5:35 pm	<p><u>Principal's Report</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ <u>Vacancies:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ facilities positions have been filled; however, the grounds person position has not been filled yet. ▪ Discussion was had as to ½ custodial and ½ grounds keeping. ❖ <u>Construction Update:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 2 portables are to be demolished. ▪ 2 New "modules" (updated versions of portables) are approved for our school. ▪ Concern is housing night school during transition. Using campus rooms possibly ❖ <u>Instructional Updates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ PM2 data is trending up. ▪ Focusing on lowest quartile, especially "triple threat" students (students in 3 of the "buckets" for testing) ▪ Looking to PM 3 and students retaining info ▪ Using VR headsets in some classes as well as other technology ▪ Increase in immersion and field trips (Everglades, Flying classroom etc.) ❖ <u>Operational:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Asking for parental support with campus initiatives (ID badges MUST be worn at all times and with student dress code adherence...even in colder temperatures) ❖ <u>Proposal for spending of accountability funds:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Total amount of funds is \$13,672.29. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Pole Banners:</u> positive behavior pole banners for the campus (\$5,000) • <u>Culinary:</u> items such as a counter-top griddle, a warmer, a drink machine would be purchased. Ideally, as we do not have kitchens approved for event center, this would take steps to increasing culinary experience for the students. (\$3,000) • <u>Crunch-time classroom supplies:</u> this would cover items that would be used in any tutoring for PM3 or for any additional needed instructional supplies like small whiteboards etc. (\$2,000) • <u>Campus Beautification projects:</u> This would be used for items like refreshing the fence displays, banners, etc. on campus (\$2,000) • <u>Rewards, incentives etc. for performance on PM3 tests:</u> these items include incentives, like ice pops 	Lisa Livingston
