- **Florida School Funds Proposal Recognition**

Mr. Howard presented the following information to the SAC members and answered all questions:

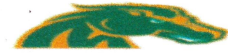
SAC discussed the ballot in detail. SAC made recommendations to add the word equally and discussed calendar days employees and employees who will receive the one time bonus. Ultimately SAC decided: A+ Funds will be paid to 2024-2025 regular staff who were actively employed by McArthur High School for at least 99 days of their 2024-2025 school year contract calendar. A+ funds payment will include itinerant staff (i.e. staff to include teachers, administration, family counselor, school social worker, custodian worker, cafeteria worker, security, BT, Instructional assistants (paras)) will be distributed in an equal manner among all staff who worked at McArthur High School during the 2024-2025 school year.

Staff members who were on leave during this time period are not eligible for a bonus or district support who comes in to support content areas.

***FAST ELA PM1 and PM2 Comparison Analysis**

***Mustang Literacy "A" Game Program Analysis**

***FAST Grade 9 ELA PM1 vs PM2 Performance Analysis**

Student Performance Trends

Analysis shows 20.8% of students improved, 18.2% declined, and 60.9% remained stable between PM1 and PM2.

Proficiency Level Growth

Proficiency increased from 31.1% to 34.0%, with an 11-student net gain in Levels 3 to 5 proficiency.

Need for Targeted Intervention

About 66% of students remain below proficiency, emphasizing the need for focused interventions and differentiated instruction.

***FAST Grade 10 ELA PM1 vs PM2 Performance Analysis**

Student Performance Trends

27.1% of students improved, 18.7% regressed, and 54.2% remained stable between PM1 and PM2 assessments.

Proficiency Improvement

Proficiency increased from 28.9% to 35.9%, showing a 7 percentage-point gain due to effective instructional strategies.

Net Gain in Proficient Students

50 students moved into proficiency while 22 fell below, resulting in a net gain of 28 proficient students.

Need for Targeted Interventions

Continuous monitoring and differentiated instruction are essential to sustain progress and support regressing students.

Subgroup Categories

***9th Grade: SWD**

Significant Improvement

Several students advanced two levels, indicating effective targeted interventions and strong progress.

***10 Grade SWD**

Stable Higher-Level Proficiency

19.3% of students were at Level 3 or above at both PM1 and PM2, showing no overall growth in advanced proficiency.

***9th Grade ESOL**

Limited Progress Observed

Only a small percentage of students showed progress, indicating challenges in language development acceleration.

***10th Grade ESOL**

Three students moved from below proficiency to Level 3 or higher, showing measurable success.

***Mustang Literacy "A" Game Program Report**

Student Improvement Rates

60.5% of students improved from PM1 to PM2, showing positive learning development over time.

Level Distribution Shift

Student distribution shifted upwards with more in Levels 3 and 4 by PM2, indicating academic growth.

Need for Targeted Support

37.2% of students regressed, highlighting the need for differentiated interventions and support strategies.

Importance of Continuous Monitoring

Continuous assessment is crucial to sustain progress and promptly address learning gaps among students.




