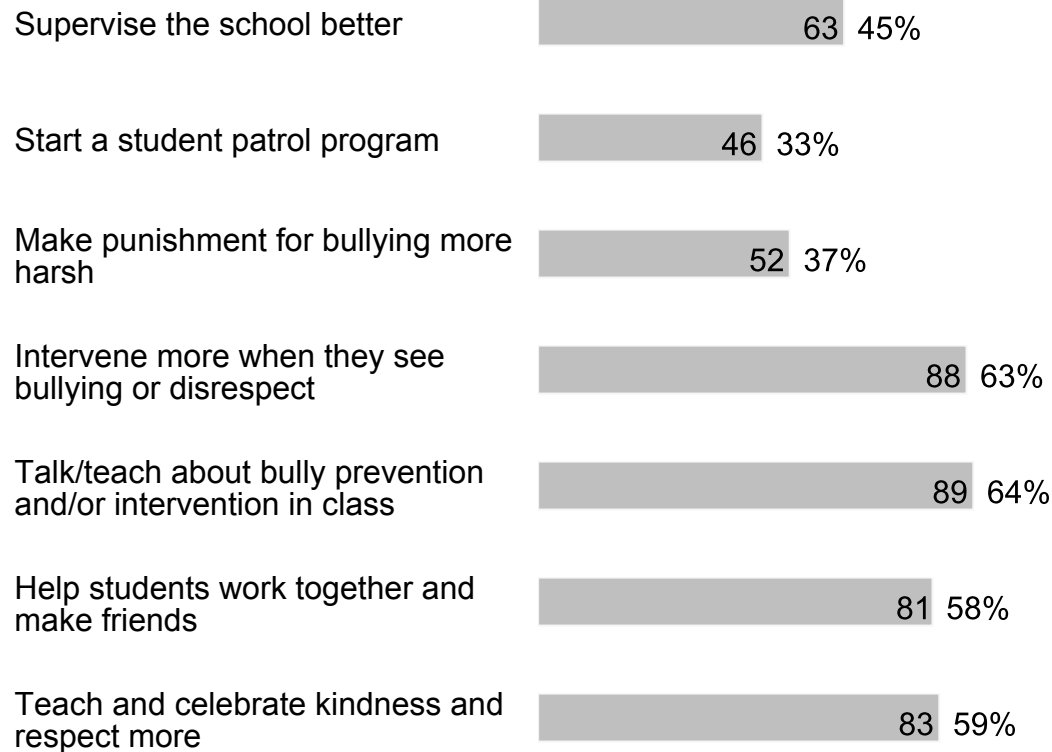

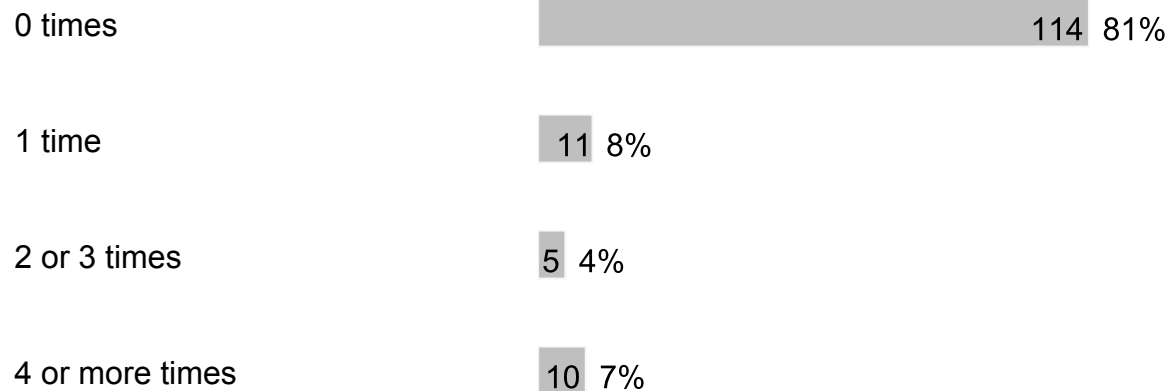


12. What can adults do to help stop bullying at school? (check all that apply)



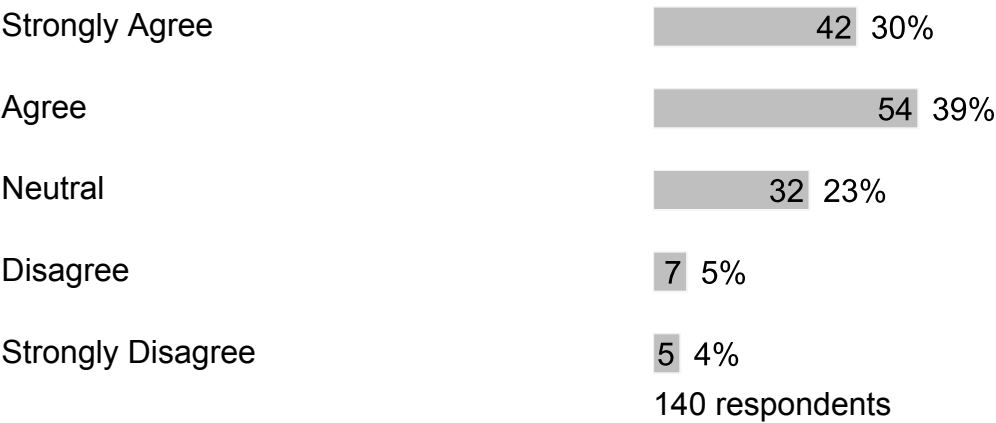

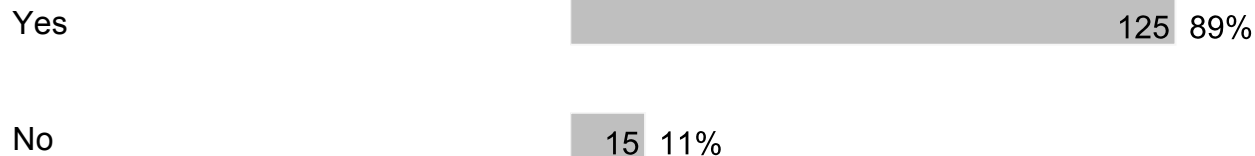

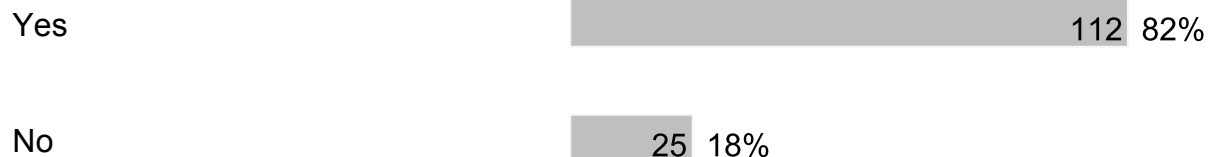

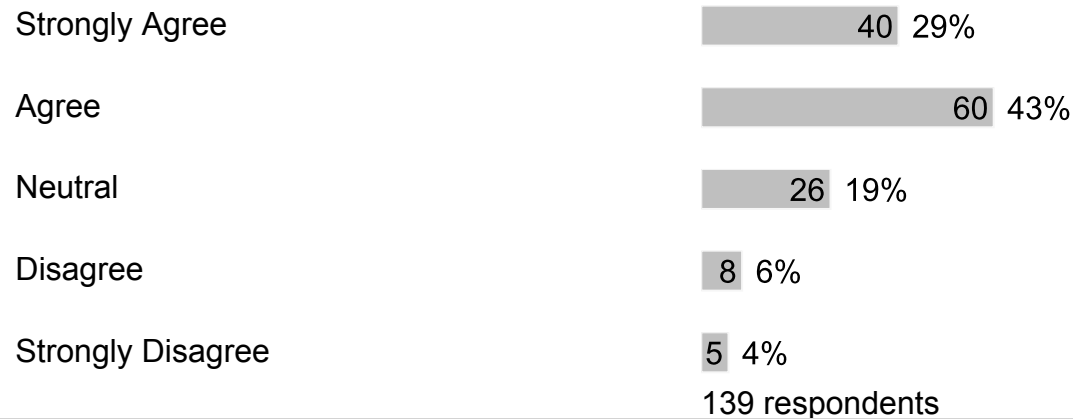

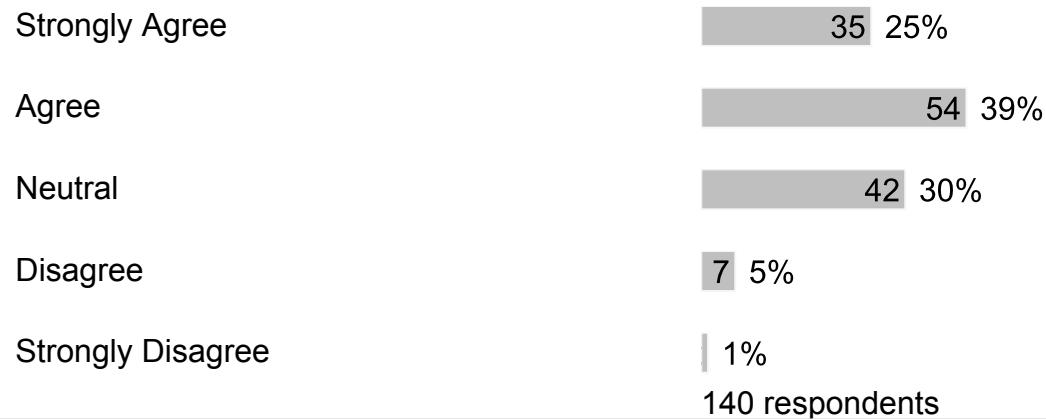

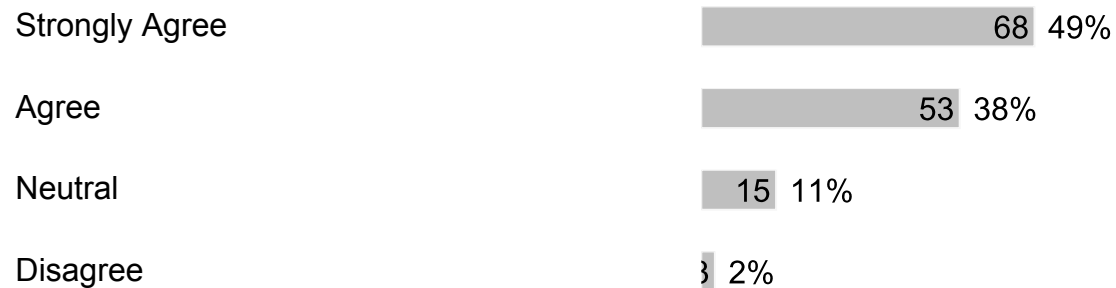

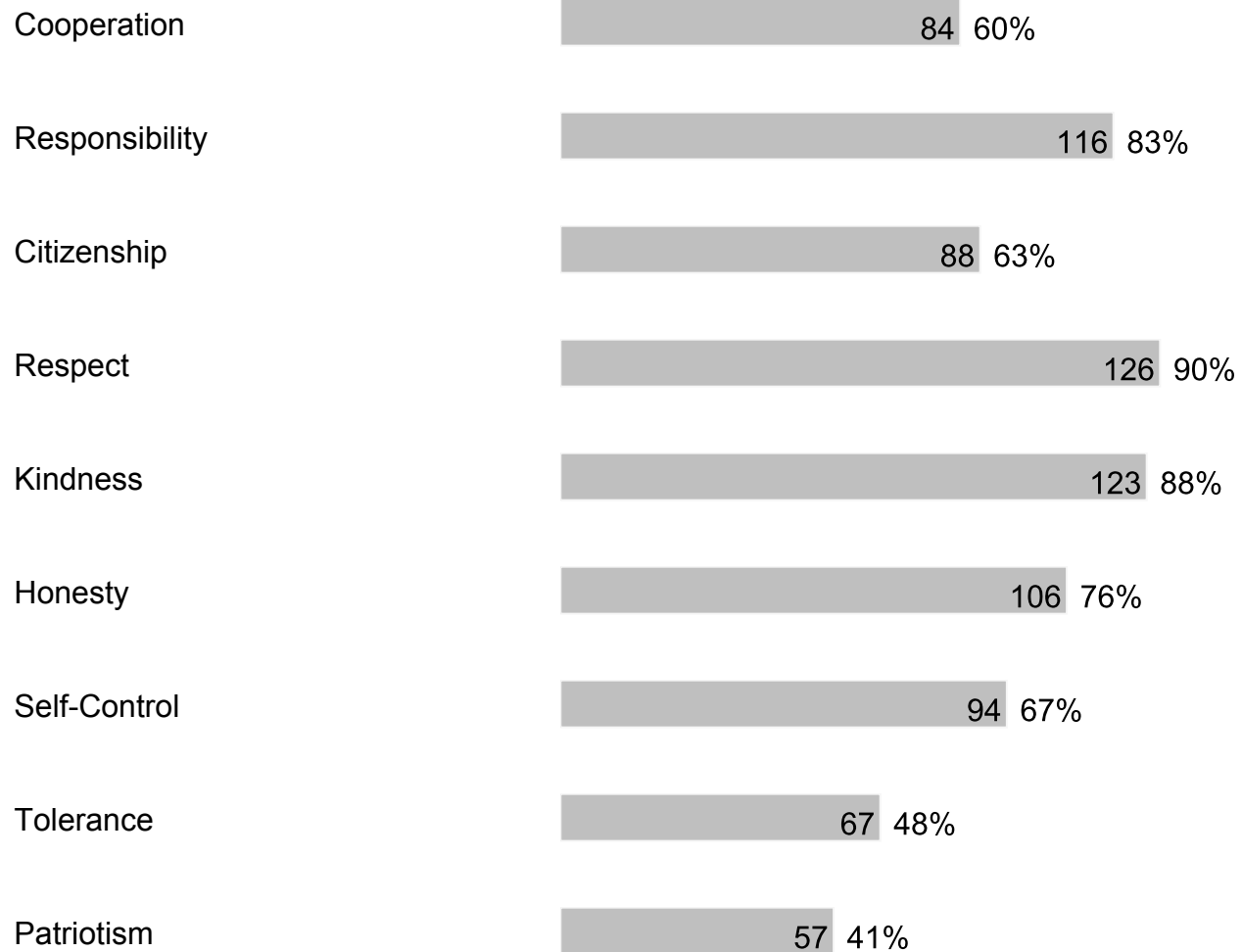

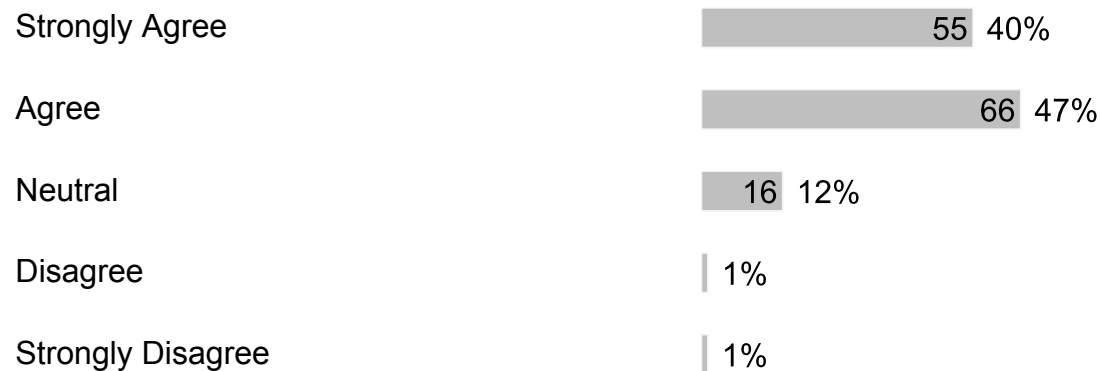

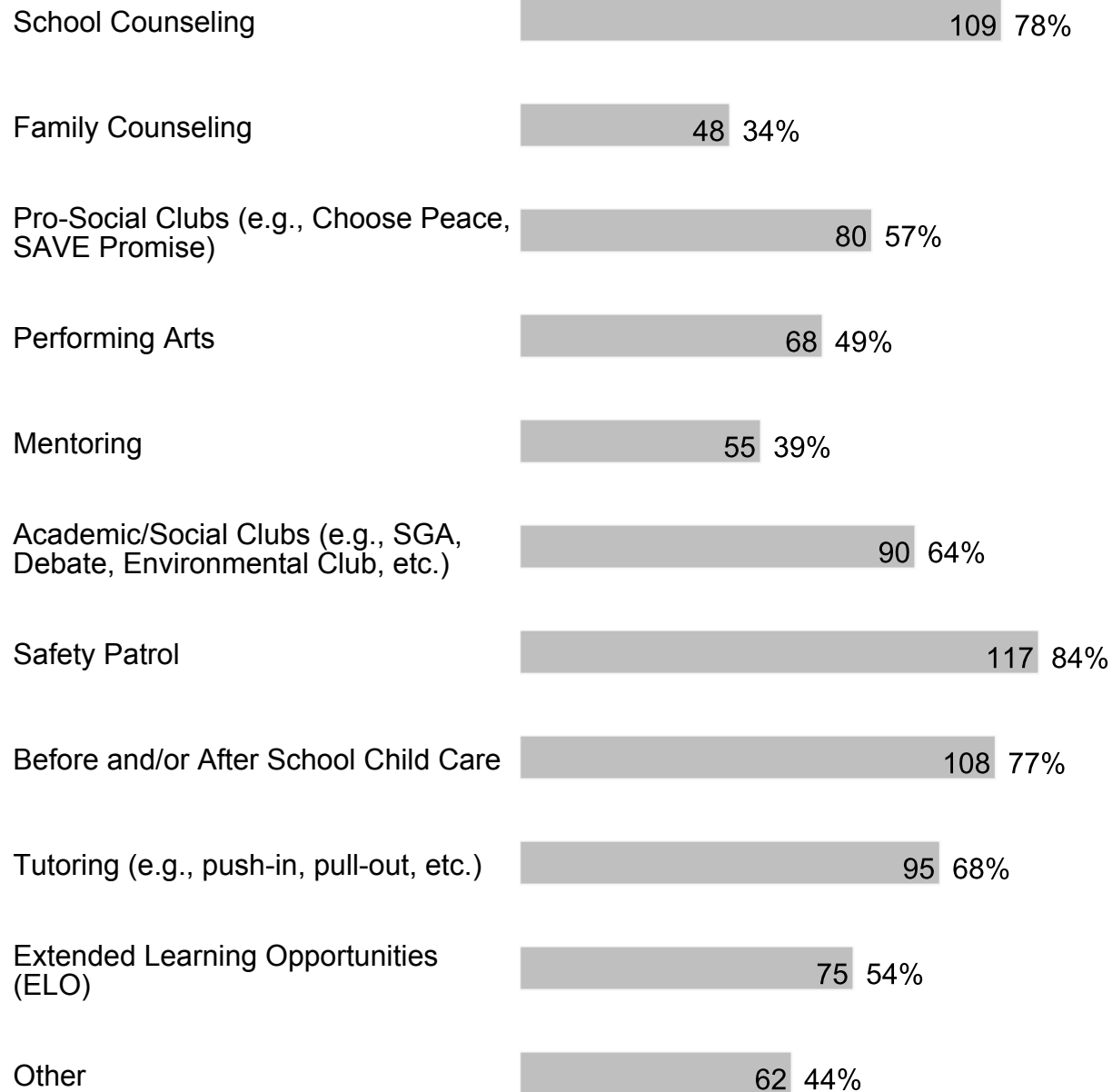

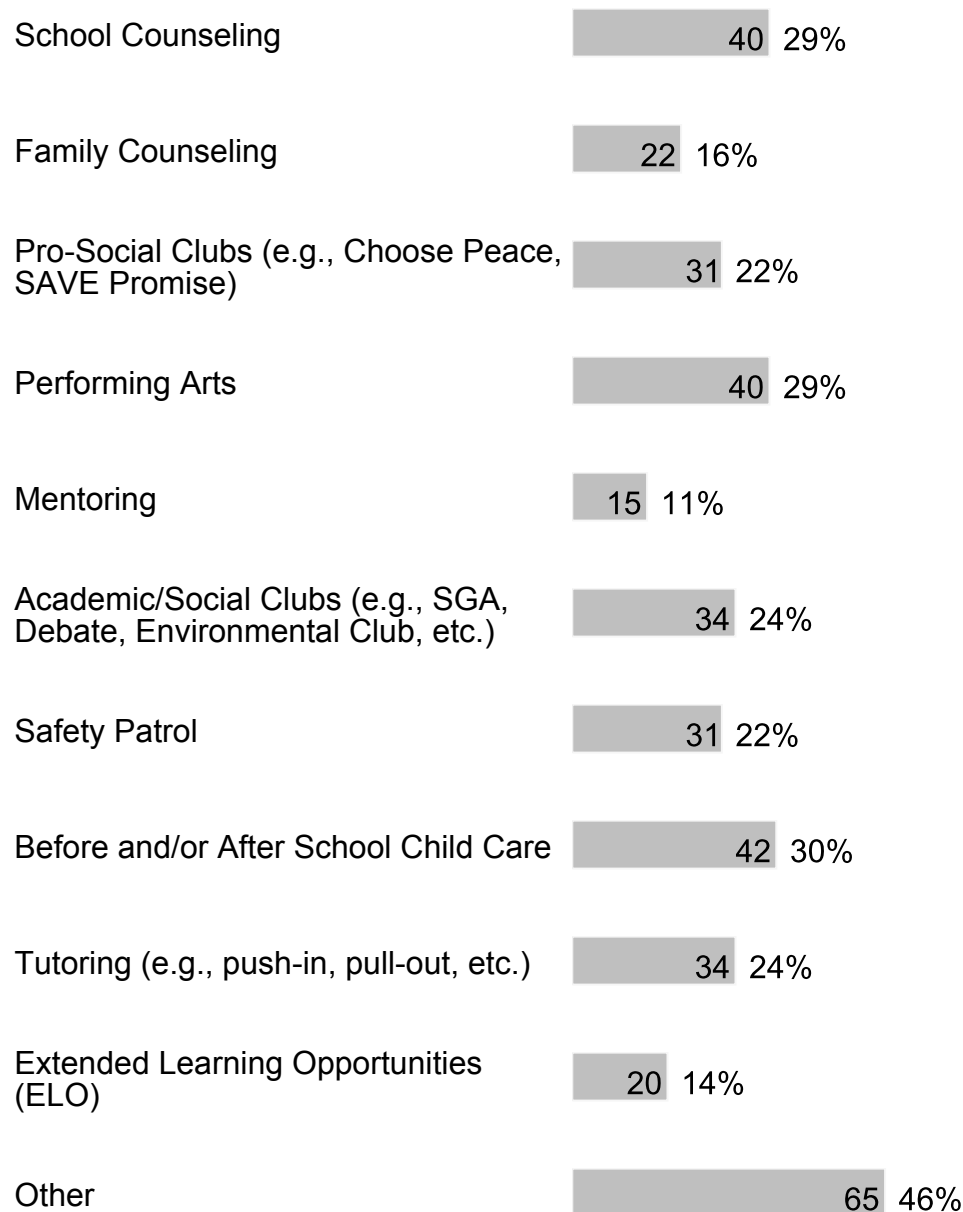

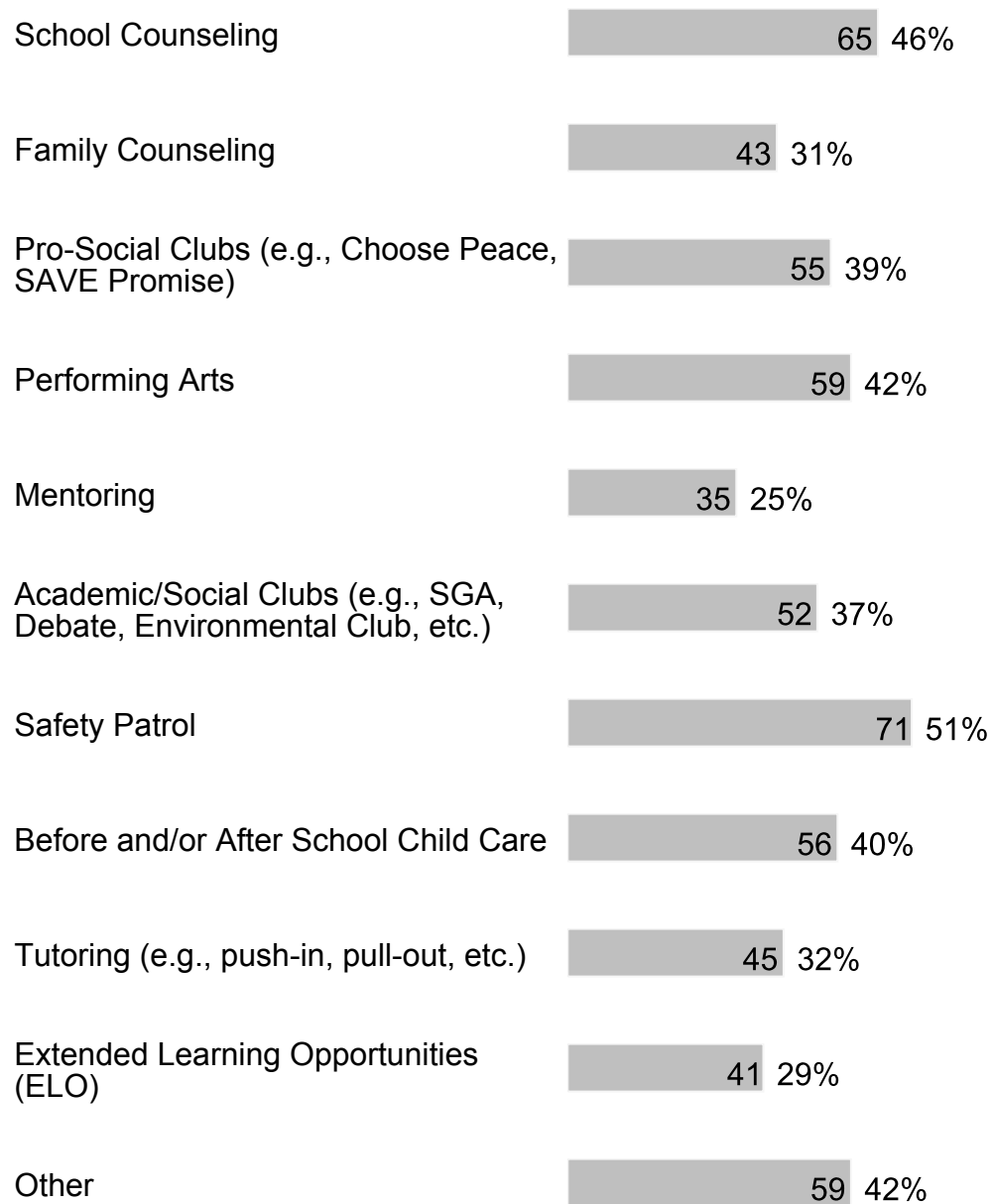

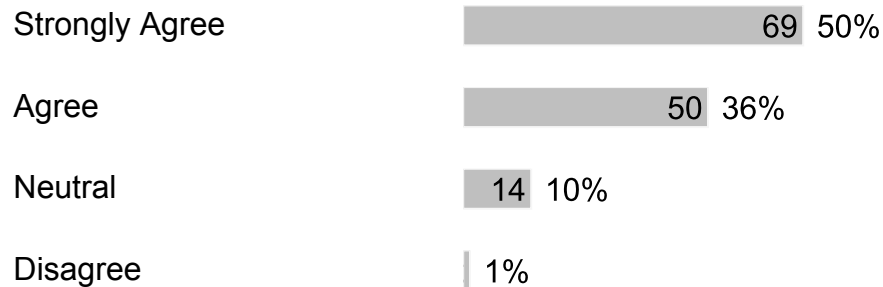
