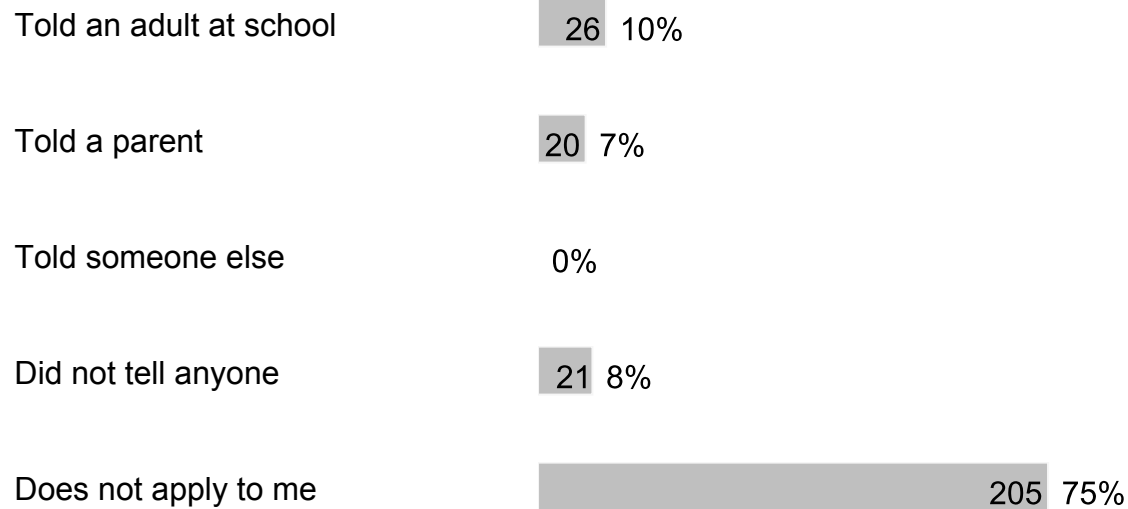

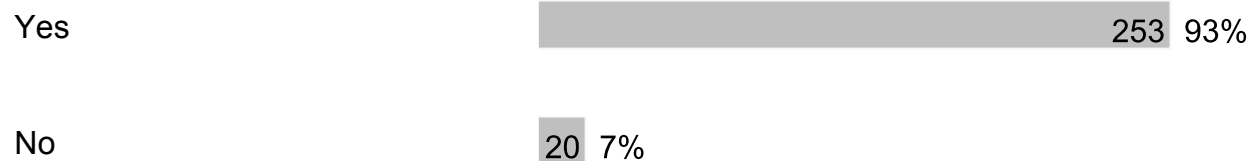

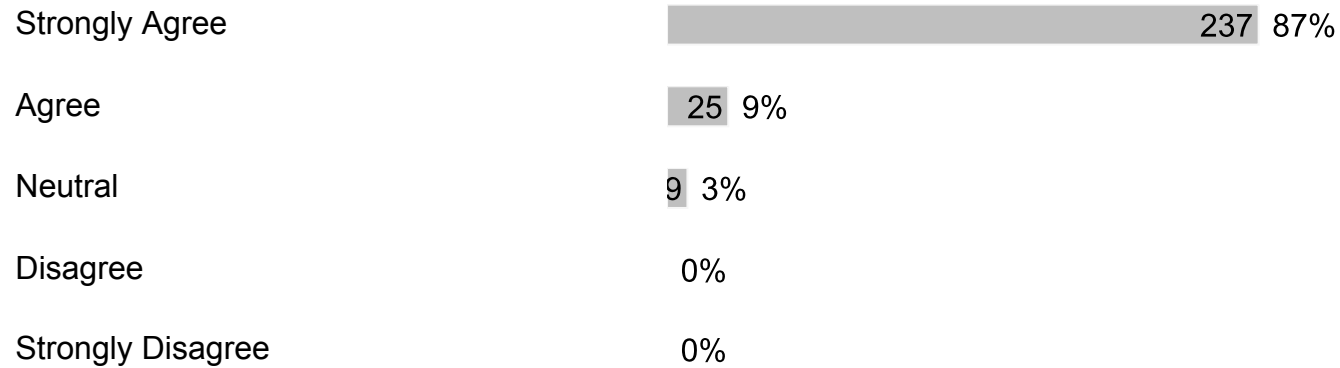

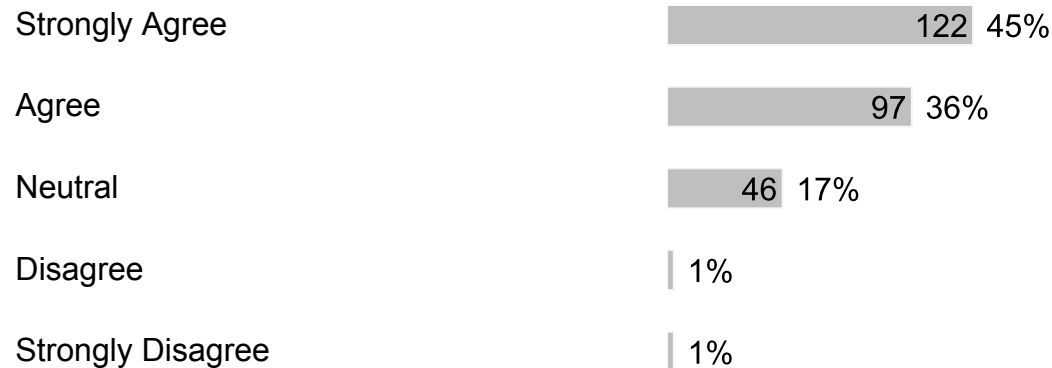

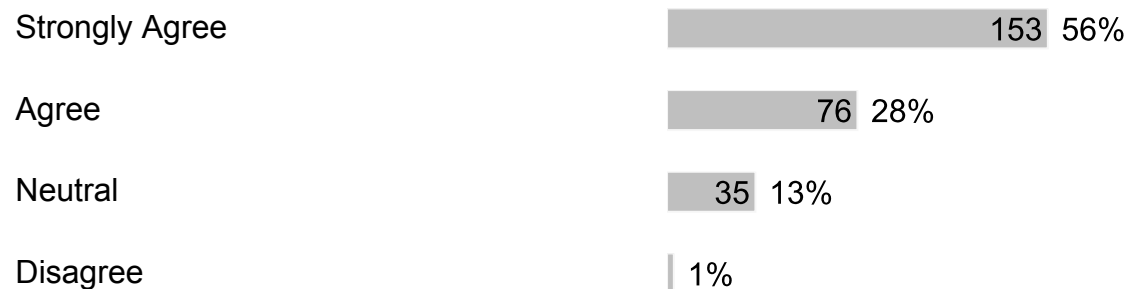

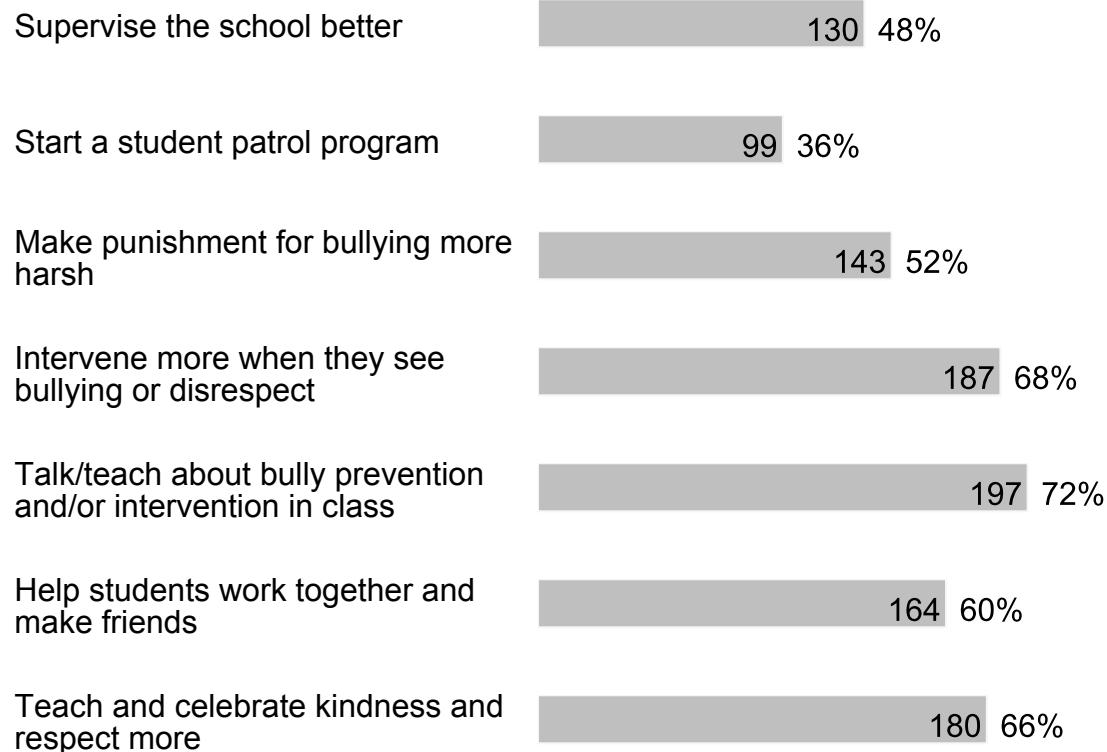

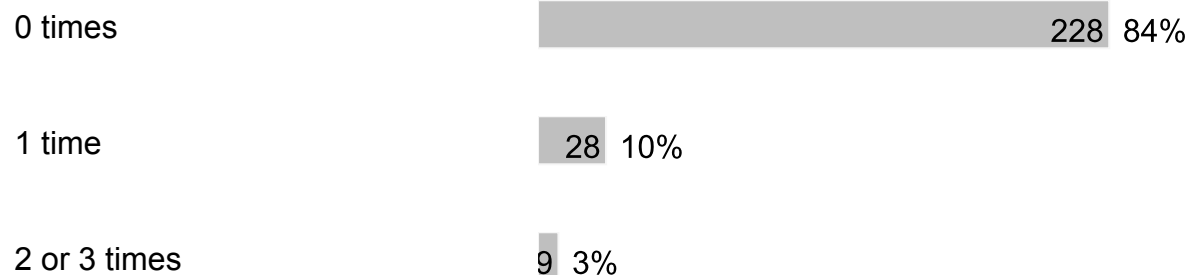

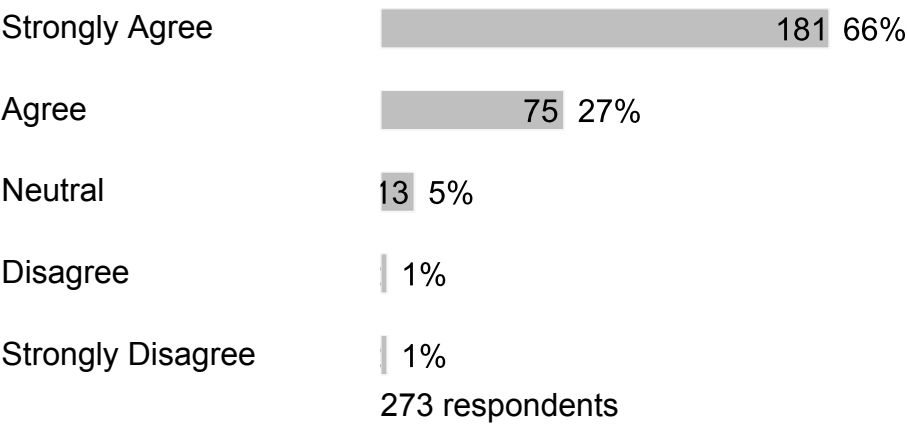

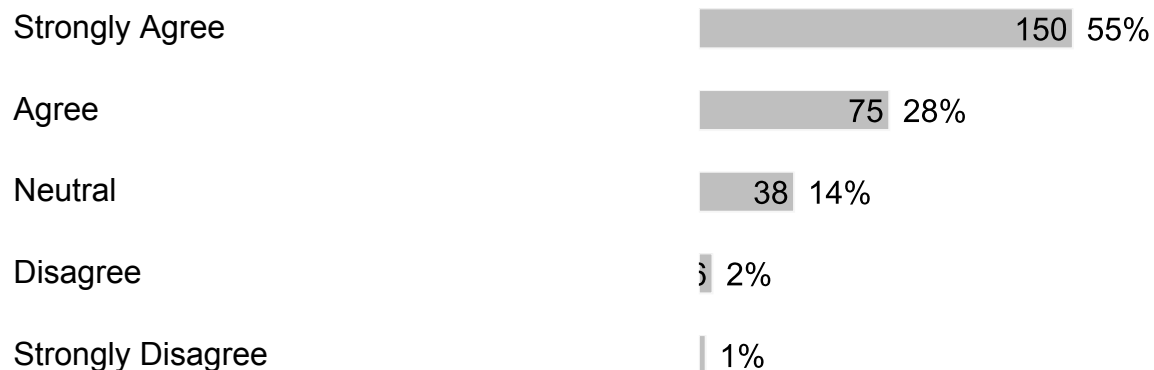

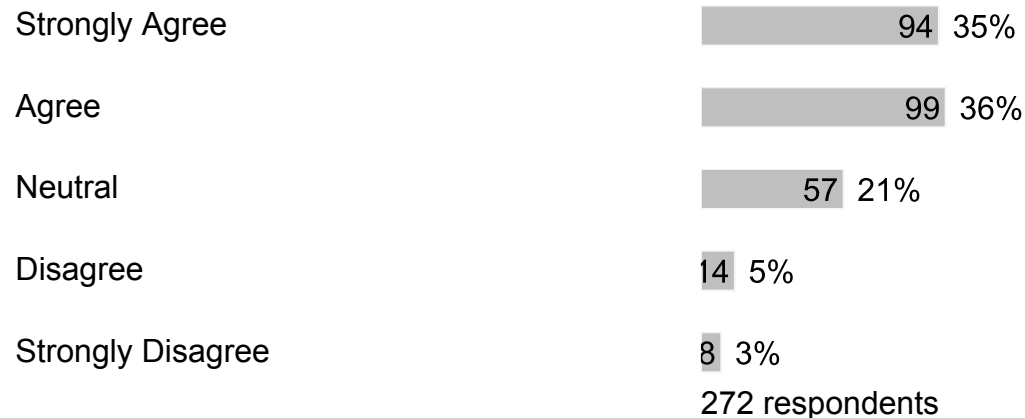

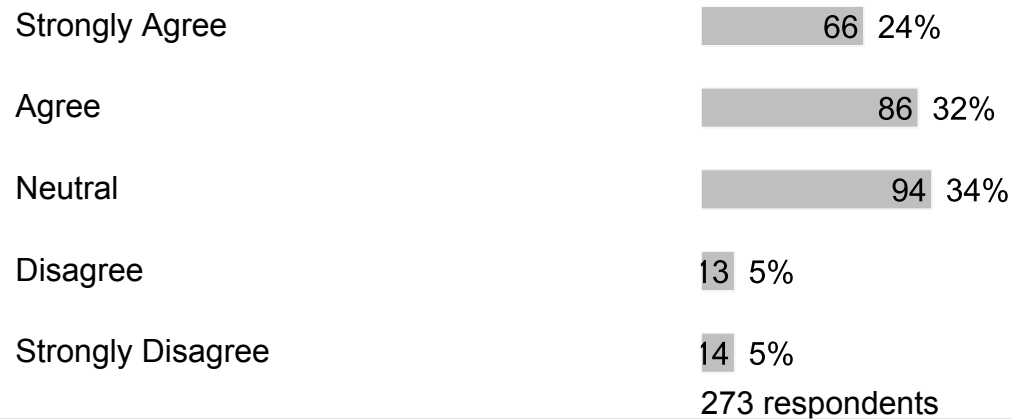

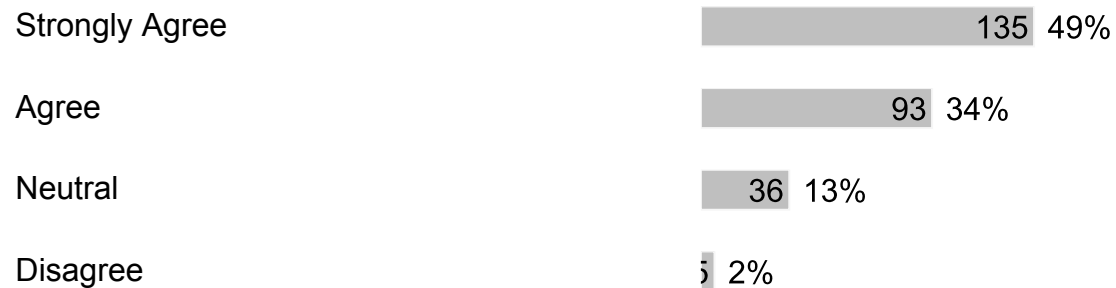

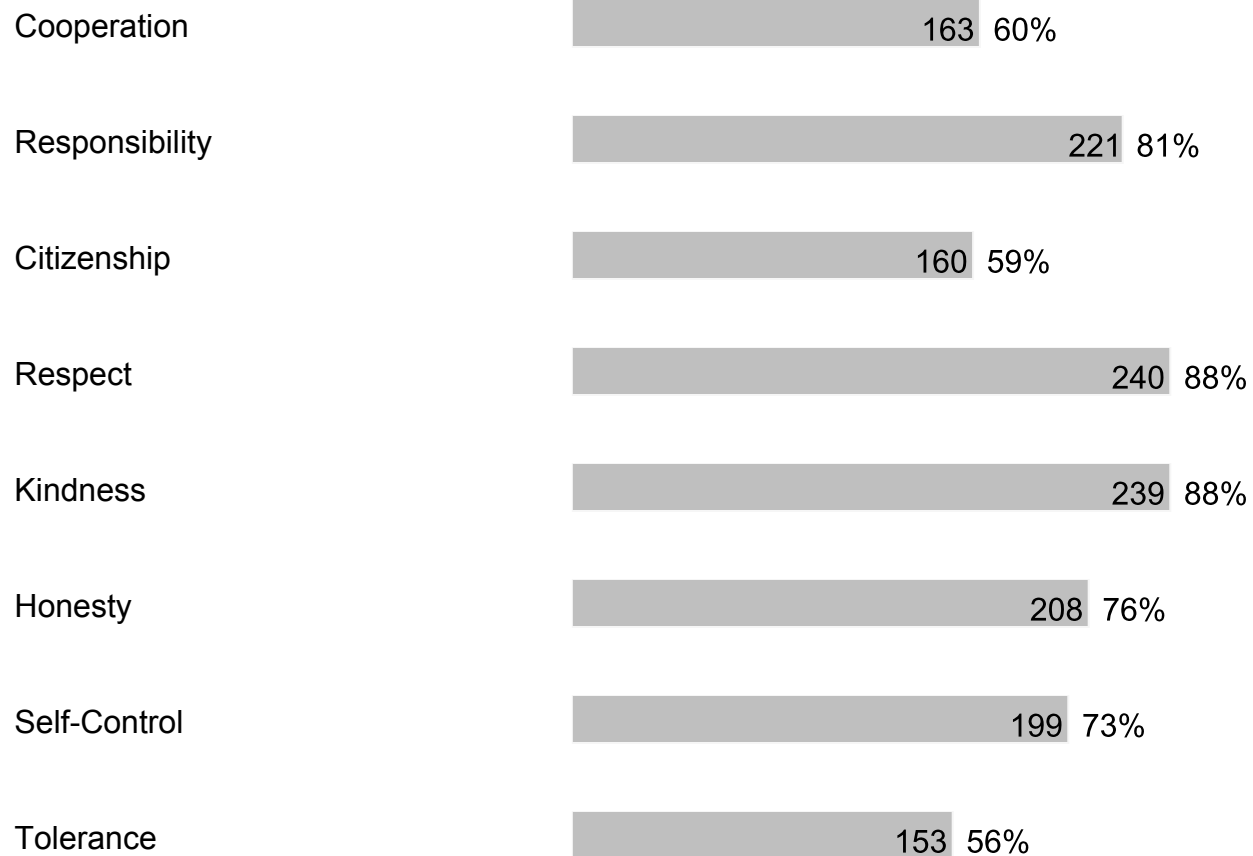

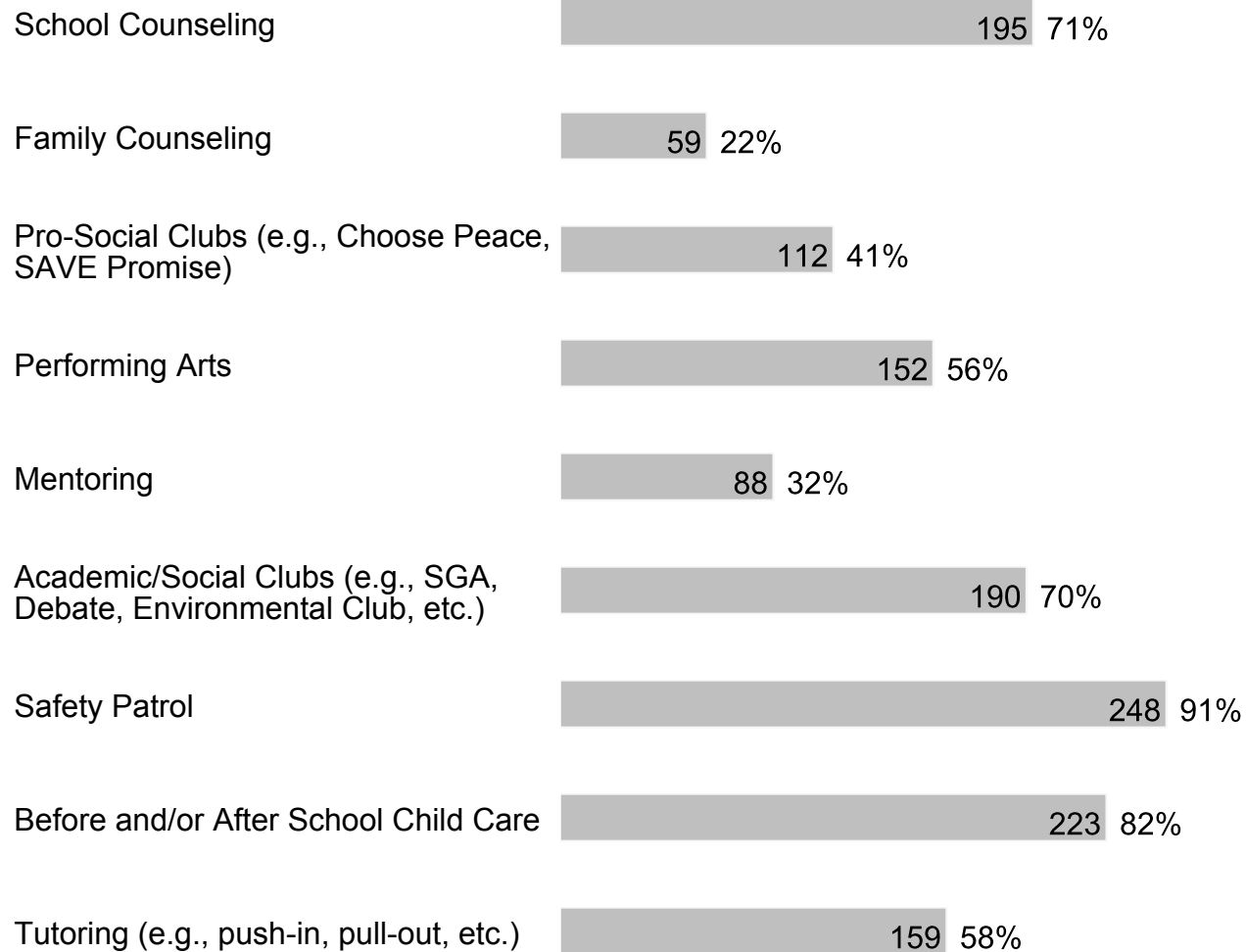

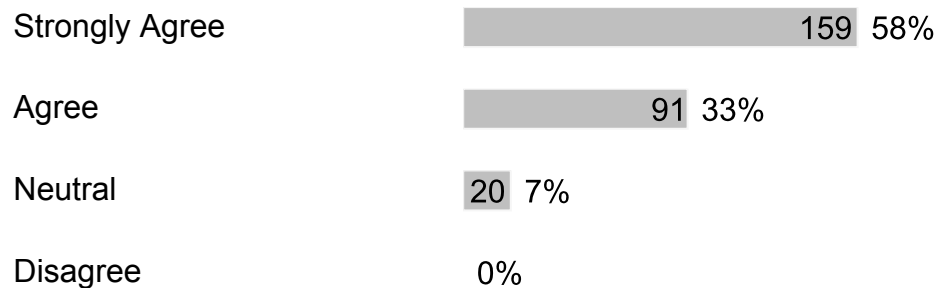

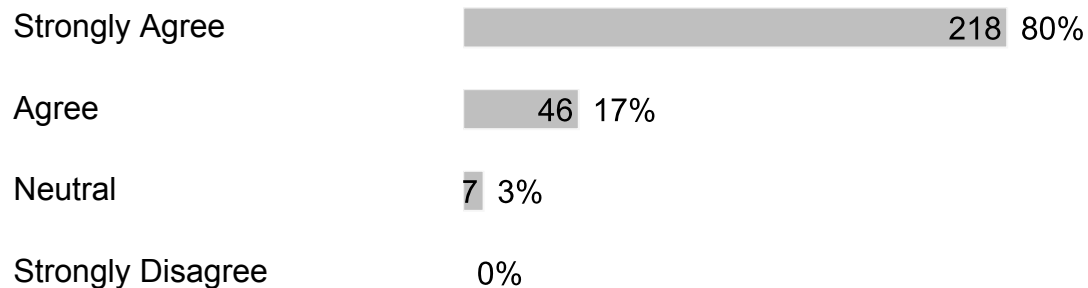

2. My teachers use different activities to help me learn new things.



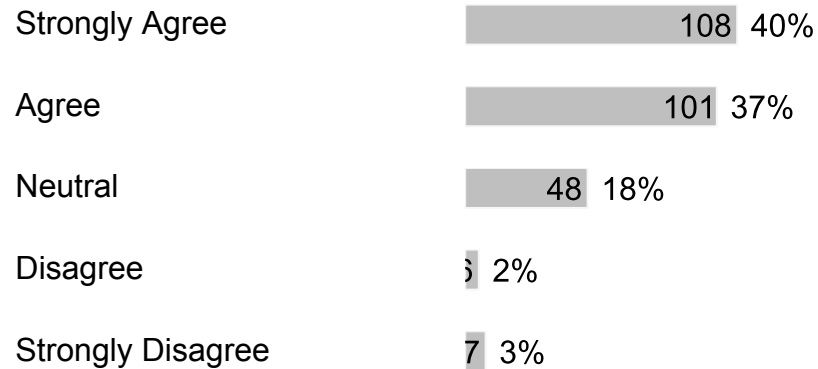

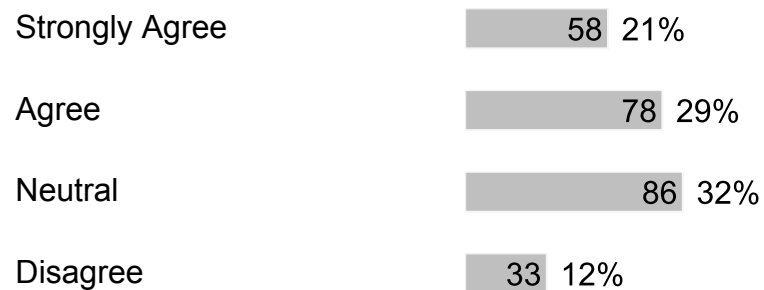
