SAC Minutes – February 24, 2025

**Attendance:** Please see the attached roster

**Call to Order:** A meeting of the South Broward High School Advisory Council was held in the Innovative Learning Commons Center (Building 5) on February 24, 2025. Chair Ryan Perez Rodrigues called the meeting to order at 3:00 PM. The minutes for this meeting were recorded.

**Introduction:** Chair Perez Rodrigues welcomed attendees, and introductions were made. A quorum was established.

**Approval of Minutes:** A motion was made to review and approve the minutes from the January 2025 SAC/SAF meeting. Ms. Amy Mujica motioned to approve the minutes, and Mr. Bruce Coach seconded it. The motion passed unanimously.

### **New Business:**

- *Annual Black Male Symposium:* Chair Perez Rodrigues introduced Mr. Baker, Assistant Principal, who announced that the Black Male Symposium will take place on February 28, 2025. This event will bring community leaders and role models to meet with students, encouraging them to strive for excellence.
- *South Broward DECA Update:* Chair Perez Rodrigues noted that 19 students from the South Broward DECA chapter qualified for the Career Development Conference in Orlando, Florida, a significant increase from last year's eight qualifiers. He will report at a future meeting on any students who advance to Nationals (ICDC).
- *Innovative Learning Commons Presentation:* The SAC/SAF was informed that Ms. Ridlehoover's presentation will be postponed due to additional state-mandated reporting requirements. Chair Perez Rodrigues clarified that the Broward County School Board recently renamed all Media Centers to "Innovative Learning Commons" to reflect the shift away from traditional libraries, as outlined in SBBC Policy 4140.
- *Professional Learning Communities (PLC) Funds:* Discussion transitioned to PLC funds allocated in previous SAC meetings. Chair Perez Rodrigues explained that a misfiled document from previous SAC leadership delayed the disbursement of \$2,500 (voted during the 2023-2024 school year) and an additional \$1,200 (approved in January 2025). He has since refiled the paperwork, and payments should process within two to three pay periods.

### **School Updates:**

- *Middle School Visits:* Mrs. Williams, Assistant Principal, informed the SAC/SAF that 8th graders from Olsen and Attucks Middle Schools will visit South Broward from February 24-28, 2025, providing students and parents with information about South Broward's magnet programs to boost enrollment.

**Principal's Report:** Mr. Francois provided updates on the spring sports season and congratulated the SBHS Wrestling Program on winning the District Championship. He expressed gratitude to the PTSO and their team for organizing the Beautification Project on February 6, 2025. He also highlighted the success of the Day of Service and Love, hosted by Ms. Bergeron and the Student Government Association, which saw strong participation from students, staff, and faculty. The Chris Hixon Run was another major success, with South Broward winning the \$1,000 registration prize for the seventh consecutive year. Mr. Francois then addressed school safety, emphasizing that during lockdowns, he is required to provide updates to parents, students, and staff at designated intervals. He discussed a recent lockdown prompted by an off-campus incident in the community, which was extended after a weapon was discovered in the student parking lot. However, he clarified that the weapon was unrelated to the lockdown and reassured the school community that South Broward remains committed to maintaining a safe and secure campus.

**School Environment Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) Data:** Chair Perez Rodrigues reviewed the SESIR Report, stating that 17 incidents were recorded in January 2025. He noted that SESIR incidents continue to decline at South Broward.

**School Accountability Fund:** The current SAC budget balance is \$5,760.20 for the 2024-2025 school year.

### **School Improvement Plan (SIP) – Continuation Waiver Ballot & SIP Progress**

Chair Perez Rodrigues reported that South Broward High School was projected to receive a “C” grade based on 2023-2024 baseline data. In response, administration and curriculum leaders developed a strategic plan to restore the school’s “B” grade, aligning with the 2021-2022 performance level. The school is currently just 1% away from this goal, leading to the adoption of the “1% better every day” mindset. The SIP plan, which is accessible on the school website, focuses on increasing proficiency in all tested areas by 3-5% and remains on track as of March 2025. Ballot language was discussed and adopted without vote to be presented to the school faculty for an official vote for ratification and approval by the School Board of Broward County, FL.

Chair Perez Rodrigues emphasized that exam exemptions are a powerful incentive for academic achievement and attendance. Studies, including those by Jesse Savage (2021) and Jennifer Jennings (2009), support the positive impact of exemptions in motivating students. South Broward aims to increase competency in Social Studies, Mathematics, and English/Language Arts through both the Exam Exemption and Professional Study Day waivers, fostering long-term academic success.

The SAC reviewed the ballot language for the upcoming staff election. SAC agreed to utilize the language used in the sample created and distributed by the District’s School Transformation Office. A motion for its adoption and to proceed with the faculty election was brought forth by Ms. Amy Mujica and seconded by Mr. Bruce Couch. The motion passed unanimously.
