Call to Order: The School Advisory Council (SAC) meeting was called to order at 4:41 pm by Mrs. Robbi Beth Centeio.

Principal's Report:

- **FAST testing at 97% complete for FAST PM2**
 - **ELA is currently at 57% proficient for the school; currently 1 point behind last years pace.**
 - **Math is currently at 44% proficient for school; last year PM2 was 27%. Math as currently 2 points ahead of last year's pace.**
 - **37% of our lowest quartile students have already made learning gains.**
 - **7th grade ELA 57% learning gains already but it is it not the final score**
- **Boys' basketball championship game held at Stranahan High School, Thursday 12/18/26**
- **Reminder: Accountability funds no longer roll over.**

Department Updates

- **Social Studies:** Civic students are taking the Civics assessment; results will be reviewed to identify student needs
- **Math:** Algebra and Geometry students are taking midterms exams; data will be available for the next meeting.
- **Science:** Biology midterms are in progress; additional midterm data will be reviewed at the next meeting.
- **Reading:** MAP testing is being completed. An initiative led by Dr. Green will provide student-specific FAST standard breakdown sheets to support goal setting and target small groups.
- **Elective Department:** No updates at this time.
- **ELA:** No additional updates beyond PM2 completion and upcoming data chats.
- **Inclusive Practices/ ESE Program:** ESE students attended an immersive Egypt exhibit field trip; the trip was reported as successful.
- **Media Center:** Collection value is \$11,000+ in books. Collection is approximately 51% fiction and 48% nonfiction. Focus areas include increasing the average publication age of the collection and increasing students' usage of Sora (district rank #3 among middle school) and Gale (district rank #5). Plans include incentives after winter break and staff support/ training on Sora.
