1. Dr. Noel presented SIP mid-year reflection and evaluation data for the Math, ELA, Social Studies, and Science departments. She also presented new actions that are needed to accomplish the intended outcome for each department focused areas. The data in each department supports the need to continue the waiver and will be affected by the decision made to continue the waiver.

2. Dr. Noel then presented a sample of the developed Professional Study Day (PSD) continuation waiver ballot for the faculty waiver vote. SAC members viewed the ballot, and they had no issues with its language. Dr.Noel also discussed the timeline and the remaining steps for the continuation waiver.

After Dr. Noel's presentation, she provided time in meeting for SAC members to ask questions and provide feedback.

3. Dr. Noel proceeded to present the Extended Learning Opportunity (ELO) proposals for the following departments: This aligns with the SIP goal to increase US History to 76%, Math to 44%, Biology to 58%, ELA to 52%. ELO will focus on small group, academic games, question deconstruction, subgroup focus on ELL and ESE. Students enrolled in ELO will be based on BSA results and class performance. Students are currently taking BSA's for each EOC area.
