- Mrs. Sanchez shared that the school has partnered with Apex Leadership Co to give leadership training and engage students in interactive activities to learn about leadership and teamwork. This partnership will conclude with a culminating event, Fun Run, on Thursday, October 9th.
- We completed the first administration of Star, Star Early Literacy, and the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) by September 10th.
- Students are now dismissed utilizing CurbSmart, which provides all students with a unique number and parents with car hangtags with the corresponding numbers.
- Parents have the right to provide input into the performance evaluations of instructional and/or administrative employees.

Ms. Louis/Ms. Clair opened the floor for questions and/or concerns. At this time there are no questions or concerns to be addressed.


