ACTIVITY	STANDARD	DESCRIPTION
Example: School-wide Emotion Charades	Students will recognize, identify, and appropriately express basic emotions in themselves and others.	Example: In this school-wide activity, students across grade levels participate in "Emotion Charades" by acting out basic emotions using facial expressions and body language while peers guess the emotion. Class discussions follow, helping students better understand and express emotions in themselves and others.
Example: Emotion Explorers	LSW A. Students will recognize, identify, and appropriately express basic emotions in themselves and others.	Example: "Emotion Explorers" is an interactive activity where students identify, act out, and describe basic emotions. Through movement, facial expressions, and storytelling, students learn to recognize how emotions feel and look in themselves and others.
Example: My Calm-Down Toolbox	LSW B. Students will demonstrate the ability to manage emotions and behaviors to achieve personal and academic goals.	Example: In "My Calm-Down Toolbox," students explore different ways to manage strong emotions like anger, frustration, or anxiety. They'll learn simple, age-appropriate coping strategies and create a personalized visual toolbox filled with techniques that help them feel calm and in control.
Example: Friendship Bingo	LSW C. Students will engage in positive social interactions and demonstrate respectful and cooperative behaviors.	Example: "Friendship Bingo" is a fun, social activity where students practice respectful and cooperative behaviors by completing positive social actions listed on their bingo cards. This encourages students to be kind, helpful, and inclusive throughout the school day or week.
