#### School Improvement Plan/Title 1/Stakeholder Feedback

- **Science & Math Presentation**
- Assistant Principal Cummings provided an overview of both science and math content areas.
  - We received two varsity tutors' camps, one for our ESE population. It is the 6th year that our ESE students have not gained enough on the math proficiency test. Varsity Tutors will be virtually meeting with kids 2 times a week for 30 minutes. One for math and one for science. We have provided what students need based on their last PM results.
  - The biggest struggle the 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students had was in "Number of Based Operations" (adding, subtracting, place value, etc.). Students will get remediation from teachers as well as Varsity Tutors.
  - The school also just purchased IXL (Math, ELA & Science) for 3rd-6<sup>th</sup> graders. We took every single student's result from PM2 and provided that to IXL to provide the skills the students need to work based on their level. This is going to be done during the WIN (What I Need) block. IXL provides explanations and tutorial videos. This can be done both at school and at home.

- ELL Camps will start next week on Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday mornings in the Media Center from 7:40 AM – 8:20 AM.
- After spring break, we will be holding math and science camps. Students are going to have the ability to conduct real-life experiments as if they were scientists.

#### **Title 1 Overview & Addendum Review**

- SAC Chair presented the Parents and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP) poster that was approved in multiple languages.
  - Requirement is that this poster needs to be placed in a business or church, which promotes the school to increase student enrollment.
  - In this poster, we included events and activities that the school will be conducting in the 2026-27 school year.
- Principal Centrone also discussed marketing tools that are being created, i.e., realtor signs to be placed within the neighborhood promoting the school.
- School tours are being held weekly for incoming new students.

#### **SESIR**

- One fight (mutual contact) for the month of January was that two kids fought each other.
