- a. School Advisory Chair
 - i. Welcome and Introductions of all voting members.
 - ii. Review of last month's meeting minutes. Stanley Arnoux moved to approve the minutes. Mr. Banaska seconded the motion.

 - iii. Account Balance
 1. \$54.00 has rolled over.
 2. Teacher ClassWallet money that went unused is \$2,562.94 and has been rolled over to SAC and now the total balance totals \$ 2,616.94
 - iv. School Improvement Plan (SIP) goals:
 1. The percentage of Algebra I and Geometry students scoring proficient or higher will increase from 80% to 83% as measured by the BEST EOC Algebra 1 and Geometry tests by the end of May 2026.
 2. By May 2026, the percentage of students in grade 9 and 10 scoring proficient or higher in ELA will increase from 93% to 94% as measured by the FAST PM3.
