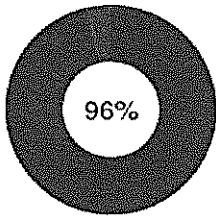

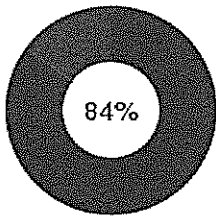

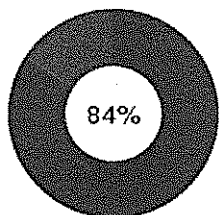

Hello PBHS Families,


