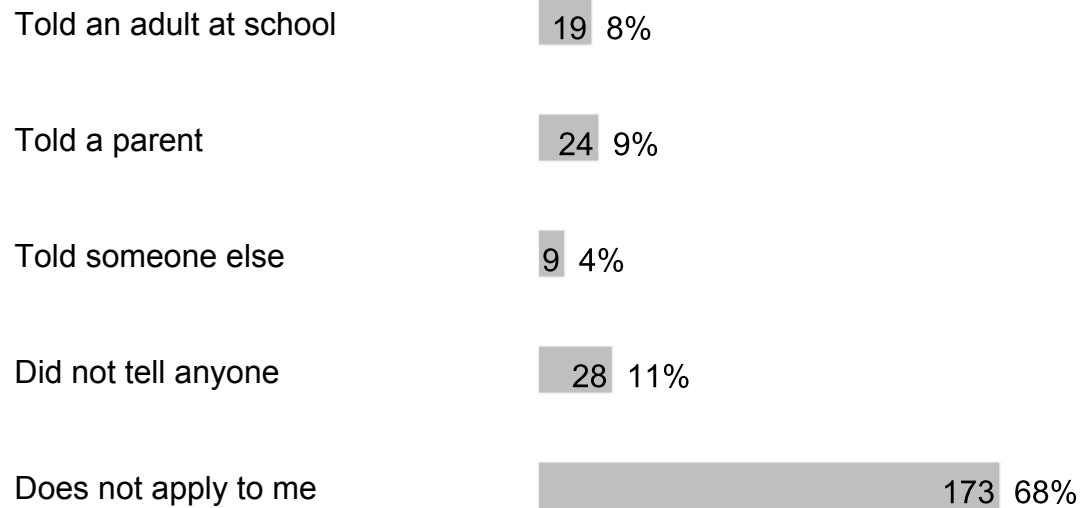

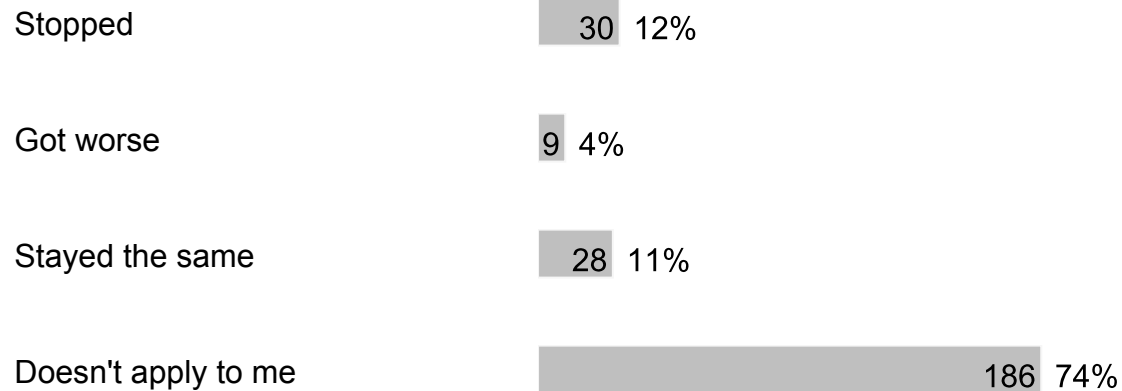

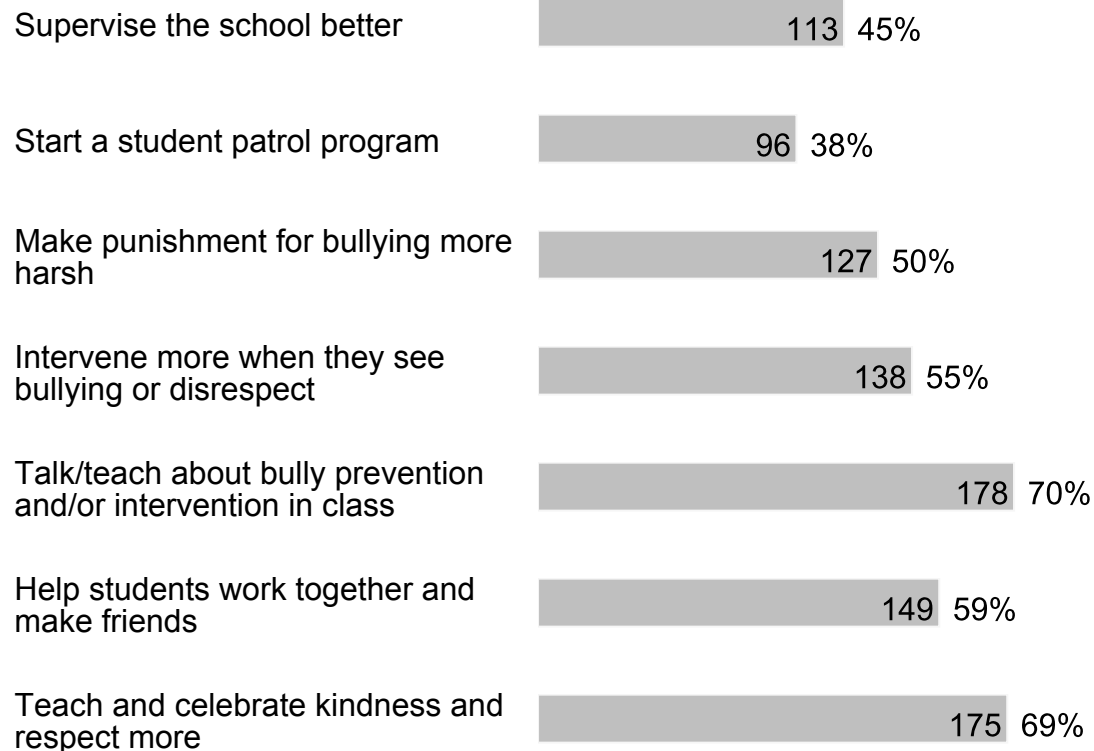

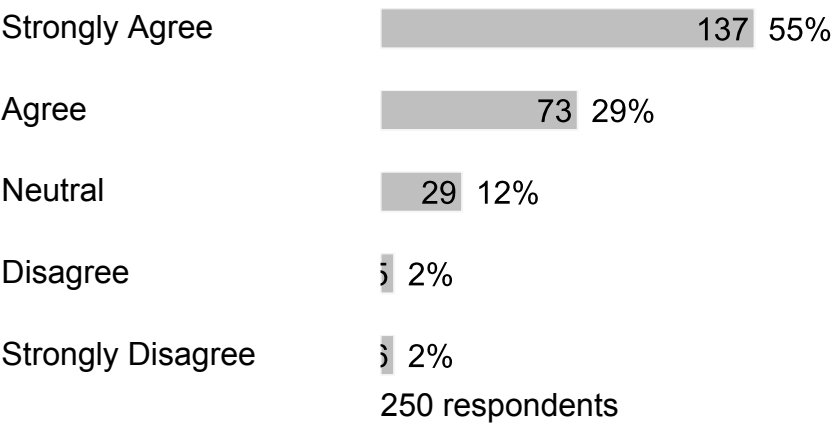

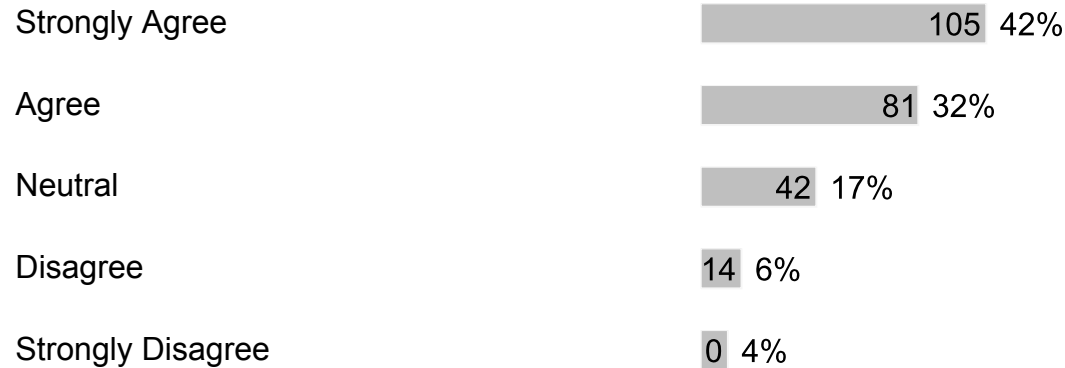

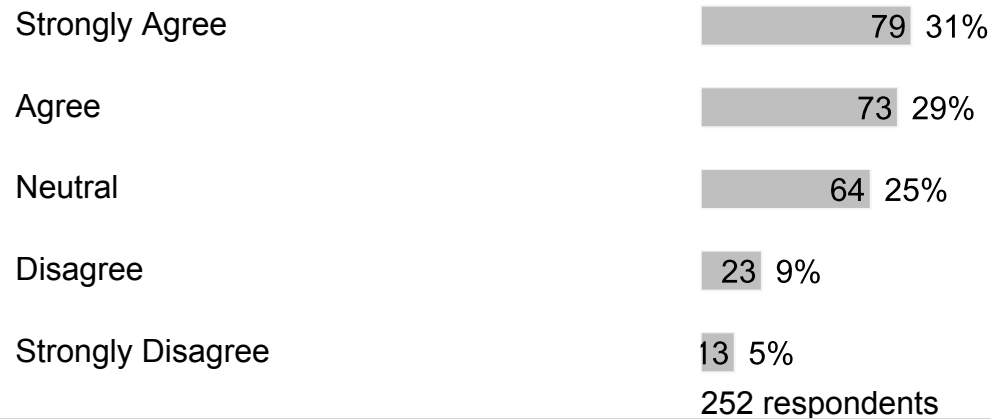

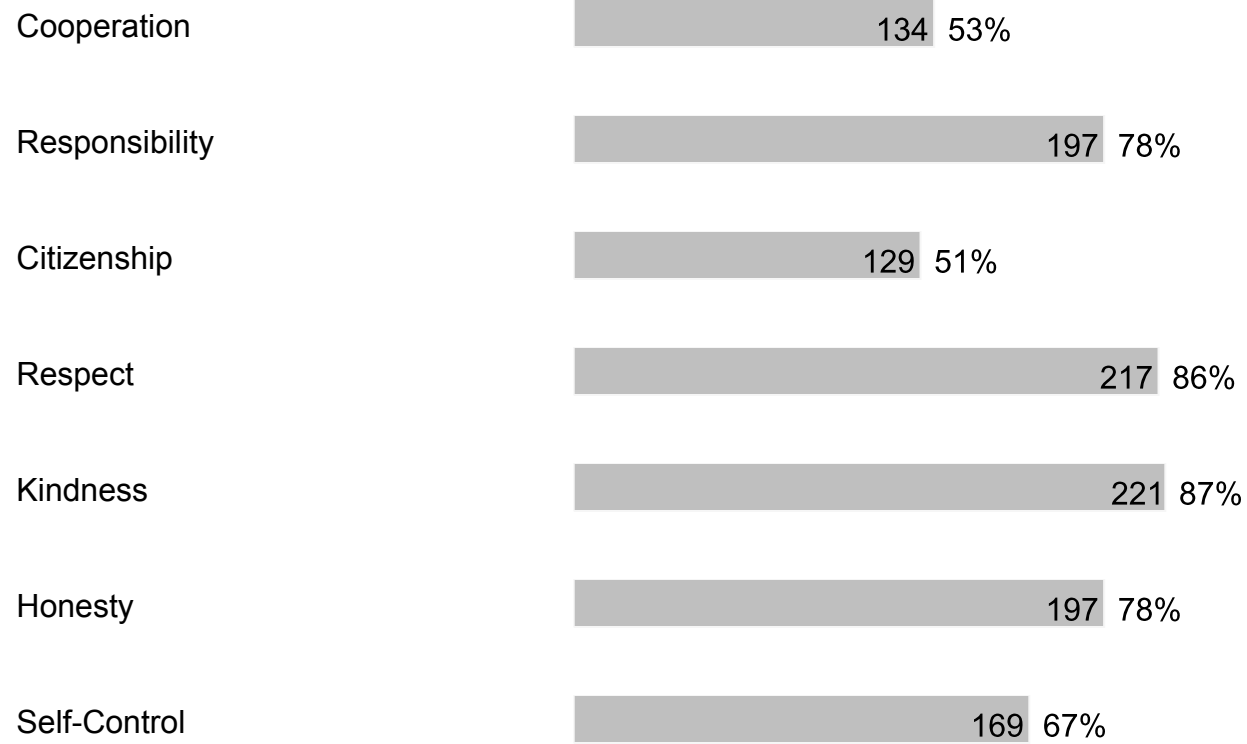

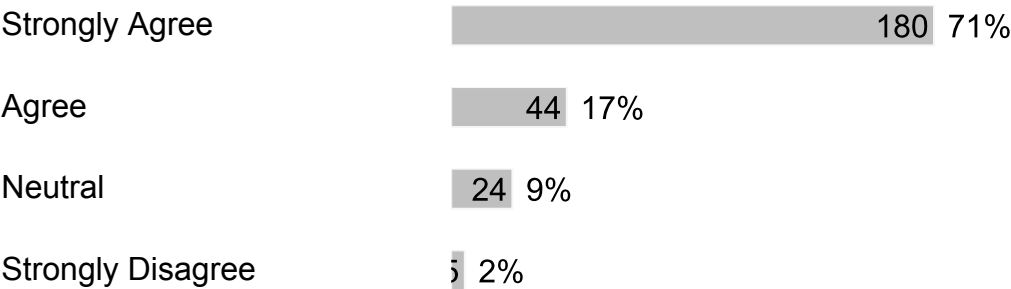

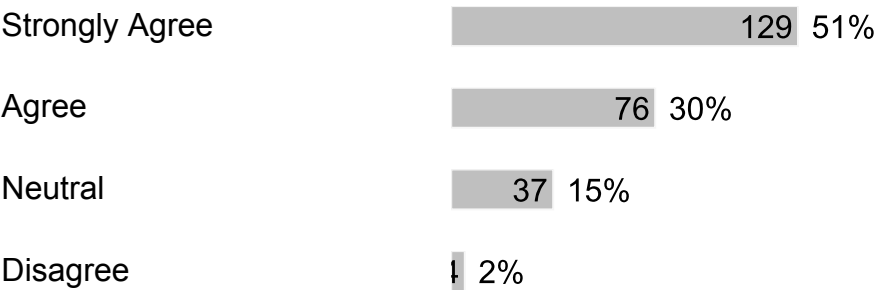

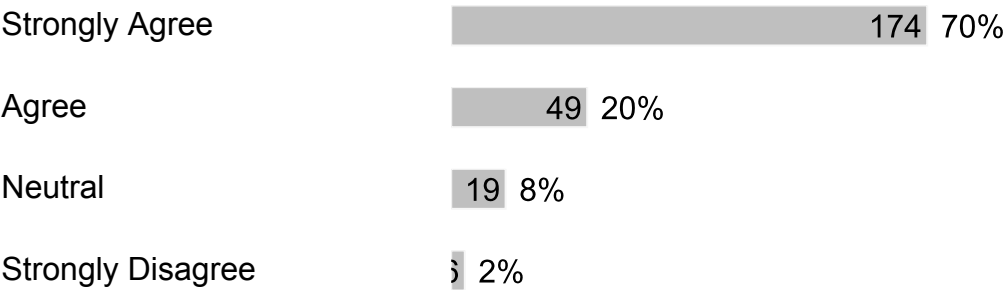
2. My teachers use different activities to help me learn new things.

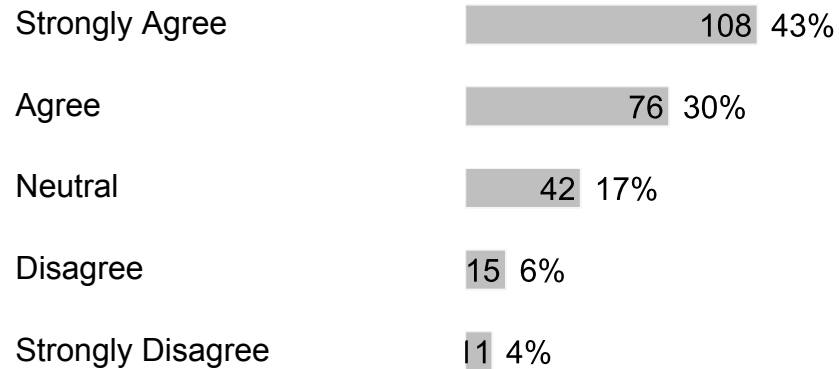

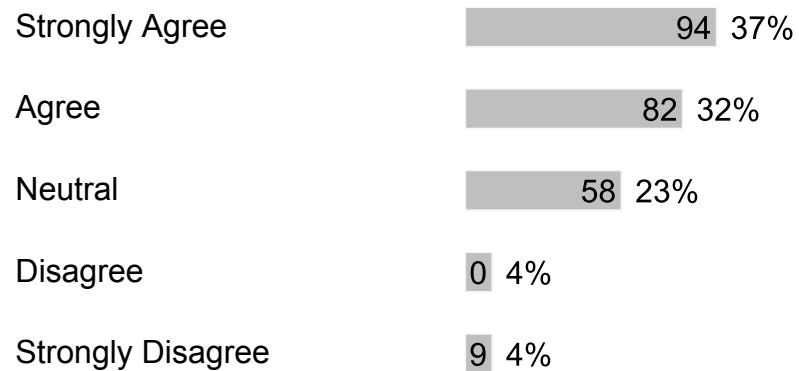

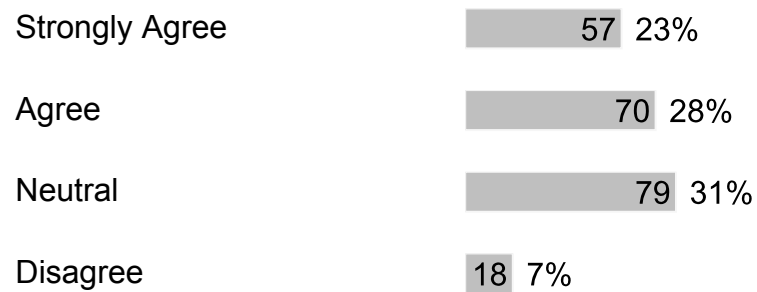

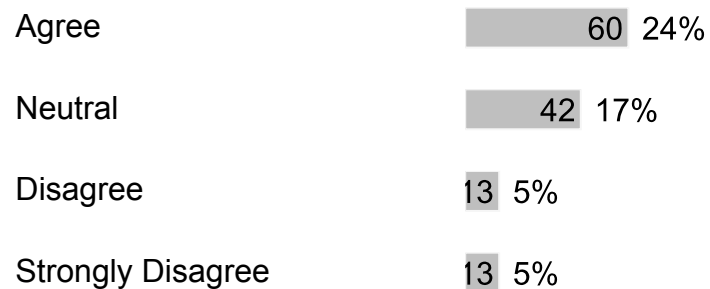

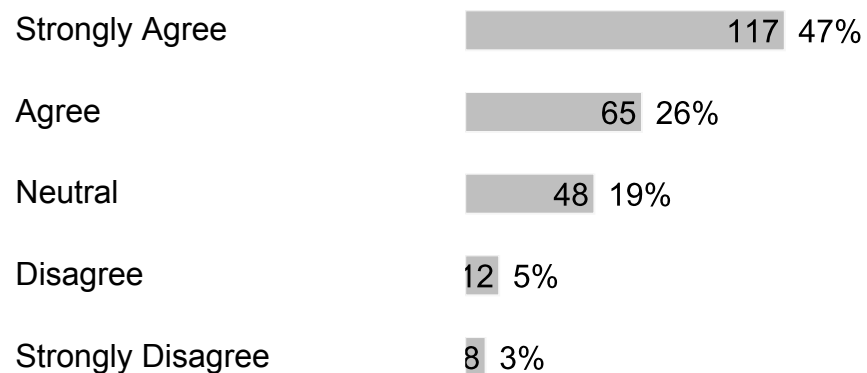
15. My teachers tell me how I should behave.

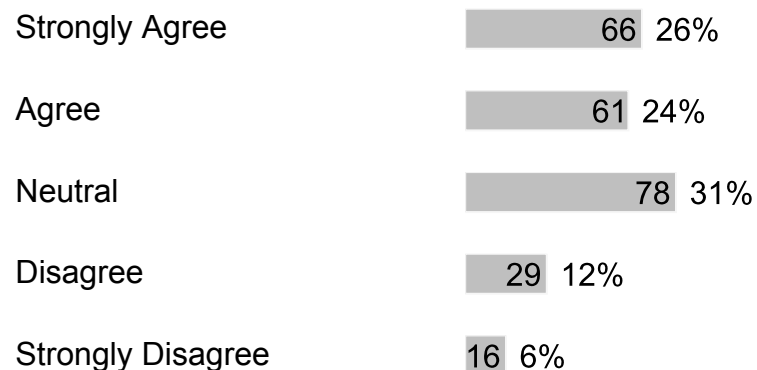

16. My teachers tell my family how I am doing in school.



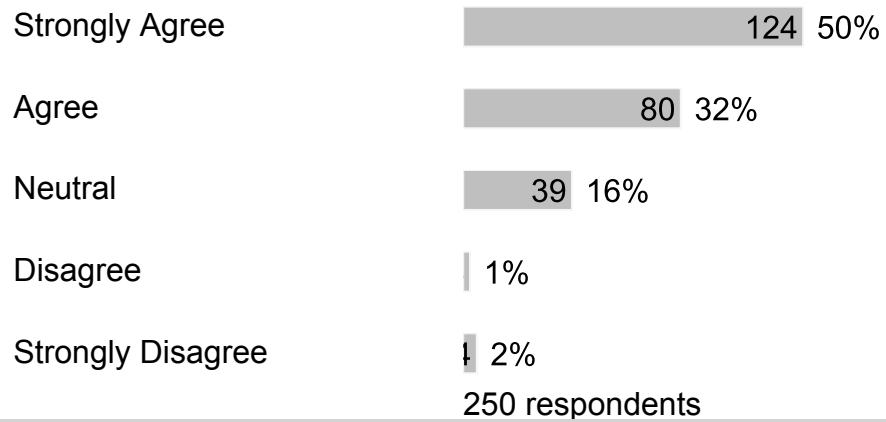

17. My teachers ask my family to come to school activities.

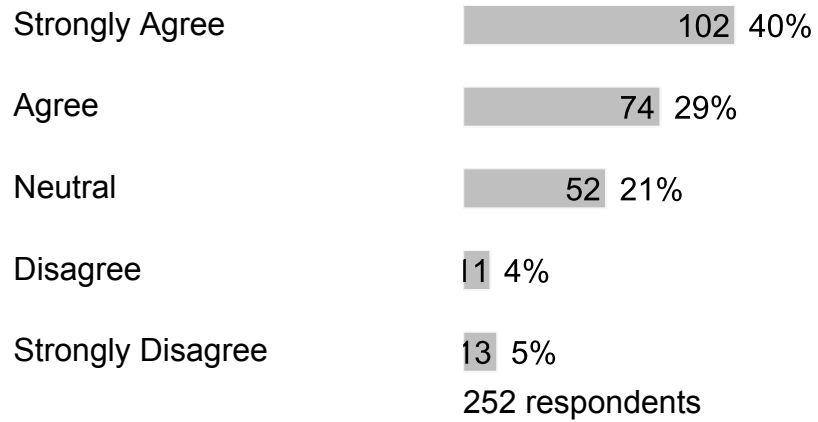
