


I. Welcome/Introduction

Ms. Merilus welcomed everyone to the meeting. She asked for a motion to start the meeting at 5:33 pm. A parent, Jacque Hilliard mentioned for the meeting to begin. Ms. Garcia seconded the motion.

II. Attendance Quorum

Eight out of Fifteen (53%) SAC members were in attendance.

III. Principal's Report

Ms. Bonny was not in attendance, so Ms. Merilus moved on to the next agenda item.

IV. Approval of Meeting Minutes

V. New Business - Election of Officers and SAC By Laws

Ms. Merilus discussed the purpose of SAC, and how it allows members to have a voice.

Ms. Merilus explained that there are different ways that SAC monitors the SIP and informed the stakeholders of where they could access it. She explained that there are SMART goals and based on the goals they can discuss what adjustments need to be made. Ms. Merilus asked for input for the SIP plan and no input was given at this time. She reminded that every month they will have an opportunity to provide input for the SIP.

Ms. Merilus explained that there are 11 by laws and she provided the members with copies of it.

She then explained that there are different members that are part of the SAC composition and that certain members are needed to represent the different groups that are in the school.

Ms. Taylor went through the Title I Addendum with the members present. She discussed the needs assessment for the school to decide the areas of need, the strategies that we utilize to ensure we have highly effective teachers and described how some of the Title I funds have been utilized such as the Parent Nights,

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Agenda books and ELO Camp. She informed the members present that if there were any other issues that they would like to address, they could provide their input at this time. No other input was provided. Ms. Taylor reminded everyone that if they had any input they could reach out to herself or Ms. Merilus.

VI. Department's Report

a) Schoolwide Positive Behavior Plan

VII. SESIR Data
