5. Accountability Funds: \$5445.51- used for needs based on what SAC decides. Mrs. Ringler discusses SAC needs. Perhaps funds can be used for ELL Camp and Camp for lowest testing quartile. Title 1 funds are no longer available as we are not a Title 1 school. SAC funds come from the state. Tutoring is beneficial and funds would be helpful.
6. School Improvement Plan- Mrs. Ringler discusses HHE school data- broken down by grade and subject. Third grade scores count as "double" but need to consider that each year is a different group of kids. Points are awarded for learning gains-even if the student did not reach a level 2+. Lowest quartile in ELA went down in 2025. Math gains were strong. Lowest quartile also made gains. Science gains were apparent in 2025. Overall, a 62% TOTAL makes for an "A" school. Data chats with teachers are this week. Will discuss i-Ready and PM 1 data and goals. PM 2 is a more accurate depiction of end of year. Not all about proficiency- more so about gains. Abby Castillo asks if funds for tutoring will focus on lowest scoring students. Mrs. Ringler explains that invitations for tutoring camps are based on a range of scores. Students who transfer to our school after October do not "count" regarding school grades. Today (9/24/25) is the last day for free lunch for students. Encourage parents to apply.

- a. Literacy- Mrs. Pacheco- data chats start this week. Will be looking at scores and setting goals. Students will meet with their teachers and do student/teacher data chats to set their own personal goals. We will be doing a pep-rally for all grade levels this year before PM 3 for motivation. Meeting with teachers for RTI (Response to Intervention) in hopes of closing gaps. Did planning and training with reading representatives from the county.
- b. BTU-Mrs. Duran- State only gave us .5% raise, which is about \$300 a year. BTU is fighting for more. State also wants teachers to pay out of pocket for insurance.
- c. School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR)- Severe discipline issues that get reported to state- such as a major threat. Most reports are low level verbal disagreements between students. Fights that result in injury or involve weapons are reported to state. There are ZERO for HHE currently. All information is available online.
