Mrs. Gayle reported that teachers will be reviewing statewide assessment data to inform instructional planning. Quarterly assessments will be utilized to help structure classroom instruction and support student achievement.
Mrs. Gayle also shared that Extended Learning Opportunities (ELO) program will begin February 8, 2026, for participating students.

i. SAF Chair, Mrs. Azim, was present and attended the recent SAF meeting. Mrs. Azim also shared that district staff members who hold teaching credentials are being utilized this month to assist in filling vacant instructional positions throughout the district. Additionally, it was emphasized that field trips should not be canceled. Information was provided regarding Hazel Health, which allows students to access telehealth services online. Parents must provide authorization for students to participate, along with a medical authorization form from the student's physician. A clinic authorization form must be on file for services to be provided.

Legislative updates were discussed, including:

SB 318, which addresses increased oversight of scholarship programs.

SB 320, which requires teachers to take a loyalty oath to the Department of Education. This oath is renewable every ten years.

Updates regarding restrictions on books for minors.

Installation of cameras in special education classrooms.

Expanded parental access to student information

V. Mr. Ward presented mid-year data for science and showed a Q1 70% proficiency Q2 42% in science.

Ms. Smith presented mid-year math data showing the individual gains with students and students who needed remediation.

Ms. Smith presented social studies mid-year data showed gains 56% proficiency. Students are taking advantage of ELO opportunities.

Mrs. Gayle proposed funding request for \$1,000 for progress learning. The science department Us Test Prep program. Motion Ms. Azim made the motion 2nd by Ms. Smith 2nd the motion.

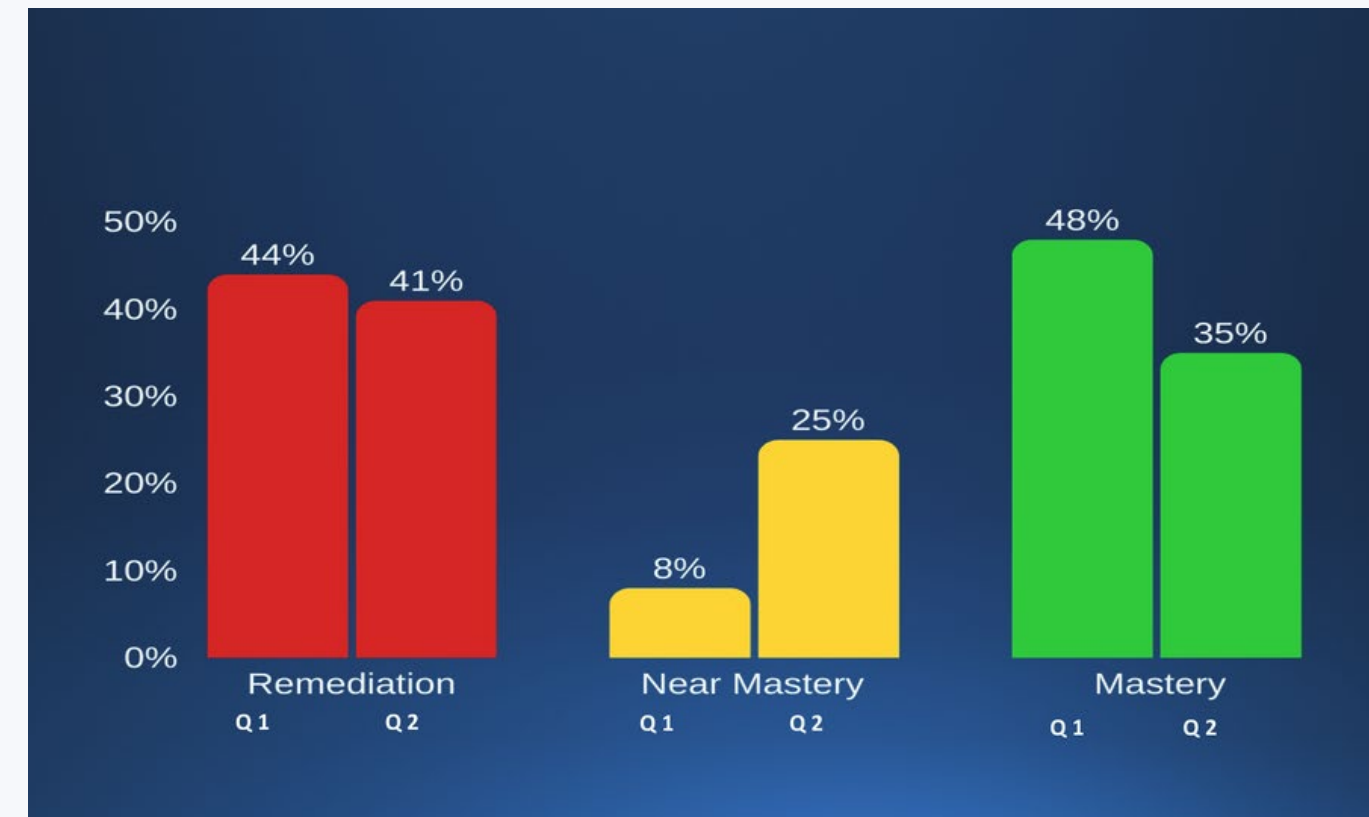

BIOLOGY – 2024-2025

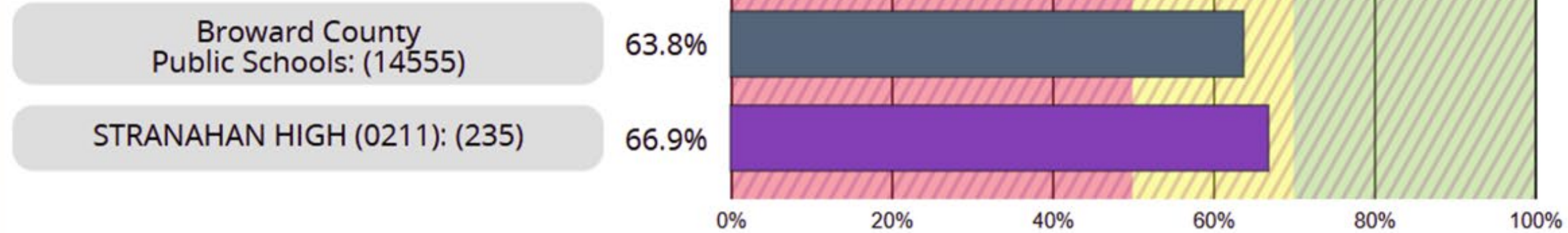

2025-2026 Q1/Q2 BSA Comparison

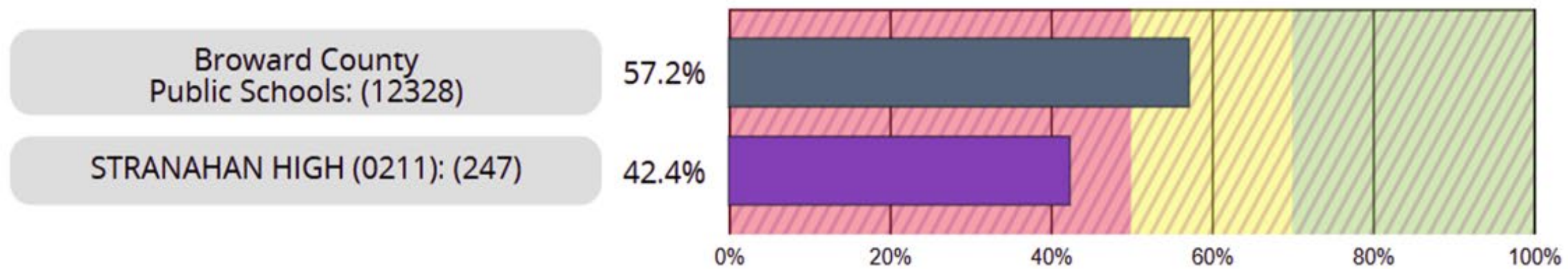

- America 250 Initiative:

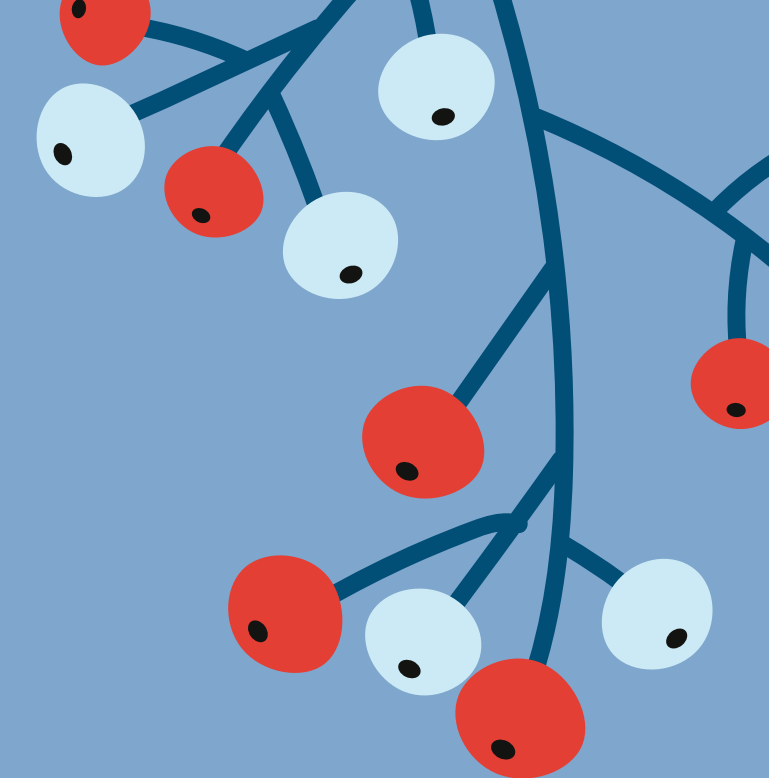
