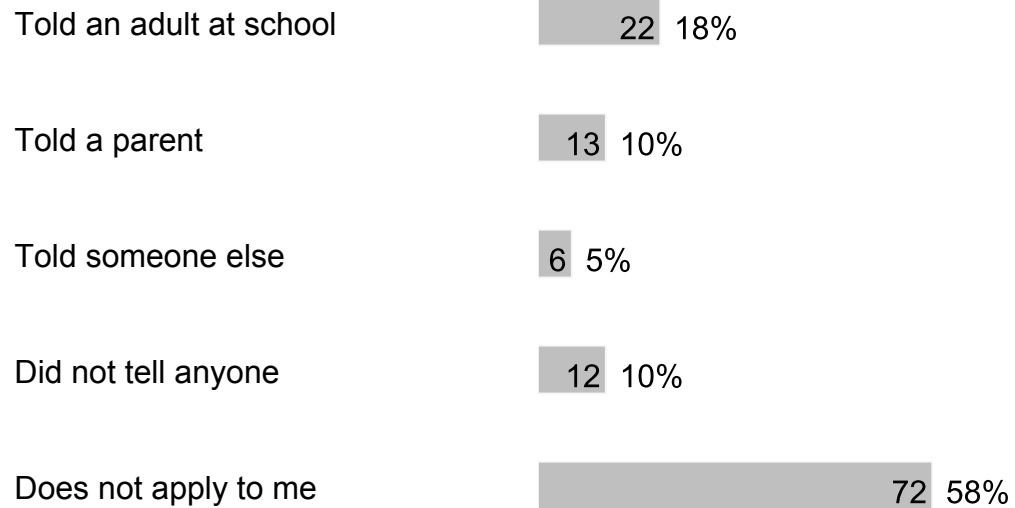

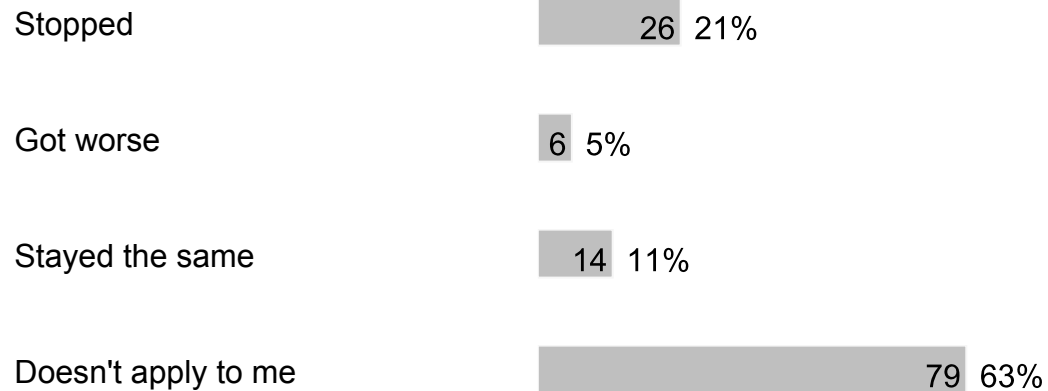

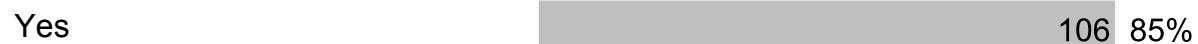

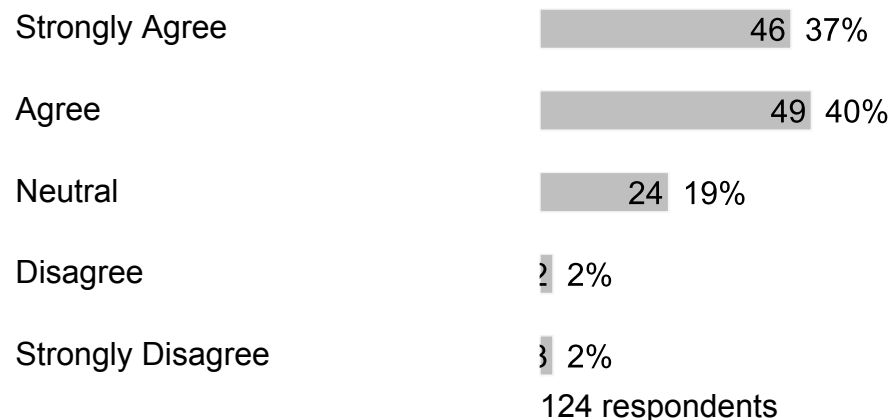

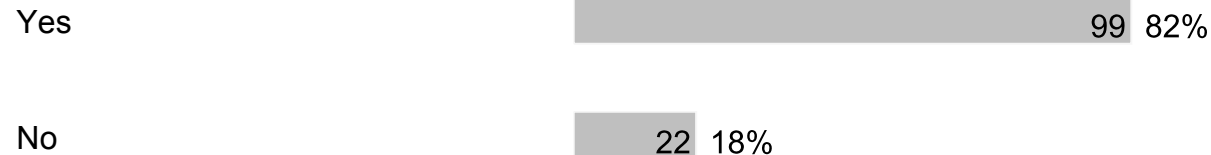

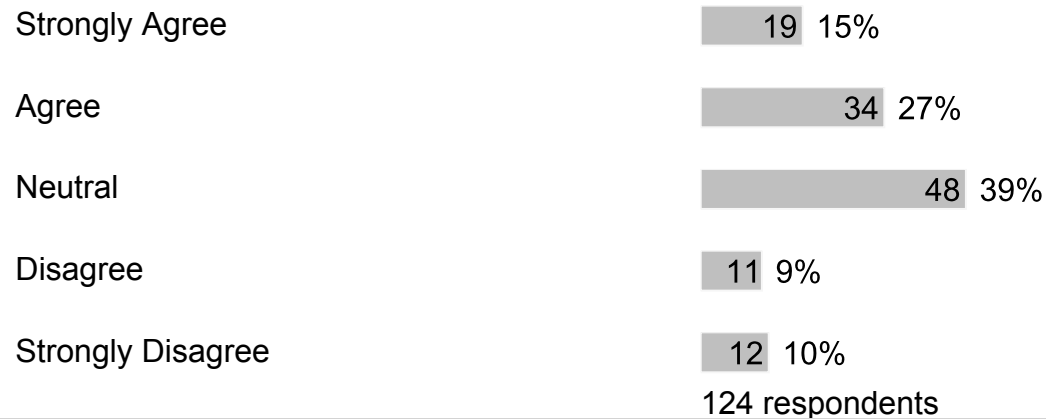

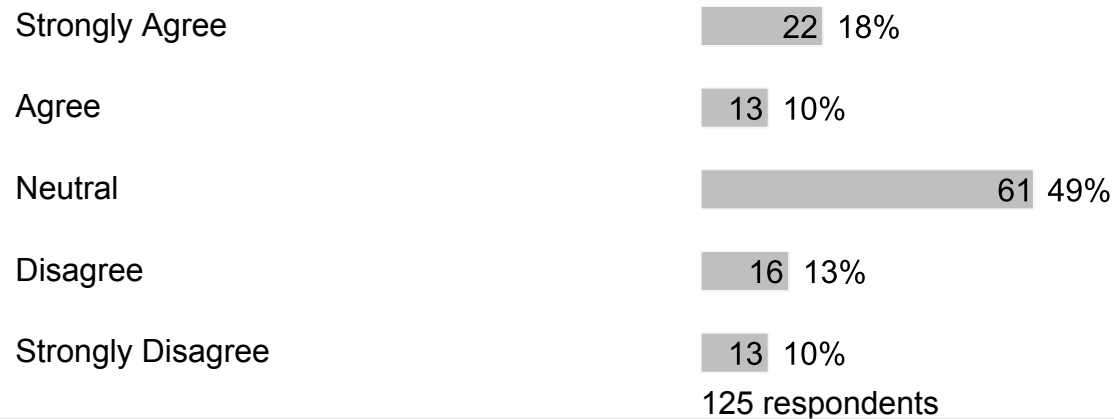

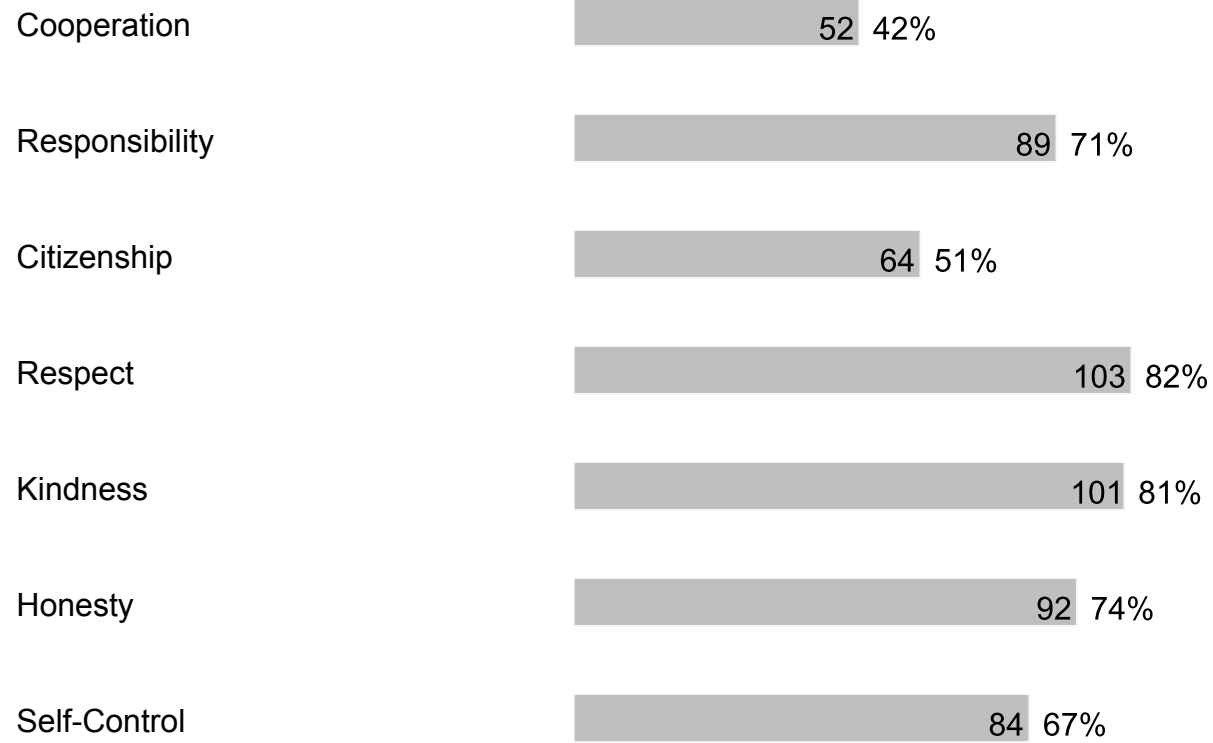

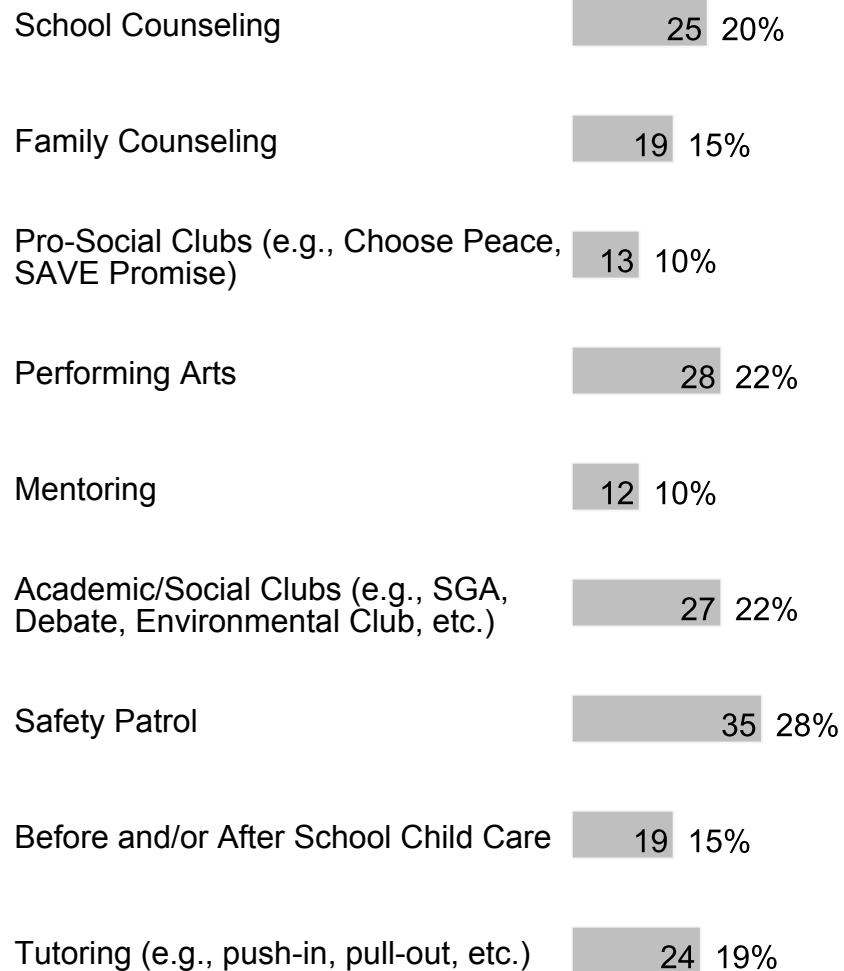

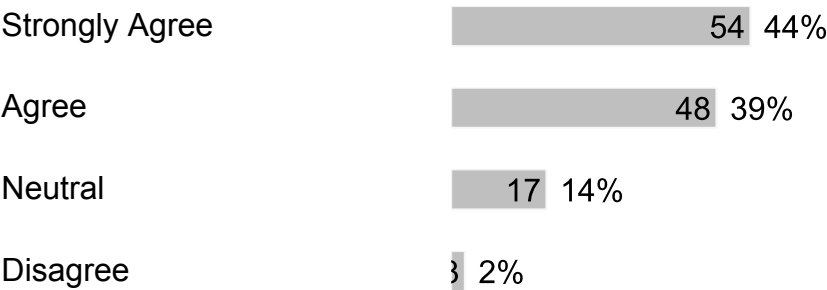

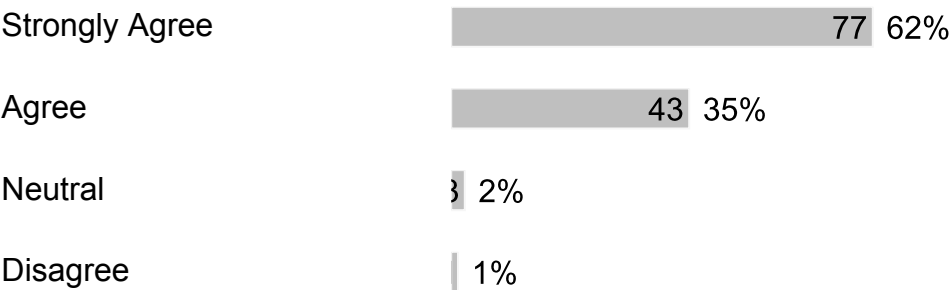

## 2. My teachers use different activities to help me learn new things.



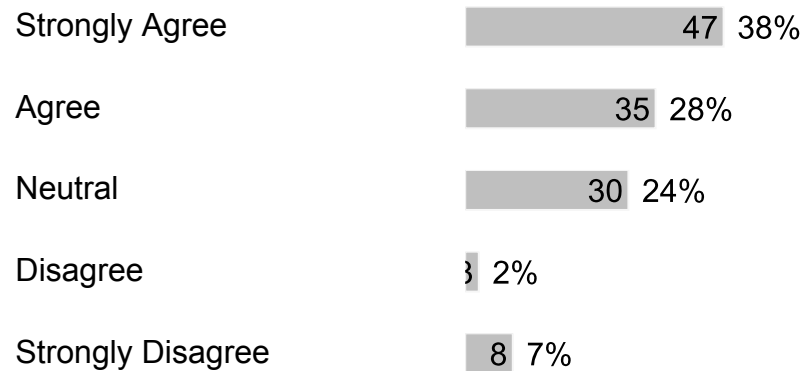

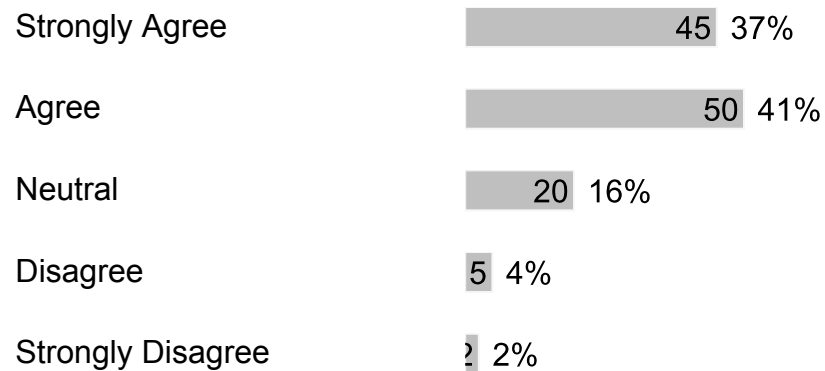

#### 4. I set academic goals for myself.



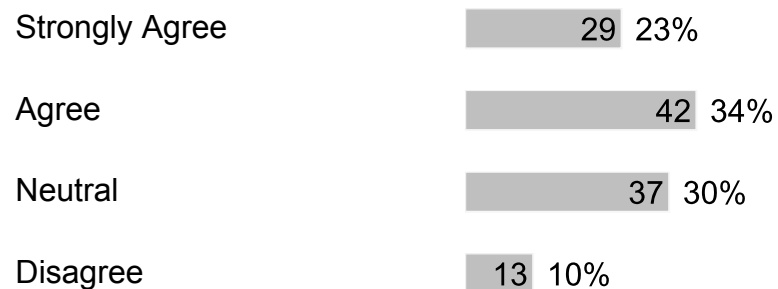

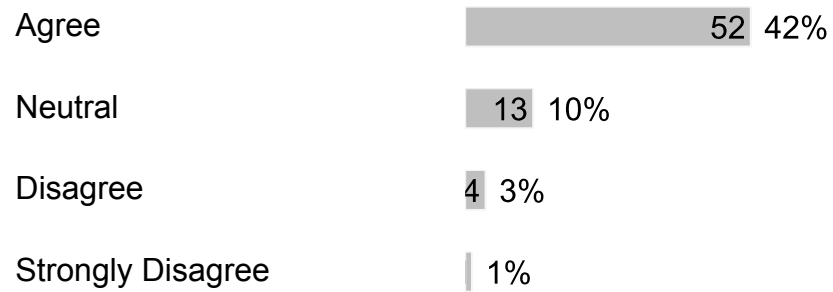

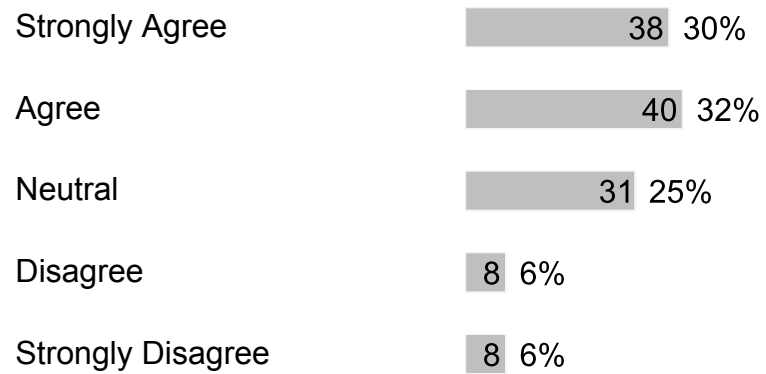
