- All students will demonstrate at least one year's worth of learning gains as we strive toward all students becoming proficient.
- We will continue to prepare professionally to meet the needs of our students through weekly ELA lesson studies and math professional learning communities.
- Student Enrollment and Staffing: K-5 = 412 students; Pre-K = 37 students
- We have exceeded our K-12 student projection enrollment for 2025-2026.
- Our Annual Celebrations and Traditions Around the World was a success. Students researched and shared critical information on six of the seven continents, pointing out the common traditions and celebrations that unite us as well as the unique customs and celebrations that make us all uniquely interesting.
- Students will complete the second of three progress monitoring cycles as follows:
- Teachers will analyze the student data and generate differentiated lessons to address students' individual needs.
- Students will participate in two additional progress monitoring cycles this year.
