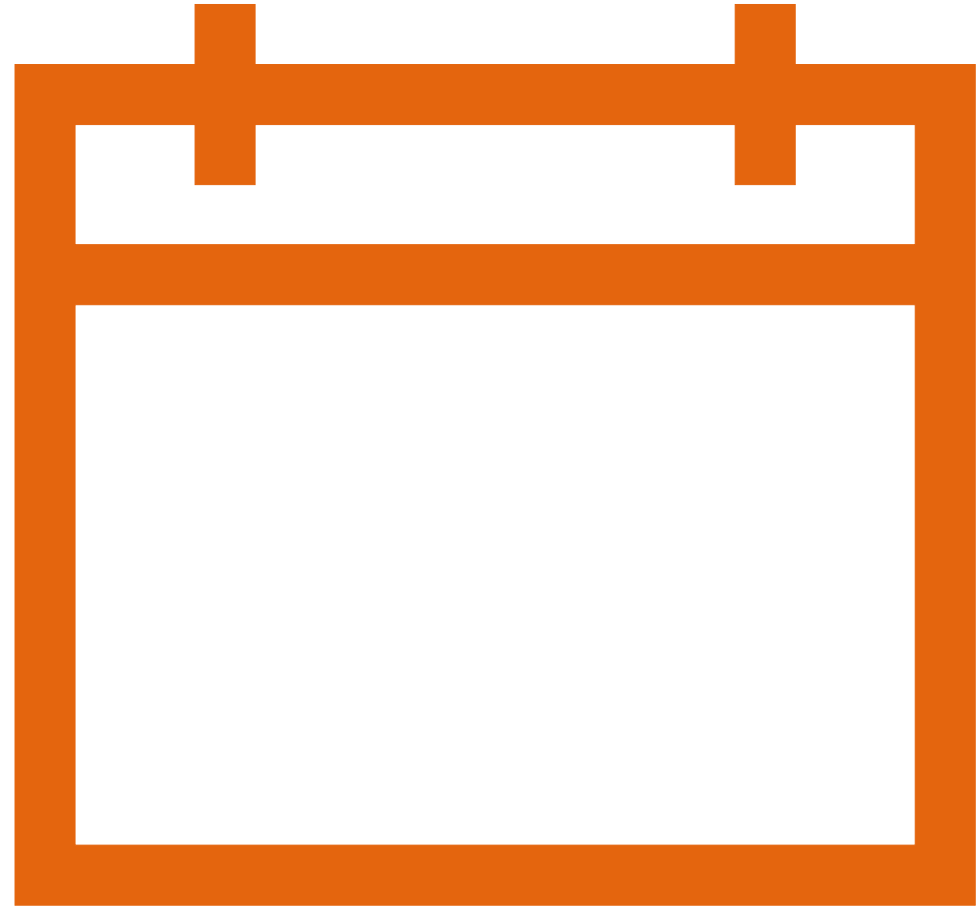

### SAC Minutes

I. Welcome & Call to Order – Kenneth Hart Chair: at 5:40 pm the order was called by Mr. Hart.

December minutes have been approved unanimously by the SAC.

III. Old Business

a. **Accountability Funds Balance - \$36,446.08**

Mrs. Gayle explained that the original fund was \$40000 but there was a deficit that was paid.

II. New Business

a. **School Improvement - Accountability Funds Review**

Mr. Hart gave details about the funds and how the SAC intended to use them for the students.

**i. Purpose of Extended Learning Opportunities**

To improve student academic achievement in Math, ELA and Science

**ii. Mid-Year Student Performance Data Review**

Per Mrs. Gayle, based on the mid-year data we are 7-points short for ranking A.

**iii. Presentation of Tutoring Program Proposal**

Mr. Hart said that math showed a 14% proficiency increase in math

Ms. Smith said that ELA showed a 10% proficiency increase in ELA

Ms. Wallace and AP Goodwin presented the data for science, and they plan to use study Halls for the ELO program.

Ms. Smith is to increase students' enrollment in the ELO program and she points out CTE program ranked third in the district in certification and 1<sup>st</sup> in learning gains in the Industrial certification program.

**iv. Voting - Tutoring Program Proposal**

Mr. Hart gave insight into the ELO program

Content areas: Math, ELA, history, science, CTACE, 13 teachers/\$ 40. Ms. Anderson

Propose a motion to approve the ELO fund as it is. The motion was seconded by Ms.

Azim. The motion was approved unanimously.

Mr. Hart and Ms. Smith talked about the incentives for students testing days and ELO Tutoring.

A motion to approve the student incentives as it is with room to adjustment may be made by Ms. Azim. Ms. Gayle stated that students believe snacks will help them.









The motion to spend \$11333,21 for student incentives has been approved unanimously.


