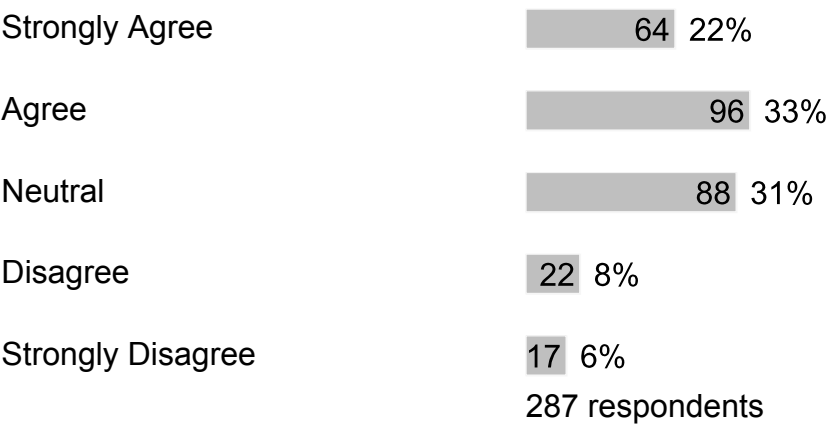

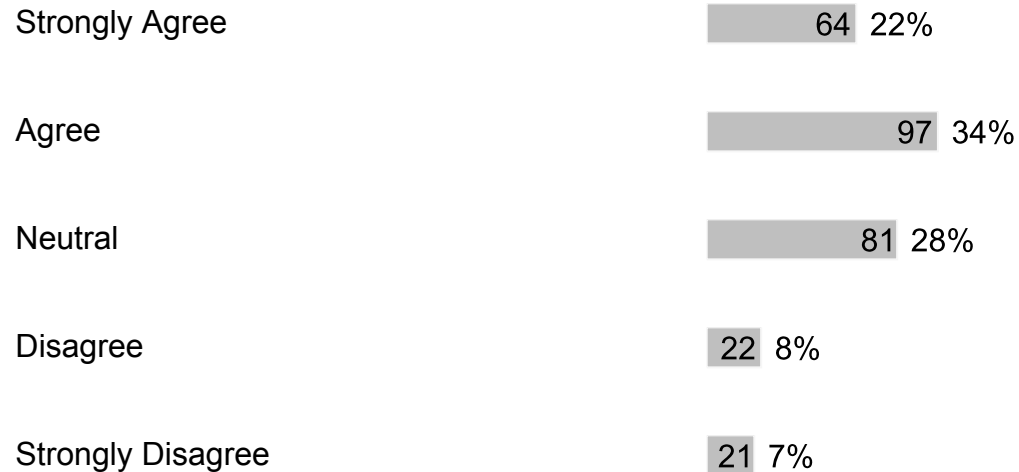

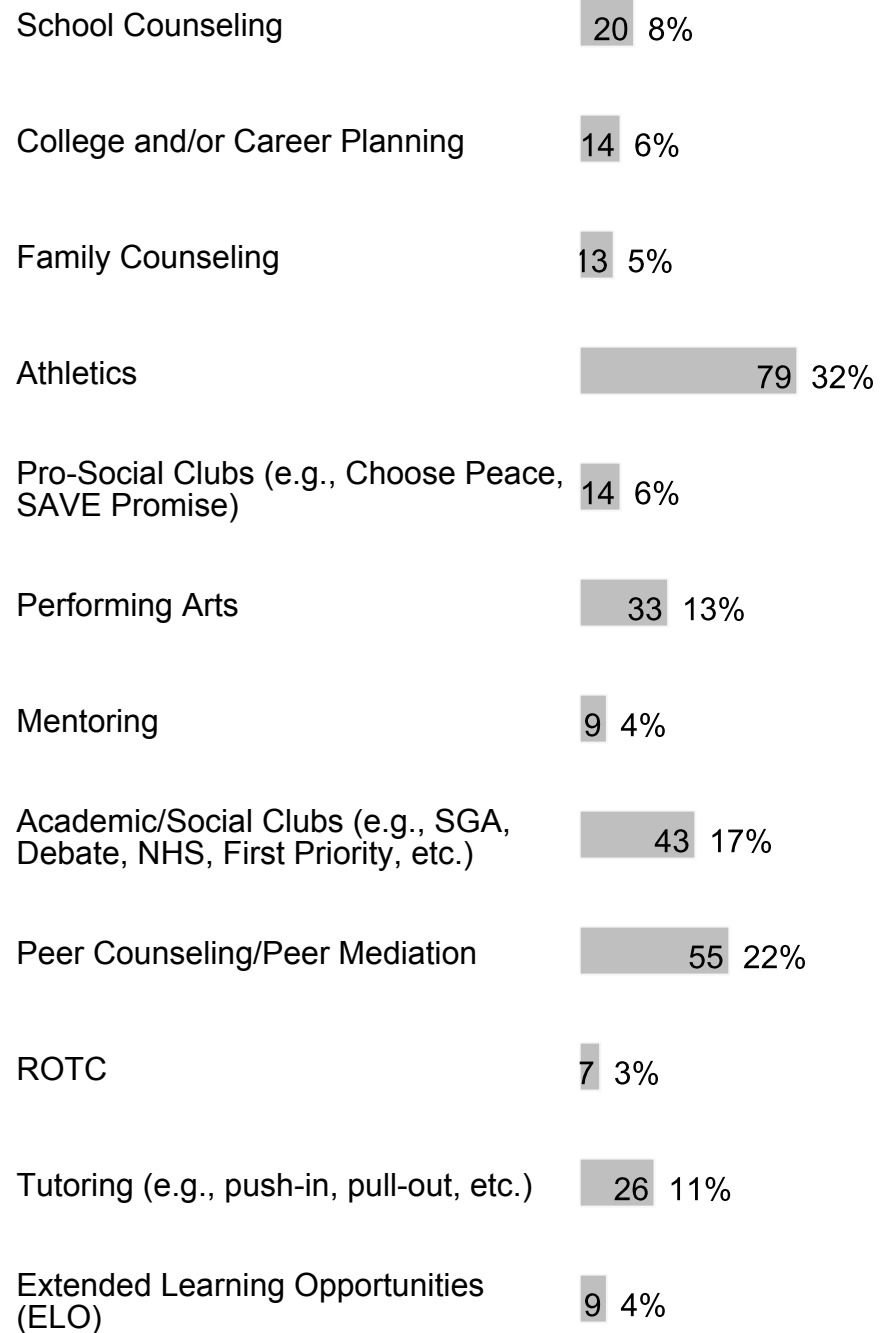

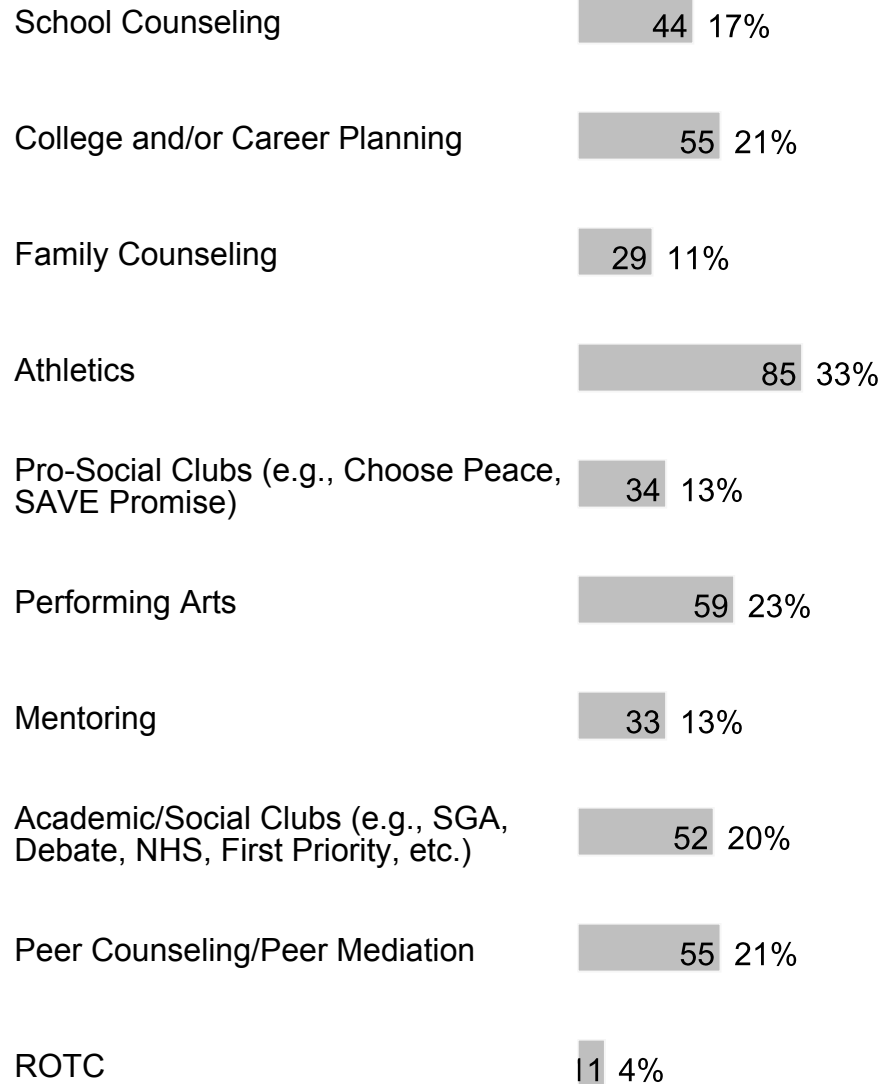

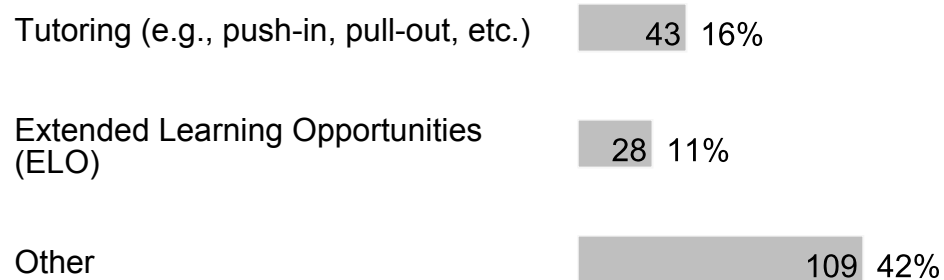

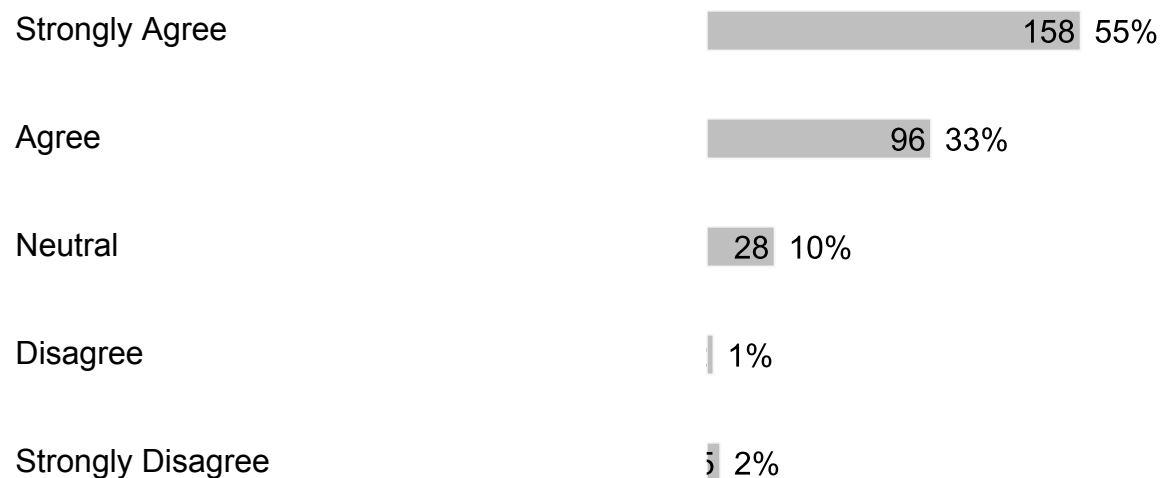
10. These are the programs/services at my school that I value most or would value if they were available at my school (check all that apply):

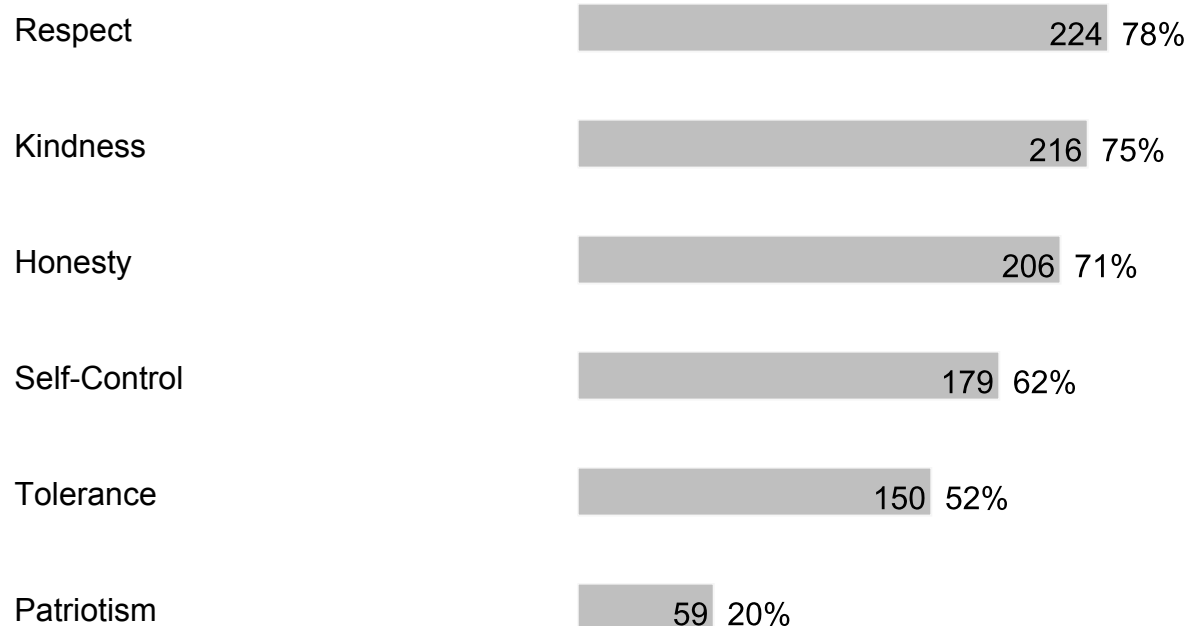

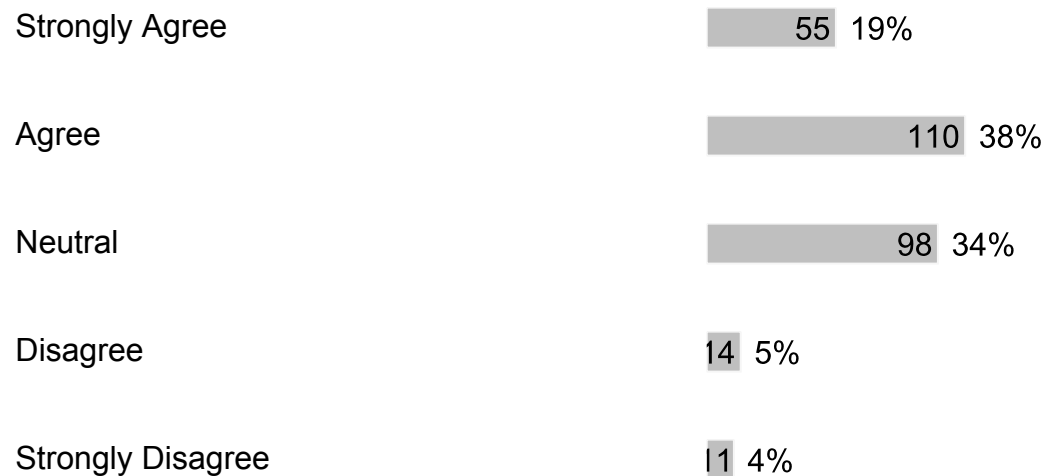
12. Which character traits do you value the most in yourself and others? (check all that apply)





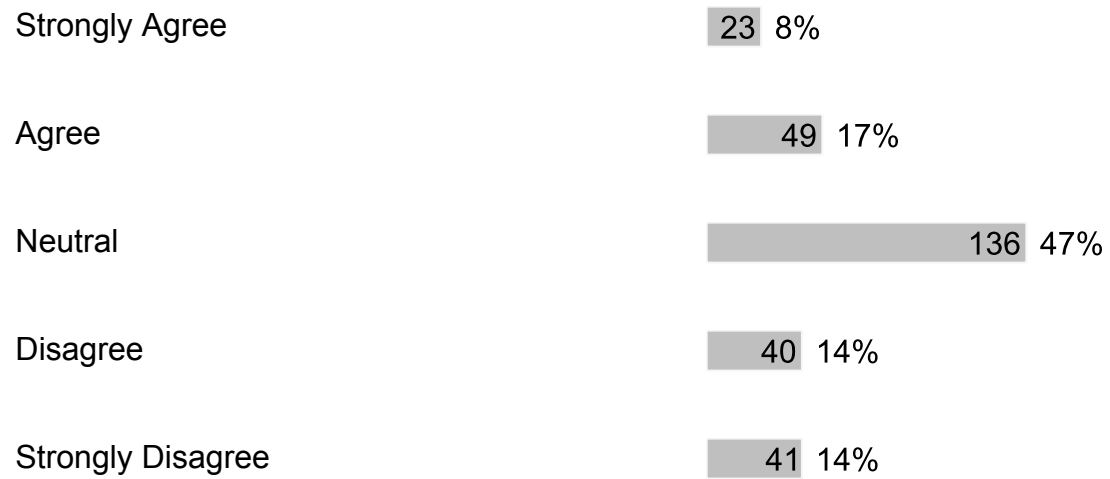

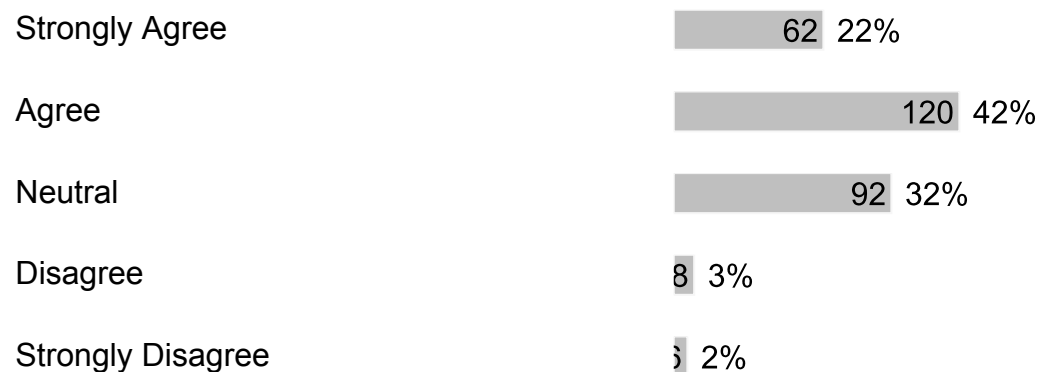

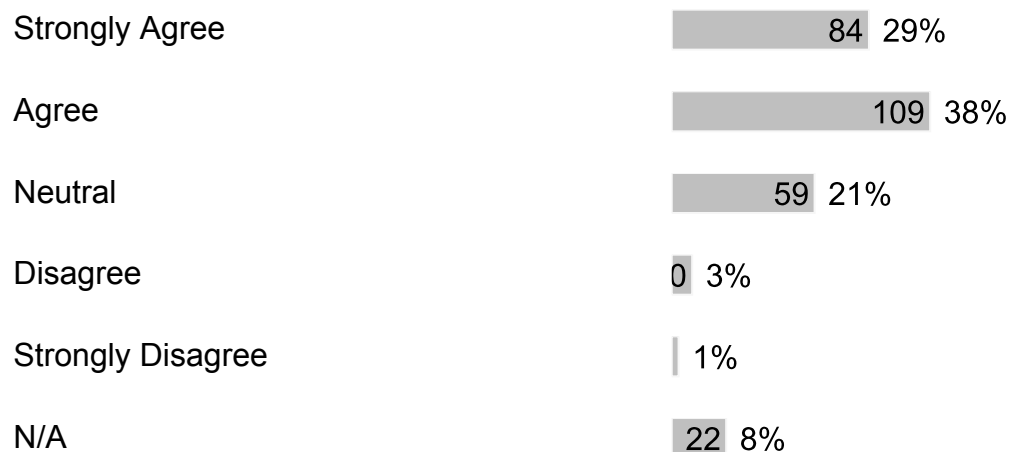

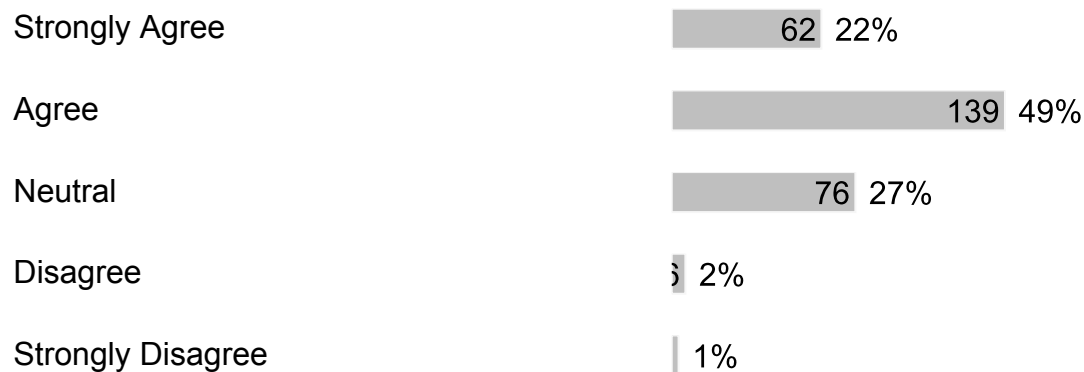

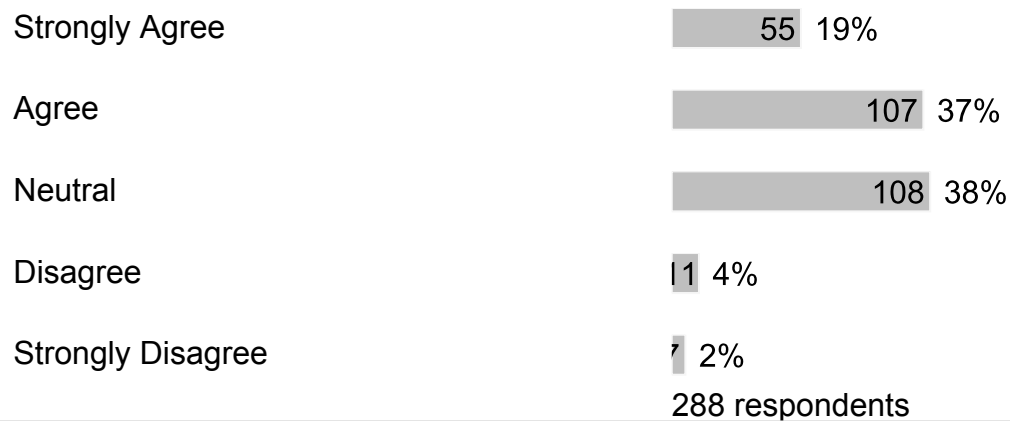

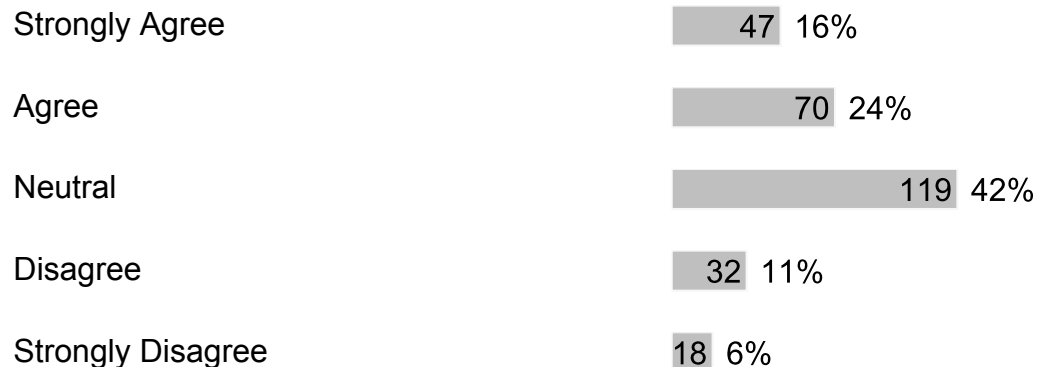

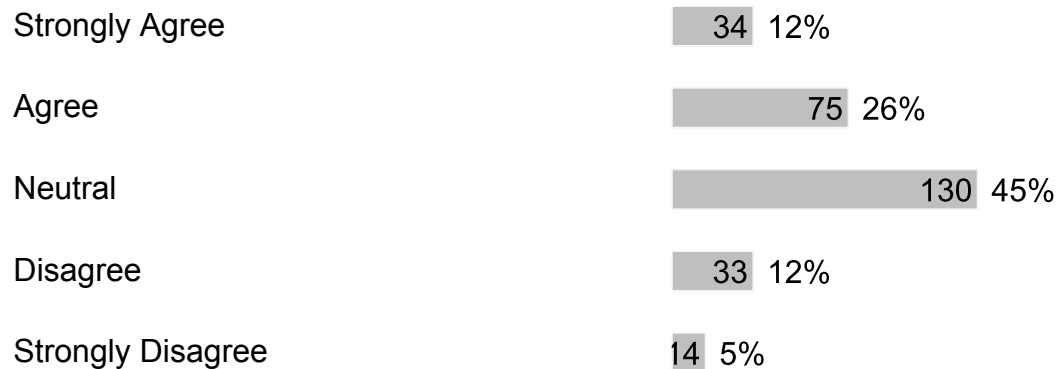
